### Roster Moves

The Braves today placed OF Cristian Pache (strained left groin) and LHP Max Fried (strained right hamstring) on the 10-day injured list and recalled OF Guillermo Heredia and LHP Tucker Davidson to Atlanta.

Davidson, 25, made his major league debut with Atlanta last season and went 0-1 with a 10.80 ERA (2 ER/1.2 IP) in his only appearance, a start on September 26 vs. Boston...He is ranked by MLB.com as Atlanta's No. 8 prospect.

Atlanta claimed Heredia, 30, off waivers from the New York Mets in February and his first appearance will mark his Braves debut...He is a career .239/.316/.344 batter over five major league seasons, and split the 2020 season between the Pirates and Mets.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Marlins continue a four-game set tonight with the third of 19 matchups between the clubs this season...The clubs will play again on June 11-13 in Miami for the next meetings between the teams.

🔥 Miami has won each of the first two games of this series, beating Atlanta in consecutive games for the first time since September 7-8 of last season... Atlanta would score a National League-record 29 runs versus Miami on September 9.

🔥 The Braves went 6-4 against the Marlins last season, winning the season series with their NL East rival for the sixth consecutive season...They went 9-10 against the Marlins in 2014.

🔥 The Braves have won 10 of their last 11 series against the Marlins in Atlanta, including taking three-of-four the last time Miami was here, September 21-24, 2020...The Marlins won two-of-three, September 7-9, 2020, although the Braves scored 29 runs in their one win that series.

🔥 RHP Charlie Morton is 7-4 with a 3.77 ERA (32 ER/76.1 IP) in 13 career games, all starts, against the Marlins, including a 5-1 mark and a 2.84 ERA (14 ER/44.1 IP) in seven starts since 2013...The 6-foot-5, 235-pound native of Flemington, N.J., last faced Miami in 2019 and fired 6.0 scoreless innings to earn the win.

🔥 RHP Nick Neidert is set for just his second career start and his sixth appearance in the majors... An Atlanta native, Neidert has made one career appearance against the Braves, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings here at Truist Park last September.

**OZZIE DOUBLES:** 2B Ozzie Albies doubled in last night's seventh inning for the 100th two-base hit of his career... He ended the night 2-for-4 with a home run and one RBI, his first multi-hit game of the season.

🔥 Albies' 100th double came in his 415th game played, the fourth most in franchise history through the same amount of games...Only Martin Prado (106), Brian McCann (105) and Marcus Giles (105) had more.

**START STRONG:** The Braves led 3-0 after the first inning last night and have scored in the initial at-bat for four consecutive games...They have lost three of those four games.

🔥 The Braves lead the majors with 13 first-inning runs scored this season...OF Ronald Acuña Jr. has scored five of those runs this season, also the most in the majors.

🔥 Last season, the club went 14-3 when they led after the first.

🔥 When the Braves scored first in the game last season, they went a NL-best 24-6 (.800)...The only team better in the majors was Tampa Bay, who finished 25-6 (.806) when scoring the first run of the game.

**LINEUP CHANGE:** Manager Brian Snitker batted 1B Freddie Freeman second and OF Marcell Ozuna third in last night's starting lineup for the first time this season...Freeman doubled and reached base three times, while Ozuna went 3-for-4 with three RBI and his first home run of the season.

🔥 Entering play last night, Freeman was batting .143 (5-for-35), while Ozuna was 5-for-36 (.139) with five singles and 15 strikeouts.

🔥 Freeman hit second in the starting lineup 26 times last season, batting .390 (39-for-100) with six home runs, 25 RBI and a 1.202 OPS...The Braves went 17-9 with Freeman in the second spot and averaged 6.7 runs per game with him there.

🔥 Last season, Ozuna hit .375 (36-for-96) with nine home runs and 30 RBI in 24 games from the three hole...He slugged .708 and compiled a 1.182 OPS from that spot in the lineup.

**ACUÑA JR. STAYS HOT:** OF Ronald Acuña Jr. went 1-for-4 with a walk and two runs last night, and leads the National League slugging percentage (.881), OPS (1.371), hits (18), runs (12) and extra-base hits (10).

🔥 He ranks second in the N.L. in batting average (.429), doubles (tied, 5) and stolen bases (tied, 3), and ranks third in home runs (tied, 4) and on-base percentage (.490).

