### Out-Homered

Last night, Washington hit a pair of solo home runs while the Braves failed to leave the yard. It marked Atlanta's 15th game without a longball this season, playing to a 6-9 record in that regard.

Since the beginning of 2023, the Braves have played to just a 5-52 record (.088) when getting out-homered by at least two. The MLB average winning percentage in such games is .139.

Atlanta hadn't won with a two-homer deficit since July 31, 2025 at Cincinnati, an extra-inning affair that saw both teams score eight runs in the eighth inning.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Braves and Nationals today continue a three-game weekend series with the sixth of 13 scheduled games between the two teams this season...Atlanta and Washington are set to see each other next from July 30-August 2 at Truist Park for a four-game series.

**A** Atlanta is in the midst of its first of two three-game homestands this season...The team will host another from September 22-24, when it welcomes Cincinnati for three games, before finishing the regular season with three games at Miami.

**A** The Braves snatched the series opener in extra innings last night, 5-4...The team moved to 12-5 in series openers overall and to 8-1 in series openers at home.

**A** Atlanta took three-of-four from Washington at Nationals Park earlier this season, April 20-23...The club went 9-4 against Washington last year, and has won the season set versus the Nationals in seven of the last eight seasons dating to 2018...The Braves are 81-49 (.623) in 130 total games against the Nationals in that span.

**A** RHP Jake Irvin is set to duel the Braves for the ninth time in his big-league career, tied for his most starts against any club...The 6-foot-6, 234-pound Minnesotan has also faced the New York Mets nine times...In his eight previous starts against Atlanta, Irvin has pitched to a 2-3 record and a 3.98 ERA (19 ER/43.0 IP)...He last faced the Braves on April 20, when he allowed four runs, three earned, across 5.0 innings at Nationals Park...The Braves won that game, 9-4.

**A** RHP Grant Holmes is slated to pitch for the Braves today after navigating 6.0 scoreless innings against Boston in his last turn...He scattered five hits and a walk while striking out four batters...The native of Conway, SC will make just his second start (3rd appearance) against Washington...In his first two outings against the Nationals, the 6-foot-0, 226-pound right-hander has pitched 7.1 innings and allowed just one run, good for a 1.23 ERA...The only team he's faced multiple times and maintained a lower ERA against is San Diego (1.13 ERA).

**DIVISION LEAD:** Atlanta's win last night, coupled with Philadelphia's loss to Cleveland, increased the Braves' division lead to a season-high 10.5 games...It's the largest division lead in MLB by a wide margin.

**A** The next-largest lead belongs to Tampa Bay, which maintains a 5.5-game lead on the New York Yankees entering play...The Cleveland Guardians (+3.5 games), Milwaukee Brewers (+2.5 games), Athletics (+1.5) and Los Angeles Dodgers (+0.5) are the other leaders.

**A** Today marks the first time the Braves have held a double-digit lead in the National League East since October 1, 2023, when they won the division by 14 games over the Phillies.

**A** Atlanta went 965 days between double-digit division leads.

**COMEBACK:** The Braves entered the bottom of the 10th inning saddled with a two-run deficit, 4-2, before scoring three unanswered runs to walk off the Nationals, 5-4, in 11 innings.

**A** C Chadwick Tromp, who entered the game in the seventh inning, logged two extra-inning, RBI-knocks to advance the cause...Since 2008, he's one of just two Braves with multiple hits and multiple RBI in extra innings, joining Peter Bourjos on April 11, 2018 at Washington.

**A** The last MLB player to do so while coming off the bench was Seth Brown, achieved the feat for the Athletics on September 6, 2024.

**A** Atlanta hadn't won a game wherein it faced a multi-run deficit in extra innings since August 20, 2022 versus Houston.

**A** The Braves are 18-16 (.529) when they trail at any point in a game, the only team in MLB with a winning record under such circumstances...For context, the average winning percentage after trailing in a game is .312.

**A** Atlanta has played to a 43-40 all-time record in extra-inning games against Washington.

**BUNT:** Ha-Seong Kim dropped down a go-ahead safety squeeze in the bottom of last night's seventh inning, just the third bunt-RBI of Kim's six-season MLB career.

**A** The Braves' three bunt-RBI this year are tied for most in the National League and for second most in baseball, only trailing the Tampa Bay Rays...Eli White owns Atlanta's other two bunt-RBI, one of five players in the majors with multiple.

**A** Atlanta's three bunt-RBI are already the team's most in a single season since the 2018 club logged four...The Braves tallied three bunt-RBI in the last six seasons combined, from 2020-25.

**AUSTIN RILEY:** Reached base in all four of his plate appearances last night in a 3-for-3 performance...He also drew a walk and scored the go-ahead run in the seventh.

**A** Since the calendar turned to May, Riley is slashing .270/.321/.500 (20-for-74), including five home runs and 14 RBI across 20 games.

**RAISEL IGLESIAS:** Fired a perfect ninth inning to preserve last night's stalemate...Atlanta's closer has yet to allow an earned run in 15 outings and 15.2 innings pitched this year.

