RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their seven-day, six-game road trip with the opener of a three-game series with the division-rival Milwaukee Brewers tonight at American Family Field, their last road series of the season ... The Cardinals began their road trip by dropping two-of-three to the Padres at Petco Park over the weekend.

FLIGHT PATTERN: With six games remaining, the Cardinals enter today in 5th place in the NL Central, 6.0 games behind 4th-place Pittsburgh ... St. Louis has spent 140 of 174 days in last place on the MLB schedule (April 26-May 19, May 29-July 7 & July 28-present) ... The Cardinals 68-88 record is their lowest at the 156-game mark since 1978 when they were 67-89 (.429).

DIVISION MATH: The Cardinals enter tonight's game with an 18-28 mark (.391) in divisional play with six games remaining against the Brewers and Reds ... It's their 2nd-lowest mark in divisional play behind 1995 (20-32, .385), and it will be the first time since 2017 (34-42, .447) that they will finish below .500 within the division ... St. Louis has finished .500 or better within the National League Central in 22 of 30 seasons since MLB's six-division alignment began in 1994.

MAKE YOURSELF AT HOME: Paul Goldschmidt has gone yard 18 times at American Family Field, 5th among all visiting players and 2nd among active opponents to **Joey Votto** (24) ... Goldy enjoyed a three-homer game here on March 29, 2019 in his second career game as a Cardinal. **ALL IN THE FAMILY:** The Cardinals have hit the most home runs (233) of all opposing teams at American Family Field since it opened in 2001.

NORTHERN EXPOSURE: Since St. Louis and Milwaukee began regular season play in 1997, the Cardinals own the most wins against the Brewers (238-187, .560) and have the best road winning percentage (122-88, .581) of any team to visit Milwaukee since 1997 ... Their .585 win pct. (110-78) since American Family Field opened in 2001 is tops among all teams who annually play in Milwaukee.

HEIR JORDAN: 21-year-old rookie **Jordan Walker** has hit safely in 18 of his 21 games played in September, and extended his hitting streak to 10 games on Sunday ... With his active 10-game hitting streak (.306/.390/.444, 11-36), Walker is:

- 1 of 8 Major Leaguers (and the only rookie) this season with 3+ different double-digit game hitting streaks (17, 12, 10) ... Walker owns 3 of the 15 longest rookie hit streaks, with **Josh Jung** being the only other rookie with two (14 and 10).
- 1 of just 5 Cardinals rookies since 1900 with three or more different double-digit hitting streaks in the same season, joining **Albert Pujols** (3 in 2021); **Bake McBride** (4 in 1974); **Johnny Mize** (3 in 1936); and **Pug Bennett** (3 in 1906) ... Pujols and Walker are the only two to do so at age 21 or younger. - *Elias*
- The 1st Cardinal overall with three different double-digit hit streaks in same season since **Yadier Molina** (11, 16, 11 in 2016).
- The 10th Cardinals rookie since 2000 to collect 23 or more hits in September/October.

THE TIMES THEY ARE A-CHANGIN': Thursday's series finale was changed from 6:40 p.m. to a 3:10 p.m. CT first pitch to avoid conflicting with Green Bay Packers-Detroit Lions 7:15 p.m. CT scheduled kickoff at Lambeau Field for Thursday Night Football.

- In light of **Adam Wainwright's** retirement ceremony on Sunday, October 1 beginning at 1:30 p.m. CT, the Busch Stadium gates will be opening earlier for all fans at 11:45 a.m. CT ... First pitch is scheduled for 2:15 p.m.

PLAYERS USED: Irving López recently became the 52nd different player to appear for the Cardinals in 2023, breaking the franchise single-season record of 51 shared by the 1997, 2021, and 2022 Redbirds ... Only two Cardinals have avoided the Injured List and been active for every game this season (excluding suspension): **Miles Mikolas** and reigning National League MVP **Paul Goldschmidt**.

MR. SEPTEMBER: Since making his MLB debut in 2019, **Tommy Edman** trails **Trea Turner** (153), **Marcus Semien** (143), and **Freddie Freeman** (141) with 138 combined hits in the month of September ... Edman also ranks among MLB leaders in September in games played (130, T-2nd) and stolen bases (24, 3rd).

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Ryan Helsley made his MLB debut on April 16, 2019 at Milwaukee...his first strikeout victim was Ryan Braun (swinging) that night.

Willson Contreras' younger brother, **William**, is also a catcher for the Brewers.

