AROUND THE HORN

VOTE D-BACKS: Voting is open on the 2026 KONAMI eBaseball MLB All-Star Ballot for the MLB All-Star Game exclusively online and via mobile devices at MLB.com/vote, all 30 Club web sites, the MLB App and the MLB Ballpark App until the voting period for Phase 1 concludes at 9:00 a.m. PHX on June 25.

MEXICAN HERITAGE NIGHT: Tonight, fans can enjoy a night of culture, music and dance with Mexican Heritage Night presented by Coors Light... fans who purchase the Special Event Ticket Pack will receive both a game ticket and a Mexican-inspired D-backs jersey...the evening will feature a ceremonial first pitch by acclaimed Phoenix chef and restaurateur Rene Andrade and national anthem performances by renowned mariachi duo Luis and Angel Garcia...pregame recognitions will honor ASU's Marco Serrato as well as Team Mexico.

HERE'S THE STORY: Since May 9, the D-backs are 9-3 in their last 12 home games...9 home wins are tied for second in the NL (also: Mets), behind the Brewers (10).

- Since May 9, the D-backs' 15 wins (15-9) are tied for fourth in the NL (also: Phillies), behind the Brewers (17), Braves (16) and Dodgers (16).
- Since May 15, the D-backs are 12-4 in their last 16 games against NL West opponents (6-0 vs. Giants, 5-2 vs. Rockies, 1-2 vs. Dodgers).
- Since April 26 vs. NL West rivals, the D-backs are tops in the division in wins (13), win percentage (.765), AVG (.283) and OBP (.347).

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 7-0 vs. Dodgers last night.

- **Gabriel Moreno** made his third career start batting third in the lineup and had 1 double.
- **Taylor Clarke, Ryan Thompson** and **Jonathan Loaisiga** combined for 3.0 scoreless innings with 1 walk and 4 strikeouts.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled LHP **Philip Abner** and RHP **Kade Strowd** from Triple-A Reno, optioned RHP **Brandon Pfaadt** to Reno following last night's game and placed RHP **Taylor Clarke** on the family medical emergency list.

UPCOMING MILESTONES: The D-backs are 1 win shy (2,199) of 2,200 regular-season wins as a franchise.

- **Corbin Carroll** is 1 triple shy of tying Stephen Drew's 52 (773 G) for the club record.
- **Torey Lovullo** is 4 wins shy of 700 in his D-backs' managerial tenure.

SERIES RESULTS: The D-backs have won 5 of their last 7 series, including 2 sweeps (W 2-1 vs. Mets, L 1-2 @ Rangers, W 2-1 @ Rockies, W 3-0 vs. Giants, W 3-1 vs. Rockies, W 3-0 @ Giants, L 0-3 @ Mariners).

- The D-backs look to secure their eighth home series or split tonight in their 10th overall (5 wins, 2 losses, 2 splits).

IT'S HOT AT HOME: **Ketel Marte** owns an 11-game home on-base streak, batting .429 (18-for-42)/1.350 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 17 RBI and 5 walks, including 7 games reaching base 2+ times.

- **Nolan Arenado** has reached base in 18 of his last 19 home starts, hitting .344 (22-for-64)/1.065 OPS with 6 doubles, 4 homers, 13 RBI, 8 walks and 3 HBP.
- **Ryan Waldschmidt**, in 13 home games, is batting .421 (16-for-38)/1.016 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 5 RBI and 3 walks, including 7 multi-hit games.
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base in 8 of his last 9 home games, batting .368 (14-for-38)/1.095 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 triples, 1 homer, 5 RBI and 1 walk, including 5 games reaching base 2+ times.

WITH THE LEATHER: **Ketel Marte** is 1 of 2 middle infielders (also: 2B McLain/CIN) and 1 of 6 infielders overall without an error (also: Freeman/LAD, McLain, Rumfield/COL, Stewart/CIN and Walker/HOU) [min. 375.0 inn.].

MORENO UP TOP: **Gabriel Moreno** has batted third in the lineup in back-to-back games for the first time in his career and reached base 4 times (1B, 2B, 2 BB).

- When batting 1-3 in the lineup, owns an 8-game hitting streak at a .414 clip (12-for-29)/1.041 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 4 RBI and 3 walks, including 4 multi-hit efforts.
- In 22 career games, is hitting .398 (35-for-88)/1.024 OPS with 10 doubles, 2 homers, 15 RBI and 8 walks.

VS. THE SOUTHPAWS: The D-backs have won 3 of their last 4 games vs. left-handed starters and are 9-4 overall this season, including a 5-1 home record.

- Vs. lefties overall, the D-backs lead the Majors in AVG (.279) and fewest strikeouts (105)...rank second in OPS (.787) and SLG (.451), behind the Yankees (.806/.467).

BULLPEN FOCUS: **Ryan Thompson** has allowed 1 run over his last 12 games, going 1-1 with a 0.77 ERA (1 ER in 11.2 IP), 2 walks and 8 strikeouts, including 4 outings of 1.1+ innings.

- **Kevin Ginkel** has stranded all 11 of his inherited runners.
- **Brandyn Garcia** is scoreless in his last 8 games (6.1 IP) with a 0.95 WHIP, 1 walk, 5 strikeouts and 0 extra-base hits...has not allowed an earned run (1 R) in 12 home games (11.0 IP) since Sept. 16, 2025, with a 0.82 WHIP, 1 walk and 10 strikeouts.

VS. DODGERS: The D-backs look to secure their second straight 4-game split at home (last: May 8-11, 2025).

- **Ketel Marte** has reached base in 25 of his last 27 games, hitting .301 (31-for-103)/.945 OPS with 5 doubles, 7 homers, 13 RBI, 15 walks and 1 HBP...has homered in 2 of his last 4 games with 4 RBI.
- **Corbin Carroll**, has reached base 18 times in his last 13 games (14 H, 4 BB)/.884 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers and 7 RBI, including 6 games reaching base 2+ times.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base 26 times in his last 21 games, hitting .301 (22-for-73) with 5 doubles, 2 homers, 9 RBI and 4 walks.

ON DECK VS. NATIONALS: The D-backs are 8-4 in their last 12 home games since 2022 and have taken 3 of the last 4 series at Chase Field.

- Has won in his last 4 decisions.
- In his last 5 starts, is 4-0 with a 2.36 ERA (9 ER in 34.1 IP), opponent .213 AVG, 7 walks and 19 strikeouts.
- In his last 2 home bids, is 2-0 with a 2.77 ERA (4 ER in 13.0 IP), 3 walks and 10 strikeouts.
