RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a five-game, six-day road trip against the Yankees (1-0, one to play) and Orioles (three to play) today at Yankee Stadium...are a season-high 19 games above .500, the third-earliest date they have reached that mark in franchise history behind 2023 (May 3, 25-6) and 2010 (May 20, 30-11)...own the best record in the majors for the sixth consecutive day, their first time leading MLB since June 30, 2023 (57-28)...have won five straight, nine of 11, 16 of 19, 22 of 26, and 29 of their last 37 games...the 22-4 run is tied for the best 26-game span in franchise history (3x, last: June 30-July 30, 2013)...since Opening Day, have boosted their postseason odds from 28.9 pct. to 93.6 pct., an MLB-leading 64.7 pct. increase (FanGraphs)...are off to the second-best start in club history, trailing only the 2023 Rays (35-14), in spite of having the fourth-toughest strength of schedule (.506 opp. winning pct.) in the majors thus far...hold a 5.5-game lead in the AL East, their largest since July 4, 2023 (6.0 GA, 57-31)...have led the division for 15 consecutive days (May 9-pres.), their longest reign at the top since a club-record 113-day streak in 2023 (Opening Day-July 19)...have spent 21 days leading the AL East, 25 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth...are 13-3 on a stretch of 20 games (May 4-27) that includes 18 meetings with divisional opponents.

★ The Rays took the first game of their series in New York, 4-2, on Friday night...marked their ninth straight win in a series opener, tied for the third-longest streak in team history (also: July 25-Aug. 22, 2023) and their longest since a 10-game streak between May 23-June 24, 2025.

★ The Rays earned their 14th comeback win behind a four-run 8th inning, tied for the most in the AL with the Athletics and Guardians (see more in "Refuse To Lose" note below).

★ **Nick Martinez** spun 6.0 innings with one run allowed on Friday night, his 10th straight start with two runs or fewer to begin the campaign...he is one of 17 traditional starters in the modern era (since 1900) to turn the trick and is the oldest pitcher in that group.

★ They improved to 14-2 vs. AL East clubs, tying the 2016 Cubs, 1998 Padres, and 1982 Cardinals for the second-best intradivision start in the divisional era (since 1969), trailing the 1981 Athletics (15-1)...have won a franchise-record four straight games against the Yankees to open the season...the club has won five consecutive games or more vs. a divisional opponent to begin a campaign twice previously (5G vs. TOR, May 4-12, 2026) and (6G vs. BAL, May 18-June 13, 2021).

★ Per Stats Perform, the Rays are an MLB-best 16-3 during May, tied for their best start (April 2023 & July 2013) to any calendar month in franchise history (see note "May Flowers" below).

★ Yesterday's game will be made up during a split doubleheader on Sept. 22 at 1:05 p.m. with game two scheduled for 7:05 p.m.

★ The Rays are a major-league best 12-2 (.857) when facing a left-handed starting pitcher in 2026.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Today, the Rays placed **OF Jonny DeLuca** (right hamstring strain) on the 10-day IL (retro May 23) and recalled **OF Victor Mesa Jr.** from Triple-A Durham.

★ During stints with Class-A Charleston (3G) and Triple-A Durham (18G), Mesa Jr. slashed .350/.435/.575 (28-for-80) with 7 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR, 9 RBI, and has hit safely in 20 of the 21 games.

★ He made his MLB debut with the Marlins on May 26, 2025 at SD and was acquired from Miami on Feb. 6 in exchange for minor league **INF Angel Brachi**.

WHAT'S AT STAKE—With a win today, the Rays would:

★ Tally their MLB-leading seventh sweep, the most sweeps before the end of May in franchise history, surpassing the 2023, 2021, 2010 clubs (all 6)...they had seven sweeps all of last season.

★ Sweep the Yankees for the second time this season, marking the first time they have swept the Yankees twice in the same year...would mark the first time the Rays have swept the same team twice in a campaign since 2023 (April 10-13 vs. BOS & Sept. 26-27 at BOS).

★ Record their second sweep on the road, tied for the most in the majors with six other clubs.

★ Tie the 2023 Rays for the best start in team history (35-15)...it would be the third-earliest date they have reached 20 games above .500 behind the 2023 (26-6, May 4) and 2010 (32-12, May 23) campaigns.

