BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue a six-game, seven-day homestand tonight against the Dodgers (1-0, 2 to play) and Pirates (3 to play)...The Birds have won four straight games for the first time since a five-game streak from July 26-29 (G2).

🦅 Last night, **Samuel Basallo** sealed an Orioles victory with a two-out, walk-off solo homer in the ninth inning...He became the first Oriole since **Henry Urrutia** (8/19/15 vs. NYM) whose first career home run at Camden Yards was a walk-off, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...Basallo is the first left-handed hitting Oriole to launch a walk-off long ball against an opposing left-handed pitcher (Tanner Scott) since **Chris Davis** did so on August 15, 2015 vs. Oakland off Pat Venditte.

🦅 At 21 years, 23 days old, Basallo became the youngest player in team history (since 1954) to hit a walk-off homer, surpassing **Cal Ripken, Jr.**, who was 21 years, 337 days old when he hit a walk-off homer on July 27, 1982 vs. Detroit.

🦅 Basallo became the youngest player with a walk-off home run since TEX's Jurickson Profar on September 26, 2013 vs. Los Angeles-AL, per [@SlangsOnSports](#).

🦅 During Baltimore's four-game winning streak, Oriole relievers have posted a 0.95 ERA (2 ER/19.0 IP).

MR. ROGERS' NEIGHBORHOOD: **Trevor Rogers** was named American League Pitcher of the Month for August after going 4-1 with a 1.29 ERA (6 ER/42.0 IP), 41 strikeouts, and 0.86 WHIP across six starts.

🦅 He has tossed 7.0 innings in four straight starts, tied for the second-longest streak by any MLB hurler this season with PHI's Cristopher Sánchez, ATL's Spencer Schwellenbach, and DET's Tarik Skubal...The only pitcher to do so in five straight this year is PHI's Ranger Suárez (5 GS).

🦅 Rogers is the first O's pitcher to throw 7.0+ innings in four straight starts since **Chris Tillman's** four-start run from July 5-21, 2016...The last to accomplish the feat in five straight starts was **Jeremy Guthrie** (5 GS) from July 19-August 8, 2011.

🦅 He has worked 6.0+ innings and allowed two runs or fewer in each of his last 10 outings, the longest single-season streak by any MLB pitcher since PHI's Zack Wheeler's 11-start stretch from August 4-September 28, 2024.

ACTION JACKSON: Since making his MLB debut on August 1, **Jeremiah Jackson** is slashing .318/.348/.509 (35-for-110) with five doubles, two triples, four home runs, 15 runs, and 17 RBI...

🦅 Jackson has 34 hits through his first 27 career starts, becoming the fourth Oriole in team history (since 1954) to accomplish the feat along with **Bob Hale** (38 H, 1955), **Billy Ripken** (36 H, 1987), and **Curtis Goodwin** (35 H, 1995).

🦅 His 53 total bases are tied with Ryan Mountcastle (2020) for the fourth most by an Oriole through their first 27 starts in franchise history (since 1954), trailing **Trey Mancini** (65 TB, 2016-17), **Chito Martinez** (59 TB, 1991), and **Jim Traber** (59 TB, 1984-86).

🦅 He has reached base safely in 15 straight games since August 21, the sixth-longest active streak in the AL...His 13-game hitting streak ended on Wednesday at San Diego, which was the second longest by an Oriole this season (Henderson: 14 G, 6/5-20).

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS: **Dylan Beavers** has reached base safely in 14 of his first 17 career games since debuting on August 16, slashing .302/.431/.434 (16-for-53) with four doubles, one homer, 10 runs scored, six RBI, 12 walks, and one stolen base.

🦅 He has reached base safely 28 times to begin his career, third most in franchise history (since 1954) through an O's first 17 games behind **Curtis Goodwin** (30 TOB, 1995) and **Ryan Mountcastle** (30 TOB, 2020).

🦅 Since making his MLB debut on August 16, his 12 walks are third most by all MLB rookies behind ATH's Nick Kurtz (17 BB) and TB's Hunter Feduccia (14 BB)...He is one of three Orioles in team history (since 1954) to have three multi-walk performances in his first 17 career games, joining **Colton Cowser** (3 G, 2023) and **Glenn Gulliver** (3 G, 1982).

NIP AND TUCK: Since August 10, nine of Baltimore's 13 home games have been decided by one run, with the O's going 3-6 in those contests.

🦅 Following the All-Star break, Baltimore has played an MLB-high 21 one-run affairs (8-12), ahead of Seattle (16 G)...The Birds opened the year playing 22 one-run games (12-10), tied for second fewest in the majors ahead of the Tigers (21 G).

