**THE WORD ON THE BIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals continue their longest homestand of the first half playing nine games over 10 days with their second opponent, the Texas Rangers. St. Louis won the series against the Chicago Cubs with a 5-1 win on Sunday Night Baseball. The Cardinals and Rangers will play three straight 6:45 p.m., starts beginning tonight. The Cincinnati Reds will conclude the homestand this weekend (June 5-7).

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis opens the month of June in 2nd place in the National League Central, 4.5 games behind first place Milwaukee. All five teams in the National League Central enter today above .500 with Cincinnati carrying the anchor at 30-28.

**BIRTHDAY BASH:** Cardinals catcher **Iván Herrera** is celebrating his 26th birthday today. Herrera is playing the 3rd career game on his birthday tonight, previously hitting safely on each of his last two; at PHI (2024) going 1-for-4 with a double and at TEX (2025) 1-for-3 with a walk. The last Cardinals player to homer on his birthday was **Nolan Gorman** at Milwaukee (5/10/24) with **Tony Peña** (6/4/1988 at PHI) and **Ted Simmons** (8/9/1974 vs. LAD) as the only Cardinals catchers.

**HELLO, JUNIOR!:** St. Louis has just finished a stretch of 11 straight games against the National League Central (4-7). The Rangers are their 9th American League opponent of the season. The Cardinals have recorded a 13-11 record in Interleague play this season. The 13 wins are the 5th-most Interleague wins this season in MLB and the .542 winning pct. ranks 10th.

**SKIP TO MY LOU:** Former Cardinals player and coach **Skip Schumaker** returns to St. Louis as manager of the Texas Rangers. Schumaker is a career 6-7 as an opposing manager against the Cardinals, all 13 games with the Miami Marlins. He's also managed a 5-11 record vs. CIN and 5-10 vs. LAD, the two other teams he's played for in his Major League career.

**DIRTY MIKE AND THE BOYS:** Tonight's starting pitcher for the Cardinals, **Michael McGreevy**, made his Major League debut vs. the Texas Rangers on July 31, 2024 at Busch Stadium and pitched 7.0 innings en route to a 10-1 win. McGreevy led the Cardinals to a series win against the Rangers in 2024, the only time the Cardinals won a series at home against the Rangers and overall since the 2011 World Series.

**WETHERING THE STORM:** Cardinals rookie **JJ Wetherholt** has reached base safely in each of his last 14 Interleague games dating back to 4/13 vs. CLE. Wetherholt is 15-for-53 (.283) with a .993 OPS over that span. The Cardinals lead-off man has reached base safely in 21-of-23 career Interleague contests

**BATMAN AND DOBBINS:** Cardinals pitcher **Hunter Dobbins** was recalled yesterday and celebrated with his first professional save, locking down the final 3.2 innings in relief of **Matthew Liberatore** (3-3), who threw his first scoreless start of the season. Dobbins became the first Cardinals pitcher to record a save of 3.2 innings or more since **Steven Matz** (4.0 IP vs. MIN 3/30/25) and right-hander since **Kent Bottenfield** (4.0 IP at ARI 6/14/1998). Dobbins had not recorded a save since his freshman year at Texas Tech in 2019.

**UNDER THE BRIGHT LIGHTS:** The Cardinals are playing the fourth of a string of seven straight night games. St. Louis is 21-11 (.656) in night games this season, 3rd-best record in MLB behind Atlanta (.721, 31-12) and Tampa Bay (.677, 21-10). The Texas Rangers rank 22nd in MLB with a 17-22 (.436) record in night tilts. St. Louis has won 7-of-their-last-9 home night games.

**NOOT NEWS:** Cardinals OF **Lars Nootbaar** continued his injury rehabilitation assignment going 1-for-3 yesterday with two walks and a run scored in Springfield (AA). Through 10 games, Nootbaar is batting .259 (7-27) with 2 HR, 4 RBI, 7 walks and a .931 OPS. He's played 7 games in left field and 3 as the designated hitter.