🔥 Acuña Jr. has scored two runs in each of the last three games, tied for the longest such streak of his career, and has at least one run scored in five straight.

**RISP:** The Braves went 4-for-13 with runners in scoring position last night and are batting just .208 (16-for-77) in such situations this season...That mark ranks sixth lowest in baseball.

🔥 1B Freddie Freeman, OF Marcell Ozuna and 2B Ozzie Albies are a combined 6-for-36 (.167) in these situations this season, with three of those six hits coming last night.

🔥 Last season, the Braves compiled a .853 OPS with runners in scoring position, good for the fourth-best mark in the major leagues...1B Freddie Freeman compiled a 1.468 OPS in these situations, the best in the majors.

**FEW WALKS:** Braves batters walked four times last night, with Ronald Acuña Jr., Marcell Ozuna, Ozzie Albies and Ender Inciarte each drawing a free pass... Atlanta has just 30 walks through 11 games, sixth fewest in baseball.

🔥 Atlanta drew 239 base-on-balls last season, tied for most in the N.L. and third most in the majors.

🔥 Braves batters walked in 10.2% of all plate appearances last season...That number is just 7.6% through 11 games in 2021.

🔥 Ronald Acuña Jr., Freddie Freeman and Marcell Ozuna have each walked six times this season...No other batter has more than two.

Tonight's Game

- Set for his third start of the season and the 261st of his career...Is his 262nd career appearance.
- Last started on April 9, Atlanta's home opener, and held Philadelphia to four hits and one run over 6.0 innings to earn his first win of the year.
- The win was Morton's first for Atlanta since he beat the Florida Marlins on August 28, 2008, a span of 4,607 days.
- Morton has surrendered three run-scoring hits this season, all to Philadelphia, and none have been hit harder than 75 miles per hour.
- In his first start of the season, allowed run-scoring hits to Zack Wheeler (74.9 mph) and Rhys Hoskins (72.2 mph).
- Andrew McCutchen's RBI-single in the third inning of his last start left the bat at just 66.2 MPH
- Makes his 14th career start against Miami, and is 7-4 with a 3.77 ERA (32 ER/76.1 IP) over his first 13 career games, all starts.
- Is 5-1 mark and a 2.84 ERA (14 ER/44.1 IP) in seven starts since 2013.
- Last faced Miami in 2019 and fired 6.0 scoreless innings to earn the win.

2021 Recap

- With his start on 4/9 vs. PHI, each of his last three starts in the regular season were made against the Phillies...He faced Philadelphia in his final turn last season, 9/25, and in his first start this season, 4/3.
- Has faced the same opponent consecutive starts in a single season nine times... In his first starts of those nine instances, he is 3-2 with a 3.14 ERA (18 ER/51.2 IP), 43 hits allowed and 45 strikeouts...In the second game of those starts, he is 3-2 with a 4.50 ERA (23 ER/46.0 IP), 48 hits allowed and just 40 strikeouts.
- Morton made his second debut, 4/3 at PHI, and returned to the Braves this offseason on a one-year contract worth \$15 million.
- Morton made his major league debut with the club on June 14, 2008, beating Los Angeles (AL), 9-4 with 6.0 innings of three-run ball...He made 15 more appearances for the Braves that season, with his last coming on September 21 vs. the Mets.
- With his first start this season, Morton went 12 years, 194 days between Braves appearances.
- According to research from the Elias Sports Bureau, only four other Braves in the modern era (since 1900) had a gap of at least 12 years between appearances, with Bucky Walters' 17-year, 302-day span the longest.
- Walters played third base with the Braves in 1932, before transitioning to the mound where he became an MVP with Cincinnati in 1939. He returned to the Braves as the club's pitching coach in 1950, and made one final relief appearance for the team on July 23 of that year at the age of 41.
- The other three Braves with 12-year gaps between appearances for the club were Darrell Evans (1976-1989;12 years, 296 days), Ray Mueller (1938-1951; 12 years, 203 days) and Johnny Evers (1917-1929; 12 years, 94 days).

