**THE TWINS:** After getting swept in three games at Truist Park by the Braves last weekend, the Twins returned home and began their six-game homestand by going 2-1 against the White Sox over the last three days...tonight, the Twins will welcome the Angels for a three-game series over the weekend.

☞ Twins are 6-6 at home this season and have gone 5-2 in their last seven at Target Field.  
 ☞ Due to NBA playoff scheduling conflicts (Wolves vs. Lakers at Target Center), tonight's game against the Angels has been moved from 7:10 to 6:40 pm and Sunday afternoon's game has been moved from 1:10 to 12:40 pm...the series is tied at 1-1.

**RAIN WASHES OUT A SWEEP CHANCE:** The Twins were shut out by the White Sox yesterday afternoon by a score of 3-0 in a rain-shortened 7-inning game, missing the opportunity to sweep...Chris Paddock (0-3) was the starter and dealt the loss, allowing two runs on five hits (1 HR - Lenyn Sosa) in 5.0 innings pitched, with four walks and five strikeouts...the offense recorded six hits, two apiece from Brooks Lee and Christian Vázquez...Minnesota went 0-for-9 with runners in scoring position and left seven men on base...marked the third shutout of the Twins this season.

**RE-CELEBRATING PABLO DAYS:** The Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Pablo López from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List...López has missed the Twins' last 14 games with a right hamstring strain...he made one rehab start with Triple-A St. Paul on April 19 at Iowa, allowing one run on three hits (1 HR), with no walks and four strikeouts...López takes the 26-man roster spot vacated by right-handed pitcher David Festa, who was optioned after his start on Wednesday night against the Chicago White Sox.

**LÓP-ACE:** Since being acquired by the Twins in January of 2023, Pablo López has gone 27-19, 3.77 ERA (396.0 IP, 166 ER) with 91 walks, 446 strikeouts, a 1.17 WHIP and 39 quality starts in 67 starts...below are López's ranks among AL starters since the start of 2023 (minimum 350.0 innings pitched):

**I CAN SEE YOUR HALO:** The Twins went 5-1 against the Angels last season, going 3-0 in Anaheim from April 26-28 and 2-1 at Target Field from September 9-11...they outscored the Angels 50-28 over the six games...they won the season-series over Anaheim for the first time since 2019 (5-1).

☞ Last season, the Twins hit .332 (71-for-214) with 8.3 runs-per-game and a .961 OPS over the six games with Anaheim...50 overall runs scored were their most against any non-AL Central opponent.

☞ Ty France is hitting .297 (22-for-74) with 16 RBI and a .936 OPS in his last 21 games against the Angels...additionally, he has 36 career RBI against LAA, his most vs. any opponent.

☞ Carlos Correa has reached safely in each of his last nine games against the Angels...he is hitting .302 (105-for-348) with 25 doubles, 17 home runs, 69 RBI, a .382 on-base percentage, a .520 slugging percentage and a .902 OPS in 94 career games against the Angels...the 69 RBI are his most vs. any opponent and the 17 home runs are his second most (Texas - 21)...additionally, his 69 RBI are tied for fifth most among actives.

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .391 (9-for-23) with 10 RBI and a 1.274 OPS in his last six games against the Angels.

☞ Trevor Larnach has reached base safely 11 times in his last 17 plate appearances against the Angels (.647 OBP, 6 hits, 5 walks).

**LUKE OVER HERE!:** Luke Keaschall has hit safely in all six games played, hitting .368 (7-for-19) with three doubles, two RBI, four runs, five walks and five stolen bases.

☞ Keaschall's five stolen bases already rank him tied for fourth among MLB rookies...Tampa Bay's Jake Mangum is the leader with eight.

☞ Last Twins rookie to hit safely in each of their first six games was Brooks Lee, from July 3-8, 2024...the last to hit in their first seven was Miguel Sanó, from July 2-8, 2015 (also 7)...the club record for a rookie is 23, held by Kent Hrbek from April 17-May 13, 1982.

**NO RISP, NO REWARD:** After hitting .273 (45-for-165) with runners in scoring position in their first 20 games (through April 18) - a mark that ranked seventh in baseball in that span - the Twins are hitting .128 (6-for-47) with RISP in their last five games...they went 4-for-15 on Wednesday night and 0-for-9 yesterday.

**REJOICE, HERE COMES ROYCE:** Infielder Royce Lewis is beginning his rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul as the Saints host Indianapolis at 5 pm at CHS Field...Royce has missed all 25 Twins games with a left hamstring strain, an injury he suffered in spring training on March 16, running out a ground ball to third base.

