2-1 to the Diamondbacks over the weekend, followed by a split of the first two games against
the Yankees this weektonight, Minnesota will play the three-game series finale against New
Yorkthe Twins will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then host the Guardians for four games this
weekend — including a doubleheader on Saturday (make-up of May 20).

♣ Twins have 11 games remaining, five at home and six on the road.

♣ Twins have gone 6-13 in rubber games this season...they lost each of their last two chances, on Sunday vs. Arizona and last Wednesday at Los Angeles-AL...their last rubber game win was August 31 vs. San Diego.

TWINS RUN OUT OF INNINGS: The Twins lost to the Yankees last night at Target Field by a score of 10-9, scoring eight unanswered runs from innings 5-9...Minnesota was down 10-1 at one point and had they completed the comeback, it would have marked the largest comeback victory in Twins history (since 1961)...the club record being a seven-run comeback win on May 10, 2000 vs. Cleveland (from 1-8 to 10-9)...Zebby Matthews was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing a career-high tying nine runs on a career-high 11 hits over 3.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded nine hits, highlighted by home runs from Ryan Fitzgerald (3), Trevor Larnach (17) and James Outman (3).

TWINS-YANKEES: The Twins and Yankees are playing for the sixth and final time in 2025...Twins are 2-3 this season, going 1-2 at Yankee Stadium (August 11-13) and 1-1 at Target Field.

♣ These two teams will play six times in 2026...the Twins will visit the Bronx for three, from July 3-5 and they will host the Yankees for three, from September 14-16.
♣ In five games against the Yankees this season, Byron Buxton is hitting .294 (5-for-17) with two doubles, one home run and four walks...Buck has a .993 OPS in his last 19 games against the Yankees, including six doubles, six home runs, 11 RBI and a .621 slugging negrentage

percentage. ₱ Trevor Larnach is hitting .364 (4-for-11) with two doubles, two home runs, three walks, a .467 on-base percentage, a 1.091 slugging percentage and a 1.558 OPS in four games against New York this season.

ALL ABOUT THAT BASE: The Twins stole four more bases last night (Buxton - 2, Larnach - 1, Lewis - 1), giving them 103 on the season, their most under a Rocco Baldelli-led team (since 1961)...103 is their most since stealing 135 in 2012...the club record is 151 in 1997...since August 1, they have stolen 48 bases (57 attempts), second-most in baseball in that span, trailing only the Yankees (50)...prior to August 1, the Twins stole 55 bases, sixth-fewest in baseball

NOTHING RUNS LIKE A DEER BUCK: Byron Buxton stole two more bases last night, making his 24-for-24 on the season...no Twin has ever finished a season with a stolen base percentage of 100% (minimum of 20 attempts)...the club record is held by Buck in 2017, when he went 29-for-30 for a 96.7% success rate...he has gone 30-for-his-last-30 with his last caught stealing being May 1, 2024 at Chicago-AL (Korey Lee/Chris Flexen)...Buxton and Trevor Story (30-for-30) are the only two players in baseball yet to be caught stealing (min. 20 steals).

BY-RUNNIN' WILD: Buck's two steals last night gave him 117 for his career, tying and passing Dan Gladden and moving into sole possession of sixth on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

AUSTIN MART-HIM: Austin Martin went 1-for-5 last night, extending his career-high on-base streak to 13 games (previous was 8)...over his last 20 games, Martin is hitting .344 (22-for-64) with six doubles, four RBI, 13 runs scored, 14 walks, just 12 strikeouts, a .462 on-base percentage and an .899 OPS.

◆ Martin has posted a .417 on-base percentage in 15 games this month, the highest on the team and 10th-best in the AL.

TWINS GO FOR THE MEATLOAF (2 OUT OF 3 AIN'T BAD): With a win tonight, the Twins will earn their 18th series victory of the season...Minnesota is 17-29-2 in series play, going 11-11-2 at home and 6-18-0 on the road.

◆ Twins last series win against the Yankees was April 24-26, 2023 at Target Field, taking two of three...0-3-0 vs. New York since that series.

◆ Twins have won just one series (August 29-31 vs. SD) in their last 10 tries. >>>

LARNACH LUMBER: Over his last 15 games, Trevor Larnach is hitting .345 (19-for-55) with three doubles, one home run, nine RBI, seven walks, a .406 on-base percentage and an .861 OPS.

KEA PLAYER: Luke Keaschall has reached safely in 39 of 43 games to start his career...he has posted an on-base percentage of .396 on the season, reaching base 74 times (51 hits, 18 walks, 5 hit-by-pitch) in 187 plate appearances...marks the second-most times on base in Twins history (1961-) through a player's first 43 career games (Luis Arraez - 76 in 2019).

