3 Mariners starting pitching has allowed 3-or-fewer runs in 16 of their last 18 games (5/31-c)...they hold a 2.54 ERA (31 ER, 109.2 IP) over that stretch.

4 The Mariners have won their last 4 get-away day games (5/26 at WSH, 6/6 at OAK, 6/9 at KC and 6/16 vs. TEX).

7 The Mariners have won 7 of the last 9 games they have played in Cleveland (6/13/21-c).

TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners continue their 9-game road trip with the last of 3 games against the Cleveland Guardians (1-1)...starting tomorrow night, Seattle will visit the Miami Marlins (3 G, June 21-23) and will finish the current trip with Tampa Bay (3 G, June 24-26)...the Mariners are coming off a 7-game homestand (6-1) against the Chicago White Sox (3-1) and Texas Rangers (3-0)...today's game will be televised live on **ROOT SPORTS** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Mike Blowers** on the call...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzo** and **Gary Hill** on the call.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners dropped last night's middle game to the Guardians, evening the series at 1-1...despite the loss, the Mariners are 13-5 over their last 18 games (5/31-c) and 17-6 over their last 23 games (5/26-c)...the Mariners are 34-5 (.872) when scoring 4+ runs in a game (2nd-best record in MLB behind the Yankees)...Seattle is 34-3 when out-hitting its opponent.

- **Rubber Souls** - The Mariners are 6-4 in rubber games this season, having gone 6-1 over their last 7 rubber games after beginning the season 0-3.
- **Series-ly Sensational** - The Mariners own a 13-4-1 series record over their last 18 series (4/15-c).
- **Double Digits** - Seattle leads the AL West by 9.0 games, tied with the Dodgers (+9.0) for the largest divisional lead in MLB.
- **Quality Beginnings** - The Mariners are 36-10 (.783) when their starting pitcher tosses a quality start this season.

BEST IN THE WEST...the Mariners (44-32) hold 1st place in the American League West Division by 9.0 games over the Houston Astros (34-40) and Texas Rangers (34-40) who are tied for 2nd place...the Mariners have held 1st place for 39 consecutive days (5/12-c).

60-GAME DASH...Luis Castillo is making his 60th start since joining the Mariners on Aug. 3, 2022...in a pitcher's first 59 starts for Seattle, he ranks 1st in strikeouts (388), 4th in ERA (3.30), 10th in wins (24) and 13th in innings pitched (351.2)...a win tonight would make him the 10th pitcher in franchise history with 25 wins in their first 60 starts...he would be the first to do so since Marco Gonzales in 2019.

FUN IN THE SUN...Julio Rodriguez has batted .318 (34x107) with 5 doubles, 4 home runs, 14 RBI and 14 runs in day games this season...his .318 average is the 9th-best in the Majors and 7th-best in the AL this season (min. 100 PA)...Rodriguez has reached base in 22 of the 26 day games he has played in this year, including 9 of his last 10 (5/25-c).

ROAD D-MOLITION...Dylan Moore is 2-for-7 with 3 runs, 1 double, 1 home run, 1 RBI, 1 walk and 1 stolen base during the current road trip...in 32 games this season on the road, Moore is batting .270 (27x100) with 21 runs, 10 doubles, 1 triple, 5 home runs, 14 RBI and 8 stolen bases, getting on base at a .402 clip and slugging .540 (.942 OPS)...among players with at least 100 plate appearances on the road this season, Moore ranks 9th in OPS and 12th in slugging percentage.

MASTERING THE MOUND...the Mariners pitching staff leads MLB in WHIP (1.07), fewest walks-per-9 innings (2.42), strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.51) and quality starts (46), while ranking 2nd in opponent batting average (.217), T-6th in ERA (3.50) and 3rd in fewest hits-per-9 innings (7.21).

WATCH US WHIP...Seattle has 3 starters that rank among the top-10 in the American League in WHIP this season: **Logan Gilbert** (0.92 WHIP, 1st), **Bryce Miller** (1.01 WHIP, 9th) and **George Kirby** (1.01 WHIP, 10th), while **Luis Castillo** ranks 17th with a 1.14 WHIP...the last team to finish a season with 4 qualified pitchers posting a WHIP of 1.15-or-lower was the 2016 Chicago Cubs.

NEVER DONE WITH ONE-RUN...Seattle is 17-7 (.708) in 1-run games, most 1-run wins in the big leagues and best 1-run record in the Majors, ranking ahead of Minnesota (.700/14-6) ...since **Scott Servais** took over as Mariners manager (2016-c), Seattle owns the most 1-run wins (231) and best 1-run winning percentage (.570/231-174) in the Majors during that span.