Jacob Barnes was selected by the Brewers in the 14th round of the 2011 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons (2016-19) in Milwaukee before being claimed off waivers by Kansas City.

Devin Williams was born in nearby Florissant, Mo...was 1st Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Pre-season High School All-American at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the Univ. of Missouri before drafted by Milwaukee in the 2nd round in 2013.

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Dylan Carlson and **Rowdy Tellez** are both graduates of Elk Grove High School, where Dylan's father Jeff Carlson was the head baseball coach.

Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (1994-96) with the Brewers.

Dakota Hudson (freshman) and **Brandon Woodruff** (junior) were teammates at Mississippi State University in 2014.

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** and **Pete Vuckovich** by the Cardinals for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** and **Lary Sorensen**.

Ricky Horton made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA) in the Brewers organization in 1990.

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & broadcaster **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for **Jimmie Coker** and **Gary Kolb** (Apr. 9, 1964).

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

KMOX studio host **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and postgame shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...also was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-Green Bay women's basketball team.

Cardinals AGM/Player Development **Gary LaRocque** was selected by Milwaukee in the 14th round of the 1975 MLB draft.

Cardinals Special Asst. to the GM, Player Procurement **Matt Slater** is a Marquette Univ. graduate...started in pro baseball as the Brewers' Scouting and Player Development Assistant (1991).

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2023 is making his MLB-leading 34th start of 2023, his 177th career appearance & 149th career start.
- Is facing the Brewers for his 2nd-straight start and for the 2nd time in seven days. The Cardinals have been shut out in each of his last four starts vs. Milwaukee.
- His 214 hits allowed lead the majors and are the most allowed by a Cardinals pitcher in a single season since Adam Wainwright (220) in 2016.
- This year marks his fourth 32+ start season among his five active seasons as a Cardinal (missed 2020 COVID-shortened season due to injury).
- Is currently at 52-53 for his career, as his W-L record dipped below .500 following his loss to the Brewers last Thu. (9/21) for the 1st time since July 27, 2014 (3-4, .429 pct).
- He's 48-47 career as a Cardinal despite losing 13 games in back-to-back seasons (2022-23). Miles lost a career-high and NL-leading 14 games in 2019 after winning 18 in 2018.
- Has received 3 runs of support or fewer in 26 of 33 starts this season, including just one run or fewer in 15 of his 33 starts (45%).
- Has crossed the 180.0 innings threshold for the 4th time in his MLB career. Leads the Cardinals in innings pitched (187.1) and shares the team lead in wins (7)
- Has allowed 23 of his 106 runs in the 1st inning (6.27 ERA, .341 BA).
- Since joining the Cardinals in 2018, Mikolas has issued the fewest walks in MLB (min. 750 IP) with 148; **Justin Verlander** (150) is 2nd. His 1.63 walks/9 IP is 2nd behind **Zack Greinke** (1.61) for the fewest in MLB in that span.
- Hasn't committed an error since 8/2/18 vs. COL. One of two pitchers (**Erick Fedde**) with 100+ total chances and zero errors since 8/3/18. Ranks 8th among MLB pitchers in fielding pct. (.988) since 2018 (min. 100 TC). Miles is one of 10 qualifying MLB pitchers with a perfect 1.000 fielding pct. (30 total chances) this season.
- Ranks 2nd among current Cardinals behind only **Adam Wainwright** (2,668.1 IP) in most career innings pitched (819.0) as a member of the Cardinals. He's ranked 58th in Cardinals history in career IP - 8.0 IP back of **Red Ames** (827.0).
- Among all-time Busch Stadium III leaders, ranks 5th in ERA (3.28), T-9th in wins (22) with **Braden Loper**, and 8th in innings pitched (417.2).

- Is making is 15th career start and 16th appearance vs. MIL. It's his 2nd meeting of the season against the Brewers and the 2nd in the past seven days.
- His 8 career wins against MIL are his most against any team, and he has 8 Quality Starts amongst his 14 career starts vs. the Brewers (6 in 8 career starts at MIL).
- Was credited with the win (6-2) in his last appearance at MIL, as the Cardinals clinched the NL Central title on 9/27/22 at American Family Field.
- His last four losses against Milwaukee have all been shutout defeats.
- Struck out a career-high 10 vs. MIL (8/27/19) in a 6-3 win at American Family Field.
- Made one relief appearance coming with the Padres on the final day of the season in 2012, threw 2.0 scoreless innings in a 4-3 loss.
