**TODAY'S GAME:** The Braves and Nationals finish a three-game set today with the 19th and final meeting between the teams this season...The clubs are not scheduled to meet again until June 9-11 of the 2020 regular season...They have no Grapefruit games against each other next season.

*A* The Braves improved to 6-2 here after last night's victory and are now one win shy of tying the franchise record for the best record in a season at Nationals Park, which opened in 2008...The 2013 club went 7-2 here...Over the last three years the Braves are 16-11 (.593) here, after going 1-19 (.050) in D.C. in 2015 and 2016.

*A* The Braves have taken the season set from the Nationals for the second consecutive season and are looking for their 12th win of 2019 against them today...They went 10-9 against Washington last season...From 2015-2017, the Braves went 18-39 (.316) against their National League East division rival.

*A* After opening the season series with three straight losses to Washington, the Braves have won 11 of the last 15 games between the clubs...The Braves took three of four from the Nationals last weekend, September 5-8, at SunTrust Park.

*A* Atlanta has now won four straight in Washington, the club's longest single-season winning streak at Nationals Park since 2013...They won their first six games here that season.

*A* LHP Max Fried is set to face Washington for the fifth time in his career, for the fourth time as a starter and for the third time this season...The lefty is 1-1 with a 2.87 ERA (5 ER/15.2 IP) in his career against Washington after he went 7.0 scoreless innings on September 5 against the Nationals in a 4-2 win.

*A* RHP Aníbal Sánchez is 2-0 with a 4.50 ERA (11 ER/22.0 IP) in four games, all starts, against the Braves this season after he spent 2018 with the club...Both of the righty's wins over Atlanta have come here at National Park, while Washington lost his two starts at SunTrust Park.

**HOME RUN RECORD:** The Braves failed to hit a home run yesterday, a day after tying the franchise record for most home runs in a single season at 235 (also, 2003)...The game marked the first time this season Atlanta scored double-digit runs without going deep.

*A* The Braves rank third in the National League with their 235 home runs, trailing the Dodgers' total of 261 and Chicago's 237.

*A* The Braves have hit 112 homers away from SunTrust Park this season, and are 12 shy of the franchise record for single-season road home runs, first set in 1957 and matched in 2003.

*A* The club already has the franchise record for most home runs at home, after they finished their last homestand with 123...The old record of 119 was set by the 1966 team.

**PLAYOFF BOUND:** The Braves clinched a postseason berth yesterday, and enter today with a magic number of four to clinch the National League East, which would give the club their second consecutive division title..

*A* The Braves are looking for their 19th division title in franchise history, and they are currently tied with New York (AL) for the most in MLB history.

**SERIES PLAY:** The Braves took another set with yesterday's win, and are now 31-10-8 in series play this season.

*A* The Braves have not lost a multi-game series since dropping both games to Kansas City, July 23-24, at SunTrust Park...They have gone 11-0-4 in multi-game series play since that sweep.

*A* The Braves' streak of 15 straight multi-game series without a loss is the longest such streak in the majors this season...The Astros went 13 straight from May 4-June 14.

*A* The 15-series streak is tied for the third longest by a Braves team with one fashioned by the 1916 Boston Braves from June to the middle of August.

*A* Only two Braves team in the modern era (since 1900) have had longer such streaks than this year's club: the 2002 club had a franchise-record 22-series streak, while the 1996 team went 17 without a loss.

**LATE GAME BRAVES:** The Braves scored nine of their 10 runs following the sixth inning yesterday, and now have a major league-most 293 runs in these late innings this season.

*A* The next closest team, Washington, has 273.

*A* The Braves have also hit 87 late-inning home runs, again the most in baseball.

*A* Since 1974, only eight teams have ever scored 300 runs in the seventh inning or later during a single season...The 2009 Yankees were the last team to do so, scoring 336 such runs, which stands as the most over that 46-season time frame.

*A* That Yankees team also hit 92 late-game home runs, the only club with more in that 46-season stretch than the Braves' total this season.

**40-40?:** OF Ronald Acuña Jr. homered and stole two bases Thursday moving him within one home run and four steals of becoming the fifth player in baseball history to collect a 40-homer, 40-steal season.

*A* OF José Canseco was the first player to go 40-40, reaching 42 home runs and 40 steals in 1988...Barry Bonds then matched those numbers in 1996, while Alex Rodríguez had 42 homers and 46 steals in 1998...Alfonso Soriano then had 46 and 41 in 2006.

*A* Thursday, Acuña Jr. became the 15th player in history to have 35 home runs and 35 stolen bases in a single season, and the youngest to accomplish the feat...The last player to reach those marks was Matt Kemp in 2011 with the Dodgers.