**"TREAT YOURSELF A ROUND OF SAUSAGE!":** On this day last season, the Twins debuted the Rally Sausage...it came near the middle of what turned out to be a 12-game winning streak, where the Twins beat the White Sox four times, Angels three times, White Sox again three times and the Red Sox twice - from April 22-May 4.

☞ After seven consecutive wins, pre-game on April 28 in Anaheim, media asked Rocco Badelli to comment on the sausage and he replied with this: "It's a tangy summer sausage...I actually looked at the package yesterday...and it's bringing us a lot of runs and hits and stuff, so I'm all for it...I mean, for those who haven't been following, it's a substantial package...Jeffers has been carrying it around in his bag...and like, throwing it at people when we score runs and hit homers...I'm not even an adult, but slightly concerned, as like, more of an adult than some of the people in the other room...that thing hasn't been refrigerated in many days...when that thing opens up, no doubt in my mind whoever is touching it is in deep, deep trouble...there's no doubt that we are carrying around something that is very unhealthy to the human body."

- ☞ López is 3-1 with a 3.38 ERA (24.0 IP, 9 ER), 9 walks and 34 strikeouts in four career starts against Los Angeles-AL.
- ☞ Allowed one run on three hits (0 ER), one walk and six strikeouts in 4.2 innings during his last major league start at Kansas City on April 8, before exiting the game due to injury.

**CLEAN BILL OF HEALTH:** Pitched on April 19 for the Triple-A St. Paul Saints on a rehab assignment against the Iowa Cubs at Principal Park...allowed one run off three hits, with no walks and four strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...took the loss in St. Paul's 0-1 defeat.

- ☞ Until this season, López had not missed a major league game in three years, pitching 32 games in 2022, 2023 and 2024.
- ☞ His last appearance in the minors was in 2021 when he was on rehabilitation assignment with the Triple-A Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Last pitched for the Twins on April 8 at Kansas City, opposite Cole Ragans, allowing one unearned run on three hits, one walk and six strikeouts over 4.2 innings...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-1 loss...exited the game with two on and two outs in the fifth inning due to a right hamstring strain; in relief, Cole Sands recorded the third out without allowing a run...López was placed on the 15-day Injured List on April 11.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Pitched on April 2 at Rate Field vs. the White Sox...earned his first win of the season, and his first win since September 10, 2024, in Minnesota's 6-1 victory...allowed one run on four hits (1 ER, 1 HR) in 7.0 quality innings...secured his first career win against the White Sox and the Twins' second win of the season.

- ☞ With 7.0 innings pitched, López surpassed 900 career innings...he is the 53rd among active starting pitchers in MLB to accomplish this.
- ☞ His lone run allowed was a home run from Brooks Baldwin during the seventh inning.
- ☞ This marked the first time he has allowed one run or less since his scoreless three game streak from August 18-30, 2024.

**FALLEN ANGELS:** In four career starts against Los Angeles-AL, López is 3-1, posting a 3.38 ERA (24.0 IP, 9 ER), with six walks and 34 strikeouts...allowing 13 runs off 22 hits (4 HR)...lone loss came in his first start on May 21, 2023 at Angel Stadium; has been undefeated since.

- ☞ Last start vs. the Halos came on September 10 at Target Field, allowing four unearned runs on eight hits in 7.0 innings, with one walk and 10 strikeouts...earned the win in a Twins 10-5 victory.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Since being traded to the Twins, López has gone 13-8 with a 3.86 ERA (191.1 IP, 82 ER), 10.21 K/9, 1.93 BB/9 and 0.99 HR/9 in 32 starts at home, compared to 16-11 with a 3.52 ERA (217.1 IP, 85 ER), 9.90 K/9, 2.19 BB/9 and 1.28 HR/9 in 37 road starts.

- ☞ In his last five starts at home, López has gone 4-1, posting a 1.08 ERA (33.1 IP, 4 ER), with five walks and 35 strikeouts...allowed nine runs on 30 hits (3 HR).
- ☞ Pablo is 2-0 in two starts against the Angels at Target Field, and has posted a 2.08 ERA (13.0 IP, 3 ER), with two walks and 17 strikeouts...also has a .250 (13-for-52) opponent batting average.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Through three starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .333/.333/.515 in 33 at-bats vs. López, while righties have slashed .125/.176/.156 in 32 at-bats...lefties posted an average exit velocity of 91.8 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 53.6 compared to righties' 86.2 mph and 26.1 percent.

- ☞ Has a whiff rate of 19.7 percent vs. lefties and 26.8 percent vs. righties.
