AROUND THE HORN

PRESIDENTIAL VISIT: Yesterday, **Derrick Hall, Steve Mullins, Luis Gonzalez, Torey Lovullo & Erubiel Durazo** visited with **President of Mexico Claudia Sheinbaum Pardo** along with invited guests from Major League Baseball and the San Diego Padres...the President shared about the visit on social media "...We will continue working to strengthen this relationship and, at the same time, foster among young people the passion for the king of sports: a sport that demands discipline, mind, and a lot of heart."

\$100 MILLION IN GIVING: The D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation earned a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations with the historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving, in fewer than 3 decades, through their signature "D-backs Give Back" investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 was proclaimed "D-backs Give Back Day" by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

HERE'S THE STORY: Since March 30, the D-backs' 14 wins are tied for fifth in the Majors (also: Dodgers, Yankees, A's, Pirates) behind the Reds (15), Padres (16), Cubs (16) and Braves (17).

- Since April 4, the D-backs' 11-6 (.647) record is fifth in the NL to the Reds (13-6, .684), Braves (13-6, .684), Cubs (14-5, .737) and Padres (15-3, .833).
- The D-backs are 5-3 in their last 8 games and 9-5 in their last 14.
- **Ildemaro Vargas'** career-best 21-game hitting streak since Sept. 26, 2025 is the Majors' longest active streak and second-longest overall streak since 2025, behind Bobby Witt/KC (22 G).

MLB'S MEXICO CITY SERIES: The D-backs host the Padres in MLB WORLD TOUR'S third regular-season visit to Mexico's capital...the clubs were initially slated to face off in the 2020 Mexico City Series (April 18-19), which was canceled due to the pandemic.

MLB World Tour - Mexico City Series:

- 2023: April 29-30 - Giants @ Padres...Padres won 16-11 and 6-4.
- 2024: April 27-28 - Astros @ Rockies...Astros won 12-4 and 8-2.

HALL ON MEXICO CITY SERIES: **Derrick Hall**/President, CEO & General Partner was quoted in the December announcement about the Mexico City Series:

"We are extremely excited to showcase our brand internationally once again and thank Major League Baseball for selecting us. We have played more games in Mexico than any other team in the league and have invested heavily in growing our fanbase across the border over the years. Mexico has long been a valued location and focal point for us in searching for talent, building relationships, and growing the number of loyal D-backs followers."

INTERNATIONAL FLAIR: This is the D-backs second regular-season international action along with the 2014 Opening Series in Sydney, Australia at the historic Sydney Cricket Ground from March 22-23...the D-backs lost 3-1 on March 22 and 7-5 on March 23.

EXHIBITIONS IN MEXICO: The D-backs have played 12 exhibition games in Mexico since 1998.

- Played in the 2019 Spring Training Mexico Series in Monterrey, splitting a 2-game set with the Rockies, losing 5-1 @ Rockies on March 9 and winning 5-2 vs. Rockies on March 10.
- Played 10 games in Hermosillo, Mexico: 1998-99 (Brewers), 2000 (Angels), 2001 (A's), 2002 (Padres), 2003 (Royals), 2008 (White Sox), 2009 (Team Mexico), 2010 (Rockies), 2015 (Rockies).

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 4-1 vs. White Sox on a 3-run homer in the ninth inning to break a 1-1 tie.

- **Ildemaro Vargas** extended his career-best 21-game hit streak with a fourth-inning single.
- **Michael Soroka**, in 5.0 innings, allowed 1 run on 7 hits and 1 walk with 6 strikeouts.
- **Ketel Marte** singled then scored on **Adrian Del Castillo's** double in the first inning.

VARGY ON A HEATER: **Ildemaro Vargas** ranks among Major League leaders (min. 70 PA) in AVG (T-1st, .357), SLG (4th, .671) and OPS (4th, 1.046).

- On April 22 vs. White Sox, had a career-high-tying 2 homers and career-best 5 RBI.
- With homers in 3 straight plate appearances on April 21-22 (April 21 - Bot 9, April 22 - Bot 2, Bot 3), became the 11th D-back to homer in 3+ straight plate appearances (team record is 4 straight).

VARGY IN GOOD COMPANY: **Ildemaro Vargas'** 18-game hit streak is tied for the Majors' fourth-longest streak to start a season since 1998:

- **Alek Thomas'** 6 DRS are tied for third in the Majors with Bobby Witt/KC and Wilyer Abreu/BOS behind Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHI (8) and Cole Young/SEA (8).

ABOUT APRIL: The D-backs have won 4 of their last 5 series (4 straight between April 7-19) and won/split 6 of their last 7 series (6 straight from March 30-April 19).

 - Starters: 6-1 with a 3.22 ERA (31 R-28 ER in 78.1 IP), an opponent .249 AVG (75-for-301)/.722 OPS, 28 walks and 60 strikeouts.
 - Relievers: 4-3 with 6 saves, a 2.63 ERA (17 R-14 ER in 48.0 IP), an opponent .186 AVG (32-for-172)/.521 OPS, 8 walks and 46 strikeouts.
