## AROUND THE HORN

**VOTE D-BACKS:** Voting is open on the 2026 KONAMI eBaseball MLB All-Star Ballot for the MLB All-Star Game exclusively online and via mobile devices at MLB.com/vote, all 30 Club web sites, the MLB App and the MLB Ballpark App until the voting period for Phase 1 concludes at 12:00 p.m. ET on June 25.

**JAPANESE HERITAGE NIGHT:** Tonight, Japanese Heritage Night will feature an exclusive jersey, a parade, recognitions and performances.

**MEXICAN HERITAGE NIGHT:** Tomorrow, fans can enjoy a night of culture, music and dance with Mexican Heritage Night presented by Coors Light...fans who purchase the Special Event Ticket Pack will receive both a game ticket and a Mexican-inspired D-backs jersey...the evening will feature a ceremonial first pitch by acclaimed Phoenix chef and restaurateur Rene Andrade and national anthem performances by renowned mariachi duo Luis and Angel Garcia...pregame recognitions will honor ASU's Marco Serrato as well as Team Mexico.

**HERE'S THE STORY:** Since May 9, the D-backs are 9-2 in their last 11 home games...9 home wins are tied for second in the NL (also: Mets), behind the Brewers (10).

- Since May 9, the D-backs' 15 wins (15-8) are tied for second in MLB (also: Braves, Dodgers and White Sox), behind the Brewers (17).
- Since May 15, the D-backs are 12-3 in their last 15 games against NL West opponents (6-0 vs. Giants, 5-2 vs. Rockies, 1-1 vs. Dodgers).
- Since April 26, the D-backs' 13 wins and .813 win percentage vs. NL West foes are tops in the division.
- **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 18 straight home starts, hitting .367 (22-for-60)/1.131 OPS with 6 doubles, 4 homers, 13 RBI, 8 walks and 3 hit-by-pitches.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs lost 6-5 vs. Dodgers last night after trailing 4-0 after the second inning and 6-2 in the top of the seventh.

- **Corbin Carroll** went 2-for-5 with a solo homer in the third inning.
- **Ketel Marte** had a RBI sac fly in the fifth inning.
- **Nolan Arenado** hit a 2-run double in the seventh inning to cut the deficit to 6-4.
- **Pavin Smith** drew a PH bases loaded walk bench in a 3-run seventh to get the D-backs within 1.

**UPCOMING MILESTONES:** The D-backs are 1 win shy (2,199) of 2,200 regular-season wins as a franchise.

- **Corbin Carroll** is 1 triple shy of tying Stephen Drew's 52 (773 G) for the club record.
- **Torey Lovullo** is 4 wins shy of 700 in his D-backs' managerial tenure.

**1-RUN AFFAIRS:** The D-backs have had 4 of their last 6 games decided by 1 run (1-3).

- The D-backs' 22 1-run games are tied for most in the Majors (also: Mariners) and their 11 wins are tied for third (also: Athletics and Cardinals), behind the Phillies and White Sox.

**SERIES WINS:** The D-backs have won 5 of their last 7 series, including 2 sweeps (W 2-1 vs. Mets, L 1-2 @ Rangers, W 2-1 @ Rockies, W 3-0 vs. Giants, W 3-1 vs. Rockies, W 3-0 @ Giants, L 0-3 @ Mariners).

**IT'S HOT AT HOME:** **Ketel Marte** owns an 11-game home on-base streak, batting .429 (18-for-42)/1.350 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 17 RBI and 5 walks, including 7 games reaching base 2+ times.

- **Corbin Carroll** has an 8-game hitting streak, batting .412 (14-for-34)/1.223 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 triples, 1 homer, 5 RBI and 1 walk, including 5 games reaching base 2+ times.

**WITH THE LEATHER:** **Ketel Marte** is 1 of 2 middle infielders (also: 2B Matt McLain/CIN) and 1 of 6 infielders overall in MLB without an error (also: Freddie Freeman/LAD, McLain, TJ Rumfield/COL, Sal Stewart/CIN and Christian Walker/HOU) [min. 350.0 inn.].

**MORENO UP TOP:** Last night, **Gabriel Moreno** batted third in the lineup for the second time in his career (also: May 21, 2025), reaching base 3 times (1B, 2 BB).

- In 21 career starts hitting 1-3 in the lineup, is batting .405 (34-for-84)/1.036 OPS with 9 doubles, 2 homers, 15 RBI and 8 walks.

**DIVISION RIVALS:** Vs. NL West rivals since April 26, the D-backs lead the division in AVG (.295), OPS (.830), OBP (.358) and rank second in SLG (.477).

- **Corbin Carroll**, in his last 14 games, is hitting .362 (21-for-58)/1.129 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 triples, 3 homers, 9 RBI and 6 walks, including 10 games reaching base safely 2+ times.
- **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 15 straight games, hitting .306 (15-for-49)/.994 OPS with 6 doubles, 2 homers, 10 RBI, 9 walks and 3 hit-by-pitch, including 8 games reaching base safely 2+ times..
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base in 10 of his last 12 games, hitting .326 (14-for-43)/.900 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 7 walks, including 8 games reaching base safely 2+ times.

**STARTING STRONG:** Since May 5, D-backs' starters have recorded an MLB-leading 18 quality starts in their last 27 outings, allowing 2 or fewer runs in 17 games.

- Since May 5, the D-backs' rotation ranks among MLB leaders in innings (1st, 171.1), IP/G (1st, 6.1), ERA (2nd, 2.94), OBP (3rd, .272), BB/9.0 IP (3rd, 1.94), Wins (T-4th, 16) and WHIP (4th, 1.06).

**BULLPEN FOCUS:** **Taylor Clarke** is scoreless in his last 14 games (11.1 IP) with an opponent .108 AVG (4-for-37)/.258 OPS, 0.53 WHIP, 2 walks and 6 strikeouts.

- **Kevin Ginkel** has stranded all 11 of his inherited runners.
- **Brandyn Garcia** is scoreless in his last 8 games (6.1 IP) with a 0.95 WHIP, 1 walk, 5 strikeouts and 0 extra-base hits...has not allowed an earned run (1 R) in 12 home games (11.0 IP) since Sept. 16, 2025, with a 0.82 WHIP, 1 walk and 10 strikeouts.

**VS. DODGERS:** The D-backs are 4-5 in their last 9 meetings at Chase Field and split the last 4-game series from May 8-11, 2025.

- **Ketel Marte** has reached base in 25 of his last 27 games, hitting .301 (31-for-103)/.945 OPS with 5 doubles, 7 homers, 13 RBI, 15 walks and 1 HBP...has homered in 2 of his last 4 games with 4 RBI.
- **Corbin Carroll**, in his last 12 games, is hitting .311 (14-for-45)/.960 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 7 RBI and 4 walks, including 6 games reaching base 2+ times.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base 25 times in his last 20 games, hitting .304 (21-for-69) with 5 doubles, 2 homers, 9 RBI and 4 walks.

**VS. DODGERS:** 17th start, eighth at home.

- In 7 home starts, is 1-1 (team is 5-2) with a 3.86 ERA (17 ER in 39.2 IP), opponent .240 AVG (36-for-150), 11 walks and 48 strikeouts.
- Made the Opening Day start on March 26 @ Dodgers (L, 4 ER in 4.0 IP, 5 H, 2 BB, 2 K).
