**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners continue a 6-game homestand with the 2nd of 3 games against the Baltimore Orioles (1-0)...Seattle will also host the Red Sox for a 3-game set (June 19-21) on the homestand... the Mariners are coming off a 10-game road trip where they saw the Orioles (2-2), Tigers (1-2) and Nationals (1-2)...tonight's game against the Orioles will be televised and streamed live on **Mariners.TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Angie Mentink** on the call, and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** as sideline analyst...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Shannon Drayer** on the call.

**ODDS & ENDS**...the Mariners won the series opener last night by a 3-1 final score over the Orioles... Seattle is 13-7 (.650) over their last 20 games since May 25, the 2nd-best record in the AL and 5th-best in MLB over that span.

- **Best In The West** - The Mariners (38-36) are in first place in the American League West Division, 1.5 games ahead of the second place Athletics (36-37).
- **Small Ball** - Yesterday Seattle won 3-1 despite failing to record an extra base hit...the Mariners are 2-17 dating back to the start of the 2025 season when recording only singles; the only other win in the 19 games came at Baltimore on Aug. 12, 2025 (a 1-0 win in a game started by **George Kirby** that also featured a hold by **Eduard Bazarzo** and a save from **Andrés Muñoz**).
- **Davila Answering the Call** - Right-handed reliever **Nick Davila** has not allowed an earned run over 10 appearances (10.2 IP) to begin his Major League career, the 5th longest such streak in Mariners history.
- **All About That Bazz** - RHP **Eduard Bazarzo** has been stellar in relief this season, holding a 2.23 ERA (8 ER, 32.1 IP), 11 walks and 28 strikeouts in 34 appearances...he ranks 3rd in the AL with 13 holds and T-8th in appearances.

★**PUNCH THEIR TICKET TO PHILLY**★...Major League Baseball announced a ballot update to Phase One of voting for the 2026 MLB All-Star Game on July 14 at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia...the Mariners currently have a player in the Top 8 of voting at every position...OF **Julio Rodríguez** and OF **Randy Arozarena** headline the list, ranking 6th and 7th among AL outfielders, respectively...fans can submit up to 5 ballots per day until the conclusion of Phase One on June 25...Phase Two, which takes the finalists at each position, will run from June 29-July 2 before the All-Star rosters are announced on July 4... for more information and to vote, visit [Mariners.com/Vote](http://Mariners.com/Vote).

**FLURRY OF ROSTER MOVES**...the Mariners yesterday announced six roster moves: C **Cal Raleigh** (right oblique strain) and INF **J.P. Crawford** (right hand contusion) were reinstated from the 10-day Injured List, and OF **Curtis Washington Jr.** was recalled, in corresponding moves, OF **Randy Arozarena** (left hamstring strain, retroactive to June 13) was placed on the 10-day IL, INF **Will Wilson** (fractured left thumb) was transferred to the 60-day IL and C **Jhonny Pereda** was optioned to Triple-A Tacoma...today the Mariners recalled INF/OF **Connor Joe** from Triple-A Tacoma and optioned Washington Jr. (post-game June 16) to High-A Everett.

**DOM DIALED IN**...**Dominic Canzone** has been impressive over his last 19 games since May 24, batting .379 (22x58) with 11 runs, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs and 10 RBI, reaching base at a .429 clip and slugging .793 for a 1.222 OPS...during that span he leads Major League batters in slugging percentage and ranks 2nd in OPS behind only Yordan Alvarez-HOU (1.231 OPS) among players with at least 50 plate appearances...he has hit safely in his last 6-consecutive games (6/10-c).

**COLE YOUNG'S HOT STRETCH**...**Cole Young** has hit safely in 16 of his last 18 games since May 27, batting .307 (23x75) with 9 runs, 2 home runs, 5 RBI, 2 walks and just 8 strikeouts, reaching base at a .329 clip in 80 plate appearances...his 10.0% strikeout rate during that span ranks 3rd-lowest in the American League, closely behind teammate **Josh Naylor** (8.5%) and trailing only Trent Grisham-NYY (7.0%)...Young recorded a career-high 11-game hitting streak from May 27 to June 8.

**JULIO: MADE FOR THE SPOTLIGHT**...**Julio Rodríguez** is currently poised to move on to Phase Two of All-Star voting, sitting 6th in voting for AL outfielders...Julio has made the All-Star Game in 3 of his first 4 seasons and has the chance to be the third Mariners player to make it 4 of their first 5, joining Ken Griffey Jr. and Ichiro Suzuki...in 74 games this season, Rodríguez is batting .248 (74x298) with 14 doubles, 13 home runs, 35 RBI and 9 stolen bases with a .736 OPS...among AL center fielders (min. 50% G as CF), he ranks 3rd in doubles, 3rd in home runs, 3rd in extra-base hits (27), T-3rd in RBI and 4th in stolen bases.

**EMERSON EXCELLING**...in 24 games to begin his career, **Colt Emerson** has hit .241 (19x79) with 12 extra base hits: 5 doubles, 1 triple and 6 home runs...his 6 home runs prior to his 21st birthday also rank 3rd-most in Mariners history, trailing only Ken Griffey Jr. (38 HR from 1989-90) and Alex Rodriguez (26 HR from 1994-96).

