TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS:

- Signed LHP Wade Miley to a 1-year Major League contract.
- Placed on the 15-day injured list RHP Hunter Greene (right groin strain).
- Transferred to the 60-day IL RHP Rhett Lowder (right forearm strain & left oblique strain).

TODAY'S GAME:

- Is Game 3 (1-1) of a 3-game series vs Bob Uecker's Brewers and the third game (1-1) of a 7-day, 6-game homestand that includes an upcoming 3-game series vs the Diamondbacks.
- Following Sun's game vs AZ, the Reds will embark on a 7-day, 6-game road trip at Cle (6/9-6/11) and Det (6/13-6/15).
- The Redlegs are coming off a 3-3 road trip at KC (2-1) and Chc (1-2).

SERIES NOTES: The **Brewers** have won each of the last 11 series, 12 of the last 13 series, and 15 of the last 17 series vs Cin dating back to 2021.

- Since 7/16/21, Mil has won 41 of 57 meetings against Cin, including 23 of 32 contests against the Reds since the beginning of the 2023 season.
- The Reds have lost 30 of 41 games vs Mil at GABP since 9/24/19.

NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM: The Reds have <u>not been swept</u> in any of their first 20 series this season, including this one (6-12-1).

 It marks Cin's longest streak of consecutive series without being swept to begin a season since <u>2012</u>, when it went 22 straight series before getting broomed in a 3-game set from 6/18-6/20 at Cle.

A WIN AFTER 6: Last night's 4-2 win vs Mil marked the Reds' third win this year when tied after 6 innings (also: 4/25 at Col & 4/7 at SF).

WREAKING HAVOC IN THE FIRST: The Reds have scored at least 1 run in the first inning 21 times this season, including Mon vs **Mil** (2r, 4h).

- The Reds rank third in the majors with 50 runs in the 1st inning (LAD 54r, Wsh 51r)...this of course includes the 10 runs Cin posted in the opening frame on 5/10 at Hou.
- Cin has outscored opponents 50-22 in the first inning and is slashing .293/.376/.447 with 7 home runs.
- Reds pitchers have allowed runs (5r total) in the first inning 4 times over their last 21 games...overall, Cin is holding opponents to a .189/.284/.336 slash line in the opening frame this season.

ELLY GETS 50: SS Elly De La Cruz in Sun's 7-3 loss at **Chc** belted his 50th career home run...at 23 years, 141 days he became the fifth-youngest Red to reach that milestone.

- Over his last 14 games (since 5/19), the switch-hitting SS is slashing .438/.526/.938 with 4 HR and 12 RBI from the left side.
- 8 of his 12 HR this season have either tied the game or put Cin ahead.
- Is on pace for 31 HR and 44 SB...would become the fourth player in franchise history to join the 30 HR / 30 SB club.

TJ MAX: OF TJ FriedI went 1-for-4 in yesterday's 4-2 win vs Mil...has hit safely in 12 of his last 14g (.414/.469/.569).

- Had multiple hits in 7 straight games from 5/23-5/30 (15-for-30) and in 9 of 10 games from 5/19-5/30 (20-for-43, 465, 1hr, 3 2B, 1 3B, 10r).
- His 7-game multi-hit streak was the longest by a Red since Jonathan India's 8-game run in 2024 (6/22-6/29).
- Began the season with 6 hits over his first 29 at-bats (.207/.258/.207)...
 since then is slashing .318/.403/.456.
- Among left-handed batters vs right-handed pitchers, his 53 hits is 1 off the Major League pace (3 others: 54)...slashing .329/.409/.478 vs RHP.

HOME (RUNS) AWAY FROM HOME: The Redlegs are averaging 4.66 runs per game on the <u>road</u> compared to 4.33 runs per game here in **Cincinnati...** overall during the **Great American Ball Park** era (since 2003), the team has averaged 4.60 runs per game at **GABP** and 4.25 runs per game on the road.

- 5 times in the history of **GABP** has Cin averaged more runs per game on the road than at home (2023, 2013, 2009, 2004, 2003).
- Cin has homered 31 times in 30 games this year at home compared to 33 times in 32 road games.
- 2004 marks the only season during the GABP era in which the Reds hit
 more home runs on the road (102) than at home (92).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the 6-2 win on Fri (5/30) vs Chc (7.0ip, 1h, 0r, 1bb, 8k, 93TP).

