NEW YORK METS (42-44) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (41-45)

July 5, 2024 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA - 6:40 EDT - GAME #87/HOME #43

RHP LUIS SEVERINO (5-2, 3.42 ERA) vs. RHP PAUL SKENES (4-0, 2.06 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...lost 3-2 in 10 innings in the deciding game of their three-game series against the Cardinals yesterday...Came back to beat the Cardinals 5-4 in 10 innings Wednesday night...Have gone 15-14, including 10-7 at home, in one-run games, which is tied for the third-most wins among all National League teams along with the Brewers (the Mets and Cardinals lead the NL with 16 wins apiece in one-run contests)...Have won 10 games in their last at-bat, matching their total from all of 2023 (the team won 13 games in the final at-bat of 2022)...Have gone 31-3 (.912 winning percentage) when outhitting their opponents this season...Have not been shut out in 31 straight games, which is tied for the seventh-longest active streak in MLB (the Cardinals have the longest active streak at 64 games)...Have recorded an extra base hit in a season-high 18 straight games.

ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER: Paul Skenes gets the start tonight in the opener of this four-game series against the Mets...Since making his big league debut on May 11, Skenes is tied for the fourth-most strikeouts (70) in all of MLB...Skenes also has the fifth-best ERA (2.06) in all of MLB since making his debut...The only four pitchers with a lower ERA beginning with the action on May 11 are Garrett Crochet (1.65), Hunter Brown (1.83), Corbin Burnes (1.94) and Max Fried (2.03).

ROOKIE SENSATIONS: Pittsburgh's rookie pitchers have the second-most strikeouts (245) in all of MLB, trailing only the Giants (267)...Paul Skenes (70) and Jared Jones (98) are the first pair of Pirates players aged 22 years or younger to both record at least 70 strikeouts in the same season since Jose DeLeon (118) and Lee Tunnell (95) in 1983...Special thanks to the Elias Sports Bureau.

START ME UP: Pittsburgh's starting rotation has produced the lowest ERA (3.47) in the National League and third-best in all of MLB since the beginning of last month...The only two teams whose starting rotations have produced a better ERA since June 1 are the Astros (3.32) and Mariners (3.34).

ON THE HOME FRONT: Pittsburgh's starting pitchers has yet to allow more than five earned runs in any home game this season, which is the second-longest streak by any MLB team to begin 2024 (Giants - 44)...It's Pittsburgh's longest such streak of home games to begin a season since 2013 (62)...Courtesy of StatsPerform.

A PIRATES LIFE FOR ME: Oneil Cruz recorded Pittsburgh's 47th stolen base of the season yesterday...The Pirates have been successful in 83.9 percent of their stolen base attempts this season...The only two teams in MLB with a higher success rate are the Mets (85.3 percent) and Brewers (84.5 percent).

NEW YORK STATE OF MIND: Pittsburgh's homestand continues tonight with the beginning of this four-game series against the Mets (the first four-game series between the two teams at PNC Park since 2018)...The Pirates were swept in three games earlier this year at Citi Field from April 15-17.

LIKE, TOTALLY: Bryan Reynolds has accounted for 17.0 percent of the team's total base hits since the beginning of June, which is the second-highest share in MLB (Bobby Witt Jr. - 17.6 percent). Reynolds also has hit for 19.4 percent of the team's total bases in that span, which is second-highest in MLB (Aaron Judge - 19.7 percent)...Reynolds comes into today ranked seventh among all National League players in total bases (162)...Courtesy of StatsPerform.

KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S MILESTONES: Andrew McCutchen's double on Wednesday moved him into sole possession of sixth place for the most career extra base hits (591) in Pirates history...He is now one extra base hit shy of tying Pie Traynor for the fifth-most in team history...McCutchen also ranks fifth on the team's all-time walks list (796) after passing Hall of Famer Ralph Kiner on Thursday...The only four Pirates with more career walks are Willie Stargell (937), Max Carey (919), Paul Waner (912) and Honus Wagner (877).

TODAY'S STARTER **RHP PAUL SKENES** **#30**

2024 RECORD: 4-0, 2.06 ERA

HEIGHT/WEIGHT: 6-6/235 **BATS/THROWS:** R/R
BORN: May 29, 2002 **SIGNED:** Thru 2024
AGE: 22 **HOW ACQUIRED:** Selected by the Pirates in the 1st round (No. 1) of the 2023 Draft.

STARTING OFF: The 22-year-old righthander is in his first Major League season with the Pirates...Began the season with Triple-A Indianapolis where he made seven starts, posting an 0.99 ERA (27.1ip/3er) with 45 strikeouts against just eight walks before being selected to the Major League roster on May 11...Was the No. 1 overall selection by the Pirates in the 2023 First-Year Player draft out of Louisiana State University.

PROSPECT SZN: Skenes entered the 2024 season rated as the No. Pirates 1 prospect by Baseball America, as well as the top pitching prospect in baseball and the No. 3 overall prospect in the sport by MLB.com...Entering the 2023 draft, he was rated by MLB.com as the No. 1 prospect in the 2023 class, as well as having the "Best Fastball", "Best Breaking Ball", third "Best Control" and fifth "Best Changeup" in the 2023 college class.

