**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-3 through five games on their six-game homestand, going 1-2 against Washington over the weekend, followed by a win over Boston Monday night and a loss Tuesday night...this afternoon, they will complete the series and homestand with the three-game series finale against the Red Sox...after today's game, they will travel to Cleveland for six games in seven days...after an off-day tomorrow, they will play the Guardians for three games over the weekend, then play the Tigers in Detroit from Monday-Wednesday.

**OHL NO:** The Twins lost to the Red Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 8-5...Pierson Ohl (0-1) made his major league debut and was the club's starter, allowing four runs on five hits in 3.0 innings pitched, with one walk and four strikeouts...he recorded all three of his first inning outs on strikeouts, becoming the first Twin in club history to do so in their debut as a starter...Michael Tonkin made his season debut with 2.0 innings of relief...the offense recorded eight hits, three from Brooks Lee, who entered off the bench for Carlos Correa (illness)...two of Lee's three hits were home runs, his ninth and 10th of the season.  
⌘ Lee joined Roy Smalley (1986), Chili Davis (1992), Ryan Doumit (2012), Kennys Vargas (2016) and Jorge Polanco (2017) as the only Twins switch hitters to homer from both sides of the plate in a game...full list on the bottom of page 345 in the Twins media guide.

**TWINS CALL ON DAVIS:** The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Noah Davis from Triple-A St. Paul...Davis, who was acquired in a trade with the Los Angeles Dodgers on July 14, appeared in two games for the Saints recently, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings, with no hits allowed, one walk and three strikeouts...prior to joining the Twins organization, the 28-year-old spent the 2025 season pitching for the Dodgers and their Triple-A affiliate, the Oklahoma City Comets...in 21 games for the Comets this season, he went 3-0, 3.94 ERA (32.0 IP, 14 ER), with 15 walks and 38 strikeouts...the right-hander has pitched in parts of three seasons at the major league level for Colorado (2022-24) and Los Angeles-NL (2025).  
⌘ To make room for Davis on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Pierson Ohl to St. Paul.

**BOSTON COMMON:** The Twins and Red Sox are playing for the sixth and final time in 2025...Twins are 3-2 against the Sox this season...a win today and the Twins will win the season-series for the first time since going 4-3 in 2022 (3-3 in 2024, 3-4 in 2023).  
⌘ Twins have gone 8-5 in their last 13 games against Boston, dating back to June 21, 2023.  
⌘ Ty France has 15 career doubles in 32 games against the Red Sox, his second-most against any opponent (LAA - 16).  
⌘ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .350 (14-for-40) with five doubles, two home runs and a .975 OPS in his last 11 games against the Red Sox.

**ZEBBY ZEROS:** Zebby Matthews pitched a scoreless fourth inning on July 19 at Colorado, then followed it with 6.0 scoreless innings on Friday vs. Washington...his 7.0 scoreless inning streak is the second-longest of his career, trailing his 10.0 inning streak that spanned from his second inning on May 30 at Seattle to his fourth inning on June 4 at the Athletics.

**WHERE THE RUBBER MEETS THE ROAD:** The Twins enter today 3-8 in rubber games this season and 1-3 in rubber games at home...lone home rubber game win this season came on April 16 vs. New York-NL, a 4-3 walk-off win in 10 innings...Twins have lost each of their last seven rubber games...Minnesota's last win in a rubber match was on May 4 at Boston, a 5-4 victory.

**HARRI, I TOOK CARE OF IT:** Over his last 18 games, Harrison Bader has posted a 1.000 OPS with a .377 on-base percentage and a .623 slugging percentage...in that span, he has 15 hits, three doubles, five home runs, 11 RBI and seven walks.

**JEFF YEA:** Over his last 14 games, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .391 (18-for-46) with four doubles, one home run, five RBI, three walks, a .440 on-base percentage, a .543 slugging percentage and a .983 OPS.

**TWINS GO FOR A PAIR AGAINST SOX:** With a win today the Twins will win their 15th series of the season...Minnesota is 14-18-2 in series play, going 9-6-2 at home and 5-12-0 on the road...their last series win came July 11-13 vs. Pittsburgh.  
⌘ After taking the series at Fenway Park 2-1 in early May, the Twins are looking to win two series in one season over Boston for the first time since 2006, when they went 3-0 at the Metrodome and 2-1 at Fenway.

**THIS AND THAT:**  
⌘ Twins batters have grounded into 15 double plays since the All-Star break, the most in baseball...they've grounded into multiple DPs in four of 11 games since the break.  
⌘ Twins have struck out 88 times since the break, fourth fewest in the AL.  
⌘ Trevor Larnach enters today with 399 career games at the major league level.  
⌘ Former Twins left-hander Scott Diamond is celebrating his 39th birthday today...also, former Twins bench coach Derek Shelton turns 55.  
⌘ Twins infielder Luke Keaschall (right forearm fracture) remains on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul...last night at Toledo, he went 1-for-4 with a run scored and one RBI...Keaschall has now played in nine games on rehab assignment, going 8-for-36 with five walks.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2021, the Twins acquired Austin Martin and Simeon Woods Richardson via trade with the Blue Jays, in exchange for José Berrios.