**Michael McGreevy** made his MLB debut against the Rangers (July 31, 2024 at Busch III).

**George Soriano's** first cousin, **Alfonso Soriano**, played two All-Star seasons with Texas (2004-05).

**Thomas Saggese** was originally selected by Texas in the 5th round of the 2020 MLB Draft...played parts of his first three seasons (2020-23) in the Rangers system before traded to St. Louis with RHP **Tekoah Roby** and LHP **John King** for **Jordan Montgomery** and **Chris Stratton** (July 30, 2023).

**Dustin May** was born in and resides in Justin, Texas...graduated from Northwest High School in Justin...signed his college letter of intent to play at Texas Tech Univ. before drafted by the Dodgers.

**Jimmy Crooks** was born in Euless, Texas...graduated from Trinity High School in Euless... Played the COVID-shortened 2020 season at McLennan College in Waco, Texas.

**Michael Helman** played in 18 games for Memphis (AAA) in 2025.

**Brant Brown** coached for six seasons in the Rangers minor league organization with AAA-Round Rock (2012), AA-Frisco (2009-11), and High-A-Bakersfield (2007-08).

**Hunter Dobbins** was born in and resides in Bryan, Texas...played college baseball at Texas Tech University (2019-20).

**Julio Rangel** previously served as the Rangers Pitching Coach for two seasons (2019-20).

**Jake Burger** was born in St. Louis...was a 2014 graduate of Christian Brothers College High School in St. Louis...played college baseball at Missouri State University (2015-17)

**Ramón Urías** originally signed as a 16-year old international free agent with Texas (December 2010) and played his first two minor league seasons in the Rangers system (2011-12) before being loaned to the Mexican League.

Rangers Special Assistant to the GM **Darren O'iver** pitched parts of two seasons with St. Louis (1998-99).

**Stubby Clapp** played college baseball at Texas Tech University.

**Skip Schumaker** played eight years in St. Louis (2005-12) and was the 2022 Cardinals bench coach...member of 2011 World Series Champion Cardinals...selected by St. Louis in the 5th round of the 2001 MLB Draft.

**Brandon Allen** was born in Conroe, Texas...graduated from Montgomery (Texas) High School...earned a football scholarship to Rice University as a linebacker/defensive end and had a baseball scholarship at the University of Houston.

Cardinals AGM/Scouting Dir. **Randy Flores** made his MLB debut with Texas in 2002, pitching in 20 games that season...originally became a Ranger in a trade by the Yankees for **Randy Velarde** (Oct. 12, 2001).

Cardenales Spanish broadcaster **Bengie Molina** played the second half of the 2010 season for Texas after being traded by San Francisco in exchange for pitchers **Michael Main** and **Chris Ray**...later served as First Base/Catching Coach for the 2014 Rangers.

Rangers Senior VP Communications **Rich Rice** is native of Blue Springs, Mo...graduated from the University of Missouri-Kansas City.

## TONIGHT'S STARTER:

- The 25-year-old makes his 12th start of the 2026 season tonight and his 31st career start (33rd career game).
- Is making his 2nd career start against the Texas Rangers - the team he made his MLB debut against on July 31, 2024.**
- Since his Major League debut July 31, 2024, ranks 15th in MLB in winning percentage (.667, 14-8).
- The Cardinals are 19-11 (.633 win pct.) in his 30 career games started**, losing consecutive games that he has started just three times. St. Louis is 6-5 (.545) in his games started this season.
- Has yet to issue more than three walks in any of his first 30 career starts, passing **Paul "Daffy" Dean** (29 from 1934-35) for the the longest such streak to begin a career by a Cardinal.
- Has 12 wins through his first 30 career starts, the most by a Cardinal since **Dakota Hudson** had 15 through his first 30 career starts in 2019.
- Allowed 1 run or fewer with 6.0+ IP in a four-start stretch (April 26-May 14), the longest such streak by a Cardinal since **Adam Wainwright** had four straight starts from Sept. 2-18, 2019.
- Has pitched 6.0+ innings in 18 of 30 career starts, going 11-1 with a 1.99 ERA (25 ER/113.0 IP) in those 18 contests.
- Allowed two runs or fewer in seven of his 11 starts this season.
- Since joining the rotation June 8, 2025, St. Louis has won 16 of his starts - one shy of **Matthew Liberatore** for the most among all STL starters.
- Has made 16 career appearances (14 starts) at Busch Stadium where he is 6-4 with a 3.68 ERA (88.0 IP).