★ Improve to 10-0-0 in series against the AL and 12-0-0 in series against all non-NL Central opponents.

★ Match the best 27-game stretch in franchise history from June 29-July 30, 2013 (23-4)...the 2005 Athletics are the only club since 1991 to post a 23-4 stretch and miss the postseason.

★ Improve to 15-2 vs. AL East clubs, tying the 2016 Cubs and 1982 Cardinals for the second-best intradivision start in the divisional era (since 1969), trailing the 1981 Athletics (16-1).

★ Win 17 of their first 20 games in May, tying April 2023 and July 2013 for their best start to a calendar month.

★ Join the 1984 Tigers as the only clubs to win 25 of their first 29 games against the AL to begin a season.

REFUSE TO LOSE—The Rays 14 come-from-behind victories are tied for the most in the AL (also: ATH & CLE)...alongside the Braves (13-8), they are the only teams to post a winning record when their opponents score first (11-10)...the Rays have won a major league-best seven games when trailing after the 6th inning and are tied for the most wins when trailing after the 7th frame (also: DET & PHI).

★ The Rays have won each of their last two games despite trailing after the 7th frame in both contests...it marks the 12th time in franchise history they have accomplished such a comeback in back-to-back contests (last: April 23-24, 2025 at AZ)...they have won three straight when trailing after the 7th inning once in team history: July 17-19, 2009, doing so in each of game of a three-game series at the Royals.

★ The club has scored first in 28 games this season, tied for ninth most in the majors (also: DET & PHI), and has registered a major league-best 18 wire-to-wire wins...the Rays 23-5 (.821) record when scoring first trails only the Rangers (18-3/.857) in MLB, and their 23 wins are tied for second with the Braves and Pirates, trailing only the Yankees (24).

★ They have scored first in nine of their last 11 games (May 10-pres.) compared to three of their prior 22 contests (April 15-May 8)...the Rays are 13-3 when scoring in the opening frame, including nine straight wins...they have scored in the 1st inning in seven of their last 11 games.

THE GREAT YANDINO—**Yandy Diaz** has reached base in eight straight contests (May 12-pres.)...it is his third streak of eight games or more this season (also: 15G, April 1-18 & 10G, April 20-May 1)...has gone 11-for-27 (.407) over his last seven games on the heels of a 1-for-17 (.059) skid between May 8-12 during his active streak, he has hit .344 with 3 2B, 3 HR, 10 RBI, 4 BB, 1 HBP, a .432 OBP, and a 1.151 OPS.

★ Diaz's 150 OPS+ ranks fourth in the majors (min. 150PA) among all designated hitters (min. 50% of games at position)...he trails only HOU **Yordan Alvarez** (183), PHI **Kyle Schwarber** (156), and LAD **Shohei Ohtani** (151).

★ His whiff rate of 13.3 is the eighth lowest in the majors among qualified hitters and the third best in the AL behind CLE **Steven Kwan** (8.9%) and teammate **Chandler Simpson** (9.6%).

CED, CEDD N' CEDDY—**Cedric Mullins** is batting .341 (14-for-41) with 1 2B, 1 HR, 5 RBI, 8 R, and 4 SB over his last 12 games (May 6-pres.), which included a season-high six-game hitting streak (May 12-19)...he slashed .409/.500/.545 (9-for-22) with 1 HR, 3 RBI, 7 R, and a 1.045 OPS during the streak...Mullins has batted .313 (10-for-32) against fastballs in May compared to a .129 (8-for-62) during March/April...he is one of six players in the majors (CWS **Sam Antonacci**, SEA **Randy Arozarena**, PIT **Konnor Griffin**, CLE **Brayan Rocchio**, KC **Bobby Witt Jr.**) batting .300 or better (min. 50AB) with four stolen bases or more this month. (.302/16-for-53, 4SB).

MAJ FLOWERS—The Rays are 16-3 (.842) to begin May, tying April 2023 and July 2013 for their best start to a calendar month in team history...entering play today, it is the best winning pct. during any month in franchise history...if the club wins six of its final seven games this month, it will surpass July 2013 (21-5, .808) for best winning pct. in a month in franchise history...at their current pace, the Rays would finish the month 22-4, tying April 2023 and May 2021 (both 22-6) for the most wins in during a calendar month in team history.

