TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants and Royals play game one of this three-game series...SF is 7-15 all-time against the Royals during regular season play, with just one series victory in eight sets (June 13-15, 2022, won series 2-1)...these teams meet at Kauffman Stadium for the first time since April 2017.

- ▶ The Giants enter tonight having lost 11 of their last 15 games to the Royals, dating back to 2008.
- ▶ The Giants are 13-21 (.382) since August 11...the .382 winning percentage in that span is second-lowest in the NL ahead of only Miami (13-22, .382) and fourth-lowest in MLB.

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants made the following roster moves prior to tonight's game:

- ▶ **RHP Jordan Hicks** placed on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive to Sept. 17) with right shoulder inflammation.
- ▶ **RHP Austin Warren** (#57) recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.

MAYBE NEXT YEAR: With their 5-3 loss to Baltimore yesterday, the Giants were officially eliminated from the postseason...it's the eighth time in the last 10 years since their last World Series championship that they will not be playing playoff baseball.

ROAD CHALLENGES: The road has been a challenge for SF in 2024 as they enter tonight with a 33-42 (.440) road record...the .440 road winning percentage is 22nd of 30 MLB clubs and is the fourth-lowest in the NL ahead of Colorado (.295), Miami (.360) and Washington (.410).

- ▶ However, SF has won each of its last two road series which have both come against teams currently in playoff position...the Giants took two-of-three from San Diego September 6-8 and secured a series win at Baltimore to begin this nine-game road trip.

NEW TO ME: Just seven of 28 players on the Giants' active roster have played at least one game here at Kauffman Stadium...**LHP Taylor Rogers** has the most experience in this facility among current Giants, having appeared in 23 games...**IF Mark Canha** has logged the most games here among position players with 16...the other five Giants to have checked off Kauffman as a stadium they've played in are **C Curt Casali** (8 games), **OF Michael Conforto** (5), **IF LaMonte Wade Jr.** (4), **LHP Blake Snell** (1) and **RHP Austin Warren** (1).

MASON ON THE MOUND: **RHP Mason Black** is 0-4 with a 6.39 ERA (18er, 25.1ip) with six home runs allowed in his first six career starts...Black was recalled from Triple-A in late-August when **LHP Robbie Ray** landed on the IL...he's given up eight runs in 13.2 innings (5.27 ERA) in three starts since being recalled.

- ▶ Black is still seeking his first Major League win.
- ▶ Opponents are just 11-for-75 (.147) vs. the Giants' starters over the last four games.
- ▶ Giants starting pitchers have limited opponents to three earned runs or fewer in each of their last 11 games, posting a 2.95 ERA (18er, 55.0ip) in that stretch.
- ▶ In fact, since the All-Star break, Giants starting pitchers have fashioned a 3.90 ERA in 56 games, the fifth-lowest ERA in the NL, behind the Mets (3.31), Padres (3.61), Braves (3.65) and Brewers (3.71).

TURN BACK TIME: It's been 10 years since the Giants and Royals matched up in the 2014 World Series...Salvador Perez, who fouled out to **Pablo Sandoval** with the tying run at third to end Game 7, is the only remaining position player on an active roster from that Fall Classic.

WALK THE LINE: **RHP Ryan Walker** suffered his fourth loss of the season yesterday after allowing a walkoff two-run home run to Baltimore's Anthony Santander in the 9th inning...it was the first home run Walker had allowed on the road ALL season and the first earned runs he'd allowed in a game since July 27.

- ▶ Since taking over the closer's role on August 9, Walker has converted all eight of his save opportunities while allowing just three runs (2er) in 16.2 innings...he's struck out 27 and walked just four in that time while opposing hitters have batted .153 (9-for-59).
- ▶ Since the All-Star break, Walker has allowed four earned runs in 26.2 innings for a 1.35 ERA in 25 games...his 1.35 ERA since the break is third-best among relievers (min. 25.0ip) behind ARI's AJ Puk (0.33) and CLE's Emmanuel Clase (0.33).

KEEP IT GOING: **OF Michael Conforto** has homered in each of his last two games and has collected at least one RBI in four-straight (6 RBI total)...he finished the Baltimore series by going 6-for-13 (.462) with three runs scored, two homers and five RBI.

