### **CINCINNATI REDS (9-25) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (14-19)**

May 15, 2022 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA -- GAME #34/HOME #19 RHP HUNTER GREENE (1-5, 7.62 ERA) vs. LHP JOSÉ QUINTANA (1-1, 2.70 ERA)

THE PIRATES.... are 3-3 heading into the finale of their seven-game homestand against the Dodgers (2-1) and Reds (1-2)...Have gone 5-5 in their last 10 games after dropping six-of-seven...Have won two games in a row on three occasions (last time coming on April 21-22)...Were 14-19 after 33 games last year (14-20 after 34).

**LONG-TENURED LEFTY:** Today **José Quintana** has reached 10 years of service time in the Major Leagues...Since making his big league debut on May 7, 2012, Quintana's 1420 strikeouts rank seventh among all left-handed pitchers in MLB behind Clayton Kershaw (1923), Chris Sale (1919), Madison Bumgarner (1969), Jon Lester (1569), David Price (1489) and Cole Hamels (1425)...<u>Among active southpaws, Quintana ranks fifth with 263 starts, trailing only Kershaw (381), Bumgarner (328), Price (322) and Wade Miley (278).</u>

**ON Q:** The Pirates have posted a 4-1 record in **José Quintana**'s last five starts and he has been charged with two earned runs or fewer in five of his first six starts this season...Quintana picked up his first win of the season in his last start after pitching 6.0 scoreless innings of two-hit ball Monday night against the Dodgers...In his four starts at PNC Park this season, José has posted a 2.21 ERA (20.1ip/5er); he has been charged with just one earned run in his last two starts (11.0ip).

**RENEGADE:** Last night **David Bednar** converted his fourth save of the month, which is tied for the second-most in the National League along with New York's Edwin Diaz...The only National League pitcher with more saves this month is San Diego's Taylor Rogers (five).

<u>A DOZEN ZEROES:</u> Zach Thompson picked up his second win with the Pirates last night while extending his scoreless streak to 12.0 innings...Thompson's 12.0-inning scoreless streak coming is the third-longest active streak in the National League behind Miami's Cody Poteet (14.2ip) and Milwaukee's Josh Hader (12.1ip).

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Last night the Pirates won for the first time this season when scoring three runs or fewer...Prior to Saturday, Pittsburgh's last win when scoring three runs or fewer came in a 2-1 victory last year on September 17 at Miami.

**UNTIL WE MEET AGAIN:** The Pirates are not scheduled to face the Reds after today until July 7 in a doubleheader at Great American Ball Park...That day will begin a four-city, 12-game road trip leading up to the All-Star break with additional stops in Milwaukee (three games), Miami (four games) and Colorado (three games).

**HITTING THE ROAD:** Following today's game, the Pirates will depart for a brief three-game road trip to Chicago...The Pirates took three-of-four games against the Cubs on their first trip to Wrigley Field earlier this year from April 22-24...It was the first time the Pirates won a four-game series at the friendly confines since September 4-7, 2006.

<u>SUITING UP:</u> On Thursday, **Roldolfo Castro** became the 39th different player to appear in a game for the Pirates this season (19th different position player)...The Pirates had a club-record 64 different players appear in a game last season.

**ON A SERIES NOTES:** Dating back to Sepember of 2017, the Pirates have gone 8-2-1 in the last 11 series played against the Reds at PNC Park...The Bucs have posted a 25-11 record against the Reds in last 36 meetings at PNC Park.

**LEADING THE WAY:** As a group, Pittsburgh's leadoff batters have reached base safely in six straight games and have combined to hit .314 (43-for-137) this season - the highest average among all National League teams and the third-best mark in the Majors behind the White Sox (.338) and Angels (.322)...In his 11 games from the top spot, **Ben Gamel** has gone 16-for-41 (.390) with five extra-base hits and eight RBI.

**GET A WHIFF OF THIS: David Bednar** has struck out at least one batter in each of his first 14 appearances, whiffing a total of 25 in 17.0 innings of work (13.24 K/per 9.0ip)...His 25 strikeouts this year are tied for the fifth-most among all big league relief pitchers and are the third-most among all National League relievers behind New York's Edwin Diaz (27) and Atlanta's Spencer Strider (26)...<u>Dating back to 8/3/21, Bednar has whiffed at least one batter in 30 consecutive games.</u>

<u>DANIEL THE DH:</u> Daniel Vogelbach connected for his sixth home run of the season on Saturday...Vogelbach has hit six home runs this season as a designated hitter; a single-season high for a Pirates player (the previous high was four home runs hit by **Josh Bell** in seven games as the DH in 2019)...Among all National League players this season, Vogelbach has the second-most home runs hit as a designated hitter; Bryce Harper leads all players with eight.

**BIG BEN:** Ben Gamel enters today's action with most the second-most hits in the National League (18) and tied for the fourth-most in MLB during the month of May...Batimore's Cedric Mullins leads all players in 20 hits this month...Gamel is hitting .391 (18-for-46) with four doubles, a triple, two homers and eight RBI in his first 12 games this month while lifting his season batting average from .224 to .298.

**DOING SOME YARD WORK:** The Pirates have 13 times in their last eight games after hitting a total of three long balls in their previous 11 games...Pittsburgh's 15 home runs this month are tied for fourth-most among all National League teams and tied for seventh-most in all of MLB this month (the Phillies lead all teams with 23).

#### **ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY**

May 15, 1967: Roberto Clemente went deep three times for the first time in his career while also collecting a career-high seven RBI. Clemente became the third Pirate ever and the first since Dick Stuart in 1960 to hit three home runs and record seven RBI in a game. A total of five players in Pirates history have homered three times while recording seven RBI in a game.
