PITTSBURGH PIRATES (8-15) vs. LOS ANGELES ANGELS (11-10)

April 22, 2025 - Angel Stadium - Anaheim, CA - 6:38 PDT - Game #24/Road #11

LHP Bailey Falter (1-2, 4.91 ERA) vs. RHP José Soriano (2-2, 3.16 ERA)

THE PIRATES: had the day off yesterday in Anaheim following a 3-4 homestand from April 14-20 against Washington (3-1) and Cleveland (0-3), concluding a stretch of 13 out of 16 games being played at PNC Park...Are beginning their third road trip of the season, which will wrap up this coming weekend with three games at Dodger Stadium.

CLOSE CALLS: The Pirates have played in eight one-run games this season, including Sunday's 5-4, 10-inning loss against the Guardians...Pittsburgh is one of four National League teams to play eight one-run games in 2025 (Dodgers, Mets and Padres)... The Pirates are also one of two National League teams to play four extra-inning games so far this year, along with the Cardinals.

<u>LET'S GO REYNOLDS</u>: Bryan Reynolds went 7-for-14 with a home run and two RBI over the three-game weekend series vs. Cleveland, including three-hit efforts on Friday and Sunday...The seven hits were tied for Reynolds' most in any three-game series in his career...Reynolds also had seven hits in Pittsburgh's three-game sweep of the Red Sox at Fenway Park from April 3-5, 2023.

RELIABLE RELIEVER: Justin Lawrence has pitched 9.2 consecutive scoreless innings, the second-longest scoreless streak by a Pirates pitcher this year...Andrew Heaney, who pitched for the Angels from 2015-21, will bring a scoreless streak of 10.1 innings into his start here tomorrow...Lawrence's 14 strikeouts are tied for 11th-most among National League relievers...He has multiple punchouts in six of his appearances, tied for second-most among all Major League relievers (Los Angeles-NL's Kirby Yates has eight).

PESKY LEFTIES: Southpaws Bailey Falter (7.0ip/0r on April 16) and former Angel Andrew Heaney (7.1ip/0r on Thursday) turned in scoreless outings of 7.0-plus innings in consecutive team games during last week's series vs. Washington, making them the first pair of Pirates left-handed starters to throw 7.0-plus scoreless innings in back-to-back team games since John Candelaria (9.0ip) and Larry McWilliams (7.0ip) did so from July 25-27, 1982 (per the Elias Sports Bureau)...Pittsburgh's 89.1 innings from lefties in 2025 are the most in all of Major League Baseball (the Angels are sixth with 74.2 innings), while its 71 strikeouts are tied with the Angels and Cubs for seventh-most in all of MLB.

HERE COMES FRAZIER: Adam Frazier has hit safely in five straight and six of his last seven games, with three doubles in that span...In Sunday's game vs. Cleveland, Frazier doubled, recorded two RBI and stole a base, his first time recording an extra-base hit, two RBI and a steal in a game since September 11, 2022, with Seattle vs. Atlanta...Over 32 career games against the Angels, Frazier is 29-for-92 (.315) with 14 runs and 12 RBI.

HELLO, ANAHEIM: This week's three-game series marks only Pittsburgh's fifth trip to Angel Stadium since interleague play began in 1997, with the Pirates having won six of their last nine games in Anaheim (3-0 in 2013, 2-1 in 2019, 1-2 in 2023)...In Pittsburgh's 2023 visit to Orange County, Henry Davis homered twice off Shohei Ohtani in the July 21 game (Jack Suwinski also hit his 20th home run of the season that night)...In the Pirates' win on July 22, Endy Rodríguez took Gerardo Reyes deep for his first big-league homer.

PITCHING PROWESS: Pittsburgh's 3.12 ERA (101.0ip/35er) as a staff over its last 11 games (since April 9 vs. St. Louis) ranks seventh in all of Major League Baseball...The Pirates' 2.75 ERA from their bullpen during that stretch is the sixth-lowest mark in Major League Baseball...Pittsburgh's pitching staff has posted a .205 batting average against in that span, the third-lowest mark in all of Major League Baseball, behind only Texas (.186) and New York-AL (.197)... The Pirates' 31 walks issued during that stretch are the seventh-fewest in MLB.

BUCS ON THE BASES: With Adam Frazier's steal in Sunday's game vs. Cleveland, Pittsburgh has now stolen 29 bases this season, fourth-most in Major League Baseball, behind Milwaukee (34), Seattle (32) and Chicago-NL (31)...The Pirates have six players with multiple stolen bases (Cruz, Frazier, Hayes, Kiner-Falefa, Pham and Suwinski), tied for fourth-most in all of MLB... Only Seattle (8), Milwaukee (7) and Washington (7) have more-such players.

HOW ACQUIRED: From Philadelphia in deal for INF Rodolfo Castro on 8/1/23.

STARTING OFF: The 27-year-old lefty (turns 28 on Thursday) is in his third season with the Pirates after being acquired from the Phillies at the trade deadline on August 1, 2023...Falter is in his fifth Major League season after making his debut in 2021... He was selected by Philadelphia in the fifth round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Falter won a 6-1 decision against Washington on April 16 at PNC Park...In that start, he tossed 7.0 scoreless innings while allowing just two hits and one walk...He became the first Pirates left-handed pitcher to have such a start since Jeff Locke went 8.0 scoreless with two hits and zero walks on July 4, 2015, vs. Cleveland.

AGAINST THE ANGELS: This will be Falter's first career appearance against the Angels...Los Angeles (AL) is one of five teams Falter has yet to face as a big leaguer, along with Detroit, Kansas City, Minnesota and Tampa Bay...Falter has a 4.54 ERA (39.2ip/20er) in nine appearances (eight starts) against the American League West.

ALL GOOD THINGS COME TO AN END: In his start on April 5, Falter had his streak of plate appearances without hitting a batter snapped at 1124 (began on August 20, 2022) when he hit New York (AL)'s Jazz Chisholm Jr. to start the second inning... According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the last pitcher with as long of a streak without hitting a batter was Yusmeiro Petit (1205pa) from April 21, 2017 to June 6, 2021.

2024 IN REVIEW: Falter spent his first full season in the big leagues while going 8-9 with a 4.43 ERA in 28 starts with the Pirates in 2024...He was on an Opening Day roster for the third straight season after also doing so with the Phillies in both 2022 and 2023.

MARVELOUS MAY: During the month of May last season, Falter pitched a career-best 19.2 consecutive innings without allowing a run from May 12-24...Overall, he posted a 2.23 ERA (32.1ip/8er) across his five starts that month...Among National League pitchers in the month of May, Falter ranked ninth in innings pitched and 12th in ERA.

STAYING IN THE PARK: Falter surrendered 11 home runs in 68.1 innings (1.45 per 9.0 innings) in his first 12 starts of the 2024 season...In his last 16 starts beginning on June 12, he surrendered six home runs across 74.0 innings, averaging 0.73 per 9.0 innings.

JUST LIKE SANDY: Growing up in Chino Hills, California, Falter's father, Darwin, taught him to idolize fellow left-handed pitcher Sandy Koufax...Bailey would do reports on Koufax at school and even had a framed picture of the Dodgers southpaw hanging above his childhood bed...To this day, his delivery on the mound mimics that of Koufax...In 2024, he ranked in the 98th percentile in extension (per Baseball Savant).

BACK HOME IN CALIFORNIA: Attended Chino Hills High School, where he was classmates with NBA players Lonzo and LaMelo Ball...Falter had committed to play collegiately at the University of California, Santa Barbara prior to being drafted by and signing with Philadelphia in 2015.


