TONIGHT'S STARTER: #46 - RHP BRYSE WILSON (7g, 1gs, 2-0, 3.29)

WILSON AT A GLANCE: Bryse Wilson, 26, will be making his eighth appearance and second start of the season.....Wilson last pitched last Saturday at St. Louis in relief and picked up the win as he retired all four batters he faced (1.1ip, 12 pitches).....his only start this season came on 4/17 vs. San Diego as he received no decision in the Brewers' 1-O win (3.2ip, 2h, 1bb, 2k, 57 pitches).....his last start prior to this season came on 9/28/22 vs. Cincinnati as a member of the Pirates when he received no decision in a 4-3, 10-inning victory (8ip, 3h, Or, 1bb, 6k, 1hbp).....he made 59 straight relief appearances between starts.....Wilson was acquired from Pittsburgh in exchange for cash on 1/4/23.

ARE YOU READY FOR SOME FOOTBALL?! Bryse's younger brother, Payton, was a linebacker at North Carolina State University and is expected to be selected in the 2024 NFL Draft, which begins tonight in Detroit, MI.

LAST SEASON: Wilson went 6-0 with a 2.58 ERA and 3 saves in 53 relief appearances during his first season with Milwaukee.....he was named Brewers Unsung Hero as voted on by members of the Milwaukee Chapter of the BBWAA.....he pitched as a full-time reliever for the first time in his professional career.....he held opponents to a .211 batting average, marking a career best.

CAREER: Is 17-17 with a 4.74 ERA and 4 saves in 116 games/44 starts (322.2ip, 170er)....is in his seventh Major League season with Atlanta (2018-21), Pittsburgh (2021-22) and Milwaukee (2023-24)....is 9-16 with a 5.40 ERA as a starter (201.2ip, 121er) and 8-1 with a 3.64 ERA in relief (121ip, 49er).....Wilson was selected by Atlanta in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Orange (NC) High School.....he committed to the University of North Carolina prior to being drafted.....Wilson was traded by the Braves to the Pirates, along with RHP Ricky DeVito, in exchange for RHP Richard Rodríguez on 7/30/21.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: IS 4-2 with a 3.30 ERA in 34 games/4 starts (62.2ip, 23er).....is 0-0 with a 2.25 ERA in 3 games/1 start this season (8ip, 2er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 9-11 with a 4.73 ERA in 55 games/22 starts (150.1ip, 79er).....is 2-0 with a 4.76 ERA in 4 relief appearances this season (5.2ip, 3er).

CAREER vs. PIRATES: Has gone 2-0 with a 2.40 ERA in 5 games/2 starts (15ip, 15h, 4r, 4er, 5bb, 13k, 3hr), including 0-0 with an 8.10 ERA in 3 relief appearances last season (3.1ip, 7h, 3r, 3er, 0bb, 4k, 2hr)....won both of his starts vs. Pittsburgh - coming in 2018 and 2021 with the Braves - posting a 0.77 ERA (11.2ip, 8h, 1r, 1er, 5bb, 9k, 1hr).
