THE TWINS: Have gone 2-7 through nine games on their 10-game homestand, going 1-2 vs. Arizona, 1-2 vs. New York-AL and 0-3 vs. Cleveland...today, they will play the four-game series finale against the Guardians and conclude the home portion of their 2025 schedule...after today's game, Minnesota will travel to Texas for an off-day on Monday, then play the Rangers for three games at Globe Life Field from Tuesday-Thursday...from there, they will travel to Philadelphia to complete the season with three games against the Phillies next weekend.

GUARDIANS TAKE OVER TARGET FIELD: The Twins lost both games of the doubleheader with Cleveland yesterday, losing game one by a score of 6-0 and game two by a score of 8-0...it marked the third time in Twins history (since 1961) to be shut out twice in a doubleheader (others: May 21, 1961 vs. Cleveland and April 20, 2021 at Oakland).

◆ GAME 1 - Joe Ryan (13-9) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing five runs (4 earned) on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts...Austin Martin had two of the Twins three total hits, one double and one single.

◆ GAME 2 - Bailey Ober (5-9) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing six runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and one strikeout — all six runs allowed came in the fifth inning...the offense recorded just four hits in the second game.

TWINS-GUARDS, THE FINALE: The Twins are playing the Guardians today for the 13th and final time in 2025... Twins have gone 3-9 this season, going 1-4 at Target Field and 2-5 at Progressive Field...these two will first meet in 2026 for three games at Progressive from May 8-10... Twins will host the Guards for the first time next season for three games from July 7-9. ♣ Six of the 11 games this season between these two teams have been decided by one run... the Twins have gone 2-4 in those games. ♣ Since the start of 2024, 16 of the 24 games between these two have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 3-13 in those)...and 11 have been decided by one run (Twins 2-9). ♣ Austin Martin is hitting .346 (9-for-26) in 10 career games against the Guardians.

THE LEFTORIUM: Notable individuals vs. lefties this season:

₱ Brooks Lee is hitting .392 (28-for-96) with an .805 OPS in his last 55 games vs. lefties.

₱ Byron Buxton is hitting .306 (30-for-98) with nine home runs, a .673 slugging percentage and a 1.048 OPS against left-handed pitching on the season — his highest OPS vs. lefties in his career..Buck's .673 slugging percentage ranks third-best in baseball this season, trailing Aaron Judge (.744) and Cal Raleigh (.683).

₱ Austin Martin is hitting .350 (14-for-40) with a .947 OPS against lefties this season.

AUSTIN MARTIN. INTENSITY. DRIVEN.: Austin Martin went 2-for-4 in game one yesterday, extending his career-high on-base streak to 16 games (previous was 8), and extending his hitting streak to eight games (previous career-high of 7)...however, he snapped both streaks in game two, going 0-for-3.

♣ Over his last 24 games, Martin is hitting .342 (27-for-79) with seven doubles, four RBI, 14 runs scored, 14 walks, just 15 strikeouts, a .447 on-base percentage and an .877 OPS.

♣ Martin has posted a .408 on-base percentage in 19 games this month, seventh-best in the AL and 16th-best in baseball.

FINAL DESTINATIONS: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the seventh time this season. The other six were in three games at St. Louis (March 27-30), three games at Atlanta (April 18-20), three games at Houston (June 13-15), three games vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), three games vs. the Athletics (August 19-21) and four games vs. Chicago-AL (September 1-4).

© Other than those six sweeps, the Twins have entered a finale and avoided a sweep eight times this season: April 13 vs. Detroit, June 8 vs. Toronto, June 19 at Cincinnati, July 20 at Colorado, August 3 at Cleveland, August 13 at New York-AL, August 17 vs. Detroit and September 7 at Kansas City.

© The last time the Twins were swept by the Guardians was in three games at Progressive Field, from May 17-19, 2024.

© Last time the Twins were swept by the Guards in Minnesota was in two games (April 4-6, 2024).

© Last time the Twins were swept in four games by the Guards was June 16-18, 2017 at Target Field.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul left-handed pitcher Connor Prielipp and outfielder Kyle Fedko as Twins minor league Pitcher and Player of the Week.

& Prielipp, 24, made two starts for the Saints, posting a .211 opponent batting average with 10 strikeouts over 11.0 innings pitched...the Tomah, WI native was selected by the Twins in the second round (48th overall) in the 2022 MLB Draft out of the University of Alabama.

