YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles fell to the Diamondbacks, 9-2, in the finale of the three-game set...**Dean Kremer** tied a career high with 10 strikeouts, **Adley Rutschman** clubbed his sixth home run of the season, and **Albert Suárez** worked 3.0 scoreless innings of relief in the loss...The seven-run margin of defeat is Baltimore's second-largest of the season, behind a 10-run loss (11-1) against Milwaukee on April 12.

BOUNCE BACK: The O's, Cubs, and Phillies are the only teams in MLB this year without a losing streak of at least three games...Baltimore has only lost back-to-back games twice this season: April 6-7 and April 12-13.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The Birds have won seven of their last nine games, nine of 12, 10 of 14, 14 of 20, and 18 of 25... At 26-13 (.667), the Orioles have the best record in the AL and second-best in MLB behind the Phillies (.683, 28-13).

- ⚡ The 26-13 record is tied for the third-best start through 39 games in O's history, which was also accomplished last year, 2005, 1997, and 1979; only the 1969 and 1970 squads (27-12) had better marks.
- ⚡ Only four times in team history (since 1954) has the club won at least 27 of the first 40 games - 1970 (28) and 1997 and 1969 (both 27).
- ⚡ Since the start of 2022, Baltimore is 210-153 (.579), the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.590, 211-153), Braves (.650, 229-132), and Dodgers (.650, 238-128).
- ⚡ The Orioles have won 126 of their last 200 games (.630).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 60 home runs, tied for the third-most homers through the first 39 games of a season in O's history with 2005 and trailing 2012 (61) and 1987 (63)...The most through Baltimore's first 40 games of a season is 64 in 1987.

- ⚡ The Orioles have an MLB-best seven players with at least six homers: **Gunnar Henderson** (12), **Anthony Santander** (7), **Colton Cowser**, **Ryan Mountcastle**, **Cedric Mullins**, **Jordan Westburg**, and **Adley Rutschman** (6); the Dodgers and Yankees rank second with four players with at least six long balls.
- ⚡ Henderson's 12 home runs are tied for second in MLB with Atlanta's Marcell Ozuna and rank second in the AL behind Houston's Kyle Tucker (13).

BIG TIME RUTSCH: **Adley Rutschman** enters today sixth in the AL in hits (49) and tied for seventh with Jordan Westburg in batting average (.304)...He ranks fourth in the AL and sixth in MLB in multi-hit games (15).

- ⚡ Rutschman has hit safely in 19 of 21 games since April 19 and 24 of his last 27 since April 11; for the season, he has reached safely in 32 of his 38 games and has a hit in 31 of those.
- ⚡ Since April 19, he's slashing .326/.340/.533 (30-for-92) with four doubles, five homers, nine runs, 16 RBI, two walks, and a stolen base; the 30 hits are second-most in the AL and tied for fourth in MLB over that period.
- ⚡ He had a career-long 11-game hitting streak from April 19-30, the longest by an O's batter this season.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles continue their season-long nine-game homestand today with the first of three games against the Blue Jays...Baltimore took two out of three against Arizona over the weekend...The O's have a scheduled off day on Thursday, May 16, before hosting the Mariners (3 G) from May 17-19.

- ⚡ The O's are off to a 14-8 (.636) start at home, the fourth-best home winning percentage in the AL and eighth-best in MLB.

BATTLE OF THE BIRDS: The O's and Jays begin their season series against each other with a three-game set in Charm City this week...The Orioles will host the Jays for another three games from July 29-31, and will travel to Toronto for a four-game set from June 3-6 and three games from August 6-8...The Orioles won the season series over Toronto last year, 10-3...The O's swept a three-game series at Rogers Centre from May 19-21, took two of three at Oriole Park from June 13-15, three of four at Rogers Centre from July 31 to August 3, and two of three at Oriole Park from August 22-24...Since the start of 2022, the O's hold a 19-13 (.594) edge over the Blue Jays.

