## STAY INFORMED

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RAY REPORT-The Rays open a six-game, six-day Midwest road trip through Chicago (3 to play) and Milwaukee ( 3 to play) tonight on the South Side...the Rays are 0-2-1 in their their last four games and are 5-7 since April 13 on the heels of a 5-1 run
ir la lar
The Rays are .500 or better through 26 games for the sixth consecutive season and 12th time in club history...they were last under. 500 through 27 games in 2021 (13-14). Zach Eflin carries a 12.1 scoreless inning streak into tonight's outing...he is looking to become the fourth Ray to post three consecutive scoreless starts of $6.0+$ IP including the first since Ryan Yarbrough in 2019 (July 20-Aug. 17).
According to Elias, this marks the second time the Rays have faced an opponent that entered the series with a. 120 or worse winning percentage at least 25 games into a season, joining a May 2-4, 2003 bout with the Tigers, who were 3-23 (.115). The Rays are seeking their second series-opening victory, joining April 12 vs. San Francisco...they are 0-3 in road series openers, with their last such victory coming on Sept. 26, 2023 at Fenway Park (9-7)...their 1-7 mark in series-opening games is tied with the Diamondbacks for third worst in the majors, ahead of only the Marlins and White Sox (both 0-8).
Tampa Bay has not scored first in its last four games dating back to April 21 at NYY, its longest streak of the season.
Kevin Cash (752) is just three victories shy of surpassing Joe Maddon (754) as the Rays all-time managerial wins leader
RECENT TRANSACTIONS-Earlier today, the Rays recalled RHP Manuel Rodríguez from Triple-A Durham and placed LHP Colin Poche (mid back tightness) on the 15-day IL (retro April 24)...Rodríguez, 27, last pitched in the majors in 2022 with the Cubs, splitting
last season between Triple-A Iowa and Durham after the Rays acquired him in an Aug. 1 last seas

The Rays now have 12 players on the injured list...entering the day, only the Red Sox (13) had more active IL placements (Spotrac).
SPLIT THE DIFFERENCE-The Rays - 24 run differential ranks 12th in the AL/24th in the majors...it signals their worst mark through 26 games since 2007 ( -44 )...their six defeats by $6+$ runs, which are second most in the majors behind the White Sox (7), have contributed to that mark...the Rays suffered all six losses within their first 24 games, by multiple runs at some point in seven of 10 and eight of their last 12 games...on the season, they are 11-0 in games in which they held a multi-run lead at any point.

Eight of the Rays last nine games have been decided by two runs or fewer...they
are 9-4 in such contests on the season, including 3-4 in their last seven after winning six straight to open the campaign.
The Rays have yet to outscore an opponent over the course of a series...they came closest in Colorado from April 5-7, when both clubs pushed across 18 runs.

ON THE OFFENSIVE-Rays hitters rank fifth in the AL in batting average (.244) and sit second in singles (156) behind the Astros (163)...they lead the AL in infield singles (1st, 35) while ranking third in opposite-field hits (56) behind the Yankees (60) and Red Sox (58).. however, their .362 SLG ranks 11th in the AL and their 57 extra-base hits are 13th, more than only the Mariners (55) and White Sox (50)...the 57 XBH are the fewest through the
first 26 games of a season in franchise history-the 2004 squad (58) held the previous mark st 26 games of a season in franchise history -the 2004 squad (58) held the previous mark.

Tampa Bay hitters have recorded MLB's third-lowest pull rate at 34.0 pct., ahead of the Athletics ( $33.9 \%$ ) and Blue Jays ( $32.9 \%$ ) and down from 38.8 pct. in 2023 . The Rays have been held to four runs or fewer in 17 of their 26 games (65.4\%), The Rays have been hete to four rens in in these contest and $8-1$ when plating $5+$ runs...for comparison, they going $5-12$ in those contests and 8-1 when plating 5+ runs...for
scored four or fewer times in 76 of $162(46.9 \%)$ games in 2023.

