SATURDAY’S 25TH ANNIVERSARY OF 2001 WORLD SERIES CHAMPIONSHIP WITH THROWBACK JERSEY GIVEAWAY: Saturday will celebrate the 25th anniversary of the D-backs’ World Series title born from one of the most unforgettable moments in franchise history...over 30 former players and coaches will be honored at the pregame celebration to honor the historic championship team and its enduring legacy...in addition, the D-backs voice of a generation, Greg Schulte, returns to the radio broadcast on Friday and Saturday...on Saturday, the first 25,000 fans will receive a 2001 Throwback Jersey courtesy of Chase.

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs look for their sixth series win or split in their last 8 (4 wins, 1 split).

- The D-backs look to win their first home series vs. Marlins since May 9-11, 2022 (2-1).
- The D-backs are 15-9 (.625) in rubber games this season...their 15 rubber-game wins are tied for the most in the Majors with the Pirates.
- **Merrill Kelly**, in his last 3 starts, is 1-1 with a 2.08 ERA (4 ER in 17.1 IP), opponent .183 AVG (11-for-60)/.542 OPS, 7 walks and 14 strikeouts.
 - Tossed a quality start in his last bid @ Marlins on June 11, allowing 2 runs on 4 hits in 6.0 innings with 2 walks and 1 strikeout in the D-backs’ 2-0 loss.
- **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 11 straight games, batting .324 (12-for-37)/1.147 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 homers, 8 RBI, 7 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 12 of his last 13 games with 6 doubles, 1 homer, 7 RBI and 6 walks.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 4-2 vs. Marlins in 11 innings.

- **Gabriel Moreno** kicked the game off with a first-inning solo homer (14).
- **Ketel Marte** had a pair of hits, including a 2-out, 11th-inning RBI double.
- **Michael Soroka** went decisionless, allowing just 1 run (solo HR) on 2 hits and 1 walk over 5.0 frames with 6 strikeouts.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs reinstated RHP **Ryne Nelson** from the 60-day injured list (strained right elbow) and designated RHP **Derek Law** for assignment.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are fourth in the NL Wild Card race, 2.5 games behind the Padres (WC3, Season tied 5-5), 3.5 games behind the Phillies (WC2, tied 3-3) and 4.0 behind the Cubs (WC1, trail 2-4).

ARENADO NEARING ANOTHER 25/75 SEASON: **Nolan Arenado (25 HR/72 RBI)** is 2 RBI shy of becoming the fifth third baseman since 1969 [min. 100 GS per year] with 9+ seasons of 25+ homers and 75+ RBI, to join Mike Schmidt/PHI (12 from 1974-87), Aramis Ramirez/PIT-CHC-MIL (10 from 2001-12), Manny Machado/BAL-LAD-SD (10 from 2015-2026) and Adrián Beltré/LAD-SEA-BOS-TEX (9 from 2004-16).

STRONG ‘PEN ARMS: The D-backs bullpen’s 2.63 ERA (21 R-18 ER in 61.2 IP) in September ranks best in the NL and second in MLB, behind the Red Sox (2.44).

1-RUN WINS: 28 of the D-backs’ 80 wins (35 pct.) have been decided by 1 run...their 28 1-run victories are their most in a season since 2017 (29), and are second most in the Majors this season, behind the Dodgers (30) and ahead of the Braves (26).

NOOT THERE IT IS: Lars Nootbaar has reached base safely in 15 of his last 18 games, batting .333 (16-for-48)/1.014 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers, 10 RBI, 9 walks and 1 sac fly.

- With runners in scoring position as a D-back, he is carrying a 1.048 OPS with 1 double, 3 homers, 13 RBI, 6 walks and 1 sac fly.

LET’S GET NASTY: Justin Martinez has not allowed an earned run in his 10 games this season (2 R-0 ER in 9.2 IP) since returning from the 60-day Injured List on Aug. 18...is 2-0 with an opponent .152 AVG (5-for-33)/.512 OPS, 6 walks and 13 strikeouts.

- His 103.8 MPH sinker to strike out Otto Lopez/MIA last night marked the fastest pitch by a D-back in the Statcast Era (since 2015).

STINGY AT HOME: Brandyn Garcia is scoreless in 25 of his 26 home games, going 0-0 with a 0.36 ERA (1 ER in 25.0 IP), opponent .146 AVG (12-for-82)/.391 OPS, 0.64 WHIP, 4 walks and 21 strikeouts.

- **Juan Morillo** is scoreless in 13 straight home games (12.1 IP), going 1-0 with 2 saves, an opponent .143 AVG (6-for-42)/.432 OPS, 6 walks and 11 strikeouts.

ANSWERBACKS: The D-backs’ 45 comeback wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Cubs (42) and Dodgers (42).

- Their 23 comeback home wins are tied for fourth most in the NL with the Brewers, behind the Padres (27), Dodgers (26) and Cubs (24).

HOMERING INTO HISTORY: The D-backs’ 4 walk-off homers in games when trailing are tied for the most in a season in MLB history with the 2006 Reds and 2014 White Sox (source: OptaSTATS).

- The D-backs welcomed the Yankees to Chase Field for the first time ever during the 2001 World Series and hosted for the regular season for the first time in June 2004.
