YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles fell to the Giants, 5–3, their third straight loss...Surrendered a leadoff home run for the second straight game for the first time since July 29–30, 2019 vs. San Diego (both Tatis Jr.)...Ryan O'Hearn drove in his first run in 11 games since September 4 and Gunnar Henderson tallied his team-leading 45th multi-hit game of the year, nine more than any other Oriole.

WHAT'S TRENDING: Baltimore holds the top AL Wild Card spot ahead of the Royals (+2.5 games) and Twins (+4.0 games)...The Orioles have the head-to-head tiebreaker with Kansas City (4-2) and need to win one of the final three matchups with Minnesota (3-0) to end the season from September 27-29 to clinch that tiebreaker...The O's have lost three games in a row, five of their last six, and eight of 10 to fall 5.0 games behind the Yankees in the AL East; the current 10-game stretch is the team's worst since September 12-22, 2021 (also 2-8)...The Birds are 31-37 (.456) since July 1, 26-30 (.464) since the All-Star break, and 19-24 (.442) since August 1...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 185-129 (.579), the best record in the AL and the third-best winning percentage in MLB behind the Dodgers (.605, 190-124) and Braves (.592, 186-128) during that time.

6) New York leads the division at 89-63 (.586); an AL East winner has not finished the season with a record under .600 since 2015-17; Boston won the divison in 2017 and 2016, as did Toronto in 2015, with a 93-69 (.574) record.

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles are second in MLB with 218 home runs behind the Yankees (222)...The Dodgers (214) rank third...Baltimore led MLB in homers through June with 139, 16 more than New York-AL, but have hit 79 home runs since, tied for 16th in MLB; the team has not homered in back-to-back games for the first time since August 2-3...The 0's have hit 200 home runs in a season for the 13th time in team history and this year marks the most by the club since 2017 (232).

(b) Baltimore has nine players with at least 10 home runs, tied with the Dodgers for the most in MLB this season: Anthony Santander (41), Gunnar Henderson (37), Colton Cowser (20), Adley Rutschman (19), Jordan Westburg (18), Cedric Mullins (15), Ryan Mountcastle and Ryan O'Hearn (13), and Ramón Urías (10); the team record is 10 players, done in 2019, 2000, and 1998.

(b) Henderson and Santander are one of two duos with at least 35 home runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (53) and Juan Soto (40); the 0's did not have a player reach 35 homers last season, and this year marks the first time since 2016 that the team has had multiple players with 35+ home runs (17 runbo, 47; Davis, 38; Machado, 37).

(c) The Birds have hit 13 leadoff homers, the most by the club in a single season and second in MLB this year behind the Phillies (14); Henderson has 10 of those, second most in one season by an Oriole behind Brady Anderson, who hit all 12 for the club in 1996; Cowser (2) and Westburg (1) have the other three for the 0's in 2024.

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson is three homers shy of becoming the fourth shorstop (11th occurrence) in MLB history to hit 40 home runs, joining Alex Rodriguez (6x, 1998-2003), Rico Petrocelli (1969), and Ernie Banks (4x, 1957-60)...He passed Cal Ripken, Jr. (1991) and Miguel Tejada (2004), who held the O's record by a shortstop with 34 entering this season...With three more long balls and one more stolen base, he would be the second player in Orioles history to hit 40 homers and steal 20 bases, along with Brady Anderson (50 HR, 21 SB) in 1996.

① He was named the AL Player of the Week on September 9, the second such award of his career; Henderson slashed .417/.464/.833 (10-for-24) with one double, three homers, six runs scored, five RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games.
② Henderson's 113 runs scored are tied for third in the AL and fifth in MLB, and are the most by an Oriole since Roberto Alomar set the club record with 132 in 1996; he's the sixth player in O's history (since 1954) to score 100 runs in back-to-back seasons after scoring exactly 100 times last year, joining Manny Machado (2, 2015-16), Adam Jones (2, 2012-13), Brian Roberts (3, 2007-09), Anderson (2, 1995-96), and Ripken, Jr. (3, 1983-85).
③ He's on pace to score 121 times; Alomar, Frank Robinson (122 in 1966), and Ripken, Jr. (121 in 1983) are the only players in Orioles history (since 1954) to score at least 120 runs in a season. He ranks tied for third in the AL and MLB with 7.8 fWAR; that is the best mark by an Oriole since Ripken, Jr. set the club record with 10.6 in 1991; eight Orioles (13 occurrences) have ended a season with at least 7.0 fWAR and four O's (six occurrences) have finished with an 8.0 fWAR.
⑤ Henderson has hit 31 of his home runs when batting leadoff, the second most in Orioles history, behind Brady Anderson (35) in 1996.

