# Good Responses

After losing four straight games to open the season, Atlanta has won each of its last four games to improve to 4-4 on the year

The franchise has lost at least four straight games to open a season 12 times since 1901, and this is just the second time the club has immediately responded with a winning streak of at least the same amount of games.

The 2012 Braves started 0-4 before winning each of their next five games.

Since Atlanta began its winning streak, Braves pitchers have allowed the opposition to take a lead four different times over four games...The Atlanta offense has either tied the game or re-taken the lead in the following half inning three of those four times

Philadelphia scored twice in the top of the first last night before Atlanta tallied three runs in the bottom of the inning, and Philadelphia took a 4-3 lead with a run in the sixth before Atlanta tied it in the bottom.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Phillies conclude a three-game set tonight with the sixth of 19 meetings between the clubs this season...The Phillies will return here, May 7-9, for the clubs' next match up.

- The Braves have won four straight after their season-opening four-game losing streak...Atlanta has taken the first two games of this series after sweeping a doubleheader on Wednesday from Washington at Nationals Park.
- The Braves have won five of their last six with Philadelphia here in Atlanta, and overall, are 21-12 (.636) against the Phillies at Truist Park.
- LHP Drew Smyly has pitched in just one career game against Philadelphia, throwing 1.0 inning of scoreless relief in 2013...Smyly made 12 starts for the Phillies in 2019, going 3-2 with a 4.45 ERA (31 ER/62.2 IP) and fanning 68.
- LHP Matt Moore has made one career start against the Braves, pitching 7.0 innings of threerun baseball to earn the win in 2017 while with San Francisco...Moore allowed four hits and two runs over 3.1 innings in his only start this season.

AT HOME: The Braves have won each of their two home games this season, and have won their first series at home in every season the club has played at Truist Park...Atlanta swept San Diego in 2017, took two of three from Philadelphia in 2018, swept Chicago in 2019 and swept Tampa Bay last season.

- Atlanta went 19-11 (.633) at Truist Park last season, the club's best home record since going 56-25 (.691) in 2013.
- The team's .633 home winning percentage was the ninth best since the club moved to Atlanta in 1966.
- The Atlanta-era record was set by the 1996 team, with a 56-25 (.691) mark...The 1998, 1999, 2010 and 2013 all matched the mark.
- The overall franchise record is held by the 1877 Boston Red Stockings, who went 27-5 (.844) at home.
- Over their last 52 home games, the Braves have gone 37-15 (.712), a stretch that dates to August 17, 2019, when the club began a franchise modern-era record 13-game home winning streak.

**OFFENSE:** The Braves were held to three total runs over their first three games of the season, and hit just .128 (12-for-94) over 28 innings in that span...In the five games since, Atlanta has hit .250 (39-for-156) and scored 27 runs (5.4 runs/game).

- Atlanta has hit nine home runs over those five games, tied with Cleveland for most in the majors in that span.
- Freddie Freeman and Ronald Acuña Jr. each have three homers over that span, while Ehire Adrianza, Pablo Sandoval and Dansby Swanson have one.

RONALD ACUÑA JR.: Doubled down the line in the first inning last night, and four of his last six hits have gone for extra bases.. Eight of his 13 hits this season are extra-base hits.

- Acuna Jr. has eight extra-base hits through Atlanta's first eight games (five doubles, three homers), one off the modern-era franchise record shared by Justin Upton (2013) and Dale Murphy (1985).
- Hall-of-Famer Hank Aaron holds the franchise record for extra-base hits in a season, collecting 92 during the 1959 season (39 homers, 46 doubles, seven triples).

PINCH HITTERS: INF Ehire Adrianza came off the bench and doubled in last night's seventh inning, and came around to score Atlanta's game-winning run... Adrianza is 2-for-3 with a double and a homer as a pinch hitter this season.

- A Braves pinch hitters are batting .308/.400/1.077 (4for-13) with a majors-most three homers and four extra-base hits.
- Braves pinch hitters also lead the majors in runs (7) and RBI (7), both of which are three more than second-place Oakland.
- Last season, with no pitcher batting, the Braves had 25 pinch-hit at-bats, and had one home run and four RBI.

**HARD CONTACT:** The Braves offense has the highest average exit velocity in the National League at 91.7 and the third-longest average distance at 179 feet...Their average launch angle of 15.2 is the third best in baseball.

Despite the positive metrics, the Braves are hitting .204 as a team, the fourth-lowest mark in the NL and their BABIP of .247 is third worst.

VS. THE NL EAST: The Braves are scheduled to play their first 13 games against the NL East this season, with this homestand featuring three games with the Phillies and four games against the Marlins...The Braves completed a six-game road trip with Philadelphia and Washington on Wednesday.

- The last time the Braves opened a season with as many games against the NL East was 2007, when they went 9-4 and played all four division rivals.
- The Braves went 24-16 (.600) against the NLEast last season, after they finished 46-30 (.605) in intradivision games in 2019 and 49-27 (.645) in 2018.
- The club's 119-73 (.620) record against the NL East over the previous three seasons ranks as the second best intradivision record in the NL...Only Los Angeles was better inside their division over this time frame at 123-70 (.637).
- Last season, the Braves went 7-3 against the Mets, 6-4 against the Marlins and Nationals, and 5-5 against the Phillies.

  - Made 12 starts for the Phillies in 2019, going 3-2 with a 4.45 ERA (31 ER/62.2 IP) and fanning 68.
- ∠ Has made two career starts on Sunday Night Baseball, combining to allow eight hits and four runs over 6.1 innings (5.68 ERA)...His teams have won both games.

  - Went 3.0 innings for the Tigers on June 10, 2012 at Cincinnati, allowing four hits and three runs in the Detroit's 7-6 win.
- Did not allow a hit to a left-hander in his last start, holding Nationals lefties hitless in five at-bats.
  - Left-handers managed just three hits in 36 at bats against him last season... His .083 opposing average vs. lefties was best in the majors among pitchers with at least five starts.
- - Right-hander Randy Tate went 0-for-41 in his major league career to hold the record for most career at-bats by a pitcher without a base hit (since 1900)... Credit to The Athletic's Jayson Stark.

#### 2021 Recap

- Made his Braves debut, 4/6 at WSH, after the club signed him to a one-year contract worth \$11 million in November of 2020.
  - ★ A seven-year major league veteran, Smyly is 35-35 with a 4.13 ERA (326 ER/710.2 IP) over 188 career games, including 111 starts.
- Made four starts this spring and went 1-1 with a 3.29 ERA...Allowed 16 hits and seven runs (five earned) over 13.2 innings.

#### 2020 Recap

- ✓ Pitched in seven games and made five starts for San Francisco in 2020, going 0-1 with a 3.42 ERA (10 ER/26.1 IP) and 42 strikeouts...Allowed opponents to bat just .198 (20-for-101) and struck out 38% of batters he faced.
