**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners begin the homestand with the first of 3 games against the Arizona Diamondbacks...Seattle will also host the New York Mets (3 G, 6/1-6/3) on the homestand...tonight's game will be televised and streamed live on **Mariners TV** and **KING5** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Ryon Healy** on the call and **Angie Mentink** serving as field reporter, and also **Chris Egan** as a field reporter...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Gary Hill Jr.** on the call.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners are coming off a dominant 3-game series sweep at the Athletics, outscoring the A's 22-4 across the 3 contests, holding them to 2-or-fewer runs in each of the 3 games.

- **7:10 Reminder** - Tonight and tomorrow night's games are slated for 7:10 p.m. first pitches...it marks the Mariners first 7:10 p.m. home start times since Opening Day on March 26.
- **'90s Fireworks Night** - Tonight marks the Mariners first post-game fireworks show this year: '90s Fireworks Night, presented by T-Mobile and Warm 106.9.
- **50 Seasons Themed** - Righty **Logan Gilbert** recorded his 50th career win in Wednesday's victory at the Athletics...tonight's starter **George Kirby** recorded his 50th career win on May 11 at Houston.

**A STAR IN CENTER FIELD**...**Julio Rodríguez** has continued his excellent 2026 season, hitting a 3-run homer in Wednesday's win...Julio has reached base in 12 consecutive games (5/15-c)...in the month of May, Julio has posted an .847 OPS, batting .262 (27x103) with 16 runs, 5 doubles, 8 home runs, 15 RBI and 6 walks with a .544 slugging percentage...Julio's 8 homers are tied for the most he's had in a month, along with September/October 2023 and July 2025.

**HEROIC HURLERS**...the Mariners pitching staff has posted a combined 3.54 ERA (199 ER, 506.1 IP) with an MLB-fewest 147 walks, along with 485 strikeouts...among Major League pitching staffs they rank 2nd in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.30), 1st in fewest walks-per-9 innings (2.61), 5th in ERA, 7th in WHIP (1.22) and 10th in strikeouts...Mariners starting pitching leads MLB with 324.1 innings pitched and ranks T-4th in strikeouts (305) and T-5th in quality starts (25)...the Seattle bullpen ranks 5th in the Majors in ERA (3.16).

**WE'RE NOT TRIPPIN'**...the Mariners are coming off a 4-2 road trip against the Kansas City Royals (1-2) and Athletics (3-0)...Seattle has recorded 3 consecutive winning road trips, starting with a 5-1 trip from April 24-29 against the St. Louis Cardinals (3-0) and Minnesota Twins (2-1) and then a 4-3 trip from May 8-14 at the Chicago White Sox (1-2) and Houston Astros (3-1) before the most recent road trip.

**FIRST 10 GAMES OF COLT**...through his first 10 games in the Majors, **Colt Emerson** has posted an .877 OPS, batting .258 (8x31) with 5 runs, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 6 RBI and 4 walks in 36 plate appearances, striking out just 8 times while getting on base at a .361 clip and slugging .516...he's toting a 153 OPS+, 53% better than the league-average hitter (100 OPS+)...Colt is the second player in Mariners history with 3+ doubles, a triple, and homer over his first 10 career games, joining Jim Presley (1984)...over his last 4 contests (5/24-c), the 20-year-old Emerson is batting .429 (6x14) with 3 runs, 3 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI and 2 walks with a 1.286 OPS in 16 trips to the plate.

**PIGGYBACK**...in the 2 instances that **Luis Castillo** and **Bryce Miller** have pitched in the same game, the Mariners pitching staff has posted a 2.00 ERA (4 ER, 18.0 IP) with 24 strikeouts and 5 walks as a team, allowing just 11 hits...in those games, Miller has posted a 1.69 ERA (2 ER, 10.2 IP) with 11 strikeouts and 1 walk...Castillo has posted a 2.84 ERA (2 ER, 6.1 IP) with 10 strikeouts and 4 walks...Miller is scheduled to start this Sunday's series finale vs. the D'Backs.

**HE'S NAYLZ**...over his last 34 contests (4/17-c), **Josh Naylor** is batting .338 (45x133) with 16 runs, 5 doubles, 3 home runs, 17 RBI, 13 walks and 12 stolen bases, getting on base at a .395 clip, slugging .444 with an .839 OPS in 147 plate appearances...during that span, Naylor's .338 average ranks 5th in the big leagues (min. 100 PA)...Naylor's 12 stolen bases are tied for 2nd-most in the Majors since April 17, trailing only Nasim Nuñez-WSH (15).

