**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners play the second of a 4-game series tonight at the Baltimore Orioles (1-0)...Seattle is coming off a 3-game series at the Detroit Tigers (1-2) to start the trip, and will face the Washington Nationals (3 G, June 12-14) as the third and final leg...tonight's game against the O's will be televised and streamed live on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** on the call, with **Brad Adam** serving as field reporter...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Gary Hill Jr.** and **Shannon Drayer** on the call.

**ODDS & ENDS**...the Mariners won last night's series opener against the Orioles by a 6-3 score...Seattle is 10-3 (.769) since May 25, 13-6 (.684) since May 18, and 18-12 (.600) since May 6.

- **Best In The West** - The Mariners (35-32) are in first place in the American League West Division, 2.0 games ahead of the second place Rangers (32-33).
- **Rye Bread & Mustard** - Seattle has hit 21 grand slams since 2023, the most in the American League and 3rd most in the Majors behind the Diamondbacks (27 HR) and Dodgers (22 HR).
- **No Fly Zone** - **Julio Rodríguez** last night became the 5th outfielder in Mariners history with 10+ putouts in a 9-inning game...he also became only the 2nd outfielder in franchise history with 10+ putouts and an outfield assist in a game along with Dave Henderson (6/16/1984 vs. TEX).
- **Swung On And Belted** - The Mariners are 31-16 (.660) when they homer in a game, as opposed to 4-16 (.200) when they do not homer.

**MARINERS.COM/VOTE**...All-Star voting is underway for the 2026 MLB All-Star Game on July 14 at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia...fans can submit up to 5 ballots per day until the conclusion of Phase 1 at 9:00 a.m. PT on June 25...Phase 2, which takes the finalists at each position, will run from June 29-July 2 before the All-Star rosters are announced on July 4 at 4:30 p.m. PT...for more information and to vote, visit [Mariners.com/Vote](http://Mariners.com/Vote).

**ROAD WALTER**...in 5 starts on the road this season, **Logan Gilbert** has posted an impressive 0.94 ERA (3 ER, 28.2 IP) with 5 walks and 30 strikeouts...among all Major League starters on the road this season (min. 25.0 IP), his ERA ranks 2nd to only Shohei Ohtani-LAD (0.60 ERA)... since 2023, Gilbert's 3.40 ERA (38 ER, 100.2 IP) on the road ranks 9th in MLB (min. 100 IP)...over his last 3 starts since May 22 (both at T-Mobile Park and on the road), he is 2-0 with a 1.59 ERA (3 ER, 17.0 IP) with 5 walks and 20 strikeouts.

**SMOOTH SAILING**...during the Mariners current 10-3 stretch (5/25-c), the pitching staff holds an MLB-best 2.81 ERA (37 ER, 118.2 IP)...Seattle pitchers also lead the AL and rank 2nd in MLB with a 1.00 WHIP during that span, trailing only the Dodgers (0.99)...also during the span, the Seattle offense ranks 2nd in MLB in batting average (.285), 3rd in slugging (.495), 3rd in OPS (.833) and 1st in home runs (25)...their .495 slugging percentage leads the American League.

**COLE ON A ROLL**...**Cole Young** has hit safely in his last 11-consecutive games since May 27, batting .318 (14x44) with 6 runs, 1 home run, 4 RBI, 2 walks and just 5 strikeouts during the span, reaching base at a .354 clip with a .740 OPS in 49 plate appearances...overall this season, Young is batting .252 (60x238) with 28 runs, 10 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 31 RBI, 20 walks and 2 stolen bases...he leads Major League second basemen with 12 defensive runs saved this season and ranks 5th among all position players.

**RANDY: FIT TO BE AN ALL-STAR**...**Randy Arozarena** last night went 3-for-4 with 1 RBI for his 20th multi-hit game of the season...his single in the 4th inning also marked his 800th career hit...Randy has been a steady offensive presence this season, batting .293 (72x246) with 43 runs, 18 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs, 30 RBI, 27 walks and 18 stolen bases, getting on base at a .381 clip and slugging .447 for an .828 OPS in 67 games...among AL outfielders with at least 200 plate appearances, Arozarena ranks 2nd in average, 3rd in OPS, 5th in OBP, T-1st in fWAR (2.3), 1st in stolen bases and 1st in doubles.

**STILL NAYLING IT**...**Josh Naylor** hit a grand slam in the 5th inning of last night's game, his 3rd career grand slam and first with the Mariners...since April 17, he is batting .325 (55x169) with 22 runs, 7 doubles, 5 home runs, 23 RBI, 15 walks, 12 stolen bases, a .382 OBP, a .456 slugging percentage and an .838 OPS... during that span, Naylor ranks 2nd in MLB in average, T-3rd in hits and 4th in stolen bases.

