TWINS TRY TO MEATLOAF THE ROX: The Twins are looking to win their 12th series of the season...they have gone 11-14-1 in series play, 6-5-1 at home and 5-9-0 on the road...

WHEN LIFE GIVES YOU CLEMENS: Over his last 40 games, Kody Clemens has posted an .856 OPS and a .544 slugging percentage...in that span, he has 12 doubles, two triples, nine home runs and 23 RBI...

TWIN CITIES LUMBER CO.: Through 23 games this month, the Twins are slugging .477, which ranks second-best in baseball, trailing only Colorado (.489).

TREVOR LARNACH, PROFESSIONAL HITTER: Over his last nine games, Trevor Larnach is hitting .441 (15-for-34) with three doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, a .472 on-base percentage, a .706 slugging percentage and 1.178 OPS.

37 CARAT GOLD: In 17 games this month, Victor Caratini is hitting .351 (20-for-57) with four doubles, four home runs, 11 RBI, seven walks, a .431 on-base percentage, a .632 slugging percentage and a 1.062 OPS...

- Mike Paredes is due to make his fourth career MLB start (sixth appearance) tonight against the Colorado Rockies.
- The start will be Paredes' second consecutive start against a National League opponent...in his most recent start on June 21 at Arizona, he did not factor into the decision after allowing two runs on six hits, with three walks and one strikeout in a career-high 5.0 innings pitched in a 4-2 Minnesota victory.
- Has made one appearance at home this season on June 4 vs. Kansas City...relieved Andrew Morris as part of a bullpen game for Minnesota and allowed three runs on two hits (1 HR) in 3.2 innings pitched, with one walk and one strikeout.

LAST TIME OUT: Paredes made his third start (fifth appearance) of the season/his career on June 21 at Arizona opposite right-hander Jose Cabrera...did not factor into the decision despite pitching a career-high 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on a career-high six hits, with three walks and one strikeout in a 4-2, come-from-behind victory over the Diamondbacks at Chase Field.

- Held Arizona to a .167 (1-for-6) BAA with runners in scoring position, with his only blemish coming on a two-out, two-RBI double from Ketel Marte in the second inning.
- Threw 75 pitches in the outing, his most since firing 77 pitches in a start on August 6, 2022 with Low-A Fort Myers.
- In three starts with Minnesota dating back to June 10 at Detroit, he is 0-0 with a 3.55 ERA (12.2 IP, 5 ER), five walks, seven strikeouts, a 1.26 WHIP and a .239 (11-for-46) BAA.
- Has not received a decision since May 10, when he earned the win in his start at Las Vegas with Triple-A St. Paul; he has appeared in nine games (seven starts) between St. Paul and Minnesota since his last decision.

TWO STARTS AGO: Paredes made his second start (fourth appearance) of the season/his career on June 15 at Texas opposite left-hander MacKenzie Gore...did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on four hits – including a two-run home run by Joc Pederson – with no walks and two strikeouts in 4.2 innings pitched, as the Twins defeated the Rangers by a score of 4-2 at Globe Life Field.

- The outing marked the first of his major league career in which he did not issue a walk, and is the first time not allowing a free pass since his final start with Triple-A St. Paul on May 27 at Louisville.

WIN, WIN, WIN: Mike has made three starts this season for Minnesota after making his first two appearances as a reliever...the Twins have emerged victorious in all three games in which Paredes was the starter, winning on June 10 at Detroit (6-4), June 15 at Texas (4-2) and June 21 at Arizona (4-2).

- Marked the first time the Twins have won in each of a rookie's first three starts with the team since winning in each of Brian Duensing's first three career starts in 2009.

INTERLEAGUE NUMBERS: Paredes has made two career appearances in Interleague Play, one as a reliever (May 31 at Pittsburgh) and one as a starter (June 21 at Arizona)...in those two outings, he has no record with a 3.12 ERA (8.2 IP, 3 ER), six walks, four strikeouts, a 1.62 WHIP and a .258 (8-for-31) BAA.

- He has walked three batters in each of his first two career appearances in Interleague Play, becoming the first Twin since the inception of Interleague Play in 1987 to walk three batters in his first two games against the National League.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Paredes has made one relief appearance at home this season, and has a 7.36 ERA (3.2 IP, 3 ER) with one walk and one strikeout; in comparison he has made four appearances (three starts) on the road and has a 3.31 ERA (16.1 IP, 6 ER) with eight walks and 10 strikeouts.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: Paredes has faced 86 total batters through his first five appearances (three starts), and lefties have slashed .209/.314/.372 (9-for-43) with one double, two home runs, five walks and three strikeouts; in comparison, righties are slashing .207/.303/.241 (6-for-29) with one double, four walks and eight strikeouts...Paredes has produced very similar results against righties and lefties, and has featured his fastball and cutter to both, while relying more on his changeup to lefties and sweeper to righties.