**A** Iglesias is the only hurler in the National League that's maintaining a 0.00 ERA (min. 15 appearances)...Seattle's Matt Brash is the only other pitcher across the majors with a sterling ERA, doing so across 16 outings.

**A** The right-hander also extended his scoreless innings streak to 28.1 frames, the second-longest active in MLB behind Cristopher Sánchez (PHI, 37.2 IP)...He has converted 26 straight saves dating to July 28, 2025, which is also the second-longest active run in MLB trailing Aroldis Chapman (BOS, 27 games).

#### Today's Game

- Makes his 10th start of the season this afternoon in the second game of a three-game weekend series against Washington at Truist Park.
- Owens a 1.23 ERA (1 ER/7.1 IP) over a pair of career appearances against the Nationals, one of them a start...Tossed 6.1 innings of one-run ball in his lone career start versus Washington, May 12, 2025 at Truist Park, a no-decision in a 4-3 Atlanta win.
- Earned the win in his last turn on May 17 against Boston, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings on five hits with one walk and four strikeouts on 87 pitches in an 8-1 victory at Truist Park...A rain delay ended his outing.
  - The scoreless start snapped a six-start streak of allowing two-plus earned runs dating to April 8 at Anaheim, and marked his first scoreless turn since April 3 at Arizona.
- Enters play with a streak of 30 consecutive appearances issuing at least one walk dating to March 31, 2025, the 22nd-longest active streak in the majors.
- Has posted four quality starts over his first nine outings this season, going 3-1 with a 3.80 ERA (20 ER/47.1 IP) and 34 strikeouts...Holding opposing hitters to a .213 batting average (38-for-178) on the year.
- Has issued 22 walks and surrendered seven home runs through nine starts, equating to a 4.18 BB/9 and a 1.33 HR/9.
- His 37 career starts for the Braves are the most in Atlanta-franchise history by a South Carolina-born player.
- Made his second career Opening Day roster with the Braves this season after also breaking camp with the club to open 2025...Went 1-0 with a 1.02 ERA in five Grapefruit League appearances (four starts), fanning 20 over 17.2 innings with just one walk.

#### 2026

- Earned the win on May 17 against Boston, allowing no runs on five hits over 6.0 innings with one walk and four strikeouts on 87 pitches in Atlanta's 8-1 victory at Truist Park...A rain delay ended his afternoon.
- Received a no-decision on May 12 against Chicago (NL), allowing two earned runs on one hit over 4.0 innings with four walks and five strikeouts on 78 pitches in Atlanta's 5-2 victory at Truist Park...The lone hit was a solo home run to Alex Bregman in the fourth inning.
- Was the seventh Braves pitcher since 2000 to allow two-plus earned runs while exiting his start having allowed one hit or fewer, and the first since Spencer Strider on June 15, 2022 at Washington (5.2 IP, 1 H, 2 ER)...Marked the first Atlanta pitcher to do so while issuing four-plus walks since Jorge Sosa on July 3, 2005 (5.1 IP, 1 H, 3 ER, 4 BB).
- Was charged with five earned runs over 5.0 innings in a no-decision on May 1 at Colorado, scattering seven hits with three walks and four strikeouts on 87 pitches in Atlanta's 8-6 victory at Coors Field...The six total runs allowed in that outing tied his career high, last reached on April 26, 2025 at Arizona.
- Reached 200 career strikeouts on April 3 at Chase Field in Arizona.
- Went 1-0 with a 1.02 ERA in five spring appearances (four starts), fanning 20 over 17.2 innings with just one walk...Did not allow a run in his first four outings before surrendering two earned runs over 5.1 innings in his final spring start on March 24 against Tampa Bay.

#### Career Recap

- Awards: Midwest League Midseason All-Star (2015); Texas League Pitcher of the Week (July 30, 2017).
- In his MLB debut season in 2024, went 2-1 with a 3.27 ERA (11 ER/30.1 IP) in 26 relief appearances and one start...Was recalled by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on August 8, 2024.
- In 2022, pitched for three different minor league teams throughout the Oakland and Atlanta organizations...Separately, went 1-2 with Triple-A Las Vegas before joining the Braves system.
- Pitched the entire 2021 season for Triple-A Las Vegas and saw more relief appearances (29) than starts (7) for first time in career.
- Set career highs and led the team in games (50) and saves (13) in 2023 with Triple-A Gwinnett...Led all Stripers relievers in strikeouts (74).
- Named Gatorade Player of the Year in South Carolina following his senior year in 2014.
- Selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2014 June draft (Conway High School, SC).
- On August 1, 2016, traded by the Dodgers to the Oakland Athletics along with RHP Frankie Montas and RHP Jharel Cotton for OF Josh Reddick and RHP Rich Hill.
- Pitched 10 seasons in the minors before making his MLB debut.
- Signed by the Atlanta Braves as a minor league free agent on August 13, 2022.