ANDRÉS MUÑOZ: AL ALL-STAR?...right-hander **Andrés Muñoz** has 13 saves and a 1.47 ERA (5 ER, 30.2 IP) with 42 strikeouts and 10 walks in 29 appearances this season...Muñoz has posted a 0.95 WHIP and limited opposing hitters to a .176 batting average...the 25-year-old is 1 of 2 American League pitchers with 14+ saves and a sub-2.00 ERA this season, along with Emmanuel Clase-CLE...Muñoz has recorded 5 saves of at least 4 outs, the most in the Majors this season.

GARV SAUCE...Mitch Garver went 2-for-5 with 2 doubles, and 2 RBI in Tuesday's series opener, and has reached base safely in 11 of his last 14 games (6/2-c), batting .250 (10x40) with 5 runs, 5 doubles, 3 home runs, 13 RBI and 11 walks, getting on base at a .412 clip and slugging .600 (1.012 OPS)...his 11 walks in June are tied for 6th-most in MLB, trailing only Juan Soto-NYY (19), Freddie Freeman-LAD (14), Willy Adames-MIL (13), Aaron Judge-NYY (12) and Bryce Harper-PHI (12).

CAL RALEIGH? CAL RALLY!...Cal Raleigh has 24 RBI in the 7th inning and later this season, most in MLB...Raleigh is the only player in the Majors with 3 go-ahead or game-tying home runs in the 9th inning or later this season, and is also the only player with 2 go-ahead grand slams...Cal is toting a .956 OPS in "Late & Close" situations on *Baseball-Reference*, batting .250 (11x44) with 3 doubles, 4 HR, 18 RBI and 8 walks.

STOP IT!...Seattle's infield defense has impressed with its .987 fielding percentage (18 errors in 1,352 total chances) between 1B/2B/3B/SS ranking best in the American League behind Minnesota (.986) and Texas (.866)...**Josh Rojas'** 6 Outs Above Average are the most among third basemen via *Baseball Savant*...**J.P. Crawford** leads MLB shortstops in fielding percentage (.994), committing just 1 error across 164 total chances.

THE NEXT HOMESTAND...following the current road trip, the Mariners will return home for 9-game homestand from June 28-July 7, hosting the Minnesota Twins (3 G, June 28-30), Baltimore Orioles (3 G, July 2-4) and Toronto Blue Jays (3 G, July 5-7)...upcoming promotions on the homestand include **J.P. Crawford "City Connect" Bobblehead Night** on June 28, **Aloha Shirt Night** on June 29, Bark at the Park on July 2, **Patriotic Fireworks** on July 3 and **Patriotic Cap** on July 4.

AS YOU MAY KNOW...Andrés Muñoz is approaching 150 career appearances with Seattle, entering today's action with 146 outings in a Mariners uniform, and...**AS YOU MAY ALSO KNOW**...Muñoz holds a 2.42 ERA (39 ER, 145.1 IP) with 49 walks and 206 strikeouts in his Mariners career, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...Andrés has a chance to become the 7th reliever in MLB history age 25-or-younger to post a sub-2.50 ERA with 200+ strikeouts over his first 150 appearances with a club?...he would join Josh Hader-MIL (2.39 ERA, 347 K), Aroldis Chapman-CIN (2.20 ERA, 233 K), Kenley Jansen-LAD (2.21 ERA, 248 K), Craig Kimbrel-ATL (2.36 ERA, 258 K), Francisco Rodriguez-LAA (2.36 ERA, 259 K) and Bruce Sutter-CHC (1.87 ERA, 268 K)...of that group Muñoz would be the first in MLB history to eclipse those numbers (sub-2.50 ERA/200+ K), while also allowing fewer than 60 walks.

ABOUT CASTILLO...

- The 31-year-old right-hander is set to make his 16th start of the year and 2nd against Cleveland...he is also making his 197th Major League start and 9th career start against the Guardians. Has been named an All-Star in 2019, 2022 and 2023. Originally signed as an international free agent by the San Francisco Giants on 12/23/11. Made MLB debut on 6/23/17 vs. Washington (w/ Cincinnati). Signed a 5-year contract extension with the Seattle Mariners on Sept. 24, 2022 after being acquired in a trade with Cincinnati on July 30, 2022.

LAST TIME OUT...W#6 on 6/12 vs. Texas...tossed 6.0 innings and allowed 2 runs on 4 hits with 1 walk and 7 strikeouts...his 10th quality start of the season.