& Fedko, who turns 26 today, had five hits over 19 at-bats with two doubles, one home run, four RBI and a .943 OPS for the Saints...the Gibsonia, PA native was selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of UCONN.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: On this day in **2010**, the Twins defeated Cleveland by a score of 6-4 and clinched their sixth division title in nine years as Ron Gardenhire earned his 800th managerial win...in **1997**, Brad Radke pitched 10 innings to beat the Brewers 2-1 and earned his 20th win...he is one of 13 pitchers in club history to win 20 games and the last Twins starter to pitch 10 innings in a game.

A BITE OUT OF THE BIG APPLE: Last pitched on September 15 vs. New York-AL, opposite Carlos Rodón, where he earned his seventh win of the season in Minnesota's 7-0, shutout victory...extended his single-season career-high as well as extended his career-high win-streak to five-straight decisions (dating back to June 26)...allowed just two hits with three walks and a career-high 11 strikeouts in 6.0 shutout innings...was his second quality start of the season and ninth of his career.

© Is the fourth Twins pitcher (5th time) to record double-digit strikeouts in a game this season (Joe Ryan x2, Pablo López and Chris Paddack).

© Has now fanned six-or-more batters in three consecutive starts for the first time in his career.

© Picked off José Caballero in the fourth, his second pickoff this season and third of his career... is the first Twins pitcher to record a pickoff in back-to-back starts since Matt Shoemaker did so from April 25-May 1, 2021.

© Marked his 27th new opponent faced...excluding the Twins, Simeon has now faced every major league team except the Colorado Rockies and the St. Louis Cardinals...he is 8-5 when facing opponents for the first time and 4-2 when facing new opponents at home.

FALLEN ANGELS: Pitched on September 8 at Los Angeles-AL, opposite Caden Dana, where he earned his single-season career-high sixth victory in Minnesota's 12-3 victory...allowed three runs on five hits, with one walk and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings...permitted a two-run double to Sebastián Rivero and an RBI single to Mike Trout, both in the second inning.

◆ Recorded the second pickoff of his career, throwing out Zach Neto at first in the third inning.

GUARDING CLEVELAND: Woods Richardson is 0-1 in four career starts against the Guardians...has posted a 2.49 ERA (21.2 IP, 6 ER), with six walks, 19 strikeouts and a .192 (15-for-78) opponent batting average...2.49 is his third lowest ERA among teams he has faced at least twice, behind the Seattle Mariners (0.00) and the Pittsburgh Pirates (1.64).

♣ Last faced Cleveland on May 1 where he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-4, extra-inning defeat...allowed two runs on two hits (1 HR), with a career-high five walks and four strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work.

♣ SWR is 1-1 in five starts against division opponents so far this season...has posted a 4.07 ERA (24.1 IP, 11 ER) with 13 walks, 27 strikeouts and a .239 (22-for-92) opponent batting average.

OUR NECK OF THE WOODS: In his career, Sim has gone 6-4 with a 3.92 ERA (124.0 IP, 54 ER), 8.93 K/9, 3.48 BB/9 and 1.02 HR/9 in 25 games (24 starts) at home compared to 6-6 with a 4.74 ERA (119.2 IP, 63 ER), 7.30 K/9, 3.69 BB/9 and 1.50 HR/9 in 26 road games (25 starts).

◆ He is 5-2 in 11 starts at home so far this season, posting a 3.05 ERA (56.0 IP, 19 ER) with 20 walks, 56 strikeouts and a .222 (47-for-212) opponent batting average.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through 21 major league games in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .243/.327/.395 in 177 at-bats vs. Woods Richardson, while righties have slashed .240/.319/.431 in 204 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.6 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 35.6 compared to righties' 91.9 mph and 47.7 percent.

The same all-time high whiff rate of 23.6 percent (lefties, 20.4 percent; righties, 26.1 percent)... compared to the last three years in which he has averaged 18.8 percent.

MAKE MY DAY: In 23 career day games (22 starts), Woods Richardson has posted a 3.62 ERA and a .238 opponent batting average, .383 slugging percentage, 15 home runs, 38 walks and 108 strikeouts; compared to a 4.97 ERA, .256 opponent batting average, .408 slugging percentage with 14 home runs, 48 walks and 81 strikeouts in 23 night games (22 starts).
