CARDS VS. CARDS: The St. Louis Cardinals are preparing for their 135th season of play in the National League and yesterday concluded their 29th Spring Training in Jupiter, Florida ... This evening, the Cardinals visit the Springfield Cardinals (AA) at Hammons Field to play an Exhibition Game before hosting the Tampa Bay Rays on Opening Day on Thursday, March 26, the earliest game in franchise history ... First pitch on Thursday is 3:15 p.m. CT.

SPRINGFIELD-ST. LOUIS EXHIBITION MOMENTS: St. Louis leads the all-time series with Springfield, 5-1.

- The Cardinals are making their first trip to Springfield since March 31, 2017, when **Mike Leake** (7.0), **Sandy Alcantara** (1.0), and **Dakota Hudson** (1.0) pitched for the Cardinals opposite of 21-year-old prospect **Jack Flaherty** ... **José Martínez** and **Matt Adams** each chipped in with two hits for St. Louis.
- The last Cardinal to homer at Hammons Field was **Albert Pujols**, who belted a solo homer off **Jaime García** in the 3rd inning in the 3-2 St. Louis victory in 2012.
- The last Springfield Cardinal to homer off St. Louis at Hammons Field was **Tyler Greene**, who went yard off **Russ Springer** in 2008.
- Cardinals Coach **Jon Jay** batted leadoff and went 3-for-4 with a double for Springfield in the March 29, 2008 game, a 10-3 S-Cards victory.
- Cardinals Coach **Daniel Descalso** was 1-for-1 with a pair of walks for St. Louis in the 3-2 Cards win on April 3, 2012 ... Jay was 1-for-3 with a double that game.
- In the second exhibition on April 3, 2005, **Albert Pujols**, **Scott Rolen**, and **Jim Edmonds** all homered in the 18-6 St. Louis win.
- The most recent pitching appearance by any current Cards coach was Special Advisor & Pitching Instructor **Jason Isringhausen**, who earned a save with a scoreless 9th inning of a 3-2 win on March 29, 2008.

WEDNESDAY WORKOUT DAY: The Cardinals and Rays will hold team workouts and batting practice at Busch Stadium on Wednesday, March 25 ... Tampa Bay's workout is scheduled for 1:00 p.m. CT, followed by St. Louis.

FORMER S-CARDS: Including injury rehab appearances, 17 players on the projected 2026 Cardinals Opening Day roster (including the injured **Lars Nootbaar**) have played for Springfield in their career ... Those to have never worn a Springfield jersey include pitchers **Justin Bruihl**, **Matthew Liberatore**, **Dustin May**, **Riley O'Brien**, **Matt Pushard**, **Jojo Romero**, **George Soriano**, and **Ryne Stanek**; catcher **Yohel Pozo**; and infielder **José Fermín**.

CARDS COACHES RETURN: The Cardinals Major League coaching staff includes one former Springfield manager (**Ron "Pop" Warner**), two former coaches (**Brandon Allen & Casey Chenoweth**), and two former players (**Jon Jay & Daniel Descalso**).

- Warner piloted Springfield for five seasons from 2007-11, where he managed both Descalso and Jay.
- Chenoweth served as the hitting coach for Texas League Champion Springfield last season.
- Allen was the S-Cards hitting coach in 2019.
- Descalso played two seasons (2008-09) and was a 2009 Texas League Mid-Season & Post-Season All-Star.
- Jay played two seasons (2007-08) in Springfield and was a 2008 Texas League All-Star.

LIBBY TO START OPENING DAY: LHP **Matthew Liberatore** was named the Cardinals Opening Day starter vs. Tampa Bay on March 26, the first of his career.

- The 26-year-old Liberatore becomes one of just 16 left-handers to make an Opening Day start for St. Louis (since 1901) and the first since **Donovan Osborne** on April 5, 1999 vs. Milwaukee, the same year Libby was born.
- The last Cardinals Opening Day lefty starter to be credited with a win was **John Tudor** in a 9-3 win over the Cubs on April 7, 1987 at Wrigley Field.
- Libby will be facing his drafting team, the Tampa Bay Rays (1st round, 2018), for the 3rd time in his career and for the 2nd time at Busch ... The southpaw pitched arguably his finest career outing against the Rays at Tropicana Field (Aug. 10, 2023) firing a career-high 8.0 scoreless IP of two-hit ball with a season-high seven strikeouts in a 5-2 win.

#3 DUSTIN MAY · RHP · 6-6 · 215 LBS · AGE 28

- Signed by the Cardinals to a one-year contract with a mutual option for a second year, December 17, 2025. Was his first free agent contract.
- Played the majority of his professional and Major League career with the Dodgers organization before being traded to the Boston Red Sox at the 2025 trade deadline.
- Missed the entire 2024 season recovering from Tommy John surgery repairing a torn flexor tendon in his right arm from July 2023 and an esophageal tear in July.
- When he made his season debut on April 1, 2025 vs. Atlanta, was his first action in a Major League game in 685 days dating back to May 17, 2023.
- Carries three World Championship rings as a member of the Los Angeles Dodgers. Played in the 2020 World Series at the neutral site at Globe Life Field, home of the Texas Rangers. Was on the Injured List during the 2024 World Series. Was traded before the Dodgers won the World Series in 2025.
- Became the first Dodgers rookie to make an Opening Day start when he took the mound on July 24, 2020 in place of injured Clayton Kershaw. The last Dodgers rookie to make an Opening Day start was Fernando Valenzuela in 1981.
- Pitched for the National League in the 2019 Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game at Progressive Field in Cleveland. Pitched a scoreless 3rd inning in the game. Was teammates with current Cardinals infielder Nolan Gorman.
- Held opposing right-handed batters to a .602 OPS since the start of 2019, ranks 29th in Major League Baseball over that period (min. 600 total batters faced).

#49 BRYCEN MAUTZ · LHP · 6-3 · 225 LBS · AGE 24

- 2025 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year.
- 2025 Texas League Postseason All-Star.
- Ranks 12th in all of Minor League Baseball with 377 strikeouts since the start of 2023.
- Posted three double-digit strikeout games in his career with a career-high 12 vs. Fort Wayne (8/20/24).
- Fired a career-best 23.0 consecutive scoreless innings (7/18-8/11/23) in his first professional season.
- Pitched the entire season in Springfield (AA) making 25 starts and leading the Texas League in WHIP (1.11) and winning percentage (.727, 11-3). Ranked 2nd in ERA (2.98) and T-4th in strikeouts (134).
- Held his opposition to one run or less in 16 starts with six scoreless starts.
- Both his parents were Division 1 athletes at the University of Wisconsin. His father Alex compete in the shot put and his mother Jaime played volleyball.