GONE FISHIN'-Rays hitters own the highest chase rate in the AL (32.0\%), better than only the Marlins (34.5\%) and Rockies (32.4\%) in all of MLB...however, their 53 hits on pitches out of the zone are second most in baseball behind the Astros (55)...part of Statcast's strike zone, fifth most in the majors...Isaac Paredes (15), Yandy Díaz (14) and José Caballero (13) have been affected the most by such pitches-all three have posted career highs in chase rate.
PEN PALS-The Rays bullpen has turned in a 2.41 ERA (37.1IP, 10ER) over the club's last nine games since April 16, 10th lowest in the majors over that span...they entered that stretch with the third-worst bullpen ERA in MLB (5.11)...on the season, Rays relievers
have yielded at least one run in 22 of 26 games.

HOMER (UN)HAPPY-Rays pitching has allowed 35 HR , second most in the majors behind the White Sox (38)...the Rays are 6-12 when allowing at least 1 HR and 7-1 when holding the opposition homerless...on the season, 54 of the 127 (42.5\%) runs allowed by Rays pitching have come off the 35 HR...they have yielded 16 game-tying/go-ahead HR, matching the D -backs and Rangers for most in the majors.

Despite tying for the third fewest HR in the AL on the season (22), the Rays have homered in three straight games for the first time since a six-game streak to open Ra4...this comes on the heels of tallying 3 HR in their previous six games.

SUNSHINE IN THE WINDY CITY-The Rays and White Sox open a six-game season series tonight on the South Side, with all six games being played over the course of 13 days..the White Sox will visit Tropicana Field for a three-game set from May 6-8 in the middle of the Rays nine-game homestand...the Rays went 6-1 against the Sox in 2023, winning each of the first six matchups before a 12-9 defeat in the season series finale on April 30...in that loss, the Rays held a 9-5 lead entering the bottom of the 9 th frame before

The Rays have won four of their last five games at Guaranteed Rate Field since April 17, 2022...they have scored 9+ times in four of those contests, averaging 9.4 runs per game in that span.
Tampa Bay teed off for 19 HR in seven games against Chicago last season...its 2.71 homers per game against the White Sox were its most against any club.
Isaac Paredes has multiple hits in four straight games against the ChiSox, going
9 -for-19 (.474) with 4 2B, 1 HR and 7 RBI during the streak...Yandy Díaz is batting
.452 (19-for-42) during his 14-game on-base streak against Chicago.

White Sox Bench Coach Charlie Montoyo spent 22 seasons in the Rays organization, including
four on Kevin Cash's staff as third base coach (2015-17) and bench coach (2018), before departing to manage the Blue Jays in 2019. Chicago 1B/OF Coach Jason Bourgeois played for Chicago (6G 2008) and Tampa Bay ( $9 \mathrm{G}, 2013$ ) during his eight-year ML career. White Sox ML Coach Grady Sizemore appeared in 58 games with the Rays in 2015 to conclude his major league career
White Sox Assistant Hitting Coach Mike Tosas began his professional coaching career as a hitting coach
with Tampa Bay, worked with the Gulf Coast League Devil Rays in Gulf Coast League Devil Rays in from 1997-99.
Rays Senior Advisor, Player Development \& Baseball Operations Mitch Lukevics was a second-round selection by the White Sox in 1975 and worked in the Chicago farm
system as a pitching coach (1981 system as a pitching coach (1981-
85) and minor league administrator (1986-88).
Rays RHP Chris Devenski was drafted by the White Sox in 2011 before they dealt him to the Astros
in 2012 as a player to be named later in a trade that sent RHP Brett Myers to Chicago.
The late Al Lopez, one of four Tampa natives in the Hall of Fame is the second-longest-tenured skipper in White Sox history behind Jimmy Dykes (13), guiding the club for 11 seasons (1957-69).