**J-ROD: ALL-STAR BOUND (AGAIN!)**...**Julio Rodríguez** has made the All-Star Game in 3 of his first 4 seasons and has the chance to make it 4 out of 5...only 33 players in MLB history have earned a nod to the Midsummer Classic in at least 4 of their first 5 seasons, with 2 of them being Mariners: Hall of Famers Ken Griffey Jr. and Ichiro Suzuki...Julio is batting .256 (69x270) with 37 runs, 14 doubles, 13 home runs, 32 RBI, 22 walks, 9 stolen bases, a .315 OBP and is slugging .452 for a .767 OPS in 67 games.

**CAL WORKING HIS WAY BACK**...**Cal Raleigh** (right oblique strain) is set to join Triple-A Tacoma today to make his 2nd rehab appearance...on Sunday, Cal went 1-for-3 as the designated hitter with High-A Everett...fans with a **Mariners.TV** subscription have access to **MiLB.TV** and can watch Raleigh, along with Mariners top prospects like **Kade Anderson**, **Ryan Sloan**, **Lazaro Montes**, and others in the farm system.

**THE KID KEEPS SWINGING IT**...over his first 19 career games, **Colt Emerson** is batting .242 (15x62) with 9 runs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 10 RBI and 5 walks, reaching base at a .319 clip and slugging .548 with an .867 OPS...ten of Colt's 15 hits have gone for extra bases...Emerson is 1 of 7 players age 20-or-younger with 10+ extra-base hits and a .545+ slugging percentage over his first 19 career games and the first since Rafael Devers-BOS in 2017.

**MARINERS POST-GAME ALUMNI HOME RUN DERBY SET FOR AUGUST 7**...the Mariners announced the club will hold its first ever Alumni Home Run Derby, with participants including Hall of Famer **Ichiro Suzuki**, Mariners legend **Mike Cameron**, broadcasters **Ryan Rowland-Smith** and **Ryon Healy**, Bullpen Coach **Austin Nola**, local radio host **Bucky Jacobsen** and former Mariner **Stefen Romero**...all fans with a ticket to the game on Friday, Aug. 7 will have access to the Alumni Home Run Derby.

**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...**Randy Arozarena** last night went 3-for-4 with 1 RBI, his 20th multi-hit game of the season...**YOU MAY ALSO KNOW**...Randy recorded his 800th career hit on his single in the 4th inning last night and is 1 stolen base shy of notching 150 career stolen bases, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...that when Randy steals his next base, he will become just one of 5 players in the Major Leagues since 2019 to record 800+ hits and 150+ stolen bases?...Arozarena will join Shohei Ohtani-LAA/LAD, José Ramírez-CLE, Ronald Acuña Jr.-ATL and Trea Turner-3Tms as the players to accomplish the feat during that span.

### ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - JUNE 9

- **1979** - "Willie Horton Night" honors the Mariners DH who belted his 300th career home run June 6th, the 43rd player to reach that milestone. A crowd of 40,314 was in the Kingdome.
- **1999** - Ken Griffey Jr. hits 3rd deck façade in RF (478') at Coors Field to tie for 6th longest in Coors history.
- **2009** - M's select Dustin OF Dustin Ackley from the University of North Carolina with the 2nd overall pick in the 1st Year Player Draft. Ackley was the M's highest overall selection since Alex Rodriguez was chosen 1st overall in 1993.
- **2014** - Félix Hernández is named the American League Pitcher of the Week for the period ending June 8th. Hernandez went 1-0 with a 1.29 ERA, one walk and 23 strikeouts in 14.0 innings over two starts to claim his second career weekly honor.

ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT...

- Gilbert, 29, is making his 14th start of the season and the 160th start of his career...also marks his first start against the Orioles this season and the 4th of his career.
• Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau on June 16, 2018.
• Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitcher of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Conference.
• Named the 2022 and the 2024 Mariners Most Valuable Pitcher by the Seattle Chapter of the BBWAA.
• Named to his 1st All-Star team in 2024.

LAST TIME OUT...W#4 on June 2 vs. the Mets, tossed 5.1 innings and allowed 3 runs (3 ER) on 4 hits (2 HR) with 1 walk and 8 strikeouts...he threw 99 pitches (66 strikes) in his 8th home start of the year...he has factored into the win in each of his last 2 starts (also: 5/27 at ATH).

ROAD WARRIOR...owns a 0.94 ERA (3 ER, 28.2 IP) with 30 strikeouts to just 20 hits and 5 walks allowed across 5 road starts this season...among qualifying pitchers this season, his ERA ranks 2nd-best while his 0.87 WHIP is 8th-best...his 0.94 road ERA is the best ERA in franchise history across a pitcher's first 5 road starts of the season, ranking ahead of Randy Johnson's 1.08 ERA (4 ER, 33.1 IP) through his first 5 road starts in 1995.

