### Spreading the Wealth

Atlanta collected 16 hits and scored 17 runs last night, the most runs by any team in a single game this season.

All nine Braves starters had at least one hit and one RBI, and eight of the nine scored a run. Since RBI became an official stat in 1920, last night marked just the fourth time in franchise history that all nine starters had an RBI and the first such game since October 5, 2001 vs. Florida.

Kyle Farmer & Jorge Mateo came off the bench to drive in runs for Atlanta, and the 11 different Braves with an RBI are the most in a single game in franchise history.

### On the Road

Last night's victory for Atlanta was the club's ninth consecutive win away from home dating to last season, the longest active road winning streak in baseball.

Atlanta is 18-8 (.692) on the road dating to August 1 of last season, the best road winning percentage in baseball.

The Braves lost each of their first eight road games to begin last year.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and D-backs tonight continue a four-game weekend series with what is the second of seven scheduled meetings between the clubs this season...The two are set to meet next with three games at Truist Park in Atlanta, August 14-16.

*A* Atlanta went just 2-4 against Arizona last season, dropping the season set for the first time since 2019...The Braves won both of the first two games before losing each of the last four.

*A* Both of Atlanta's wins over Arizona last season came here at Chase Field, and the club is 55-42 (.567) all-time here since the facility opened in 1998...The Braves' .567 winning percentage here is second best of any NL team, trailing just the Cardinals (53-40, .570), while Atlanta's 3.92 ERA in this building is the best of any team in baseball.

*A* RH Grant Holmes has made two starts and two relief appearances against Arizona in his career, and owns a 6.08 ERA (9 ER/13.1 IP) without a decision all-time against the club...In his season debut on March 29, the 6-foot-0, 226-pound native of Conway, SC, allowed five hits and three runs over 5.0 innings to take the loss.

*A* LH Eduardo Rodríguez is set tonight to make the third start of his career against Atlanta, but his first since 2021 while with Boston...The 6-foot-2, 231-pound Venezuela native is 1-0 with a 5.59 ERA (6 ER/9.2 IP) in his two turns versus the Braves, while his teams have won both such starts.

**FULL COUNTS:** Ten different plate appearances for Atlanta went to a full count last night, and the Braves went 2-for-6 with a double, homer, three RBI and four walks in that count, good for a 1.600 OPS.

*A* On the season, Atlanta leads the majors in average (.367), slugging (.867), OPS (1.471), hits (11), doubles (3, tied), home runs (4), runs (11), RBI (11), walks (18, tied), extra-base hits (7) and total bases (26) when the count is full...The Braves' 48 total 3-2 plate appearances trails just the Angels.

**HARRIS II HARD HIT:** Michael Harris II put six balls in play last night, and they left the bat at 101.7, 101.1, 102.9, 99.8, 111.6 and 111.6 miles per hour...His 11 total balls in play this season over 100 mph are tied with Yordan Alvarez for the most in baseball.

*A* Harris II's five balls over 100 miles per hour last night are the most by a player in a single game this season, and one of just 60 such games in baseball's Statcast era that dates to 2015.

*A* Since that 2015 season just four Braves batters have had five balls in play over 100 mph in a single game, and Harris II now has two of them...He also did so April 4 of last year...Austin Riley (June 30, 2021) and Ronald Acuña Jr. (September 19, 2023) have the others.

*A* Dating to his debut on May 28, 2022, Harris II's 545 balls in play over 100 mph rank 13th in the majors...However, his percentage of pitches hit that hard, 7.2%, trails just Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (7.3%).

**RUN DIFFERENTIAL:** Atlanta outscored Arizona by 15 runs last night, and currently owns a run differential of +27 this season (41 scored, 14 allowed)...That is the best run differential in baseball this season.

*A* Furthermore, the Braves' +27 run differential through their first seven games is the largest in franchise history, one better than their +26 in 2018.

**OLSON EXTRA BASES:** Matt Olson clubbed his first home run of the season in last night's first inning, and tacked on two more doubles on the night...His five total extra-base hits on the season are tied for most in the National League and sit just one behind three AL players for most in the majors.

*A* Since he joined Atlanta prior to the 2022 season, Olson's 306 total extra-base hits are by far the most in the National League...Freddie Freeman, with 287, ranks second...Across all of baseball in that span, only Shohei Ohtani (337) and Aaron Judge (306) have more.

**DRAKE BALDWIN:** Collected just one hit in six at-bats last night, but came around three times to score...His nine runs scored this season are most in the majors, and the most by a Brave through the first seven games of a season since Freddie Freeman scored 10 in 2018.

