NEW YORK YANKEES (5-2) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (2-6)

April 5, 2025 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 4:05 EDT - Game #9/Home #2

RHP Marcus Stroman (0-0, 5.79 ERA) vs. LHP Bailey Falter (0-0, 3.00 ERA)

THE PIRATES: fell for the fifth time in their last six games with Friday's loss vs. the Yankees in the 2025 Home Opener...Returned to PNC Park after a seven-game, season-opening road trip in Miami (March 27-30) and Tampa Bay (March 31-April 2)...Opened the season on the road for the ninth consecutive year and the 10th time in 11 years (only time opening at home in that span came in 2016 against St. Louis)...Finished 2024 with a 76-86 record (fifth place in the N.L. Central).

SEVENTH HEAVEN: Oneil Cruz recorded his seventh walk of the season (tied for fifth-most in Major League Baseball) and stole his seventh base of the campaign (most in all of MLB) during Friday's Home Opener at PNC Park against the Yankees...Cruz is one of only eight Major League players since 1901 to have seven-plus steals and seven-plus walks through his team's first eight games of a season, the first since John Cangelosi with Chicago (AL) in 1986...Cruz has also hit two home runs in the first eight games of the season, making him the only Major League player since 1901 with two-plus homers, seven-plus steals and seven-plus walks through his club's first eight games of a season.

A PRO'S PRO: In Friday's Home Opener against the Yankees, Andrew McCutchen made his 14th appearance (10th start) in right field since rejoining the Pirates in 2023, his first since playing an inning there on June 23, 2024 vs. Tampa Bay (first start there since June 9, 2024 vs. Minnesota)...On Friday, McCutchen had three hits in a game for the first time since June 8, 2024 vs. Minnesota...At 38 years and 176 days old, he became the oldest Pirate to appear in a game in the outfield since Bill Robinson (38 years and 353 days) on June 14, 1982 vs. New York (NL)...He also became one of six Pirates since 1901 over the age of 38 to start a game in the outfield, joining Robinson (1981-82), Roberto Clemente (1972), Dixie Walker (1948-49), Tommy Leach (1918) and Fred Clarke (1911, 1913, 1915)...Over his last three games, McCutchen has hit safely in five of eight at-bats.

CAN'T CATCH ME: On Friday, Oneil Cruz successfully stole his 27th consecutive base (streak began on April 28, 2024)...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, it matched Frank Taveras' streak from April 23, 1976 to July 20, 1976 for the third-longest streak of consecutive successful steals by a Pittsburgh player since 1976...The only ones with longer streaks were Tony Womack (32 steals) from April 6, 1997 to July 4, 1997 and Nate McLouth (28 steals) from May 2, 2008 to May 26, 2009.

LOCK AND KE': In the seventh inning of Friday's game, Ke'Bryan Hayes connected for his first home run of 2025 and first since August 10, 2024 at Los Angeles (NL), a three-run shot off the Yankees' Fernando Cruz...Hayes also tripled in Wednesday's win at Tampa Bay, marking the first time he's recorded an extra-base hit in consecutive games since April 13 and April 14 of last season at Philadelphia...Hayes has hit safely in three consecutive games and in five of Pittsburgh's first eight games to begin the 2025 season.

IKF: Isiah Kiner-Falefa had two hits Friday and is 9-for-23 (.391) while hitting safely in each of his last seven games (he's hit out of the ninth spot of the lineup in each of the first eight games)...His .360 (9-for-25) average is the seventh-best in the National League (best among all Major League nine-hole hitters with 20-plus at-bats)...The last Pirate with a .360 average or better and four-plus steals through the team's first eight games of a season was Kiki Cuyler (.387, 4 steals) in 1927.

LEAN ON THE LEFTIES: Joey Wentz tossed 2.1 scoreless innings in relief while striking out three Yankees on Friday...Wentz' 6.1 innings so far in 2025 are tied with Los Angeles (NL)'s Luis García for second-most among Major League relievers, trailing only St. Louis' Steven Matz (7.0)...Pittsburgh's 17.2 innings from left-handed relievers (Wentz, Ryan Borucki, Caleb Ferguson and Tim Mayza) trail only the Dodgers (19.1) for most in all of MLB, while its 17 strikeouts from its left-handed relievers are tied with Philadelphia for second-most in MLB (Los Angeles-NL, 23)...Wentz has a 1.47 ERA (18.1ip/3er) w/18 strikeouts in 12 games with the Pirates (claimed from Detroit last September).