GOOD MORNING BALTIMORE...is making his first start against the Orioles since Aug. 13, 2025 when he threw 6.1 innings and allowed 2 runs (2 ER) on 4 hits (1 HR) with 2 walks and 6 strikeouts at Camden Yards...in his first career start against Baltimore on June 23, 2023, he threw 7.0 innings of 1-run baseball (1 ER) while allowing just 2 hits and 1 walk with 5 strikeouts, in the Mariners' 13-1 win on the road.

#50...earned his 50th career win in his last road start on May 27 at the Athletics, becoming the 13th pitcher in Mariners history with 50+ career wins with the club...joins teammate George Kirby who also surpassed 50 career wins on May 11 at Houston.

WELCOME JUNE...is 12-5 and owns a 3.35 ERA (52 ER, 139.2 IP) with 137 strikeouts to 25 walks allowed across 24 career starts in June...among pitchers with 20+ career starts in June since 2021, his 1.024 career WHIP in June ranks 2nd in MLB, trailing only Max Fried (1.022), while his 5.48 strikeout-to-walk ratio in June is 2nd-best, trailing only George Kirby (7.40).

MAY FLOWERS...was 2-1 with a 3.26 ERA (11 ER, 30.1 IP), 30 strikeouts and 8 walks allowed across 5 starts in May...marked his lowest ERA across any month of May in his career...finished the month with a 0.890 WHIP which is the 7th-lowest mark in any month of his career and his lowest of any month since a 0.791 WHIP in April/March of 2025.

SHUTTING IT DOWN...has thrown 6.0+ IP without an earned run allowed in 2 starts this season (last: 5/27 at ATH) and in 18 career starts...he has thrown 7.0+ IP without an earned run allowed in 9 career starts, including 5 times in 2024...his 5 such starts in 2024 were tied for the most in MLB that season.

AMONG THE LEAGUE...among American League leaders since 2021, he ranks 1st in strikeouts (961 SO) and in total starts (159 GS), ranks 3rd in innings pitched (909.0 IP), 4th in quality starts (74 QS), T-7th in K/BB (4.85), T-8th in wins (51) alongside Baltimore's Dean Kremer, T-9th in WHIP (1.06), and 9th in BB/9 (1.96)...his 84 career starts with 6.0+ innings thrown are tied for tied for 3rd-most in AL since 2021 while his 26 games with 7.0+ innings are 8th-most among AL pitchers.

IN COMMAND...has thrown 8+ strikeouts with 1-or-fewer walks in 29 career starts, including twice this season (last: 6/2 vs. NYM)...his 29 such starts are 10th-most in MLB since 2021...his 49 starts of 7+ strikeouts and 1-or-fewer walks are 3rd-most in MLB since 2021, trailing only Aaron Nola (55) and Zack Wheeler (52).

STAYING OFF THE BASE PATHS...in his May 10 start vs. the White Sox, he allowed only 1 base runner for his 7th career start with 2-or-fewer base runners allowed over 6.0+ innings...his 7 such games are most in MLB since 2021.

QUALITY CONTROL...has thrown a quality start with 1-or-fewer walks issued in 58 career games (last: 5/10 at CWS), the 5th-most such games in MLB since 2021, just trailing behind rotation-mate George Kirby (59)...his 27 quality starts without a walk are T-5th-most in MLB since 2021.

AMONG THE GREATS...his 3.59 career ERA (363 ER, 909.0 IP) is 5th-best among pitchers in Mariners history (min. 500 IP), trailing Randy Johnson, Félix Hernández, Hisashi Iwakuma, and James Paxton who each hold a 3.42 career ERA, and ranks ahead of Luis Castillo (3.62)...his 961 career strikeouts are 5th-most in Mariners history (next: Mark Langston, 1078 SO)...he also ranks 1st in WHIP (1.062), T-2nd in K/9 (9.5, also James Paxton), and 2nd in K/BB (4.85) only behind George Kirby's 6.17 K/BB (min. 500 IP).

HEY BATTER BATTER SWING...recorded a season-high 21 swings and misses in his last start vs. the Mets, tied for the 4th-most in a single game across his career...among American League leaders this season, his 28.9% whiff rate ranks 7th-best (min. 750 pitches) while his 171 swings and misses are 9th-most...his 2,080 career swing and misses rank 5th-most in MLB since 2021...also owns a 43.5 career whiff rate on his splitter, ranking 3rd among pitchers with 1000 splitters thrown since 2021.