**IN OUR AROZARENA ERA**...in 57 games this season, **Randy Arozarena** is batting .295 (61x207) with 38 runs, 15 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs, 25 RBI and going 14-for-16 in stolen base attempts, getting on base at a .382 clip and slugging .464 for an .846 OPS...among qualified AL hitters, he ranks T-7th in average, T-6th in hits, T-3rd in doubles, T-7th in runs, and T-3rd in SB...in 25 games this month, Randy is batting .301 (28x93) with 6 doubles, 4 home runs, 14 RBI, 7 stolen bases and an .878 OPS.

**THE BULLPEN BOYS**...right-hander **Eduard Bazarzo** has a 2.22 ERA (6 ER, 24.1 IP) with 23 strikeouts and 9 walks in 26 appearances this season...right-hander **Matt Brash** has a 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 13.1 IP) with 11 strikeouts and 2 walks, posting a 0.60 WHIP and limiting opponents to a .143 batting average (6x42).

**BIG THUNDER RUMBLES ON**...**Luke Raley** is batting .264 (37x140) with 20 runs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 11 home runs, 29 RBI, a .322 OBP and slugging .550 for an .872 OPS in 51 games...over his last 18 games (5/8-c), he is batting .292 (14x48) with 1 double, 5 home runs, 13 RBI and a .971 OPS.

**HOMESTAND HIGHLIGHTS**...the Mariners are at T-Mobile Park for a 6-game homestand against the Diamondbacks (3 G, May 29-31) and Mets (3 G, June 1-3)...featured on the homestand is '90s Weekend (May 29-31) with '90s Fireworks Night tonight, **Julio Rodríguez** '90s Jersey Night on Saturday and '90s Pin Day on Sunday, as well as Pride Night on June 1.

**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...the Mariners offense has been red-hot over the team's last 4 games...since May 24, Seattle's offense is batting .312 (48x154) with 28 runs scored (7 runs per game), 17 extra-base hits (9 doubles, 1 triple, 7 home runs) with a .519 slugging percentage and .865 OPS in 165 plate appearances, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...the Mariners have recorded 10+ hits in each of their last 4 contests?...it marks the first time they've done that since June 20-23, and if Seattle records double-digit hits tonight, it will mark the first time the Mariners have registered 10+ hits in 5+ consecutive games since July 25-30, 2023, doing it in 5 consecutive games at the Minnesota Twins (2 G) and at the Arizona Diamondbacks (3 G).

### ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - MAY 29

- **2000** - **Mike Cameron** robs Herbert Perry of a home run while trailing 3-0 against Chicago in the 5th inning. The Mariners come back to win 5-4.
- **2002** - **Freddy García** records his 50th career win at Tampa Bay, he is the sixth Mariners pitcher to win 50 games.
- **2003** - **Bret Boone** hits his 200th career home run off of Brad Radke in Mariners 10-6 win at Minnesota.
- **2015** - **Taijuan Walker** had the best start of his young career, tossing 8.0 scoreless innings to lead the Mariners to a 2-1 win over Cleveland...Walker tied a career high with 8 strikeouts in the game.
- **2025** - **Andrés Muñoz** entered in the 9th inning of a 9-3 10-inning loss to the Nationals, and recorded his 300th career strikeout, extending his franchise-best mark of 23.2 consecutive innings to begin a season without an earned run.

ABOUT GEORGE KIRBY...

- The 28-year-old right-hander is making his 12th start of the season and 1st against the Diamondbacks...
• Is in his 5th season with Seattle; selected by the Mariners in the first round (20th overall) of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Ty Holub.
• Named to his 1st All-Star team in 2023.
• Named AL Rookie of the Month in August 2022 after posting a 2.15 ERA and 5-0 record.
• Is the highest drafted player out of Elon University.

LAST TIME OUT...L#4 on May 23 at Kansas City, tossed 6.0 innings and allowed 5 runs (3 ER) on 9 hits with no walks and 3 strikeouts...he has yet to allow a walk to the Royals across 5 career starts (32.0 IP).

AGAINST ARIZONA...is making his 2nd career start against the Diamondbacks...in his only other start against Arizona on April 27, 2024 at T-Mobile Park, he threw 7.0 scoreless innings while allowing just 2 hits with 1 walk and 12 strikeouts...it marked his 9th career start of 7.0+ IP without an earned run allowed (last: 8/12/25 at BAL), T-7th most such games in MLB since 2023.

PLENTY OF PUNCHOUTS...has tossed 12+ strikeouts in 3 career games, including a career-high 14 strikeouts twice last season...is 1 of 10 pitchers with 3-or-more games of 12+ strikeouts since 2024.

