D-BACKS ACQUIRE HOFFMAN FROM ROYALS FOR GRICHUK: Last night, the D-backs acquired RHP Andrew Hoffmann (optioned to Triple-A Reno) from the Royals for OF Randal Grichuk.

- In his first season in the Majors, has made 3 relief appearances (4.2 IP, 6 R-2 ER, 7 H, 4 BB, 5 K)...made his debut on May 30 vs. Tigers (2.0 IP, 2 R-2 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 4 K).