2020 Recap

- Made nine starts in his second season with Tampa Bay, going 2-2 with a 4.74 ERA (20 ER/38.0 IP) and 42 strikeouts to help guide the Rays to the A.L. East title.
- Over the past three seasons, his .750 winning pct. (33-11) ranks second in the majors behind HOU/NYY Gerrit Cole, who is 42-13 (.764).
- Was on Tampa Bay's injured list from August 10 to September 1, missing 21 games with right shoulder inflammation.
- In four starts prior to injury went 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (10 ER/16.2 IP) and allowed opponents to bat .304 against him...In five starts after returning, pitched to a 4.22 ERA (10 ER/21.1 IP) and held opponents to a .259 average.
- Used his curveball for 32.7 pct. of his pitches, compared to 37.3 pct. in 2019—the highest rate in the majors (min. 100 IP).
- His curveball registered a horizontal movement of 17.9 inches according to StatCast, tied for second in the majors.
- Made four starts in the postseason, going 3-1 with a 2.70 ERA (6 ER/20.0 IP) as the Rays advanced to the World Series.
- In Game 7 of the League Championship Series vs. HOU, recorded his fourth career win in a “winner take all” game, extending his own major league record...Marked his fifth career win in a potential elimination game, breaking a tie with five other pitchers for the most in major league history

Career Recap

- A 13-year major league veteran, has compiled a 93-89 record and a 4.08 ERA (653 ER/1439.1 IP) across 259 games, 258 starts...Has fanned 1,276 and pitched a pair of shutouts.
- Has pitched for Atlanta (2008), Pittsburgh (2009-15), Philadelphia (2016), Houston (2017-18) and Tampa Bay (2019-20).
- Is a two-time All-Star (2018 & 2019) and won the 2017 World Series while with Houston.

**Tucker Davidson • LHP • 6-2 • 215 • 25 yrs • #64**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0     **Holds:** 0     **1st Batter/Retired:** 0/0     **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- Was recalled to Atlanta today, 4/14, and his first appearance will be his season debut.
- Made his major-league debut on September 26, allowing seven runs (two earned) through 1.2 innings pitched for an ERA of 10.80 during his start... Spent the rest of the season at Atlanta's alternate training site.

**Grant Dayton • LHP • 6-2 • 210 • 33 yrs • #75**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0     **Holds:** 0     **1st Batter/Retired:** 2/2     **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 5/0

- Making his third Opening Day Roster (second with Atlanta and also '17 with LAD) after finishing with a 6.43 ERA and seven strikeouts in six games during the spring.
- Last season appeared in 18 games and pitched a 2.30 ERA (7 ER/ 27.1 IP) with a record of 2-1.
- In 2020 made 11 relief appearances of more than 1.0 inning, tied for the second most such appearances in MLB.
- His 27.1 innings pitched in relief were tied for the third most among left-handers last year.
- Among lefty relievers, his 32 strikeouts were tied as the fourth highest mark in the majors last season.

**Luke Jackson • RHP • 6-2 • 210 • 29 yrs • #77**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0     **Holds:** 1     **1st Batter/Retired:** 4/3     **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 2/0

- His nine-game winning streak is the longest active streak in the majors.
- Has induced 66 ground balls since the beginning of the 2020 season, the most in the majors.
- Enters his fifth season with Atlanta after striking out seven in seven relief apparances during Spring Training with a 3.52 ERA.
- In 2020, his sixth major-league season, went 2-0 with a 6.84 ERA (20 ER/26.1 IP) in 19 appearances out of the bullpen.
- In his 19 relief appearances last year, Jackson induced 60 ground balls, the most among relievers in baseball...An average of 3.16 ground balls per outing.
- Converted 19 of his 27 save chances after logging just one career save prior to 2019.

**Nate Jones • RHP • 6-5 • 230 • 35 yrs • #49**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/1     **Holds:** 1     **1st Batter/Retired:** 5/2     **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 2/2

- Logged a 1.23 ERA with four strikeouts in seven games with Atlanta this spring.
- Last season he made Cincinnati's Opening Day roster and pitched in 21 games, going 0-1 with a 6.27 ERA (13 ER/18.2 IP) and fanning 23.
- Has gone 22-14 with a 3.31 ERA (114 ER/310.0 IP) over 305 career games, fanning 341 batters and logging nine saves.
- Was drafted by the Chicago White Sox in 2007 and debuted with the club in 2012...Played his entire professional career with Chicago until being traded to Texas in July, 2019...Did not appear for the Rangers, and signed with Cincinnati for the 2020 season.

