Chad Patrick last night made the first start of his Major League career and tossed 4.2 scoreless innings.....the Hebron, Indiana native was supported by over 300 guests, which included his parents, coaches, family friends and high school friends.

Nice Abs

Abner Uribe made his season debut last night and retired all four batters he faced (1k) to earn the win.....Uribe had not pitched for the Brewers since last May 1 vs. Tampa Bay....he had right knee surgery last July 18 and began this season serving a 4-game suspension from a fighting incident against the Rays last April 30.

You Rang?

Brice Turang is the only player on the team who has hit safely in all 5 games this season....he is currently batting .368 (7-for-19, 1hr, 3rbi) while posting a .381 OBP/.526 SLG/.907 OPS....he collected 3 hits in last night's victory.

Back on Track

Jackson Chourio has hit safely in 4 straight games (5-for-18, .278, 2rbi) after going O-for-5 with 5 strikeouts on Opening Day at Yankee Stadium.

Rebel Yeli

Christian Yelich last night collected the 750th RBI of his Major League career on a fielder's choice.....he later hit his first home run of the season with a solo shot off John Schreiber

They're Out of Our League

The Brewers begin the 2025 season with six consecutive games against American League teams.....Milwaukee has gone 75-42 (.641) since 2022 in Interleague Play, trailing only the Dodgers (78-37, .678).....the team snapped a 5-game Interleague losing streak last night.

Well Red

Following this series, the Brewers will take on the Reds in a 4-game set..... Milwaukee has gone 37-14 [.725] against the Reds over their last 51 games, including 9-4 last season.

THIS AFTERNOON'S GAME: Is game 3 (1-1) of a 7-game homestand against Kansas City (1-1) and Cincinnati (4g).....following this homestand and an off day next Monday, the team takes a 6-game road trip to Colorado (3g) and Arizona (3g).

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without **Bob Uecker** on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16

IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: LHP Aaron Ashby (right oblique), RHP Aaron Civale (left hamstring), LHP Robert Gasser (left elbow), LHP DL Hall (left lat), RHP Nick Mears (illness), RHP Tobias Myers (left oblique), OF Blake Perkins (right shin) and RHP Brandon Woodruff (right shoulder) are on the injured list.....Gasser and Hall are on the 60-day injured list.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....Murphy was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after guiding the team to a 93-69 record and the NL Central division championship.....he became the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

CDACHES: Returning from the 2024 coaching staff is associate manager Rickie Weeks (2nd season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (7th season), assistant pitching 6 strategy coach Jim Henderson (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (4th season), assistant coach Daniel de Mondesert (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd season) and third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role).....first base coach Julio Borbón, lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf and hitting coach Eric Theisen are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

<u>2024 IN REVIEW</u>: The Brewers went 93-69 and finished in first place in the NL Central, 10.0 games ahead of the Cardinals and Cubs.....they tied the Padres for the fourth-best record in baseball behind the Dodgers (98-64), Phillies (95-67) and Yankees (94-68)..... the Brewers lost to the Mets, 2 games to 1, in the NL Wild Card Series in Milwaukee.

<u>BREWING SUCCESS</u>: The Brewers have made the postseason six times over the last seven seasons (missed in 2022) and have won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four, and two straight....the Brewers are one of just five teams to qualify for the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons....they are joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include the shortened 2020 season.....the Brewers have 667 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

TODAY'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA (1gs, 0-1, 3.60)

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: Freddy Peralta, 28, is making his second start of the season.....Peralta started on Opening Day at Yankee Stadium - his second career Opening Day start - and took a 4-2 loss (5ip, 4h, 2r, 2er, 1bb, 8k, 2hr, 93 pitches).....he was acquired from Seattle with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

LAST SEASON: Peralta went 11-9 with a 3.68 ERA in a career-high 32 starts last season.....the team went 19-13 in his starts.....he made 11 quality starts.....his 173.2 innings pitched marked a career high.....he was among National League leaders in K/9IP (5th, 10.36), H/9IP (5th, 7.41), strikeouts (6th, 200) and AVG (6th, .224).....he produced 200+ strikeouts (200) for the second time in his career and for the second straight season (210 in 2023), joining **Teddy Higuera** (2x), **Corbin Burnes** (3x) and **Yovani Gallardo** (4x) as the only pitchers in franchise history with multiple 200+ strikeout seasons.

CAREER: Is 53-37 with a 3.79 ERA and 1 save in 179 games/130 starts (759.1ip, 320er).....is in his eighth Major League season, all with the Brewers (2018-25).....has gone 45-35 with a 3.78 ERA as a starter (675.1ip, 284er) and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief (84ip, 36er).....was an All-Star in 2021.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 31-19 with a 3.52 ERA in 95 games/67 starts [407ip, 159er].....went 6-5 with a 4.01 ERA in 17 starts last season [94.1ip, 42er].

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 22-18 with a 4.11 ERA in 84 games/63 starts (352.1ip, 161er).....went 5-4 with a 3.29 ERA in 15 starts last season (79.1ip, 29er).

CAREER vs. ROYALS: Peralta made his only career start against the Royals in a 5-1 win on 6/26/18 at American Family Field (7ip, 1h, 0r, 1bb, 10k).....his other outing against Kansas City came out of the bullpen on 9/20/20 in Milwaukee (1.2ip, 0h, 0r, 0bb, 1k).

LHP Nestor Cortes will be making his second start of the season.....Cortes made his Brewers debut last Saturday at New York-AL and took a 20-9 defeat (2ip, 6h, 8r, 8er, 5bb, 2k, 5hr, 64 pitches).....his 8 runs allowed tied a career high (also 8/14/20 at Houston).....his 5 walks and 5 home runs allowed marked career highs.....he became the first pitcher in Major League history to allow home runs to the first three batters of a game on the first three pitches (Goldschmidt, Bellinger and Judge).....Cortes made his only career appearance against the Reds in a start with the Yankees on 7/14/22 at Yankee Stadium (7ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 4k, 1hbp).....he received no decision in the Reds' 7-6, 10-inning win.
