BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their longest road trip of the season tonight (11 games in 10 days) with the fourth game of a 5-game series in Cincinnati...the Cardinals blanked the Reds, 3-0, last night after splitting Monday's day/night doubleheader with a 2-1 win in Game 1 and a 6-5 loss in 10 innings in Game 2...the Redbirds are 4-2 in the 1st six games of this trip, taking 2-of-3 from the Cubs last weekend at Wrigley Field...this week's 5-game series in Cincinnati is the longest the two teams have played here in the Queen City since a 5-game set August 7-10, 1952 at Crosley Field...the Cardinals have won a season best four consecutive series (at NYY, vs. COL, vs. PHI, at CHC)...including tonight's game, the Cardinals have 35 games remaining in the regular season with 15 at home and 20 on the road.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters play today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 13.5 games behind 1st place Milwaukee; 3.5 games ahead of 4th place Pittsburgh and 3.0 games out of the final National League Wild Card position...the Cardinals are 7-3 in their last 10 games, 12-8 in last 20 and 14-16 in last 30...they are 33-34 vs. teams that are currently above .500 and 32-28 vs. the sub .500 teams.

GOLD STAR NIGHT: On the anniversary of this 2023 MLB debut, short-stop **Masyn Winn**, the 2025 NL Gold Glove recipient, had a Gold Star night (apologies to Skyline) in last night's 3-0 win as he enjoyed his 1st career 3 XBH game, including a solo HR in the 5th to snap a 0-0 tie, and a pair of 2B's, while making star-studded plays in the field. **WINN-ING:** Winn matched his 2025 RBI total (51) last night & is just 6 RBI shy of his career-high 57 RBI in 2024...20 of his 51 RBI have come with 2 outs & runners in scoring position (T-2nd among NL shortstops to the Mets **Bo Bichette**-22)...Masyn's 6 doubles this month lead all MLB shortstops.

KEYSTONE COMBO: The Cardinals keystone combo, led by Gold Glove shortstop **Masyn Winn** and rookie 2nd sacker **JJ Wetherholt** is leading all of MLB by far in Middle Infield Fielding Run Value according to *Baseball Savant*...the Cardinals middle infielders have recorded a **37 FRV that more than DOUBLES the next closest team**, the Chicago Cubs (18)...it ranks as the top mark in in the Statcast Era (since 2018) ahead of the 2018 Arizona Diamondbacks (33 FRV). **TWO FOR THE PRICE OF ONE:** Winn and **Wetherholt** hold the top MLB total for starting middle infielders in double plays (158) with Winn leading all MLB shortstops (86) and JJ ranking 2nd at second base with 72.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: With approaching/surpassed personal Triple Crown highs in BA (.289), HR (21) & RBI (92), 2025 NL Silver Slugger **Alec Burleson** is currently leading the majors in both RBI and a career-high 33 doubles...according to research by the *Elias Sports Bureau*, there have only been seven players to lead MLB in both 2B's & RBI - the last being Colorado's **Todd Helton** in 2000...Burly has an MLB-leading 21 RBI in August.

WALKER'S 20/20 VISION: Adding his career and team-high 17th stolen base in Game 2 on Monday, **Jordan Walker** (24 HR) pulled closer into view of the the Cardinals first 20 HR/20 SB season since OF **Tommy Pham** (23 HR/25 SB) did so in 2017...Pete Crow-Armstrong (30/30), **Elly De La Cruz** and CJ Abrams are the lone MLB players with 20/20 totals this season. **BRING THE HEAT:** Walker is batting a team-best .344 (21-61) through baseballs "dog days" of August, ranking 5th in the N.L....it's the highest mark (min. 50 PA) for a Redbirds outfielder since **Corey Dickerson** hit a scorching .411 (23-56) in August of 2022.

BLANK CHECK: The Cardinals 3-0 shutout win last night was the team's 11th in 193 games played at Great American Ball Park...for the 2nd time in three games this series, the Cardinals limited the Reds to 3 hits or fewer, something they've done only 13 times (allowed 3 hits -11 times/2 hits twice), including just 2 hits earlier this year on 5/23/26 [1].

CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

Terry Francona played in 86 games in 1990 with the Louisville Redbirds (AAA), including five at pitcher...his father, **Tito Francona**, played parts of two seasons (1965-66) with St. Louis...became a Cardinal via trade by Cleveland in exchange for a player to be named (Dec. 15, 1964)...originally signed by the St. Louis Browns before the 1952 season (MLB debut for Baltimore in 1956).

César Prieto made his MLB debut at Cincinnati on Aug. 29, 2025 & collected 1st MLB hit on Aug. 31 off **Emilio Pagán**.

Caleb Ferguson pitched in 26 games (one start) for the Reds this season...was born in Columbus, OH...graduated from West Jefferson High School.

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12)...won the 2010 Gold glove and was a two-time All-Star (2010-11)

Reds Asst. Pitching Coach **Matt Tracy** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Christian Brothers College HS.

Justin Bruhl pitched for the Reds Triple-A Louisville affiliate in 2024.

Riley O'Brien made his MLB debut with Cincinnati (Sept. 28, 2021 at Guaranteed Rate Field).

Bryan Torres made his MLB debut at Cincinnati on May 23, 2026 (G1)...singled off Chris Paddock for his first MLB hit and homered off Jose Franco.

Julio Rangel served as Bullpen Coach for the Reds in 2019.

Pierce Johnson pitched three seasons (2010-12) at Missouri State University...set the school's single-season record with 119 strikeouts in 2012.

Cardinals.TV broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played outfield for both the Cardinals (1995-97) and Reds (1999).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for Cincinnati in 1996.

Reds Senior Advisor **Cam Bonifay** played two minor league seasons with the Cardinals...worked for St Louis as a professional scout and special asst.

Reds Special Asst. to the GM **John Morris** played five seasons (1986-90) with the Cardinals.

Reds President of Baseball Ops **Nick Krall** previously interned for the New Jersey Cardinals of the NY Penn League (SS).

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 13 games for the Reds in his final season (2010).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** played in 44 games for the Reds during his final 1972 season.

Reds Senior Advisor **Eric Davis** played two seasons (1999-2000) for St. Louis.

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Office **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Reds CEO **Robert Castellini**, Chairman **W. Joseph Williams Jr.** and Vice Chairman **Thomas Williams** were Cardinals investors from 1995-2006...interests were sold as a condition of their acquisition of a controlling ownership stake of the Reds.

TODAY'S GAME:

- The 26-year-old Cardinals Opening Day starter makes his team-leading 25th start of the season. It marks his 145th career Major League appearance and his 78th career start.
- Is 6 strikeouts away from matching his single-season high with 122 in 2025. Cardinals' team leader with 116 strikeouts
- His 78th start moves him into 21st all-time among Cardinals left-handers.
- Is one of five Cardinals pitchers who have induced double-digit GIDP this season (11).
- Tied for 3rd in the National League with four pick-offs, most by a Cardinal since **Lance Lynn** (4 in 2015) and by a southpaw since **Mark Mulder** (5 in 2005).
- Is the third Cardinals lefty with 21+ wins since 2000, joining **Jamie Garcia** (62-45) and **Mark Mulder** (22-18). His next win ties **Alex Jackson** (1966-67), **Jerry Reuss** (1969-71), **Ferdie Shupp** (1919-21), and **Mulder** (2005-08) for 34th all-time among Cardinals left-handed pitchers.
- Opponents are batting .184 (9-49) off his curveball this season. Boasts a 40.7% whiff on his curve (12th-best in MLB) and 50.9% K% on his curve.
- The Cardinals are 19-18 in his 37 career starts at Busch Stadium, where he has gone 13-13 with a 4.28 ERA (183.0 IP/87 ER) with 11 quality starts (all 11 starts with 6.0 IP or more).