**Tyler Matzek • LHP • 6-3 • 210 • 30 yrs • #68**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0     **Holds:** 2     **1st Batter/Retired:** 5/5     **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- Ranks first in the NL in FIP (2.00 - min. 30.0 IP), strikeouts (49), and third in innings (33.2 IP) since the beginning of the 2020 season.
- Over the last two seasons, his 0.27 HR/9 rate is the lowest among relievers and second lowest in MLB (Min. 30 IP).
- In 2020 led the majors with 12 relief appearances of more than 1.0 inning this season... His 43 strikeouts and 29.0 innings pitched on the season were the most among left-handed relievers.
- Last season pitched to a 1.94 FIP this season, lowest among all lefties and fourth in MLB (min. 25 IP).
- Made 20 appearances, 19 starts, for Colorado in the 2014 season...His major league debut came against Atlanta at Coors Field on 6/11...Pitched a shutout on 9/5 vs. SD, becoming the fourth rookie in franchise history to toss a shutout...Made Colorado's 2015 Opening Day roster.

**A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 27 yrs • #33**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/1     **Holds:** 2     **1st Batter/Retired:** 6/5     **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- Has a 2.67 FIP since the beginning of the 2020 season, third lowest in the NL among lefties (min. 25 IP).
- Appeared in 22 games for Atlanta in the 2020 season, and finished 1-1 with a 0.83 ERA (2 ER/21.2 IP)... His 0.83 ERA was the lowest in the National League and second in the majors among left-handed pitchers (min. 20.0 IP)...Was the only lefty in the National League (one of two in MLB) with two earned run or less in at least 20.0 IP.
- Made his first career start in Game 5 of the NLCS... Minter became the first pitcher in major league history to make his first career start in the postseason... Held Los Angeles (NL) to one hit while fanning seven without issuing a walk over 3.0 scoreless innings during his start.
- Pitched to a 2.84 FIP last season, third lowest in the National League among lefties with as many innings pitched, behind only Drew Smyly and teammate Tyler Matzek.

**Sean Newcomb • LHP • 6-5 • 255 • 27 yrs • #15**

**Saves/Opp:** 1/1     **Holds:** 0     **1st Batter/Retired:** 3/2     **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- His 24.30 K/9 rate this season is the second highest in the majors, trails only Aroldis Chapman (27.00 K/9)...Nine of the 10 outs he has recorded in 2021 have been strikeouts (3.1 IP).
- Logged his second career save after striking out the side on April 7 at Washington.
- Enters his fifth major league season after posting a 1.29 ERA in one start and five relief appearances during Spring Training.
- In 2020 made four starts for Atlanta and went 0-2 with a 11.20 ERA (17 ER/13.2 IP). Did not allow a run in two spring appearances... Newcomb averaged 3.1 innings pitched per game and did not pitch more than 4.2 innings in any of his starts.

**Will Smith • LHP • 6-5 • 255 • 31 yrs • #51**

- Makes his first Atlanta Opening Day roster as he enters his second season with the Braves...Opened the 2020 season on the injured list.
- Was 1-0 with a 1.59 ERA (5.2 IP) in six Spring Training relief appearances.
- Made his Braves debut on 8/9/20 at Philadelphia after missing 13 games on the COVID-related injured list to open the season.
- Had a 6.23 ERA (6 ER/8.2 IP) in his first nine games of the season and a 2.45 ERA (2 ER/7.1 IP) over his last nine games... Seven of his eight runs allowed came by way of a solo home run...Seven of the 11 total hits he allowed were homers.

**Josh Tomlin • RHP • 6-1 • 190 • 36 yrs • #32**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0     **Holds:** 1     **1st Batter/Retired:** 5/5     **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 3/3

- Went 1-0 with a 1.80 ERA in four Spring Training appearances as he enters his 12th major league season.
- In 2020 he made five starts and appeared in 16 games and finished with a record of 2-2 with a 4.66 ERA...Had a 2.95 ERA (6 ER/18.1 IP) with 24 strikeouts and four walks in 12 relief appearances.
- Has made 251 appearances and started in 150 games in his 11-year major-league career...Among all active pitchers in the majors with at least 500.0 innings pitched, ranks first with just 1.31 walks per 9.0 innings in his career since making his debut in 2010...In 1017.2 innings has walked 148 batters.

**Jacob Webb • RHP • 6-2 • 210 • 27 yrs • #71**