#### Today's Game

- A* Set for his 29th start and 31st appearance of the season...Makes his 38th career start and his 54th career appearance.
- A* His 16 wins are most in the National League by a left-hander, and second most in the majors among lefties...BOS's Eduardo Rodríguez has won 17 games.
  - A* Fried's 16 wins are most by an Atlanta left-hander since 2002, when Hall-of-Famer Tom Glavine won 18 games.
  - A* No Atlanta pitcher has won 17 games since Tim Hudson in 2010.
  - A* Atlanta is 21-7 in his starts as a team, including 14-3 in his last 17 turns.
- A* Makes his fifth career appearance against the Phillies, and his fourth start...Is 1-1 with a 2.87 ERA (5 ER/15.2 IP) in his first four games, including two this season.
  - A* In two games, both starts, against Washington this season, is 1-1 with a 2.84 ERA (4 ER/12.2 IP)...Started against them on September 5 at SunTrust Park, and allowed just one baserunner over 7.0 innings while striking out nine.
  - A* In 13 intradivision games this season, including 11 starts, is just 4-3 with a 5.34 ERA (37 ER/62.1 IP)...It is easily his highest ERA against any one division...Has a 2.18 mark against the Central (6 games), a 4.14 ERA against the West (8 games) and a 2.55 mark versus the American League (3 games).
- A* Lost his last start, September 10 at Philadelphia, to snap a career-best seven-game winning streak that dated to July 15 at Milwaukee.
  - A* Went 7-0 with a 3.02 ERA (17 ER/50.2 IP) during the run, with wins over Milwaukee, Philadelphia, Cincinnati, Minnesota, the Mets, the White Sox and Washington.
  - A* The stretch spanned nine total starts, and Atlanta won all nine...Atlanta had not won more consecutive starts by a left-hander since 1993, when the Braves won 13 straight games started by Steve Avery.
- A* Starts today on four days' rest, and is 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA (34 ER/79.1 IP) in 14 games on regular rest this season.
  - A* When getting more than four days between starts, is 7-3 with a 4.54 ERA (35 ER/67.1 IP) in 13 starts.

#### 2019 Recap

- A* Lost at Philadelphia, 9/10, after allowing seven hits and five runs over 5.0 innings.
  - A* All five runs scored on home runs, including three solo shots and a two-run homer...Became the first Atlanta pitcher to allow four home runs in a single outing since Mike Foltyniewicz on 7/5/16, also at Philadelphia.
- A* Struck out a career high-tying 11 batters, 8/30 vs. CWS, to earn his 15th win of the season...Allowed four hits and four runs in 6.0 innings.
  - A* Also won both of his starts against the Cubs this season, becoming just the second Atlanta pitcher to beat both the Cubs and White Sox in a single season...Tim Hudson earned victories over both Chicago clubs in 2013...Dallas Keuchel also did so this season, beating the White Sox the day after Fried.
- A* Started against the Dodgers, 8/18 at SunTrust Park, and allowed eight hits and three runs in 5.0 innings...Did not factor in the decision.
  - A* Surrendered all three runs in the first inning and allowed the first two hitters to reach in the second, before retiring 11 of the next 13 hitters, including the final eight he faced.
  - A* Picked A.J. Pollock off first base in the opening inning, his fifth pickoff of the season...His five pickoffs are tied for second most in the majors.
- A* Won five consecutive starts from July 15-August 13, becoming the first Atlanta pitcher to win five consecutive starts since Mike Minor won five in a row between the 2012 and 2013 seasons.
- A* Missed nine games with a blister on his left index finger, July 16-July 27.
  - A* Was his second career stint on the Braves' injured list due to a blister...Missed from July 6 to July 29 of last season with a blister on his left third finger.
- A* Appeared in 20 games before the All-Star break, and set full-season career highs in wins (9), games (20), starts (18), innings (98.2) and strikeouts (97).
  - A* Went 9-4 with a 4.29 ERA (47 ER/98.2 IP) before the break...His nine wins were the most by a Braves lefty before the All-Star break since 2013, when both Paul Maholm and Mike Minor had nine...No Braves left-hander has won more since Tom Glavine had 11 wins at the break in 2002.
  - A* His nine wins were second most by a left-hander in the National League...Only the Dodgers' Hyun-Jin Ryu won more (10 wins).
- A* Allowed seven hits and two runs over 6.0 innings, 4/16 vs. ARI...Walked one and struck out three.
  - A* Opened the season with 16.2 innings without allowing an earned run, before Arizona scored twice in the fourth...It was the longest streak without an earned run to open the season by a Braves pitcher since 2013 (Paul Maholm, 25.1 IP).