MASHED TATERS: Anthony Santander is the eighth Oriole (ninth occurrence) to hit 40 home runs in a season and the first since Mark Trumbo in 2016 (see chart at right)...He's the eighth switch-hitter (12th occurrence) in MLB history to hit at least 40 homers in a season, along with New York-NL's Carlos Beltrán (2006), Houston's Lance Berkman (2: 2002, 06), Texas' Mark Teixeira (2005), Atlanta's Chipper Jones (1999), New York-NL's Todd Hundley (1996), San Diego's Ken Caminiti (1996), and New York-AL's Mickey Mantle (4: 1956, 58, 60-61)...Mantle is the only switch-hitter in MLB history to hit 50 homers, when he did so in 1956 (52) and 1961 (54).

Ø: He's five RBI shy of 100 for the season; no Oriole has reached that mark since Jonathan Schoop (105) in 2017; the last Baltimore switch-hitter to do so is Bobby Bonilla (116) in 1996.

Ø: Santander has hit 32 home runs since the start of June, two behind Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani and one behind New York-AL's Aaron Judge and for the most in MLB during that time; his 41 home runs rank third in MLB behind Judge (53) and Ohtani (48).

Ø: His 102 home runs since the start of 2022 are tied for sixth in MLB during that time and for second in the AL with Houston's Yordan Alvarez, behind only Judge (152).

Ø: He's the ninth player in 0's history with multiple 30-homer seasons, joining Manny Machado (3, 2015-17), Chris Davis (4, 2012-13, 15-16), Adam Jones (2, 2012-13), Rafael Palmeiro (4, 1995-98), Eddle Murray (5, 1980, 82-83, 85, 87), Boog Powell (4, 1964, 66, 69-70), Frank Robinson (3, 1966-67, 69), and Jim Gentille (2, 1961-62).

HOLY COWSER: Colton Cowser leads AL rookies and is tied for third among MLB rookies with 20 home runs with Chicago-NL's Michael Busch, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (24) and Milwaukee's Jackson Chourio (21)...He's the 10th rookie in team history (since 1954) to hit at least 20 homers and the first since Gunnar Henderson (28) last year...He also the ninth rookie in 0's history to record 20 doubles and 20 home runs in a season and the first since Henderson (29-2B, 28 HR) in 2023...Among rookies, Cowser is second in the AL and fifth in MLB with 3.6 fWAR, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (4.9), Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (3.9), Milwaukee's Jackson Chourio (3.8), and New York-AL's Austin Wells (3.7)...He's among AL rookies in runs scored (1st, 71), extra-base hits (2md, 46), walks (2md, 50), total bases (2md, 202), RBI (3md, 48), doubles (3md, 23), DPS (3md, 761), and slugging percentage (4md, 43).

(b) His 11 Outs Above Average are more than all other 0's defenders combined, per Statcast; eight of those have come in left field, two behind Toronto's Daulton Varsho for the most among MLB left fielders; Detroit's Riley Greene is the next closest left fielder with four OAA.

THE FINAL HOMESTAND: Baltimore's final homestand of the regular season began on Tuesday with the first of three games against the Giants through today...The home schedule concludes with three games against the Tigers beginning tomorrow...The Birds are 42-35 (.545) at Camden Yards this season, but 13-18 (.419) at Oriole Park since the beginning of July...The Orioles are 91-67 (.576) at home since 2023.

AGAINST THE GIANTS: The Orioles and Giants meet for their only series of the season this week... Baltimore won two of three at Oracle Park last season from June 2-4...Entering this series, the 21 games against San Francisco were tied for the fewest against one opponent along with Cincinnati, Los Angeles-NL, and St. Louis...Baltimore's eight games against the Giants at Camden Yards are the fewest

against one opponent.

• The Birds are 19-26 (.422) against the NL this season.

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...He is one win away from 400 for his career, all with Baltimore...Four previous managers have won 400 games at the helm of the Orioles: Earl Weaver (1,480), Buck Showalter (669), Paul Richards (517), and Hank Bauer (407).

DOCUMENT IT: A documentary focused on the city of Baltimore and the Orioles to air on a streaming network or digital carrier in Spring of 2025...The story of the city coming back from an economic and human catastrophe (the Key Bridge collapse), while a new ownership group and President usher in the next chapter of Oriole excellence...A team that has long been part of the city's DNA and mirrors its resilience...Interwoven are stories from our neighborhoods, our fans, and our schools (starting with Harlem Park Elementary, which the Orioles have adopted)...All combining to tell the riveting story of a City, State, and Major League team making a run for a Championship.