THE ARSENAL: Paredes has displayed a four-pitch arsenal through his first five big league appearances...here are his numbers, per Baseball Savant:

- CUT IT UP:** Paredes has held opposing hitters to a .077 (1-for-13) BAA his cutter which ranks first among all Twins pitchers (min. 10 PA).

WAY TO GO, ROOK: Paredes has faced 31 batters with runners on base this season and has held them to a .194 (6-for-31) BAA, which ranks sixth among all rookie pitchers in Major League Baseball (min. 30 at-bats).

- He ranks third among American League rookie pitchers in that same category (BAA with runners on base), trailing Texas' Gavin Colyer (.121) and fellow Twins teammate Kendry Rojas (.188).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - LHP CONNOR PRIELIPP (2026: 2-5, 5.17 ERA // CAREER: 2-5, 5.17 ERA)

Connor Prielipp is slated to start tomorrow afternoon's three-game series finale against the Colorado Rockies...in his last start on June 19 at Arizona, Prielipp was saddled with his fifth loss of the season after allowing a career-high-tying six runs (three earned) on a career-high nine hits (1 HR - Ketel Marte), with three walks and four strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched in a 9-5 Twins defeat...his 6.0 innings pitched tied his season high (done four times) and it was the first time that he has thrown 6.0-or-more innings on the road this season...will make his first career start against the Rockies tomorrow and his fifth career Interleague start...is 0-2 with a 4.09 ERA (22.0 IP, 10 ER), seven walks, 20 strikeouts and a 1.36 WHIP through his first four career starts against National League opponents.

CAREER NOTES

- Contract selected by the Minnesota Twins on May 31, 2026; made his MLB debut the same day in Pittsburgh against the Pirates.
- Began the 2026 season with Double-A Wichita and went 1-1 with a 7.07 ERA (14.0 IP, 11 ER), one walk and 21 strikeouts in four appearances (three starts).
- Was promoted to Triple-A St. Paul on April 21, where he made nine appearances (seven starts) and had a 2-1 record with a 3.38 ERA (34.2 IP, 13 ER), eight walks, 33 strikeouts and a 1.13 WHIP.
- In 2025, combined to go 11-0 with a 2.38 ERA (105.2 IP, 28 ER), 28 walks, 92 strikeouts, and a 1.01 WHIP in 38 appearances (two starts) between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul.
- Spent nearly the whole 2025 season with Double-A Wichita, going 11-0 with a 2.43 ERA (103.2 IP, 28 ER) with 28 walks and 91 strikeouts over 37 appearances (two starts).
- Named Texas League Pitcher of the Week on June 29...led Wichita in ERA with 2.43 (min. 50 IP), wins (11) and innings pitched (103.2), third in strikeouts (91)...led the Texas League in wins (11).
- Promoted to Triple-A St. Paul on September 18, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings with zero hits allowed, zero walks and one strikeout in his only appearance.
- In 2024, combined to go 2-3 with a 3.02 ERA (65.2 IP, 22 ER), 13 walks, 61 strikeouts and a 1.14 WHIP between Low-A Fort Myers, High-A Cedar Rapids and Double-A Wichita.
- Began the season on rehab assignment for one game with Low-A Fort Myers on April 24...activated from 7-day Injured List on April 26...assigned to Double-A Wichita, posting a 5.79 ERA (18.2 IP, 12 ER) with eight walks and 13 strikeouts over 13 appearances.
- Then was assigned to High-A Cedar Rapids where he spent the majority of season (June 4-August 26), going 2-2 with a 1.80 ERA (45.0 IP, 9 ER) with five walks and 45 strikeouts over 17 appearances (three starts)...ranked third on the Kernels in ERA with 1.80 (min. 20.0 IP).
- In 2023, spent the entire season with High-A Cedar Rapids, going 7-1 with a 3.14 ERA (63.0 IP, 22 ER), 20 walks and 58 strikeouts in 28 games (three starts).
- His seven wins in 2023 were tied for first on the Kernels and his 63.0 innings pitched ranked third among relievers.
- In 2022, spent the entire season with Low-A Fort Myers, going 7-4, 3.27 ERA (85.1 IP, 31 ER) with 16 walks and 63 strikeouts in 24 games (13 starts).
- Paredes' seven wins ranked first on the Mussels, while his 85.1 inning pitched ranked second.
- In 2021, made two appearances (one start) with FCL Twins, going 0-0 with a 2.25 ERA (4.0 IP, 1 ER), one walk and six strikeouts.
- Played collegiately for three seasons at San Diego State from 2019-21...named 2020 Mountain West All-Academic selection as a sophomore...played summer ball for Kalama-zoo in the Northwoods League in 2019.
- Attended San Diego High School and was four-year letterwinner...earned team MVP honors on three occasions and was twice named San Diego City League Player of the Year...received Second-Team All-CIF recognition and was named a 2018 San Diego County All-Star.