- ▶ Conforto's 18 home runs this season are his most in a single campaign since he hit 33 with the Mets in 2019.

TOUGH ON US: Opposing Royals starting pitcher, RHP Michael Wacha, has gone 3-0 with a 1.80 ERA (10er, 50.0ip) and a .224 opponents avg. against in nine career starts against the Giants...he faced them twice last season as a member of the Padres and allowed two runs in 6.0 innings in each of the two starts.

GOING FOR 20: With a stolen base in this series, **IF Tyler Fitzgerald** will have 20 stolen bases and 15 home runs (currently has 16) in the first 100 games of his career...the only shortstops to achieve that feat in the modern era are Bobby Witt Jr. and Fernando Tatis Jr. (Stats, LLC).

SEPTEMBER 20, 2016 - The Giants defeated the Dodgers 2-0 at Dodger Stadium to move within 5.0 games of LA for first place in the NL West...**Johnny Cueto** logged 5.1-shutout innings to earn his 17th victory of the season...**Eduardo Núñez** and **Brandon Belt** both homered to provide the Giants all the runs they'd need in their shutout win.

WITH THE GIANTS: Black is making his seventh start and his eighth appearance with the Giants at the MLB level this season...he has spent parts of four seasons in the system after being taken in the third round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University (Bethlehem, PA)...Black returned to the rotation after **LHP Robbie Ray** hit the IL with a left hamstring strain on August 27.

LAST TIME OUT: Was tasked with facing the San Diego Padres for a second straight start in his outing last Saturday at Oracle Park... Black suffered the loss, allowing two runs on six hits in 4.0 innings... he struck out two, walked one and surrendered one home run in his 79-pitch effort...SF lost the game 8-0.

THE MIXTAPE: Black adjusted his pitch mix during his four August outings at Triple-A and his three outings back in the Majors have resembled what was working for him down in AAA...below is a breakdown of his pitch mix in his last three starts w/SF versus his first four MLB games (three starts) in May of this year.

THE HOMERS: Has allowed one homer in each of his seven MLB games thus far, surrendering seven home runs in 28.0 MLB innings total (2.25 HR/9ip)...in the minors this year, Black allowed 12 homers in 84.1 innings at AAA (1.28 HR/9ip).

SEAMHEAD: Since his return to the Majors on August 31, Black has struck out better than a batter per inning, whiffing 14 hitters in 13.2 innings of work (9.2 K/9)...eight of the 14 punchouts in that time have come with his four-seam fastball (his most used pitch since returning)...however, hitters are 6-for-19 (.316) off his four-seamer in his three starts (five singles, one homer)...Kansas City has a .751 OPS versus four-seamers this year, 18th of 30 MLB teams...their 19.3% strikeout rate on four-seamers is fifth-lowest in MLB.

AUGUST IN AAA: Black had a 2.91 ERA (7er, 21.2ip) in four starts at the Triple-A level in August before returning to the big league roster on August 31...it was his best month since being optioned down to Triple-A after his first stint w/SF ended in late May...prior to August, Black had an 8.25 ERA (33er, 36.0ip) with one quality start over his previous 10 AAA outings from May 28-July 26.

THE PIPELINE: The 24-year-old right-hander enters today as the Giants eighth-best prospect overall according to *MLB.com*...he's the third-best pitching prospect in the system behind **LHP Carson Whisenhunt** (#3) and **LHP Joe Whitman** (#6)...below is a look at the pitching prospects in SF's system as of today.

FAMILY TIME: Made his debut with SF on May 6 at Philadelphia in the ballpark he grew up going to as a child...Black was born and raised in nearby Scranton, PA before attending Lehigh University in Bethlehem, PA...Black had nearly 60 family and friends on hand for his debut at Citizens Bank Park...Black was the seventh Giant, and sixth pitcher, to make his Major League debut this season.

WHAT'S IN A NAME?: Black told reporters this spring that he and his brother Dixon's names are inspired by the Mason-Dixon line, which is a line that separates Pennsylvania, Maryland, Delaware and West Virginia...per *The Athletic's Andrew Baggarly*, Mason and Dixon have matching tattoos of the geographical location (39° 43' 18" N.) to honor their namesake... Dixon is an infielder at Wofford University.