OLICK HITS: Scheduled to make his eighth start with the Orioles and 27th this season this afternoon against the Giants...Reinstated from the 15-day Injured List prior to his start on September 1; placed on the IL (right shoulder inflammation) on August 20, retroactive to August 17; marked his second stint on the IL this season after being reinstated on June 5 (lower back inflammation)...Won his first five starts to begin his Orioles career, joining Jack Harshman (1958) as the only Orioles to win each of their first five appearances with the club in team history; Eflin is the first to win each of his first five with all of them being starts and the first Oriole to win each of his first five starts with the team since Ben McDonald (7/21-8/13/90)...Was acquired by the O's from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for minor leaguers RHP Jackson Baumeister, INF/OF Mac Horvath, and OF Matthew Etzel on July 26...Became the first MLB pitcher since Andrew Cashner in 2019 to make back-to-back starts against the same opponent with different franchises in the same season (BAL and BOS against TOR), per the Elias Sports Bureau; no pitcher had been acquired by the Orioles in the same season and faced the same opponent he did in his previous start in franchise history (since 1954)...Ranks in the 99th percentile with a 2.8 walk percentage this season, per Statcast... His 16 wins in 2023 were tied with Toronto's Chris Bassitt for the most in the American League, becoming the third Rays pitcher to lead the AL in wins and helping him finish sixth in the AL Cy Young award voting...Signed a three-year contract with the Rays on December 13, 2022...Spent seven seasons with the Phillies, going 36-45 with a 4.49 ERA (329 ER/659.1 IP) in 127 outings (115 GS) from 2016-2022...Acquired by Philadelphia from Los Angeles-NL on December 19, 2014 in exchange for Jimmy Rollins and cash considerations...Traded to the Dodgers a day prior as part of a package for Matt Kemp...Originally selected by the Padres in the C-A round (33rd overall) of the 2012

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his ninth loss of the season and his second with the Orioles on September 13 at Detroit; has lost consecutive starts after winning his first five to begin his Orioles tenure...Allowed one run on five hits (1 HR) and one walk with three strikeouts across 6.2 innings; exited with a runner on first base who was stranded...Surrendered a solo home run to Kerry Carpenter in the first inning, the second batter that he faced; nine of the 11 runs he has allowed as an Oriole have scored via home runs...The 0's were no-hit until two outs in the ninth inning...Has gone at least 5.0 innings and allowed three or fewer runs in all seven of his starts to begin his career with Baltimore; the only Orioles starters to have longer streaks to begin their career with the team this century are Jeremy Guthrie in 2007 (11) and current teammate Corbin Burnes this season (15)...Threw 100 pitches, 64 strikes.

AGAINST THE GIANTS: Making his ninth career appearance (7 GS) against the Giants...Owns a lifetime 1-2 record with a 4.79 ERA (19 ER/35.2 IP) in eight prior outings (6 GS)...Suffered the loss after allowing seven runs (6 ER) on nine hits (a career-high-tying 4 HR) with six strikeouts across 5.0 innings in his last start against the Giants on June 20, 2021 (w/PHI) in San Francisco.

AGAINST THE NL WEST: Making his 31^{st} career start (34^{th} appearance) against the NL West...Has gone 6-13 with a 4.80 ERA (91 ER/170.2 IP) in those games...His last appearance against the division came on September 1 at Colorado; earned the win after allowing one run on four hits and one walk with nine strikeouts in 7.0 innings; took a perfect game into the sixth inning before issuing an infield single to Jake Cave to lead off the inning.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT: Effin has issued 18 walks in 154.2 innings this season; his 1.05 BB/9 is the best in MLB among qualified pitchers...His 2.8 walk percentage ranks in the 99th percentile in MLB this season, the second-best mark among qualified pitchers, per Statcast, trailing only Seattle's Bryan Woo (2.6); the 2.8% walk rate would be his career low; the lowest walk rate by an Oriole in the Statcast era is Tommy Hunter (3.3, 2011)...12 of his 26 starts this season have been walkless, tied for the third most in MLB with Chicago-AL's Garrett Crochet, trailing Seattle's George Kirby (13) and St. Louis' Miles Mikolas (14); had 13 such starts last year, tied for second most in MLB with Mikolas, while trailing Kirby (16)...Has not walked more than one batter since July 19 at New York-AL, a streak of eight straight starts.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Eflin is 0-1 with a 5.17 ERA (9 ER/15.2 IP) in 11 career Postseason outings (16S)...Made his first career Postseason start last season, taking the loss in Game 1 of the American League Wild Card series against the Texas Rangers on October 4 at Tropicana Field (w/TB)...Allowed five runs on nine hits (2 HR) and two walks (1 IBB) in 5.0 innings...Appeared in 10 playoff games in relief for the Phillies in 2022, posting a 3.38 ERA (4 ER/10.2 IP) en route to an NL pennant.