★ **Jonathan Aranda**, who turned 28 yesterday, is slashing .333/.425/.439 (22-for-66) with 4 2B, 1 HR, 13 RBI, 10 BB, and an .864 OPS over 19 games during May...he ranks highly in the majors in on-base pct. (5th) and average (6th) in May, and has reached base safely in 16 of the 19 games.

★ With runners in scoring position, Rays hitters have slashed .336/.407/.461 (51-for-152) this month compared to .271/.349/.382 (71-for-262) in March/April...their .336 average with RISP is the fourth-highest in franchise history over a single month, behind only August 2023 (.338), May 2013 (.337), and March/April 2010 (.336 - by pct. points).

THE UNSLEEPING CITY—The Rays and Yankees conclude their second of four sets this season today...the Rays swept the Yankees at Tropicana Field between April 10-12, their first sweep of the Yankees since April 16-18, 2021 at Yankee Stadium...they will meet again in St. Petersburg between July 6-9 and in the Bronx from Sept. 22-24.

★ In his career, **Jonathan Aranda** is batting .400 (12-for-30) with 3 2B, 2 HR, 7 RBI, and a 1.157 OPS over nine games at Yankee Stadium, including a six-game hitting streak and a four-game RBI streak.

★ **Taylor Walls** has reached base safely in 15 straight games at NYY (Aug. 17, 2022-pres.), tied for the third-longest streak at in Rays history behind **Yandy Diaz's** (21G, June 3, 2021-April 20, 2024) and **Carl Crawford** (26G, Sept. 23, 2004-April 4, 2008) during the streak, he has slashed .327/.400/.538 (17-for-52) with 6 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 10 RBI and a .938 OPS...min. 40 AB, marks the fifth-best average by any player at Yankee Stadium over that span, trailing LAA **Mike Trout** (.386), PIT **Ryan O'Hearn** (.370), BOS **Rafael Devers** (.347), and TOR **Ernie Clement** (.340).

TODAY'S START—Drew Rasmussen will toe the rubber this afternoon for his 10th start of the campaign and 140th career appearance (91st start)...min. 40.0 IP, ranks second in the AL in opp. on-base pct. (.253) this season, while ranking sixth in both strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.14) and WHIP (1.00).

- ★ Min. 150.0 IP, his 2.22 ERA (190.1IP, 47ER) in day games ranks fourth among active pitchers, trailing CLE Emmanuel Clase (1.92), TEX Jacob deGrom (2.02), and TOR Tyler Rogers (2.13).
- ★ Rasmussen has fashioned a 10-0 career record with a 1.93 ERA (121.0, 26ER) during starts with six days of rest or more since his last start (27GS)...is the only MLB pitcher in the modern era (since 1900) with 10 wins or more without a loss in such starts.
- ★ Is four starts shy of tying Matt Garza (94GS) and Matt Moore (94GS) for ninth most in franchise history.
- ★ Needs 27 strikeouts to reach 500 for his career.

LAST TIME OUT—Rasmussen threw his 47th consecutive start with four runs or fewer allowed on May 17 vs. MIA, earning his fourth win of 2026 (W, 5.1IP, 7H, 2ER, 2BB, 2SO)...won back-to-back starts for the first time this season (May 11-pres.), and for the first time since winning consecutive starts between July 28-Aug. 2, 2025...allowed two hits his first time through the order: a double to Jakob Marsee and a single to Owen Caissie...surrendered RBI-singles to Xavier Edwards and Caissie in the 3rd inning...induced a 1-4-3 double play to escape a jam with runners on first and second base with one out in the 5th inning before turning the ball over to Kevin Kelly with one out in the 6th.

- ★ Improved to 3-0 with a 2.32 ERA (31.1IP, 8ER) across seven career appearances (five starts) against the Marlins.
- ★ Utilized his fastball at a 31.0 pct. clip (29-of-93), up from his 28.0 pct. usage on the season entering the start and threw his changeup 15.0 pct. of the time (14-of-93) compared to his 10.0 pct rate across his previous outings.
- ★ Rasmussen's average velocity on the four-seam fastball was 96.2 mph, his second-highest average this season behind his prior start on May 11 at TOR (96.3mph).