BUCS ON THE BASES: With Oneil Cruz' stolen base in Friday's game, Pittsburgh has now swiped an MLB-best 20 bases through the first eight games of 2025 (San Diego ranks second with 15 steals)...The 20 steals are the Pirates' second-most through their first eight games of a season since 1901 (the 1907 team had 24 steals through eight games)...They're also tied with the 1992 Milwaukee Brewers and the 1990 Cincinnati Reds for the third-most by any Major League team through its first eight games of a season in the Live-Ball Era (since 1920), trailing only the 1986 St. Louis Cardinals and the 1984 Cleveland Indians, who each had 21 steals.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

April 5, 2023: The Pirates completed a three-game sweep of the Boston Red Sox at Fenway Park with a 4-1 victory. Mitch Keller picked up his first win of the season, allowing one run on four hits with seven strikeouts in 7.0 innings. Bryan Reynolds posted his seventh RBI through the first six games of 2023 with a sacrifice fly, while also doubling, walking, stealing a base and scoring a run.

HOW ACQUIRED: From Philadelphia in deal for INF Rodolfo Castro on 8/1/23.

STARTING OFF: The 27-year-old lefty is in his third season with the Pirates after being acquired from the Phillies at the trade deadline on August 1, 2023 in exchange for infielder Rodolfo Castro...He's in his fifth Major League season after debuting in 2021... He was selected by Philadelphia in the fifth round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft.

VS. NEW YORK: Falter will make his second career start against the Yankees...He allowed four runs on four hits in 3.0 innings last September 29 at Yankee Stadium.

LAST TIME OUT: Falter did not earn a decision on March 29 at Miami after allowing only two runs with four strikeouts over 6.0 innings (Pittsburgh was walked off, 5-4).

ON THE HOME FRONT: Today will be Falter's first start of the 2025 season here at PNC Park...He went 5-4 with a 3.98 ERA (74.2ip/33er) in 14 starts along the banks of the Allegheny River last season, including 3-1 in his final five starting assignments here.

HITTING HIS SPOTS: Falter comes into today with the longest-active streak in MLB without hitting a batter (1121 plate appearances from 8/20/22 to 3/29/25)... According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the last pitcher with as long of a streak without hitting a batter was Yusmeiro Petit (1205 plate appearances) from 4/21/17 to 6/6/21... Philadelphia's Cristopher Sánchez entered 2025 with the second-longest active streak without hitting a batter, according to the Elias Sports Bureau (967 plate appearances).

2024 IN REVIEW: Falter spent his first full season in the big leagues while going 8-9 with a 4.43 ERA in 28 starts with the Pirates...He was on an Opening Day roster for the third straight season after also doing so with the Phillies in both 2022 and 2023.

MARVELOUS MAY: In the month of May last season, Falter pitched a career-best 19.2 consecutive innings without allowing a run from 5/12 to 5/24...Overall, he posted a 2.23 ERA (32.1ip/8er) across his five starts that month...Among National League pitchers in the month of May, Falter ranked ninth in innings pitched and 12th in ERA.

STAYING IN THE PARK: Falter surrendered 11 home runs in 68.1 innings (1.45 per 9.0 innings) in his first 12 starts of the 2024 season...In his last 16 starts beginning on 6/12, he surrendered six home runs across 74.0 innings, averaging just 0.73 per 9.0 innings.

JUST LIKE SANDY: Growing up in Chino Hills, California, Falter's father, Darwin, taught him to idolize fellow left-handed pitcher Sandy Koufax...Bailey would do reports on Koufax at school and even had a framed picture of the Dodgers southpaw hanging above his childhood bed...To this day, his delivery on the mound mimics that of Koufax...In 2024, he ranked in the 98th percentile in extension (per Baseball Savant).

BACK HOME IN CALIFORNIA: Attended Chino Hills High School, where he was classmates with NBA players Lonzo and LaMelo Ball...Falter had committed to play collegiately at the University of California, Santa Barbara prior to being drafted by and signing with Philadelphia in 2015.

Pitched in 12 games (five starts) with the Yankees in 2021 after being acquired from the Angels at that year's trade deadline...Had a 7.32 ERA (35.2ip/29er) and 38 strikeouts with New York.