**ROLLING TIDES**...during the Mariners 13-7 run since May 25, the Mariners pitching staff ranks 2nd in MLB in ERA (3.63), 2nd in WHIP (1.08) and 5th in strikeout-to-walk rate (3.43)...also during the span, the Seattle offense ranks 8th in MLB in batting average (.267), 10th in slugging (.448) and T-3rd in home runs (34).

**HOMESTAND HIGHLIGHTS**...highlights and promotions on the Mariners current homestand include **Mariners Value Games** during each game of the Orioles series, **Stars and Stripes Soccer Jersey Day** on Thursday, **Juneteenth Celebration** and **Fireworks Night** on Friday, where Seattle will wear their Steelheads Jerseys, and **Father's Day** on Sunday.

**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...**Cal Raleigh** returned from the Injured List last night, going 1-for-3 with 1 walk and 2 RBI, driving in the go-ahead runs in the 7th inning, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...since the start of the 2025 season, Big Dumper has 9 go-ahead hits in the 7th-inning or later, tied for the 2nd-most in MLB during that span?...he trails only Bobby Witt Jr.-KC (10 H), while fellow Mariners **Josh Naylor** (9 H, 5 with ARI, 4 with SEA), **J.P. Crawford** (7 H) and **Randy Arozarena** (6 H) rank among the leaders, and...**DID YOU ALSO KNOW?**...the Mariners lead MLB in go-ahead hits in the 7th-inning or later since 2025 with 54?...they rank ahead of the St. Louis Cardinals (46 H).

### ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - JUNE 17

- **1983** - Al Cowens legged out what appeared to be an inside-the-park HR at Kansas City, only to be called out for missing second base.
- **1997** - Jeff Fassero becomes the first Mariners pitcher to bat in interleague play.
- **2008** - In the Mariners' 5-4 win over Florida at T-Mobile Park, Félix Hernández strikes out the side on nine pitches to become the 13th pitcher in American League history to throw an immaculate inning. King Felix's fourth frame victims include Jeremy Hermida (swinging), Jorge Cantu (swinging), and Mike Jacobs (looking).
- **2015** - Félix Hernández outduels Madison Bumgarner in a battle of aces as the Mariners win 2-0 over the Giants. Hernández becomes the AL's first 10-game winner, scattering 4 hits over 8.0 shutout innings, striking out 5.

ABOUT GEORGE KIRBY...

- The 28-year-old right-hander is making his 15th start of the season and 2nd against the Orioles...is making the 127th start of his career and his 10th career start against Baltimore.
- Is in his 5th season with Seattle; selected by the Mariners in the first round (20th overall) of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Ty Holub.
- Named to his 1st All-Star team in 2023.
- Named AL Rookie of the Month in August 2022 after posting a 2.15 ERA and 5-0 record.
- Is the highest drafted player out of Elon University.

**LAST TIME OUT...**L#6 at Baltimore Orioles, tossed 6.0 innings, allowing 3 runs (3 ER) on 7 hits and 3 walks while striking out a season-high 10 batters...threw a season-high 104 pitches and 69 strikes...marks his 7th quality start in 2026, T-11th most in the AL this season, and the first time he has recorded 10 strikeouts in an outing since Sept. 26, 2025 vs. LAD...his 104 pitchers thrown are tied for the 2nd most recorded in a single game in his career (last: 8/6/25 vs. CWS) while his 7 swinging strikeouts match his season-high (also: 5/11/26 at HOU).

**BACK-TO-BACK BIRDIES...**has logged the most innings against the Orioles of any non AL West opponent (9 GS, 55.2 IP)...over his last 3 starts against the Orioles at T-Mobile, owns a 1.77 ERA (4 ER, 20.1 IP) with a 0.945 WHIP and a 7.5 K/BB...has allowed 2-or-fewer runs over 5.0+ IP in each of his last 3 home starts against the Orioles...6 of his 9 career starts against the Orioles have been quality starts, 2 being 7.0+ innings, while he has recorded 6.0+ scoreless innings in 3 starts...finished 9.0 shutout innings in his 4th start against the Orioles on August 8, 2023 before the bullpen entered for the 10th inning, marking the only 9.0+ inning game of his career.

**GOOD TO BE HOME...**owns a career 1.07 WHIP at home, ranking T-11th best in the AL since 2022 (min. 200.0 IP) while his career BB/9 (1.5) ranks 2nd and his K/BB (6.2) in home games ranks 3rd in MLB (min. 200.0 IP)...since 2025 has thrown 5.0+ IP with 2-or-fewer runs allowed in 13-of-20 home games, including 4 times this season with 2 outings being 7.0+ IP...the Mariners are 9-4 in such games since 2025 and 3-1 this season...his 35 career home starts of 6.0+ IP with 2-or-fewer earned runs allowed are tied for 5th most in Mariners history and are T-3rd most in MLB since 2022.