**LAST TIME OUT (Tuesday, May 26 at Milwaukee):** L, 6-0: 4.0 IP, 7 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 3 BB, 6 SO, 1 HR; 89 pitches

- Was his shortest start (4.0 IP) of the season and career (2nd time) and he walked a career-high 3 batters (4th time). The 5 runs he allowed were a season high.
- It was his 2nd straight start during which the Cardinals were shutout this season and the 3rd overall this year.

## 2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

**EMPTY HANDED:** The Cardinals have been blanked in each of his last two starts, losing 7-0 vs. PIT (5/20) and 6-0 at MIL (5/26); they were also shutout 4-0 in his start at DET on 4/3.

**FAITH IN FIELDERS:** Has the NL's 6th-lowest percent (20.6) of Swing & Miss; His difference in Opp. BA (.228) vs. xBA (.290) is the 2nd largest among all MLB starting pitchers (-.062).

**NESTING:** Worked at least 5.0 innings with 2-or-fewer runs allowed in his four home starts this season, becoming the first Cardinal to reach those marks in their first 4 home starts of a season since **Jack Flaherty** began 2021 with five straight.

**BE HAPPY IT HAPPENED:** Had a 14.0 scoreless innings streak that covered portions of three starts from April 26-May 8 snapped on a leadoff HR by **Nick Kurtz** that was his only run allowed during a 6.0-inning start 5/14 at ATH during a 5-4 St. Louis victory.

**ONE-HIT WONDER:** Struck out a career-high nine batters at SD (May 8) over 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball at Petco Park in a 6-0 Cardinals win.

**DODGE BALL:** Blanked the Dodgers on 3 hits over 6.0 IP in a 3-2 win on May 2 as the Cardinals turned 4 double plays behind him.

**THROW IT BACK:** Didn't hook any keepers in 5-3 loss at Miami on April 20, allowing a then season-high 4 runs over his 5.2 IP; the loss snapped the Cardinals season-high 5-game win streak.

**CURLY W:** Limited Washington to just 4 baserunners over his 6.0 IP in 6-1 win at Nationals Park on April 8, retiring his final 11 batters faced in order. Walked none and struck out one to earn his 1st win of the season.

**"NO" NEWS IS GOOD NEWS:** Retired the first nine batters en route to 6.0 no-hit innings in his first start of the season vs. TB (3/28) in a no decision the Cardinals won in 10 innings (6-5).

**FIRST IMPRESSIONS:** Became the first Cardinal to throw 6.0+ no-hit innings in a completed start since **Erick Fedde** on April 9, 2025 at Pittsburgh (6.0 IP). Since 1961, the Cardinals record for the longest hitless inning streak *as a starter* (excluding any possible intervening relief appearances) to begin a season is 8.0 IP by **Daniel Ponce de Leon** - July 23, 2018 (7.0 IP) and Aug. 21, 2018 (1.0 IP) - *Elias*

**RARE BIRD:** In his season debut on 3/28 vs. TB, became the 2nd pitcher in team history with a hitless start within his first 2 starts (**Jack Flaherty** 4/1/23 vs. TOR) and the 14th time in MLB a pitcher has in a start of 6.0+ IP. **Emerson Hancock** (SEA) had 6.0 no-hit innings vs. CLE the next day.

**SPRING FLING:** Went 4-0 with a 2.45 ERA in 5 Spring Training starts, striking out 16 to just 2 walks but did allow a team-high 6 HRs. Led MLB with his 4 Spring Training wins and ranked in top 10 in ERA (2.45), Opp. BA (.229) and WHIP (0.98).

## McGreevy vs. TEXAS:

- Making his 2nd career start/appearance vs. the Rangers, the last coming in his MLB debut on 7/31/24 at Busch Stadium in a 10-1 win.
- Tonight marks his 6th Interleague start this season (0-1, 2.28 ERA) including starts against AL West foes SEA & ATH.
- Is 1-0 with a 1.44 ERA in four career starts vs. AL West clubs, allowing just one run on five hits in each of those four starts (SEA-2, TEX-1, ATH-1).
- Received his highest career run support as a starter in his debut start against Texas on 7/31/24 with the Cardinals plating 10 runs as he recorded his 1st career MLB win (10-1).