*A* Baldwin has scored in all seven of Atlanta's games this season, and is the only such player to do so since the club moved to the city in 1966...Just two other players have done so at any point in modern franchise history - Hall of Famers Henry Aaron in 1957 and Jimmy Collins in 1900.

**AUSTIN IN ARIZONA:** In 33 career games against Arizona, Austin Riley has batted .346/.380/.797 with a 1.177 OPS and 41 RBI...He doubled home a pair of runners last night while going 1-for-3 with a walk.

*A* Four hundred forty-five players have tallied at least 100 career at-bats against the Diamondbacks since the franchise was founded in 1998...Of those, Riley's 1.177 OPS against the club ranks fourth, behind just Manny Ramirez (1.305), Barry Bonds (1.192) and Dante Bichette (1.192).

**WILD WEST:** In each of the previous three seasons, Atlanta has faced a multi-run deficit in the seventh inning or later here at Chase Field and rallied to win...No other visiting team in baseball even has two such wins.

*A* The Braves trailed, 6-2, entering the seventh on April 26 of last year before rallying to win, 8-7, in extra innings...Michael Harris II lined a go-ahead, two-run double with two outs and two strikes in the eighth to take the lead, and then won it in 10.

*A* Atlanta was losing, 3-1, entering the top of the ninth on July 8, 2024 when Sean Murphy drove a two-out, two-run homer to knot the score...The Braves would go on to win, 5-4, in 11 innings.

*A* The Braves entered the seventh on June 4, 2023 trailing, 5-3, before a run in the seventh and a ninth-inning grand slam by Eddie Rosario earned a victory, 8-5.

#### Today's Game

- ⚡ Makes his second start of the season and 30th career start in his third major league campaign...It is his first career road start of 2026 and just his fifth career start on the road as a Brave.
- ⚡ Took the loss in his season debut on March 29 against Kansas City, allowing three earned runs on five hits over 5.0 innings with four strikeouts and two walks... Surrendered a solo homer to Carter Jensen in the fourth inning.
- ⚡ Has made four career appearances against Arizona, including two starts, going 0-0 with a 6.08 ERA (7 ER/13.1 IP)...Has allowed three home runs in those four outings...In his two starts against the D-backs, both in 2025, posted a 9.00 ERA (9 ER/9.0 IP) with nine walks.
- ⚡ Needs three strikeouts to reach 200 for his career.
- ⚡ His 29 career starts for the Braves are the most in Atlanta-franchise history by a South Carolina-born player.
- ⚡ Made his second career Opening Day roster with Atlanta this season after also making the club's roster to open 2025.
- ⚡ Went 1-0 with a 1.02 ERA in five spring appearances (four starts), striking out 20 over 17.2 innings with just one walk...Did not allow a run in his first four outings before surrendering two earned runs over 5.1 innings in his final spring start on March 24 against Tampa Bay.
- ⚡ Missed the final 57 games of the 2025 season after being placed on the 60-day injured list on July 27 with right elbow inflammation.
- ⚡ Is 5-4 with a 3.17 ERA in 27 career appearances at home and 1-7 with a 5.12 ERA in 22 outings on the road.

#### 2025

- ⚡ Was placed on the 60-day injured list on July 27, 2025 with right elbow inflammation and missed the final 57 games of the season.
- ⚡ In his second major league season, went 4-9 with a 3.99 ERA (51 ER/115.0 IP) in 22 games, 21 starts, for Atlanta.
- ⚡ Became the fourth pitcher, sixth instance, in franchise history to record 15 or more strikeouts within a single game, joining Hall-of-Famer Warren Spahn, twice, Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz, twice, and teammate Spencer Strider.
  - ⚡ Was the first National League pitcher to fan 15 in a losing decision since Cliff Lee with Philadelphia, May 6, 2011 against Atlanta.
  - ⚡ Generated 25 swings and misses during the outing, tied for the fifth most in a single game in the majors at that time.
- ⚡ Was 2-8 in 10 decisions over 16 starts from May 2 through the end of the season, with a 3.86 ERA over 86.1 innings in that span.
- ⚡ Made 21 starts for Atlanta, third most on the club behind Bryce Elder (28) and Spencer Strider (23).
- ⚡ In his debut season in 2024, went 2-1 with a 3.27 ERA (11 ER/30.1 IP) in 26 relief appearances and one start...Was recalled by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on August 8, 2024.

