**BIRD WATCHING:** The St. Louis Cardinals open up their Antepenultimate homestand tonight when they begin a three-game series with the Colorado Rockies over the weekend, followed by a three-game series next week with Philadelphia...the Cardinals have yet to play Colorado or Philadelphia this season...the Cardinals, who yesterday enjoyed their 1st open date since the All-Star break, after playing 20 games in 20 days, have 47 games remaining in the regular season with 21 at home and 26 on the road.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis enters play today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 15.0 games behind 1st place Milwaukee; one-half game ahead of 4th place Cincinnati and 3.5 games out of the final National League Wild Card position...the Cardinals are 4-6 in their last 10 games, 7-13 in last 20 and 11-19 in last 30...they are 29-32 vs. team above .500 and 28-26 vs. sub .500 teams.

**NEW TO THE NEST:** Following Monday's trade deadline acquisition and a waiver claim yesterday, Cardinals fans will be getting their first home look at LHP **Caleb Ferguson** (#54) who was acquired on Monday in a trade with CIN for International Cap Space...Ferguson made his Cardinals debut with 1.2 scoreless IP on Tue. at Yankee Stadium...the Cardinals made a waiver claim yesterday, acquiring OF **Everson Pereira** (peh-RAY-ruh) from the Chicago White Sox.

**HEAD FOR THE MOUNTAINS OF BUSCH:** The Cardinals .716 home win pct. (48-19) vs. the Rockies is its best against any opponent since Busch Stadium III opened in 2006 ... St. Louis has won the season series vs. the Rockies 22 times in 32 seasons since Colorado joined MLB as an expansion team in 1993.

**HEART & HUSTLE:** Cardinals rookie **JJ Wetherholt** was announced today as the team's recipient of the MLBPA Heart & Hustle Award that is presented annually to an active player who demonstrates a passion for baseball and best embodies the values, spirit, and traditions of the game..JJ joins **Jon Jay** (2010) and **Harrison Bader** (2018) among previous Cardinals rookies to receive the recognition.

**INITIAL SERIES:** The Cardinals & Rockies 1st series meeting of the season this weekend also features the first meeting between NL Rookie standouts **JJ Wetherholt** and **TJ Rumfield**...both JJ & TJ rank among the NL rookie leaders in several categories including games played, runs scored, hits, HR's, RBI, OBP & OPS.

**LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON:** The Cardinals are recognizing **Joe Buck** this evening on his recent National Baseball Hall of Fame induction as the Ford C. Frick Award recipient for excellence in broadcasting with a pre-game ceremony and ceremonial first pitch with members of his family...Joe's father, **Jack Buck**, was the 1987 recipient of the Frick Award and he and Joe represent the only father/son Frick Award winners.

**IT ALL STARTS HERE:** Cardinals starting pitchers have provided the team with excellent stability, pitching to a 3.97 ERA that ranks 4th in the NL behind Division leaders MIL (3.36), LAD (3.56) and ATL (3.77)...the Cardinals 44 Quality Starts rank 3rd in the loop behind just the Dodgers (60) and Phillies (50)...tonight's starter **Kyle Leahy** (1.38) owned the NL's top starter ERA in July - it was the team's best July mark since 2009 when **Adam Wainwright** (1.17) & **Joel Pineiro** (1.22) had stellar Julys.

**HOLDING IT TOGETHER:** Cardinals relievers **George Soriano**, **Justin Bruihl** and **Ryne Stanek** carried Wednesday night's win for **Andre Pallante** (#12) over to closer **Riley O'Brien** for his 27th save...the Cardinals bullpen corps rank 2nd in the NL with 74 Holds, behind Atlanta (84)...**Stanek**, who marked his 9th season of MLB service time on Wed., is ranked 3rd in the NL (20) and **Soriano** T-6th (17)...**Stanek** needs one more Hold to match his single-season high 21 from 2021 with HOU...the Cardinals single-season Holds record was set in 2008 (106)...the Cardinals totaled 93 Holds last season.

**ON THIS DATE IN 2004:** Hall of Fame (2020) outfielder **Larry Walker**, who starred with the Expos (1989-1994), Rockies (1995-2004) and Cardinals (2004-2005), made his Cardinals debut on this date in 2004 after being acquired from the Rockies on August 6, 2004 in exchange for LHP Luis Martinez & LHP Chris Narverson...Walker belted 11 HR in 44 games following the trade that year and helped the Cardinals return to the World Series for the first time since 1987.