♣ His. 396 on-base percentage is tied with Roman Anthony for the highest among all rookies in baseball (minimum of 150 plate

appearances).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2022, Matt Wallner made his major league debut in game one of a doubleheader at Progressive Field...he homered in his third at-bat of the game, a solo shot in the eighth inning off Shane Bieber.

LAST TIME OUT: Started on September 10 at Angel Stadium, opposite Jose Ureña, but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-4 loss...allowed three runs on four hits (1 HR), with two walks and five strikeouts over 6.1 innings...marked his 12th quality start of the season and his first since July 18 vs. Baltimore...retired the first seven batters he faced...in the third, allowed an RBI single to Mike Trout and a two-run home run to Zach Neto...faced two over the minimum through his final 3.2

Things of work...98 pitches were his most in an outing since June 1 at Houston (104).

◆ Extended his career-high streak of allowing a walk to 24-straight games (previous high was 15-straight done in 2024)...is tied for the fourth longest streak in the majors this season.

◆ Brought his career strikeout total to 397, three away from the 400 mark.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started on September 4 vs. the White Sox, opposite Fraser Ellard, but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 8-11 loss; game was delayed 90 minutes prior to the start due to rain...allowed four runs on eight hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts over 5.0 innings...in the third, allowed a run scoring single to Kyle Teel and a two-run double to Curtis Mead...in the fifth, Teel hit a ground-rule double and later scored on Colson Montgomery's sacrifice fly.

◆ Tied his single-outing career high with four doubles allowed; also did so on July 2, 2023 at Seattle and August 7, 2024 at St. Louis.

WELL HELLO, OLD FOE: The former Tampa Bay Ray is facing the New York Yankees for the fifth time in his career, going 2-2 with a 3.42 ERA (23.2 IP, 9 ER), 11 walks and 16 strikeouts in his previous outings...has faced his old American League East opponent twice this season, on April 17 and on May 4, going 1-1 with a 6.75 ERA (10.2 IP, 8 ER), seven walks and four strikeouts...allowed six runs on April 17 at George M. Steinbrenner Field, the lone time in his career allowing two-or-more runs to the Yanks.

This career, Yankees batters are hitting .212 (18-for-85) with a .302 on-base percentage and a .306 slugging percentage (2 2B, 2 HR)...his 0.76 home runs-per-9.0 innings vs. New York ranks fifth among pitchers with four-or-more starts against the Yanks since 2024.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 13 major league home games this season, is 4-3 with a 5.29 ERA (66.1 IP, 39 ER), 24 walks and 60 strikeouts, compared to 2-4 with a 4.48 ERA (66.1 IP, 33 ER), 27 walks and 54 strikeouts in 12 road games...in 36 career home games, is 11-14 with a 4.88 ERA (190.0 IP, 103 ER), 61 walks and 214 strikeouts.

 Φ At home this season, he has posted a .260 (65-for-250) opponent batting average and a 1.34 WHIP.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: This season, left-handed batters have slashed .240/.328/.412 with 11 doubles. one triple, nine home runs, 36 RBI and a 1.73 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 233 at-bats against Bradley... right-handed batters have slashed .243/.301/.363 with 11 doubles, seven home runs, 30 RBI and a 2.95 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 267 at-bats against Bradley.

© In his career, lefties have slashed .241/.315/.411 with a 2.77 strikeout-to-walk ratio, while righties have slashed .245/.305/.441 with a 3.07 strikeout-to-walk ratio against Bradley.

This season (2148 pitches), his chase rate is 26.4 percent and his whiff rate is 23.6 percent... his walk rate is 9.1 and his strikeout rate is 20.3 percent...his average exit velocity is 89.1 mph

and his hard-hit rate is 38.9 percent.

◆ Bradley's 57.6 percent strikeout rate on his curveball ranks second in baseball among pitchers with 200-plus curves thrown this season...his 38 strikeouts on the pitch are the fourth most in baseball among pitchers with 400-or-fewer curveballs thrown this season...in 2023, Bradley had 30 strikeouts on 304 curves, and in 2024, he had nine strikeouts on 205 curves.

TWO-OUT TITAN: Among all pitchers with 20-or-more starts this season, Bradley's .184 (27-for-147) opponent batting average with two outs ranks seventh...under those same criteria, his .202 BABIP ranks fourth and his .245 opponent on-base percentage ranks tenth.

• Allowed three two-out hits on September 4, his most in a game since he allowed four two-out with the contents of 1.2024 by Treats 4.