LAST TIME OUT (Friday, August 14 at Chicago-NL): L, 3-0: 5.1 IP, 2 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 6 SO - 95 pitches

- Was pulled after 95 pitches allowing just two hits, both singles after holding the Cubs hitless through 13 outs.
- Exited with two runners on in the 6th inning of a scoreless ballgame before a three-run home run was surrendered to Seiya Suzuki for all the runs of the game (3-0).
- Suffered his 4th straight losing decision, last earning a win vs. Atlanta (7/11) at Busch Stadium. Last road win was also vs. ATL (6/30) at Truist Park.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

NOT MY DECISION: Did not factor in the decision, but the Cardinals won 5-1 at TOR (8/2) following 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball including striking out the first three batters of the game.

AND THE AWARD FOR BEST SUPPORTING CAST MEMBER ...?: Supported with 3 runs or less (6 total) in each of his five starts since the All-Star Break.

JUST PEACHY: Fanned 9 batters, one shy of his career high, in a 5-3 win vs. ATL (6/30) at Truist Park to earn his 20th career win and the blanked the Braves over 6.0 IP two weeks later in a 4-1 win at Busch Stadium on 7/11.

SUNDAY FUNDAY: Had his deepest start (5.1 IP) since a 6.0 inning effort at SD (5/7) and led the Cardinals to a series win over the Cubs on NBC Sunday Night Baseball in his 5-1 win vs Chicago on 5/31.

K-CLUB: Libby notched single-game career highs for strikeouts in consecutive starts when he fanned 9 on 5/19 vs. PIT and then he bettered that with 10 K's on Memorial Day (5/25) at MIL; He and Brewers starter Jacob Misorowski (12) combined for 22 strikeouts in the 5/25 game.

LIBBY vs. LEFTY: Recorded 38 strikeouts in May, the most by a Cardinals lefty in the month of May since Hall of Famer **Steve "Lefty" Carlton** fanned 52 in May, 1970.

FRIAR FRYER: Earned his 2nd straight win holding the Padres (5/7) to one run over 6.0 innings in a 2-1 come-from-behind win at Petco Park. Recorded his 300th career strikeout fanning Nick Castellanos in the 5th inning.

HR DERBY: Surrendered a career-high 3 HR's in 3.1 IP vs. SEA (4/25) as the two teams combined for 33 hits and 8 HR's in 11-9 Mariners win. Also allowed 3 HR's in his 6/13 start vs. the Twins at Target Field.

LIBBY'S LID-LIFTER: Made his 1st career Opening Day start and received a no decision vs. TB (3/26) despite pitching 5.0 innings and allowing just one run. Cardinals rallied for a 9-7 win (he exited with game tied 1-1).

LEFTY LIFT-OFFS: Made his 1st career Opening Day start on 3/26 vs. TB, becoming the 1st Cardinals lefty to start on Opening Day since **Donovan Osborne** (4/5/99) vs. MIL - the same year that he was born. Became one of just 16 LHP's to make the Opening Day start for the Cardinals since 1901 (MLB).

CAREER:

- Chose to switch to uniform No. 32 prior to 2026 season in honor of Hall of Fame left-handed pitcher **Sandy Koufax**, whom he grew up admiring.
- Is a career 18-31 with a 4.94 ERA (372.0 IP) in his 77 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA (81.0 IP) in 67 career relief appearances.

LIBERATORE vs. CINCINNATI:

- Making his 2nd start of the season vs. CIN (6/6 at STL) and 5th career start (12th app.). Sporting a 1-1 record with a 3.81 ERA.
- Has only allowed one career hit to a left-handed Reds batter in his career (1-for-15); a lead-off single by TJ Friedl on May 1, 2025.
- Pitched 4.1 innings in his last start vs. the Reds (6/6/26) in a no decision the Cardinals won 6-5.
- Is 0-1 with a 4.91 ERA in four career starts and 1-0 with a 1.17 ERA in 7 career relief appearances (7.2 IP, 2 H, 1 R).
- Earned a win in his first career appearance at CIN (9/8/23) tossing 1.1 scoreless innings in relief with three strikeouts.
- Did not allow a run in his first five career appearances (4.2 IP) all in relief.
- Suffered his only loss to the Reds in his first career start at CIN (5/1/25), which was delayed, causing him to exit after 3.0 innings allowing two runs in a lo