AL BEAST: Baltimore has not dropped a series against an AL East opponent in 16 straight sets beginning April 24, 2023, while going 12-0-4 in series during that time...That is the longest such streak in team history since divisions were introduced in 1969, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...The Orioles are 36-17 against division opponents over that period...The O's went 32-20 (.615) against the AL East last year, the second-best winning percentage against the division by the team since 1981 behind the .618 (47-29) mark in 2014...The Birds won the season series against the Blue Jays (10-3), Rays (8-5), Red Sox (7-6), and Yankees (7-6), the first time since 2014 that the Orioles won the season series against each of their division opponents.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: **Gunnar Henderson** and **Colton Cowser** were voted American League Player and Rookie of the Month, respectively, for March/April...It marks the first time in team history that the O's have claimed both awards in the same month...The last MLB team to do so was the Dodgers in August 2023: Mookie Betts (Player) and James Outman (Rookie)...The last occurrence among AL teammates was the Guardians in April 2022: José Ramírez (Player) and Steven Kwan (Rookie).

SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE: The Orioles have gone 104 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, that is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3)...The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS.

POWER RANKINGS: MLB.com today released updated [Power Rankings](#) and the O's have claimed the top spot for the first time since they began over a decade ago...The rankings are voted on by MLB.com contributors.

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 341 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles today reinstated outfielder **Austin Hays** from the 10-day injured List (left calf strain) and recalled outfielder **Kyle Stowers** from Triple-A Norfolk...In corresponding moves, outfielder **Heston Kjerstad** was optioned to the Tides and outfielder **Ryan McKenna** was designated for assignment...Baltimore also claimed right-handed pitcher **Corbin Martin** off waivers from the Milwaukee Brewers and optioned him to Triple-A Norfolk...The Orioles' 40-man roster currently has 39 players.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his ninth start of the season tonight against the Blue Jays...A three-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024...Entering the 2024 season, he was ranked as the No. 29 overall player in MLB Network's Top 100 Right Now...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Mary's College (CA).

LAST TIME OUT: Dealt the loss on May 7 at Washington...Allowed three runs on five hits, three walks, and a balk with six strikeouts across 6.1 innings; two of the three runs scored in the seventh inning...Marked his second consecutive start with zero run support...Threw 95 pitches, 63 strikes.

AGAINST THE BLUE JAYS: Making his second career start against the Blue Jays this evening...Earned the win in his sole start against them on June 25, 2022 in Milwaukee, allowing three runs on five hits (2 HR), two walks, and one hit batter with nine strikeouts in 7.2 innings.

BEAST OF THE AL EAST: Owns a lifetime 3-1 record with a 1.48 ERA (8 ER/48.2 IP), his lowest ERA against any division, across seven starts against the AL East...Opponents are slashing .130/.193/.224 (21-for-161) off him.

HOME SWEET HOME: Scheduled to make his sixth home start of the season...Has gone 1-1 with a 2.51 ERA (8 ER/28.2 IP) across five starts at Oriole Park this year.

NIGHT OWL: Through four night starts this season, Burnes owns a 1-2 record with a 3.38 ERA (9 ER/24.0 IP)...Has allowed eight walks, compared to 22 strikeouts in night games.

EARLY STRUGGLES: Burnes has surrendered five of his 16 runs in the first inning this season with four of those coming via solo home runs...The four first inning home runs allowed are tied for second in MLB with Atlanta's Chris Sale, trailing only San Diego's Matt Waldron (5).

RING 'EM UP: Burnes is one of six pitchers with at least 200 strikeouts in each of the last three seasons (2021-23), along with Dylan Cease, Gerrit Cole, Kevin Gausman, Aaron Nola, and Spencer Strider...His 765 strikeouts from 2020-23 were the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind Gerrit Cole (816)...He is 83 strikeouts away from 1,000.

INNINGS EATER: The 610.1 innings consumed by Burnes since the start of 2021 rank fourth in MLB (Aaron Nola - 628.1, Sandy Alcántara - 619.0, and Zack Wheeler - 611.2)...Last season, he tossed 193.2 innings, which would have been the most by an Oriole since Chris Tillman threw 207.1 innings in 2014.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Burnes' 2023 campaign was highlighted by his third consecutive All-Star Game appearance...Burnes made his second straight Opening Day start for the Brewers...On July 25, he became the sixth pitcher in Brewers franchise history to notch 800 career strikeouts...He pitched to a 5-3 record with a 2.72 ERA (30 ER/99.1 IP) across his final 16 starts of the season.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Burnes' NL Wild Card Series start on October 3, 2023 against the Diamondbacks marked his eighth Postseason appearance (2 GS)...In those games, he has posted a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP) with 11 hits, six walks, and 22 strikeouts.
