**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The 2022 National League Central Division Champion St. Louis Cardinals wrap up their home slate today with the finale of a three-game series vs. the Pittsburgh Pirates, the 3rd of six straight against their division-rivals ... With a win today, the Cards would record their 9th series sweep of the season, their 2nd of Pittsburgh (also May 20-22 at PNC Park), and their first three-game series sweep of the Buccos in St. Louis since Aug. 9-11, 2019.

**POSTCARDS:** St. Louis enters the National League playoffs as the #3 seed and will host the third NL Wild Card (#6 seed) in a best-of-three series next weekend at Busch Stadium from Oct. 7-9 ... The Cardinals join the Dodgers, Mets, and Braves as teams to qualify for the NL postseason.

**DIVISION DANDIES:** The 2022 Cardinals are NL Central Champions for the 13th time since three Division Play began in 1994, including five times in the last 10 seasons (2013, 2014, 2015, 2019, 2022) ... St. Louis has won 16 Division titles overall, with the first three coming in the NL East (1982, 1985, 1987).

**328: Adam Wainwright and Yadier Molina** make their 328th and final career regular season start as batterymates today, extending their all-time MLB record and creating distance between them and the Detroit Tigers duo of **Mickey Lolich** and **Bill Freehan** (324), a record that stood for nearly 50 seasons ... Yadi and Waino enter today's start ranking first all-time in team wins in starts (213), 2nd in strikeouts in overall appearances (1,818), 4th in innings in overall appearances (2,150.1), and 5th in appearances (371) since 1961. - *Elias*

**A PAIR BEYOND COMPARE:** **Yadier Molina** and **Adam Wainwright** have attained the majority of Busch Stadium III records since it opened in 2006:

- Today marks the duo's 171st start at Busch Stadium III (211th overall appearance), most by any starting battery at a single venue in MLB history. - *Elias*
- Molina holds the all-time Busch III record in regular season games played, at-bats, plate appearances, hits, doubles, RBI, total bases, and singles.
- Molina is one of only three primary catchers in MLB history to hold their home stadium's all-time hits record: **Jim Sundberg** (582 at Arlington Stadium) and **Buster Posey** (705 at Oracle Park).
- Yadi is one of 73 players in MLB history with 1,000+ hits at a stadium, becoming the 3rd Cardinal all-time (**Ozzie Smith** and **Lou Brock** at Busch Stadium II) and only the 2nd primary catcher in MLB history (**Yogi Berra** at Original Yankee Stadium) to do so.
- Wainwright is the all-time Busch III leader in wins, strikeouts, appearances, starts, and innings pitched.
- In MLB history, Waino is one of 27 pitchers with 1,000+ strikeouts at a stadium; one of 35 pitchers with 1,000+ wins at a stadium, and one of 22 pitchers to hold an MLB stadium's all-time record for both appearances and starts.

**AHOY, MATEY!:** Due to the offseason lockout, the season-opening three-game series at PNC Park (Mar. 31-Apr. 3) was moved to the end of the year, causing the Cards and Bucs to face off in six straight games to end the regular season:

- The last time the Cardinals and Pirates faced each other in six consecutive games was July 15-18, 1943 at Forbes Field - *Elias*.
- The last time St. Louis ended its regular season by playing the same opponent in six or more games was 1914, when the Cardinals finished with six straight at home vs. the Cubs from Oct. 2-5, 1914 at Robison Field - *Elias*

**BLOW UP THE DECK! SINK THE SHIP!:** St. Louis has won the season series over Pittsburgh for nine consecutive seasons (2014-22) and 20 times in the last 23 years since 2000 (excluding 2008, 2012, 2013).

**BURIED TREASURE:** St. Louis owns MLB's best overall win percentage against the Pirates (.599, 106-71) dating back to 2013 when the two teams squared off in the Division Series ... The Cards have reached 12 or more wins over the Buccos in the season series for the 2nd consecutive season (2021-22), while this season's .800 win pct (12-3) over Pittsburgh represents the 3rd-best between division rivals, trailing the Phillies-Nats (.833, 15-3) and Blue Jays-Red Sox (.833, 15-3).

**FABULOUS FRESHMAN:** **Oliver Marmol's** 92 wins tie **Bob O'Farrell** (1927), **Gabby Street** (1930), and **Ray Blades** (1939) for the 5th-most victories in the first full season among Cardinals first-year managers with four games to go ... **Eddie Dyer** (98), who piloted the 1946 Cardinals to a World Series title, holds the Cardinals record.

**BASEBALL AT BUSCH:** Winners of 26 of their last 33 at Busch Stadium (July 15-present), the Cardinals rank 4th in MLB in home wins (53-27) and 5th in home win pct. (.663) ... Only two other Cards teams have won 54+ games in Busch III history: 2015 (55-26) and 2013 (54-27).

**FAN-TASTIC:** St. Louis will record its 29th sellout with today's game, most since 37 in 2015 ... The Cardinals have surpassed the 3 million mark in attendance for the 17th consecutive season unaffected by limited capacity (2004-19, '22) and the 24th time overall ... The Cardinals 40,923 per game average ranks 2nd to the Dodgers in MLB.

#### PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

**Oliver Marmol** was originally selected by Pittsburgh in the 31st Rd. of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

**Yadier Molina** (June 3, 2004 at PNC Park) and **Andre Pallante** (April 10, 2022 at Busch) made MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

**Turner Ward** played parts of three seasons (1997-99) with Pittsburgh...managed two seasons in the Pirates minor league organization for the 2006 GCL Pirates and 2007 State College Spikes (A).

**Andrew Knizner's** uncle, **Matt Knizner**, was a quarterback at Penn State Univ. and was on the 1986 National Championship Nittany Lion squad.

**José Quintana** signed with Pittsburgh before the season, while **Chris Stratton** pitched parts of four seasons with the Pirates (2019-22)...the duo was traded to St. Louis for **Malcom Nunez** and **Johan Oviedo** (Aug. 2, 2022).

**Miles Mikolas** spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh for **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers for **Chris McGuinness** (Dec. 30, 2013).

**Mike Maddux** signed with Pittsburgh in April 1995 and pitched in eight games before released in May.

**Corey Dickerson** played parts of two seasons in Pittsburgh (2018-19) ... Won a 2018 Rawlings Gold Glove award in left field.

**Derek Shelton** was born in Carbondale, Ill... caught four seasons (1989-92) at Southern Illinois University.

**Johan Oviedo** signed as an international free agent with the Cardinals on July 2, 2016...pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2020-22).

**José Godoy** signed with St. Louis as an international free agent (July 2, 2011) and played parts of eight minor league seasons with the Cardinals (2012-19).

- Makes his 32nd start of the season & 457th career appearance (390th career start) in his final regular season outing.
- He and Yadier Molina make their 328th career start as batterymates today. They established a new MLB career record on Sept. 14 by passing the 324 career starts mark set by **Mickey Lolich** and **Bill Freehan** of the Detroit Tigers (1963-75) nearly 50 seasons ago.
- His 389 career starts rank 3rd all-time Cardinals: **Bob Gibson** (482) & **Bob Forsch** (401).
- Waino's 389 career starts all with St. Louis rank 15th-most exclusively with one organization in MLB history, while Gibson (482) ranks 6th. **Walter Johnson** of the Washington Senators leads at 666.
- Leads MLB pitchers in called strikes (643), percentage of total pitches called for strikes (21.1), and percentage of total pitches taken by opposing hitters (56.4), and ranks T5th in MLB in strikeouts looking (60).
- Is 7-3 with a 2.61 ERA (107.0 IP/31 ER) in 17 home starts this season. Is 4-8, 4.73 ERA (80.0/42 ER) in 14 road starts. He ranks 10th in the NL in home ERA & T9th in wins.
- Has allowed just one HR (**Ha-Seong Kim**- 9/20 at SD) in last eight starts, covering 43.2 IP, and has allowed just 4 HR's in 76.0 IP since the All-Star break.
- Turned 41 on Aug. 30. At age 41.033, is the 4th-oldest active MLB player behind **Albert Pujols** (42.259), **Rich Hill** (42.205), and **Nelson Cruz** (42.093).
- Today is Wainwright's 38th start since turning 40, 3rd-most all-time in franchise history behind **Grover Cleveland "Pete" Alexander** (80) and **Jesse Haines** (39).
- Worked 5.0+ IP in 27 of his 31 starts this season. Exceptions were twice at Milwaukee: 4.1 IP on 4/14 & 4.2 on 6/22; 4.0 IP vs. Yankees (8/7); 3.0 IP at Dodgers (9/25).
- Has recorded 10 different seasons of 25+ starts, tied with **Bob Forsch** for 2nd in franchise history (**Bob Gibson**, 13). **Zack Greinke** (14), **Justin Verlander** (13), **Max Scherzer** (12) and **Clayton Kershaw** (10) have as many or more among active pitchers.

BUSCH STADIUM III (2006-present)

- Has 107 career wins at Busch Stadium III, tying **Dazzy Vance** (Ebbets Field) for 22nd-most wins at a single stadium. .
- Waino's 203 career starts at Busch III, T21st-most career starts at a single venue in MLB history and most among active pitchers. **Tom Seaver** (203 at Shea Stadium) also ranks 21st, while **Bob Forsch** (207 starts at Busch II) ranks 18th.
- Is one of 22 pitchers in MLB history to hold a stadium's record for both appearances (234) and starts (203). Joins **Bob Forsch** (233 app/207 GS at Busch II) as Cardinals on that list.

- Making his 44th career start (50th appearance) and third start this season vs. PIT.
- He's won 10 consecutive games vs. the Pirates, last losing on 4/3/16. He's won 9 consecutive decisions over the Bucs at Busch Stadium, not losing at home since 6/29/12.
- Had his 38.0 inning scoreless streak against the Pirates ended in the 7th inn. of 5/20/22 start at PNC Park when Michael Chavis hit solo HR. His 38.0 inning scoreless streak vs. the Pirates dated to June 26, 2021, and ranks as the longest in the Expansion Era vs. Pittsburgh (since 1961), besting Phil Niekro and Jack Baldschun, both at 36.0 IP. *Elias Sports Bureau*
- Earned his 100th career win at Busch Stadium (9-0) on Opening Day (4/7/22) firing 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with no walks and six strikeouts.
- He's the only Cardinal to have ever won 10-straight starts vs. PIT. Chris Carpenter did have 10 consecutive winning decisions against the Pirates from 8/20/04-8/7/09.