- · His 7.0 innings were a season-high.
- Marked the second time in his career that he pitched at least 7.0 scoreless innings and allowed just 1 hit (also: 7/20/23 vs SF, 8ip. 1h).
- Was his 10th career scoreless outing (fourth this season).
- Finished the month of May with a 0.55 ERA, third-lowest ERA by a Reds pitcher (min. 30ip) in a calendar month since earned runs became an official stat in 1912.

MAY 24: Earned the 6-4 win on 5/24 vs Chc (5.2ip, 6h, 1r/1er, 2bb, 2k, 1hr, 83TP).

- RF Kyle Tucker's single in the 1st inning snapped Abbott's streak of starts without allowing a 1st inning hit at 9 (dating back to 8/12/24 vs StL)...had last allowed a 1st inning hit in Mia's 6-4 win on 8/7/24 at loanDepotPark (Derek Hill grand slam)...the streak matched RHP Jim Maloney 9/17/68-4/30/69) for the longest such-run by a Reds pitcher in the expansion era (since 1961).
- Allowed 3rd-inning homer to 1b Justin Turner to snap his homerless streak at 23.2 innings...went 100 batters without giving up a round-tripper.

MAY 18: Earned the 3-0 win on 5/18 vs Cle (5.0ip, 4h, 0r, 3bb, 5k, 1hb, 96TP).

- Did not issue a base-on-balls to any of his previous 45 batters until he gave up back-to-back walks to Carlos Santana and Gabriel Arias in the 1st inning...streak started on 5/1 vs StL (walk to Jordan to lead off the 4th inning).
- 28 of his 96 pitches were thrown in the 1st inning.
- It was his ninth career scoreless start of at least 5.0 innings, third-most by a Cin pitcher through their first 53 starts since 1901, fewer than only Gary Nolan (11g, 1967-68) and Ewell Blackwell (11g, 1946-47).

MAY 13: Did not factor in the decision in the 5-1, 10-inning loss on 5/13 vs CWS (6.0ip, 4h, 1r/1er, 0bb, 7k, 96TP).

- Gave up Edgar Quero's 4th inning RBI-single to end his streak of having not allowed an ER in 13.1 straight innings.
- For the second consecutive start did not walk a batter.
- Was his second quality start of the season, his first since 4/18 at Bal...was his 20th career quality start.

IN HIS MAY ERA: His 0.55 ERA in May was the lowest among qualified Major League pitchers...is his lowest ERA in a month since pitching to a 1.21 mark in June 2023 (5gs, 4qs, 29.2ip, 4er, 16h, 12bb, 30k, 3hr).

- Is the first Reds pitcher to post a 0.55 ERA over a 6-start, single-season span (min. 30ip) since RHP Hunter Greene's 0.48 ERA last year from 6/30-8/3.
- Is the first Reds starting pitcher to open a season with a 1.55 ERA or lower over his 9 starts since RHP Johnny Cueto pitched to a 1.25 ERA over his first 9 starts in 2014.

HE EARNED IT: His 3.42 ERA (295ip, 116r/112er) through his first 55 career starts is the lowest by a Reds starting pitcher since RHP Mario Soto (3.42, 1977-82).

LIMITING HARD CONTACT: Among all pitchers with at least 45.0 innings, his hard-hit percentage of .304 is the best in the majors...hard-hit percentage measures the percentage of pitches put in play at an exit velocity over 95 mph.

EASY AS 1-2-3: Is holding top of the order batters (1, 2, 3) to a .179/.257/.254 slash line (12-for-67, 1hr, 9 hard-hit pitches).

PERSONAL: Graduated from Halifax County High School (South Boston, VA), the same school attended by All Elite Wrestling champion "**Hangman**" **Adam Page** and Major League pitcher **Jeremy Jeffress...**was named 2017 Gatorade Virginia Player of the Year...was a 4-year member of the Halifax swim team...at the University of Virginia became only the second pitcher in school history to record at least 300 strikeouts.