KING OF NEW YORK—Across eight career appearances (seven starts) opposite the Yankees, Rasmussen is 4-1 with a 1.03 ERA (43.2IP, 5ER) and 0.78 WHIP...this includes a 1.09 ERA (41.1IP, 5ER) across the seven starts, with four being quality, and all have come since being acquired by the Rays in June 2021...logged a quality start in his lone outing against the Yankees this season on April 12 at Tropicana Field, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with seven strikeouts...is his lowest career ERA among any opponent in his career.

- ★ He is 10-7 with a 2.51 ERA (172.1IP, 48ER) over 41 career appearances (31 starts) vs. AL East competition, including 9-6 with a 2.63 ERA (154.0IP, 45ER) in the 31 starts.
- ★ Rasmussen has fashioned a 3-0 career record with a 1.00 ERA (18.0IP, 2ER) and 22 strikeouts across three starts at Yankee Stadium, receiving 7.50 runs of support per 9.0 innings pitched in those games.
- ★ In two career day starts against the Yankees, he has not allowed a run in 11.1 innings pitched...Yankees hitters are slashing .079/.125/.105 (3-for-38) in day games against Rasmussen.

THAT'S LIFE—Among hitters who have logged 10 PA or more against Rasmussen, four of the 11 lowest career batting averages against him are currently on the Yankees roster.

- ★ INF Anthony Volpe is 0-for-11 (.000) with seven strikeouts and one walk against Rasmussen.
- ★ OF Aaron Judge has one single, batting .077 (1-for-13) with eight strikeouts.
- ★ INF Jazz Chisholm Jr. is hitting .125 (1-for-8) with one double, one RBI, two walks, and four strikeouts.
- ★ OF Cody Bellinger has gone 2-for-11 (.182) with two singles and one walk.

OL' RELIABLE—Rasmussen has allowed four runs or fewer in 47 straight regular-season starts (April 30-pres.), the longest run in franchise history by a traditional starter, ahead of Shane McClellan's 44-start run from April 29, 2021-July 26, 2022, and the longest active streak in the majors...he is one of seven pitchers in the modern era (since 1900) to turn the trick and the first since Jacob deGrom's 59-start streak between May 22, 2019-Sept. 18, 2022...Rasmussen is nine starts behind opener Ryne Stanek (56GS from May 26, 2018-July 16, 2019) for the longest streak by any starter in franchise history.

RIGHT ON—Right-handed hitters are batting .134 (9-for-67) with 15 SO and 0 BB against Rasmussen, the third-lowest mark in the majors (min. 60AB) behind CIN Chase Burns (.133) and BOS Payton Tolle (.133)...three of those seven hits came on May 5 vs. TOR—in his other seven starts, righties have gone a combined 6-for-63 (.095) against him...right-handed batters are hitting .063 (1-for-16) against his cutter, 1-for-12 (.083) off his four-seamer, and 5-for-34 (.147) against his sinker.

- ★ Min. 300 AB, his .185 (58-for-314) opp. average vs. right-handed batters since the start of 2025 ranks third in the majors behind NYM Freddy Peralta (.184) and PIT Paul Skenes (.185).

MAY I HAVE THIS DANCE—Rasmussen is 10-3 with a 2.50 ERA (93.2IP, 26ER) and 1.02 WHIP over 22 career appearances (16 starts) during the month of May, his most wins during any month in his career and his second-lowest ERA and WHIP to August (2.03 ERA, 0.93 WHIP)...five of his last six May starts have been quality, a span that began on May 17, 2025 at MIA...three of the six starts were scoreless.

FIRST THINGS FIRST—Rasmussen earned the starting nod for the Rays on Opening Day for the first time in his career, firing 5.0 innings of one-run ball on March 26 at STL...he became the 18th Opening Day starter in franchise history (12th right-hander), third in the last three seasons, and eighth in the last nine years on the heels of Chris Archer's four consecutive starts from 2015-18...at 30 years, 260 days old, he was the third-oldest pitcher to start for the Rays on Opening Day, trailing Charlie Morton (36.255) in 2020 and Tanyon Sturtze (31.172) in 2002.

BEST OF THE BEST—Among active pitchers with 75 starts or more in their careers, Rasmussen's 2.92 ERA ranks third behind TEX Jacob DeGrom (2.59) and LAD Shohei Ohtani (2.80)...he also ranks third in opp. OPS (.605) and opp. slugging pct. (.335), fifth in opp. on-base pct. (.271), eighth in WHIP (1.06), and