TONIGHT'S START:

- The 29-year old makes his 22nd start of the season (23rd career) and 120th career appearance; the first 97 appearances of his career all came in relief.
- Colorado native is facing the Rockies for the 6th time in his career (1st start); he's 1-0, 4.32 ERA in his 5 previous relief appearances (8.1 IP) with no HR's allowed.**
- His seven wins this season are a career high and rank 2nd on St. Louis to **Andre Pallante** (12).
- Led the NL and ranked 5th in MLB among qualifying pitchers with his 1.38 ERA (26.0 IP/4 ER) in the month of July;** it was the team's best July mark since 2009 when **Adam Wainwright (1.17)** & **Joel Pineiro (1.22)** had stellar Julys.
- Has allowed just five runs over his last seven starts (1.21 ERA; 37.1 IP/5 ER) since June 23, and is 4-1 with a 2.65 ERA (78.0 IP) and 69 strikeouts in his last 15 starts since May 1. **His 2.65 ERA since May 1 ranks 10th best in MLB.**
- Has an active streak of 7 starts allowing 2 runs or less, which ranks T-3rd in MLB behind Nationals PJ Poulin (11 such starts) and Tigers Troy Melton (8).**
- His 107.1 innings pitched are a single-season MLB career high as are his 91 strikeouts. His career single season high for IP as a professional was 144.2 in 2022 between Memphis (AAA) and Springfield (AA).
- Ranks in MLB's 97th percentile in arm extension (7.3 ft.) which is measured from how far off the mound he releases the ball on average.
- Has made 7 of his starts during nationally televised games including Easter Sunday on NBC/Peacock Sunday Night Baseball in Detroit, April 11 vs. Boston on FOX, Game 2 of a Doubleheader at Cincinnati on May 23 on FOX, May 30 vs. the Cubs on FOX, July 4 at Chicago's Wrigley Field on FOX, Friday, July 10 vs. Braves on Apple TV and July 20 at the LA Angels on ESPN.
- Four of his seven wins this season have come on the road: April 5 at Detroit, April 17 at Houston, April 28 at Pittsburgh, and July 4 at Chicago Cubs.
- Kyle's 97 career relief appearances before his 1st career Major League start (Sept. 28, 2025 at CHI) were the most by a Cardinal since **Jordan Hicks** (April 21, 2022 at Miami) who made his 1st career start after having made 114 career relief appearances.

LAST TIME OUT (Friday, July 31 at Toronto): ND, L, 3-1; 6.0 IP, 6 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO, 0 HR - 98 pitches.

- Posted his 7th straight start allowing 2 or fewer runs, yet took a ND as the Blue Jays gained a 3-1 win at Rogers Centre.
- It was his 4th consecutive start without a decision. The Cardinals have gone 1-3 in those games despite Kyle posting a 1.71.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

**BEND, DON'T BREAK:** Ranks 2nd among MLB starting pitchers in Opp. BA with 2 outs & RISP at .095 BA (4-42); CIN's **Chase Burns** (.093) leads the league.

**EN GARDE:** Ranks T-6th among NL pitchers with his 24 Opponent's Sword Swings (Max Meyer-MIA, 1st with 32). A "sword" swing is an expression of the art of forcing a batter to take an uncomfortable, awkward swing.

**AIR BENDER:** Boasts average swing & miss distances of 6.2 inches on his sweeper, ranking 11th in NL.

**HIGH HEAT:** Despite pitching in high heat (94 degrees) & humidity, he fanned a career high 9 batters while throwing a career single-game high 102 pitches on 7/26 vs. CIN

**HELLO 4TH OF JULY:** Hurled 5.0 scoreless innings through the Wrigley Field fog as the Cardinals handed the Cubs a 3-0 shutout on Independence Day ... Leahy allowed three singles and struck out six on only 77 pitches ... Following a 49-minute pre-game rain delay, JJ Wetherholt homered on the first pitch of the game . The game was also halted for 15 minutes after the 6th inning due to heavy fog combined with smoke from nearby fireworks.

**PARK PLACE:** Each of his first six road games took place at Parks ( Petco Park, Comerica Park, Daikin Park, loanDepot park, PNC Park, Great American Ball Park). His start at Target Field on June 12 ended the string.

**CENTRAL FOCUS:** Earned wins in three of his seven starts against NL Central opponents this season (April 28 at PIT, May 4 vs. MIL, July 4 at Chicago) to improve to 5-1 in his career against divisional opponents.

**NO DECISIONS:** Has earned the decision in 11 of his 21 starts, but just three decisions in his last 12 starts.

**STRETCHING OUT:** Has worked at least 5.0 innings in 17 of his 21 starts on the year, including a career-high 6.1 innings on 6/22 vs. Arizona.

**SNAKE CHARMER:** Blanked the Diamondbacks on just 3 hits over his career single-game high 6.1 IP on 6/22 vs. ARI, but took a no-decision while exiting the game with a scoreless tie.

**OH MOTHER:** Blanked the Padres over his 5.0 IP on just 2 hits on May 10 (Mother's Day), and was in line for the win before the Padres Nick Castellanos tied the game with a 2-out, 2-strike 2-run HR to tie the game at 2-2, and then SD won it in the 10th, 3-2.