TONIGHT'S START-Eflin makes his sixth start of the season, including his third on the road...has gone $9-6$ with a 2.98 ERA (151.0IP, 50ER) in 26 career April starts, his lowest mark in any month during his career.
LAST TIME OUT-He did not factor into the decision on April 20 at New York-AL...threw 6.0 scoreless innings, scattering three hits with no walks and a season-high six strikeouts.

After allowing 1st-inning singles to Juan Soto and Anthony
Rizzo, retired 15 straight batters before allowing a double to Soto in the 6th frame.
Struck out Aaron Judge in each of his three at-bats...has limited
Judge to a career 1-for-12 (.083) clip with eight strikeouts.
He has received one run of support or fewer in four of his five starts, including zero runs in two of his outings.

SOUTH SIDE SHOWDOWN-In three career appearances (2GS) opposite Chicago, Eflin is 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA (12.0IP, 3ER) and 11 strikeouts agains two walks...in two starts last season, went 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA (10.0IP, 3ER) Made his second career relief appearance on Aug. 2, 2019 at Chicago as a member of Philadelphia...he tossed 2.0 perfect innings with 2 SO In 10 career appearances (9GS) against the AL Central, he is $6-2$ with a 3.31 ERA (51.2IP, 19ER)...was $6-0$ with a 1.58 ERA (45.2IP, 8ER) in his first seven appearances vs. the division, but is 0-2 with a 16.50 ERA (6.0IP, 11ER) in two starts since.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING-Eflin has tossed 12.1 consecutive scoreless innings, beginning with his start on April 15 vs. Los Angeles-AL...over his last two starts, he struck out 11 batters against zero walks while limiting opponents to a .200 (9-for-45) average

He is looking to become the fourth Ray to post three consecutive scoreless starts of 6.0+ innings, including the first since Ryan Yarbrough in 2019 (July 20-Aug. 17).
He has walked two batters or fewer in each of his last 39 starts, the longest active streak in MLB, ahead of SEA George Kirby (36GS).
Eflin has allowed 1 HR or fewer in each of his last 12 starts on the road, the longest streak of his career...the last Rays starter to do so in 13 straight road starts was Drew Rasmussen (14GS: July 2, 2022-May 11, 2023).

ONE OF A. KIND-Eflin is the only pitcher in the majors this season to have thrown at least 25.0+ innings while allowing two walks or fewer...his 0.61 BB/9.0 IP ratio is the lowest in the majors, with the next closest being SEA George Kirby (1.07)

He has walked only two of his 119 batters he has faced, posting an MLB best 1.7 pct. walk rate.
Eflin's 13.00 SO/BB ratio leads the majors, outpacing PIT Jared Jones (9.75) and MIN Joe Ryan (9.50).

He is averaging 13.4 pitches per inning, the fewest in the majors, with the next closest being SEA Logan Gilbert (13.8).

IT'S A MARATHON-In innings 1-4, Eflin has posted a 1.80 ERA (20.0IP, 4ER) and held opponents to a .181/.192/.306 (13-for-72) slash line...from the 5th inning on, he owns a 7.71 ERA (9.1IP, 8ER) and .364/.391/.591 (16-for-44) opponent line... 18 of Eflin's 26 SO have come in the first four frames.

When his pitch count resides between 1-60, opponents are 14-for 86 (.163) against him...once he surpasses the 60-pitch mark, opposing hitters have gone 15 -for- 30 (.500).

QUALITY CONTROL-He has produced the lowest walk rate in the majors since 2020 at 4.0 pct. (min. 1,500BF), ahead of Zack Greinke (4.4\%.),

Posted a 68.9 pct. strike rate last season, second highest among qualified pitchers behind MIA Sandy Alcantara (70.1\%)
Eflin did not allow 10+ hits or 3+ walks in any of his 31 starts last season...per OptaStats, it marked the most such starts in a season without recording either of those statistics in the modern era (since 1900)...the next closest pitcher is CLE Josh Tomlin in 2016 (29).

His 7.75 SO/BB ratio in 2023 ranked second in the majors behind Kirby (9.05) and was the second-best mark by a Rays pitcher behind David Price's 2014 campaign (8.22).