SO NICE HE DID IT TWICE...is the only pitcher to have multiple starts of 14+ SO and no walks since 2025, having done so twice last season (6/8/25 at LAA & 9/14 vs. LAA)...teammate Emerson Hancock recently joined him and Max Meyer-MIA (4/21/25 vs. CIN) as the only pitchers in MLB with 14+ SO and 0 BB in a game since 2025.

GEORGE & WALTER...among pitchers with 50+ starts at home since 2022, he leads MLB in walks-per-nine innings (1.48) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.28), ranking just ahead of rotationmate Logan Gilbert in both categories (1.67 BB/9 and 5.96 SO/BB).

WIN #50...earned his 50th career win on May 11 at Houston, becoming the 12th player in franchise history with 50+ wins...his 121 games are tied for the 4th-fewest games to reach 50 wins with the Mariners, alongside: Hisashi Iwakuma and Erik Hanson...behind: Jamie Moyer (100 G), Freddy Garcia (100 G), and Marco Gonzales (118 G).

LENGTH ON THE MOUND...has reached the 6th inning in 10 of his 11 starts this year and has cleared the 7th inning in 3 of those starts...his 68.2 innings pitched this season are T-5th most in MLB, alongside Bryce Elder-ATL...has pitched 6.0+ innings in 7 starts this season, T-10th most such starts this year...trails teammate Bryan Woo who has tossed 6.0+ IP in 8 of his 11 starts.

QUALITY STUFF...has thrown 6 quality starts this season (last: 5/23 at KC)...has thrown 69 quality starts across his career, T-8th most in MLB since 2022...has thrown a quality start without any walks in 37 career starts (2x this season, last: 5/23 at KC), most in MLB since 2022, ahead of Tarik Skubal-DET (26 G) and Zack Wheeler-PHI (26 G)...has also tossed a quality start with no walks in 20 home games, most in MLB since 2022 and 3rd-most all-time in Mariners history, behind Félix Hernández and Jamie Moyer who each had 22 quality starts with no walks at home.

FURIOUS GEORGE...has thrown 7.0+ innings with 3-or-fewer earned runs allowed in 3 starts this season and in 25 career starts...in addition, Kirby and Bryan Woo are 2 of 8 pitchers in MLB this season to have 3 games of 7.0+ IP, 3-or-fewer runs, and 1-or-fewer walks allowed...Kirby's 22 such starts since 2023 are T-2nd most in MLB across that span.

CRUISE CONTROL...tossed 8.0 innings on April 7 vs. Texas on the road, his 2nd career complete game (also: 8/12/23 vs. BAL)...is 1 of 7 pitchers with a complete game so far this season...became the first Mariners pitcher to toss 8.0+ IP since Logan Gilbert did so twice in 2024 (last: 9/7/24 at STL)...in addition, Kirby has thrown 8.0+ IP without a walk in 3 career games (last: 4/7 at TEX) and is 1 of 9 pitchers in MLB with 3-or-more such games since 2023, joining teammate Logan Gilbert (3 G, last: 6/16/24 vs. TEX).

KEEPING IT CLOSE...his 55.1% ground-ball percentage this season ranks 3rd-highest in MLB among starters...increased his ground-ball percentage from 44.1% last season (+11.0%)...posts a 44.7% ground-ball percentage across his career.

EFFECTIVE AND EFFICIENT...currently averages 14.8 pitches per inning this season, the 7th-lowest mark in MLB...ranks ahead of teammate Bryan Woo (T-8th, 14.9 P/IP)...is averaging 15.6 pitches per inning across his career, tied for the 12th-fewest P/IP among starters since 2022 (min. 500 IP).

FEAR THE SWEEPER...his sweeper is his 2nd-most used pitch behind his 4-seam fastball, averaging about a 20.9% usage across his career, including a 27.2% usage this season...his 2,301 sweepers thrown since 2022 are 2nd-most in MLB, trailing only Logan Webb-SF (3,360) and ranking ahead of Taylor Rogers-6Tms (2,216)...his 273 sweepers thrown this season are 3rd-most in MLB.

BEST IN ALL THE LAND...among starting pitchers since 2022 (min. 600 IP), he leads the Majors in fewest walks allowed (109), strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.20), walks-per-nine innings (1.39), and walk rate (3.8%).

FOR THE M'S HISTORY BOOKS...leads the Mariners franchise (min. 100 GS) in fewest walks-per-nine innings (1.4) and in strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.20)...ranks 5th in franchise history in career ERA (3.58) and 11th in total strikeouts (676 SO).
