- GAME #51 RECAP:** The Phillies defeated the Athletics, 9-6, in an extra-innings slugfest at Sutter Health Park ... Starter Christopher Sánchez went 4.2 IP and allowed 7 hits, 2 earned runs and 3 walks to 6 strikeouts ... Trailing by a run with 1 out in the top of the 9th, Max Kepler hit a game-tying home-run to help send the game to extras ... Orion Kerkering got out of a bases loaded jam with no outs in the 10th with help from an outfield assist from Brandon Marsh ... After tacking on 3 runs in the 11th, Max Lazar earned the first save of his career to close it out.
- GONE STREAKING:** The Phillies extended their winning streak to a season-best 9 games last night ... It is the team's longest winning streak since they won 9 straight from June 1-11, 2022 ... **With a win today, the Phillies would have their first 10-game winning streak since winning 11 in-a-row from Sept. 12-24, 2010 ... Per Elias, there has been 13 single season winning streaks of 10 games or more in franchise history ... This 9-game winning streak is now tied with the STL for the 2nd-longest streak in the majors this year and trails only MIN (13 games) ... It is now for the longest winning streak under manager Rob Thomson, surpassing an 8-game streak that was part of that 9-game streak after he took over the reigns on June 3, 2022 ... Over this streak, the Phillies starting rotation has a 2.00 ERA (12 ER, 54.0 IP) with 60 SO to 15 BB and the offense has slashed .280/.347/.460 (.807 OPS) in 363 PA with 32 XBH.**
- POWER VS POWER:** Max Kepler's home run came against a 101.4 mph fastball from Mason Miller in the 9th inning last night with a matching exit velocity of 101.4 mph ... It was the fastest pitch to ever be hit for a home run by a Phillie in the Statcast Era (since 2015), with the previous fastest being a home run by Bryce Harper against an Edwin Soto fastball of 99.9 mph on April 13, 2022 ... It was the 12th time in the Statcast Era that a Phillie homered off a pitch of 99.0 mph or faster ... Kepler's homer was also the first time in the Statcast Era in which the exit velocity and pitch velocity were both faster than 100 mph and matched exactly on a home run.
- ON A HEATER:** The Phils entered play on April 26 with a .500 record at 13-13 – since then, they are 21-5 with an MLB-best .807 winning percentage – this marks Philadelphia's best 26-game stretch since another 21-5 run last April-May ... Only 28 days ago on April 26, the Phillies were 5.0 games back of NYM for 1st place in the NL East – however, they have made up 7.0 games since and enter play today with a 3.0 game lead in the division ... **The Phillies own the best record in baseball at 34-18/.654 (next: LAD, 32-20/.615).**
- ON THE WAY TO CAPE MAY:** This Monday on Memorial Day, the Phillies will spend an off day at home before opening a three-game set against the Braves at CBP on Tuesday ... This will mark the second consecutive summer holiday the Phils have been off ... Last year, the Phillies had off on Labor Day but played on July 4th and Memorial Day
- MUST BE THE TRAVEL SUITS:** Over their last 36 games on the road against American League West or National League West clubs (since 6/13/23), the Phillies are 25-12 (.675 win%) – this includes a 15-5 record in the state of California (.750 win %) ... For context, the rest of the National League East is 76-102 against AL/NL West teams on the road in this almost 2-year span with a .427 win % - further, the rest of the NL East is a combined 35-54 in the state of California with a .393 win% - the Phillies are the only NL East club with a winning record in California during this stretch (NYM 9-10, ATL 12-15, WSH 7-8 and MIA 7-16).
- SERIESLY:** The Phillies have won 5 straight road series (2-1 at CHI, 3-0 at TB, 2-1 at CLE, 4-0 at COL, 2-0 at ATH) and 8 of their last 9 series overall (since 4/25), with the only series loss coming against STL, 5/12-14 at CBP (1-2) ... The Phillies are 12-4-1 in series play this year which marks the best series record in the National League
- ROADWORK:** The Phillies enter play today with the best road record in baseball at 17-10 and have won 13 of their last 14 road games (since 4/26), outscoring the opposition 85-43 (+42 run differential) ... **Per Elias, a win today would mark the first time the Phillies won 7 or more consecutive games on one road trip since they won 9 straight from May 11-20, 1984** ... Offensively, the Phillies have 144 hits in these 14 games including 47 extra-base hits while averaging 5.8 runs per game ... Philadelphia's starting pitchers have combined to post a 1.90 ERA (18 ER, 85.1 IP) while holding the 335 hitters they have faced to a .549 OPS.