**GOING THE DISTANCE...**has pitched into the 6th inning in 12 of his 13 starts this year and has cleared the 7th inning in 3 of those starts...his 84.0 innings pitched this season are tied for the 14th most in MLB...has pitched 77 career games of 6.0+ innings, including 8 starts this season, ranking T-9th most such games in MLB since 2022...his 84.0 IP through his first 14 starts are the most he has pitched over a 13 game span to start the year since his 2023 debut season...is also the most innings pitched over a 14 game span in a single season since he threw 84.2 over 14 starts from May 24 to August 7 of 2024.

**MAINTAINING THE RATIO...**has logged 5+ strikeouts and 2-or-fewer walks in 8 games this season (last: 6/3 vs. NYM) for the 10th most in the AL, matching **Bryan Woo** and 1 game ahead of **Emerson Hancock**...his 70 career such games are tied for the 11th most in MLB since 2022...in his last start on June 10 at BAL, logged his 7th career outing with 10+ strikeouts and 3-or-fewer walks, ranking T-11th most in the AL since 2023...among AL pitchers with 70+ strikeouts in 2026, his 2.3 BB/9 ranks 11th...owns a 3.9 K/BB over his last 6 games (5/11-c), ranking 15th best in the AL over that span (min 30.0 IP).

**QUALITY STUFF...**has thrown 7 quality starts this season (last: 6/10 at BAL)...has thrown 70 quality starts across his career, T-6th most in MLB since 2022...has 37 career quality starts without any walks (2x this season, last: 5/23 at KC), most in MLB since 2022, ahead of **Tarik Skubal-DET** (27 G) and **Zack Wheeler-PHI** (27 G)...has also tossed a quality start with no walks in 20 home games, most in MLB since 2022 and 2nd most in Mariners history, trailing **Félix Hernández** (22 G) and **Jamie Moyer** (22 G).

**PLENTY OF PUNCHOUTS...**has tossed 12+ strikeouts in 3 career games, including a career-high 14 strikeouts twice last season...is 1 of 11 pitchers with 3-or-more games of 12+ strikeouts since 2024...recorded his 4th 10+ strikeout game since 2025 on June 10 at BAL...his 4 such starts are tied for 6th most in the AL over that span, matching **Logan Gilbert**.

**KEEPING THEM ON THEIR TOES...**owns a 38.1% chase rate this season, ranking T-5th in MLB among qualified pitchers while posting a 35.7 career chase rate, ranking T-13th among qualified pitchers since 2022...his 655 swing and misses on pitches outside the zone rank 10th among AL pitchers since 2022, while his 331 strikeouts are 8th most...of pitchers with over 250 strikeouts on pitches out of the zone, his 106 walks are the fewest, trailing **Garrett Crochet-BOS** (96) and **Pablo López** (101).

**FURIOUS GEORGE...**has thrown 7.0+ innings with 3-or-fewer earned runs allowed in 3 starts this season and in 25 career starts, tied with **Luis Castillo** and **Zac Gallen-ARI** for 14th most in MLB since 2022...Kirby and **Bryan Woo** (4 G) are 2 of 7 pitchers in the AL this season to have 3+ games of 7.0+ IP, 3-or-fewer runs and 1-or-fewer walks...Kirby's 22 such starts since 2023 are the 3rd most in MLB across that span.

**EFFECTIVE AND EFFICIENT...**currently averages 15.5 pitches per inning this season, tied for the 10th lowest mark in the AL among qualified pitchers...is averaging 15.6 pitches per inning across his career, tied for the 13th-fewest P/IP in MLB since 2022 (min. 500 IP).

**BEST IN ALL THE LAND...**among starting pitchers since 2022 (min. 600 IP), he **leads the Majors** in fewest walks allowed (114), strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.10), walks-per-nine innings (1.4), and walk rate (3.9%).

**FOR THE M'S HISTORY BOOKS...**leads the **Mariners franchise** (min. 100 GS) in fewest walks-per-nine innings (1.4) and in strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.10)...ranks 7th in franchise history in career ERA (3.64), 2nd in WHIP (1.135) and 11th in total strikeouts (695 SO).

**CRUISE CONTROL...**tossed 8.0 innings on April 7 vs. Texas on the road, his 2nd career complete game (also: 4/27/23 at PHI)...is 1 of 8 pitchers with a complete game so far this season...became the first Mariners pitcher to toss 8.0+ IP since **Logan Gilbert** did so twice in 2024 (last: 9/7/24 at STL)...Kirby has thrown 8.0+ IP without a walk in 3 career games (last: 4/7 at TEX) and is 1 of 10 pitchers in MLB with 3-or-more such games since 2023, joining teammate **Logan Gilbert** (3 G, last: 6/16/24 vs. TEX).

**WIN #50...**earned his 50th career win on May 11 at Houston, becoming the 12th player in franchise history with 50+ wins...his 121 games are tied for the 4th-fewest games to reach 50 wins with the Mariners, alongside: **Hisashi Iwakuma** and **Erik Hanson**...behind: **Jamie Moyer** (100 G), **Freddy García** (100 G), and **Marco Gonzales** (118 G).