LEAGUE LEADERS: Since making his Major League debut on May 11, Skenes ranks among the NL leaders in strikeout-to-walk ratio (1st, 7.00), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (1st, 12.04), ERA (2nd, 2.06), strikeouts (T2nd, 70) WHIP (6th, 1.03), and opponents batting average (12th, .228).

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on June 29 at Atlanta, allowing just one run (a leadoff homer) on six hits with nine strikeouts against two walks in 6.0 innings pitched.

JUNE BOOM: Skenes posted a 2-0 record with a 1.78 ERA (6 ER in 30.1 IP), 40 strikeouts and five walks in five starts during the month of June...He ranked among the NL leaders last month in wins (T1st), ERA (3rd), strikeouts (T4th) and WHIP (15th).

RACKING UP PUNCHIES: Skenes has recorded seven or more strikeouts in six consecutive games dating back to the second game of a doubleheader in Detroit on May 29, which is one game shy of the franchise record set by Mitch Keller from April 27-May 31, 2023.

- In total, Skenes has recorded seven or more strikeouts in eight of his nine career outings, matching the Major League record for the most all-time by a pitcher to start a career (also: PIT Jose DeLeon in 1983; WSH Stephen Strasburg in 2010; NYY Masahiro Tanaka in 2014)...Should he do it again tonight, no player has ever had nine such outings in their first 10 career games.

FROM THE ODDITY DEPARTMENT: Skenes has allowed a leadoff home run in each of his last two outings on June 23 vs. Tampa Bay (Yandy Diaz) and June 29 at Atlanta (Jared Kelenic), but did not allow another run in either game...Per OptaSTATS, he's the first pitcher in Major League history to allow leadoff homers in back-to-back starts but pitch shutout baseball after each.

BODY OF WORK: Is making his 10th career start and appearance today...He has allowed three earned runs or fewer in each of his nine career outings, including two or fewer seven times and one or fewer six times (two scoreless outings).

- Skenes is the second pitcher in Pirates history to win at least four of his first nine career outings with 70+ strikeouts, joining Jose DeLeon in 1983 (6-2, 80 strikeouts).
- His 70 strikeouts through nine outings are the second-most by a Pirates pitcher to start a career, trailing only DeLeon's 80 in 1983.

THAT SEEMS GOOD: Skenes (70 K, 10 BB) is one of two pitchers to debut in the modern era (since 1901) with at least 70 strikeouts and 10 or fewer walks allowed through nine Major League appearances, joining NYY Masahiro Tanaka (73 K, 8 BB) in 2014.

GOING LOW: Skenes enters today with a 2.06 ERA, the fifth-lowest ERA by a Pirates pitcher through his first nine career starts, trailing Cy Blanton in 1934-35 (1.25), Burleigh Grimes from 1916-17 (1.85), Zach Duke in 2005 (1.87) and Jose DeLeon in 1983 (2.03).

ON DECK: The 27-year-old Falter will make his 17th start of the season tomorrow afternoon against the Mets (the 17 starts will be a new career-high)...Snapped his four-game losing streak after allowing one run in 5.0 innings in the team's 4-2 win against the Braves Sunday at Truist Park...His scoreless streak of 19.2 innings from 5/12-24 is the longest this season by a Pirate... Has received two runs of support or fewer when he has been in the game in 10 of his last 14 starts...Is 2-2 with a 3.38 ERA in seven starts this year at home...Will be making his fifth career start against the Mets (has a 2.79 ERA in his previous four starts)...His 2.23 ERA in May was the 12th-lowest among all pitchers in the National League.

HE'S A WINNER: Since being drafted first overall in the 2023 MLB Draft, Skenes has not lost a game as a professional (Major or Minor Leagues)...His last loss came on May 25, 2023 at Arkansas while pitching at LSU.

BRINGING THE HEAT: Skenes has thrown 70 pitches of 100.0+ mph this season, the most of any Major League starter in 2024...To date, Skenes has thrown two of the top-10 hardest thrown pitches by Major League starters this season and eight of the top 20...Prior to Angels flamethrower Ben Joyce making his first career start on June 16 and throwing nine pitches of 101.0+ mph, Skenes had previously thrown seven of the top-10 hardest thrown pitches by Major League starters this season.

- Skenes has thrown 10 pitches of 101.0+ mph, including the hardest thrown pitch by a Pirates starter since data started being tracked in 2008 (101.9 on May 11 vs. Chicago-NL)...His 10 pitches at that velocity are tops in the Majors among starters in that category, ahead of LAA Ben Joyce (9).
- His 70 pitches of 100.0-plus mph are already the most ever by a Pirates starter since 2008, topping Gerrit Cole's 33 he had during his five years with the Bucs.

MILITARY MAN: Spent the first two years of his collegiate career at the Air Force Academy, where he earned the 2022 John Olerud Award as the nation's best two-way player while both pitching and catching...He majored in Military Strategic Studies while at Air Force and was a member of Cadet Squadron 9.

- Has pledged to donate \$100 for every strikeout he records this season to the Gary Sinise Foundation to support our nation's defenders, veterans, first responders, their families, and those in need...ESPN's Pat McAfee has also pledged to match Paul's donation at the end of the season.