- ⚡ Awards: Midwest League Midseason All-Star (2015); Texas League Pitcher of the Week (July 30, 2017).
- ⚡ In 2022, pitched for three different minor league teams throughout the Oakland and Atlanta organizations...Separately, went 1-2 with Triple-A Las Vegas before joining the Braves system.
- ⚡ Pitched the entire 2021 season for Triple-A Las Vegas and saw more relief appearances (29) than starts (7) for first time in career.
- ⚡ Set career highs and led the team in games (50) and saves (13) in 2023 with Triple-A Gwinnett...Led all Stripers relievers in strikeouts (74).
- ⚡ Named Gatorade Player of the Year in South Carolina following his senior year in 2014.
- ⚡ Selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2014 June draft (Conway High School, SC).
- ⚡ On August 1, 2016, traded by the Dodgers to the Oakland Athletics along with RHP Frankie Montas and RHP Jharel Cotton for OF Josh Reddick and RHP Rich Hill.
- ⚡ Pitched 10 seasons in the minors before making his MLB debut.
- ⚡ Signed by the Atlanta Braves as a minor league free agent on August 13, 2022.

- Appeared in 42 games in his second season as a Brave, pitching to a 3-2 record and a 3.81 ERA (23 ER/54.1 IP) with 51 strikeouts and a 1.25 WHIP, his lowest since 2020...Was placed on the injured list on August 24 due to left shoulder inflammation and missed the remainder of the season.
- Ranked in the 99th percentile in baseball with a barrel rate of just 3.2% in 2025...His seven total barrels and 2.3% barrel rate allowed since joining the Braves in 2024 are both the best in the majors (min. 400 batters faced).
- Opponents hit ground balls off him 55.8% of the time last season (league average 42.4%)...Since his debut in 2017, Bummer's career ground ball rate of 64.2% is highest in the majors (min. 350 games).
- Tossed his curveball a career-high 35.1% of the time in 2025, the most of any major league pitcher with at least 900 total pitches last season...Utilized a curveball for the first time in 2024 at a 2.3% clip.

- In his third full season with Atlanta, appeared in a career-high 70 games and went 29-for-34 in save opportunities...Pitched to a 3.21 ERA (24 ER/67.1 IP)...Ranked fourth in the NL and tied for ninth in the majors in saves.
- Among active pitchers with as many appearances since his Braves debut on August 5, 2022 (222 apps.), Iglesias owns the best WHIP (0.94) and second-best ERA (2.35, 57 ER/218.2 IP).
- Ranks second among Braves pitchers in franchise history (min. 100 G) in WHIP and ERA+ (180), third in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.88), fourth in hits-per-nine-innings (6.5) and fifth in ERA and saves (97).
- Did not allow a run in 42 of 45 appearances from June 9 until the end of the season...Led major league pitchers in this span (min. 40.0 IP) in hits-per-nine-innings (4.15) and saves (21), tied for the most fWAR among relievers (1.5) and ranked second in ERA (1.25, 6 ER/43.1 IP) and WHIP (0.69).
- Was named the NL Reliever of the Month for August for the third consecutive season after converting all 10 of his save opportunities and allowing a 0.69 ERA (1 ER/13.0 IP) in the month.

- Allowed a run in his third appearance with the Braves, August 5, and then allowed one additional tally over his final 21 games...Strung together a career-high scoreless streak of 19.1 innings between runs.
- From his Braves debut on July 31 until the end of the season, Kinley led major league pitchers (min. 25.0 IP) in ERA and ranked third in WHIP and opponent's batting average (.126).

- Set a career high and led the team with 74 appearances, going 2-4 with a 3.29 ERA (25 ER/68.1 IP) and matching a career high with 76 punchouts...Collected the first two saves of his major league career.
- Did not allow a run in 31 of his first 38 appearances through June 29, tying for the sixth-lowest ERA (1.67, 7 ER/37.2 IP) among major league pitchers in that span (min. 35.0 IP).
- Ranked in the 90th percentile or better in baseball in expected ERA (91st, 2.91), walk percentage (92nd, 5.3%), hard-hit percentage (93rd, 33.5%), and whiff percentage (95th, 33.6%).
- Threw his slider 612 times and surrendered just 22 hits on it...Among pitchers that threw as many on the season, those 22 hits were the fewest in MLB...His slider carried a run value of 10, also ranking in the 95th percentile.
- Dating to his first full season in 2022, Lee's 2.76 ERA ranks fourth among all left-handed relievers in baseball to make at least 175 appearances...Among those pitchers, Lee's rate of 4.80 strikeouts-per-walk is best in the majors.