- ARMS RACE:** The Phillies starting staff has a 26.6% SO rate this year which is top among all rotations and 1.1% clear of NYY who ranks 2nd with a 25.5% SO rate ... The rotation ranks 8th in MLB with a 7.3% BB rate and their 19.3% difference from SO to BB rate is the highest of any starting staff in MLB (next: DET, 17.4%) ... Philadelphia's starters have gone at least 7.0 innings in 11 starts (most in MLB), 6.0 innings in 30 starts (most in MLB) and 5.0 innings in 45 starts (T-1st in MLB) ... As a result, Philadelphia's bullpen has had to cover 170.2 innings, which is the 4th-fewest of any relief corps in baseball (LAD's bullpen has thrown the most with 227.2 IP) ... The Phillies rotation has allowed 2 ER or fewer in 23 of their last 29 starts (since 4/22), 27 of their last 34 (since 4/17) and 37 of their 52 total games this year ... The Phillies starting rotation leads Major League Baseball in fWAR at 7.1 (next: KC, 6.1/next NL club: CIN, 5.4).
- LOVE LOOGYS:** With 158 plate appearances, the Phillies **left-handed hitters** have faced more **left-handed relievers** than any team in baseball this year (next: DET, 149 PA) ... In those 158 PA, Philadelphia's LHH are slashing .276/.376/.545 with a .921 OPS (league average for LHH against left-handed relievers is .230/.306/.360 with a .666 OPS) ... **Kyle Schwarber** (45 PA) is 2nd in MLB in plate appearances by a LHH against left-handed relievers (behind BOS' Jarren Duran) and **Bryce Harper** (43 PA) trails only Schwarber, Duran an BOS' Rafael Devers ... **Schwarber is slashing .314/.467/.914 with 7 home runs, a 1.381 OPS and more walks (8) than strikeouts (7) against lefty relievers and Harper is slashing .256/.326/.462 with 2 home runs and a .788 OPS** – for context, Duran is slashing .188/.204/.208 with a .412 OPS in his 49 plate appearances ... More on Schwarber: his current 1.381 OPS against left handed relievers would be the 2nd-highest of any LHH in the Divisional Era (since 1961), behind only **Barry Bonds** who posted a 1.752 OPS in 2002 (.420/.592/1.160) ... With another home run Tuesday night, Schwarber is now only 4 home runs away from Bonds who has the most home runs by a LHH against a LHR in the Divisional Era (11 in 2002) – Bonds and Ken Griffey Jr. (10 in 1994 and 1996) are the only 2 players to reach double digits.
- TAKE A BOW, THOMS:** With last night's win, Phillies manager **Rob Thomson** reached a career-best 81 games over .500 as manager (284-203) ... Since being named manager on June 3, 2022, Thomson (284 wins, .583 win %) has guided the Phillies to the 3rd-most wins and 3rd-best winning percentage in MLB behind only LAD (307 & .631) and ATL (294 & .607) ... His .581 career winning percentage ranks 1st in Phillies history, T-19th all time among MLB managers (min. 315 G) and 3rd among active managers, behind only Dave Roberts (.626) & Aaron Boone (.585).

- 5/17 vs PIT marked his 500th game in a Phillies uniform
- Drove in multiple runs in back-to-back games (5/14-16) for the second time this season (also, 4/6-8)
- Posted his third 3-hit game of the season on 5/6 at TB (also: 4/8 at ATL & 4/12 at STL); ranked 4th on PHI with nine 3-hit games last season
- Clubbed his 8th career grand slam and 1st with the Phillies on 4/6 vs LAD (last, 9/1/21 G2 vs STL w/ CIN)
- Was 1 of 4 players in MLB last year to start all 162 games and was the first Phillie to do so since Jimmy Rollins in 2007
- Set the record for longest errorless streak by an NL position player (414 G) from 6/16/21-6/14/24