CRUISE CONTROL...since his start on April 20 at Colorado, the right-hander is 6-3 with a 2.53 ERA (19 ER, 67.2 IP) and a 0.98 WHIP...9 of the 11 starts in that span have been quality starts.

7 7 7...in 2024, Castillo has gone 7.0+ innings and allowed 0 runs on 3 occasions, is tied for the most in the Majors (also: Ranger Suárez-PHI, Tyler Glasnow-LAD and Max Fried-ATL)...each of the 3 outings have come since April 20.

BARNSTORMING...since 9/25/22, he has thrown 5.0+ innings in 23 consecutive road starts...marks the T-3rd-longest active streak in the Majors, behind Kyle Gibson-STL (25), Mitch Keller-PIT (25), Miles Mikolas-STL (24) and Corbin Burnes-BAL/MIL (24).

WHIFF ARTIST...currently 9th in the AL in strikeouts this season with 85...he is also 8th in MLB and 4th in the AL in swings-and-misses (204) this season...had 6+ strikeouts in 8 consecutive starts from 4/2-5/12.

MASTER OF THE STRIKEOUT...since he made his Mariners debut on 8/3/22, Castillo leads the Major Leagues with 388 strikeouts and 1st in MLB with 875 swings-and-misses.

FOR CLUB & COUNTRY...in MLB history, he ranks highly among Dominican-born pitchers in various categories...minimum 1100.0 innings pitched, he ranks 2nd in SO/9 (9.8), 2nd in SO/BB (3.25), 7th in ERA (3.52) and 16th in strikeouts (1248)...he is 2 strikeouts from tying Miguel Batista (1250) for 15th-most strikeouts...among active Dominican-born pitchers, he is 2nd in games started (196), wins (68), innings pitched (1144.0), strikeouts (1248) and quality starts (109), trailing in all to Johnny Cueto (363 GS, 144 W, 2245.0 IP, 1851 SO and 206 QS)...Castillo was born in Bani, Dominican Republic.

CRITICAL MOMENTS...in 2024 is holding opposing hitters to a .214 (6x28) average when there are runners in scoring position with 2 outs...in 29 such plate appearances this season, he has allowed 2 doubles, 1 home run and 1 walk with 8 strikeouts...has gone 16 straight plate appearances without allowing a hit when there is a runner in scoring position with 2 outs.

OF QUALITY...in 7 starts from 4/14-5/18, he was 4-2 with a 2.01 ERA (10 ER, 44.2 IP), 48 strikeouts, 11 walks and a 0.90 WHIP...all 7 starts were quality starts, while opponents slashed .236/.281/.402...he is 1 of 4 pitchers in the Majors this season to have a 7+ streak of quality starts (also: Corbin Burnes-BAL (8), Ranger Suárez-PHI (7) and Luis Gil-NYY (7)).

CHASING A DREAM...entering tonight he sits in the 84th percentile for Chase% in the Majors (Chase% measures the proportion of pitches outside of the strike zone that batters swing at) (per Baseball Savant)...has a Chase% of 32.3% so far in 2024, which registers as the best in his career.

60-GAME DASH...is making his 60th start since joining the Mariners in 2022...with 1 start before he reaches 60 career starts for Seattle, he already has the most strikeouts in franchise history through a starting pitchers' first 60 starts (387)...through 59 starts, he ranks 4th with a 3.30 ERA (129 ER, 351.2 IP), trailing James Paxton (3.25), Joel Piñeiro (3.24) and Erik Hanson (3.24).

THE POWER BATS...has held batters in the 3-5 spots in the lineup to a .197 (34x173) average with 9 doubles, 1 triple, 5 home runs and 43 strikeouts this season.

QUANTITY AND QUALITY...during his start against the Chicago Cubs on 4/14, he earned his 100th quality start in his career...he is 1 of 30 active pitchers to have 100 or more quality starts in their career (27th most, 109).

1,000 AND COUNTING...recorded his 1,000th career strikeout on 5/22/23 against Oakland...he currently has the 25th-most strikeouts among active pitchers with 1,248.

AWARD SEASON...finished 5th in 2023 American League Cy Young Award voting after ranking among the league leaders in fWAR (10th, 3.4), strikeouts (4th, 219), ERA (5th, 3.34), starts (T-1st, 33), SO/9 (4th, 10.01), Opp. AVG (.218/160x735, 3rd) and WHIP (1.096, 6th)...Gerrit Cole-NYY won the award.

CAREER YEAR...set career-best marks in several categories last season, including starts (33, also: 2021), innings pitched (197.0), walks-per-9-innings (2.6, also: 2018), strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.91).
