## New York Mets (7-8)

Fourth Place, NL East, 2.0 GB

**METSCELLANEOUS:** The Mets fell to the A's, 11-4, yesterday... The Mets are in a stretch of nine straight games (1-4)...New York concludes a six-game homestand (1-4) against Arizona (1-2) and the A's (0-2)...Following this series, the Mets hit the road for their second trip of the season...The team will head out for a six-game seven-game trip against the Dodgers (three games) and the Cubs (three games).

**ROSTER MOVES:** Prior to today's game, the Mets announce the following roster moves - RHP Joey Gerber has been recalled from Triple-A Syracuse...RHP Luis Garcia has been designated for assignment.

**LET'S NOT GO STREAKING:** The Mets are on a season-long four-game losing streak...The Mets have posted a 7.25 ERA (29 ER/36.0 IP) int hat span with 14 walks and 32 strikeouts...As a team, they are batting .221/.260/.324...They have been outscored 29-6 in the current streak.

**BEAT THE SWEEP:** The Mets are seeking to avoid their first sweep of the season...The Mets have never been swept by the Athletics.

**ATTABOY ALVAREZ:** Yesterday, Francisco Alvarez Launched a solo home run to center field in the sixth, his fourth home run of the season...He joins Gary Carter (6, 1988), Todd Hundley (1995, 7, 1996), Mike Piazza (2001, 5, 2002) and John Buck (6, 2013) as the only Mets catchers with four or more home runs through the team's first 15 games of a season...In the NL, is tied for third in home runs, ranks fifth among qualifiers in SLG (.625) and seventh in OPS (1.0.16).

**THEY'RE OUT OF OUR LEAGUE:** The Mets begin their Interleague schedule this series...They are 0-2 against the AL in 2026...New York went 24-24 against the American League in 2025...Since Interleague Play began in 1997, the Mets are 302-302 against the American League.

**BO KNOWS:** Over the last 10 games, Bo Bichette is batting .333 (14-42) with five runs, two doubles, one home run, six RBI, four walks and an .844 OPS...He has safely hit in nine of those contests... This compares to a .091 (2-22) mark over his first five games of the season.

**WHAT ABOUT BOB:** Yesterday, Luis Robert Jr. extended his on-base streak to 10 games with a single in the first...In the NL, ranks third among qualifiers in OBP (.458) and tied for fourth in walks...He recorded a career-high 40 walks in 110 games last season.

**HOME, SWEET HOME:** The Mets are in the midst of their second homestand of the season...The team is 3-5 in New York this year... The team has posted a 4.97 ERA (42 ER/76.0 IP) at Citi Field in 2026.

**WHAT A RELIEF:** Craig Kimbrel struck out two over a scoreless inning in his Mets and 2026 debut...Has 1284 career strikeouts, tied with Kenley Jansen for the fourth-most in Major League history by a relief pitcher...Has now made an appearance for 10 Major League clubs.

**A'S-METS NOTES:** The Mets are hosting the A's for the first time since July August 13-15, 2024...The Mets have lost five of their last six to the Athletics in Queens and they are 6-7 against the Athletics all-time at Citi Field.

**THE HUASCAR GOES TO:** Threw a season-high 2.2 scoreless innings and struck out three...Has not allowed an earned run in 11 multi-inning appearances since 2025...Has yet to allow a run over 8.1 innings this season, the second-most innings without allowing a run in the majors by a relief pitcher (most: Antonio Senzatela 9.0 IP).

**D-FENSE:** The Mets (6) sixth in the Majors in Outs Above Average... They tied for fourth in the National League with a total of 9 Defensive Runs Saved according to The Fielding Bible.

**IN A PINCH:** The Mets have recorded an MLB leading eight RBI from their pinch-hitters this season...In 2025, the Mets recorded a total of nine RBI from their pinch-hitters...Overall this year, Mets pinch hitters are batting .400 (4-10) with two runs, one double, one home run and seven RBI...Their .400 average is the Major League lead.

**BROOKS AND DONE:** Brooks Raley has yet to allow a run through his first six appearances of the season (5.2 IP)...Since returning from "Tommy John" surgery on July 19, 2025, has pitched to a 2.01 ERA (7 ER/31.1 IP)...Has not allowed a home run over his last 52.2 innings pitched dating back to August 15, 2023, the third-longest active homerless streak in the Majors.

**WE REMEMBER:** The New York Mets announced that the club will wear a memorial "Davey" patch on the sleeve of their home and road uniforms during the 2026 season...Johnson passed away on September 5, 2025 at the age of 82...He finished his Mets career with the most managerial wins in franchise history (595) and the best winning percentage (.588)...In 1986, Johnson guided the team to a franchise-record 108 regular season victories and capped the year off with a dramatic World Championship...From 1984-1990, under his helm, the Mets averaged more than 95 wins.

**THIS DAY IN 1986:** The Mets fell to the Phillies, 9-8, in 14-innings on this day in 1986...The game was tied at 7-7 heading into the 14th until the Mets scored in the top of the frame...The Phillies scored twice in the bottom half to earn the victory...Sid Fernandez mad the start and allowed four runs in 4.1 innings...Ray Knight doubled and homered in the loss...This season, the Mets will celebrate the 40th anniversary of the 1986 World Series Champions New York Mets...The Mets will also host a 1986 World Series Reunion and Celebration to celebrate the 1986 World Champion Mets on Saturday, August 1 prior to the 4:10 p.m. game against the Miami Marlins...Additional information regarding programming for the 1986 World Series Reunion and Celebration will be available at a later date at Mets.com/1986.

- Fired 2.2 scoreless innings in relief on April 11 vs. the Athletics (2.2 IP, 2 H, 3 K)...Marked his 10th scoreless appearance of at least 2.0 innings since the beginning of last season...Is tied for the seventh-most such games among NL relievers during that span.
- Earned his first win of the season after tossing 1.1 scoreless innings on April 5 at San Francisco (1.1 IP)...Since the start of last year, he has recorded four or more outs without allowing an earned run in 17 relief appearances, which is the eighth-most appearances among NL relievers.
- Since joining the Mets in 2024, he has made 37 appearances (two starts) at Citi Field...In those contests, he is 3-1 with eight holds, a 3.07 ERA (15 ER/44.0 IP) and 37 strikeouts.
- Dating back to September 20, 2025, he hasn't allowed an earned run in each of his last 11 appearances (14.2 IP).
- Made his third career Opening Day roster and his second consecutive with the Mets.
- Pitched in three games for the Dominican Republic in the World Baseball Classic...He tossed 4.0 scoreless innings and struck out seven of the 13 batters he faced.
- Appeared in three Grapefruit League games and he threw 3.0 scoreless innings...He struck out five of the 11 batters he faced during the spring.
- Last season, he made a career-high 52 appearances and finished with a 5-2 record, two saves, 12 holds, 57 strikeouts, and a 3.57 ERA (25 ER/63.0 IP).
- In 2025, he allowed just five earned runs over 25 combined appearances in March, April, and May (1.34 ERA)...His ERA through his first 25 games of the season is the 11th-best in franchise history.