NO RISP, NO REWARD: Since August 16, the O's have recorded 194 at-bats with runners in scoring position, the third-highest mark in MLB behind the Brewers and Mets (both 199 AB)...Their .211 RISP average during this stretch, however, is second lowest in the majors ahead of the Astros (.193 AVG).

🦅 On the season, **Gunnar Henderson** is batting .343 (35-for-102) with runners in scoring position...The .343 RISP average would tied for the eighth-highest mark (min. 100 AB) by an Oriole in club history (since 1954), including the highest since **Melvin Mora** (.360 RISP AVG) in 2008.

IT TAKES A VILLAGE: Baltimore has used a franchise record 67 players this season, surpassing the previous team record held by the 2021 Orioles (62 players)...The 67 players used are tied for the MLB lead along with the Braves.

🦅 **Samuel Basallo** hit his first major league home run on August 30 at San Francisco, becoming the 23rd different player to homer for the team this season, breaking the franchise record (since 1954) previously shared by the 2018 and 2012 Orioles...The current number leads the majors this season and is the most by an MLB club since the 2024 Giants (also 23).

🦅 **Dylan Beavers** became the 19th Oriole to swipe a base this year on August 23 vs. Houston, tied for the MLB lead along with the Brewers, Mariners, Rangers, and Rays...The 19 players are the most to steal 1+ base in team history, surpassing the previous record of 17 shared by the 2018, 2001, 1990, 1988, and 1955 Orioles.

🦅 On August 18 at Boston, **Samuel Basallo** became the seventh player to appear at catcher for Baltimore this year, setting the franchise record...The previous record of six was shared by the 1986, 1962, and 1960 O's...The last MLB club to use at least seven catchers in a single season was the 2023 Cleveland Guardians (also 7)...The last to use eight were the 2022 Pirates.

LA LA LAND: Baltimore is set to host Los Angeles at Camden Yards for the fifth time since the clubs first met in the regular season in 2002 ('02, '13, '19, '23)...The O's have played the Dodgers 22 times, their fewest matchups against a single opponent in MLB ahead of the Cardinals and Reds (both 24 G).

🦅 Los Angeles DH/RHP Shohei Ohtani is one of two players in MLB history two win the MVP in both the American and National League, joining **Frank Robinson**, who did so with Cincinnati in 1961 and Baltimore in 1966.

QUICK HITS: Set to make his 15th start of the season and his 19th as an Oriole...The O's are 11-3 in his starts this year...Appointed from Triple-A Norfolk as the Orioles' 27th man for the doubleheader on May 24 (G2) at Boston and recalled from Norfolk on June 18...Placed on the 15-day Injured List on March 27 (retroactive to March 24) with right knee subluxations...On May 11, was reinstated from the IL and optioned to Norfolk...Acquired by the Orioles from the Marlins in exchange for **INF/OF Connor Norby** and **OF Kyle Stowers** on July 30, 2024...Selected by the Marlins with the No. 13 overall pick in the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of Carlsbad (NM) High School.

FEELING HOT, HOT, HOT: Rogers was named the American League Pitcher of the Month for August after pitching to a 1.29 ERA (6 ER/42.0 IP) with four wins, 41 strikeouts, an 0.86 WHIP, and .199 opponent average (30-for-151) across six starts... Became the first Oriole pitcher to earn the recognition since **Corbin Burnes** in September 2024 and the first Oriole southpaw since **Erik Bedard** in July 2007.
⚡ Led the majors in innings pitched and led the AL in ERA and WHIP.
⚡ Was the only pitcher to throw a complete game during the month (8/1 at CHC).
⚡ Became the first Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) to make at least five starts and allow one or zero runs in each of the outings in a single month.

LAST TIME OUT: Set a career high with his fourth straight winning decision on August 30 at San Francisco...Tossed 7.0 innings of one-run ball, scattering five hits (1 HR) with five strikeouts...The sole run scored on a two-out, first-inning, solo homer by Willy Adames...Threw 92 pitches, 66 strikes.
⚡ Had his 44.0-inning homerless streak snapped, which was the longest stretch by an Oriole starter since **Kyle Bradish** (50.1 IP, 9/20/23-6/8/24) and the longest by an Oriole left-handed pitcher since **Cionel Pérez** (87.2 IP, 6/3/23-3/30/25).
⚡ Opponents went 2-for-4 off his sinker...Opponents are batting .370 (10-for-27) off the pitch since July 26 (7 GS) after opening the year hitting .167 (5-for-30) through July 20 (7 GS).

WEST MEETS EAST: Set to make his second career start against the Dodgers, joining July 5, 2021 at loanDepot park...Did not factor in the decision after allowing two runs on six hits with eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings.
⚡ His career 2.70 ERA (21 ER/70.0 IP) against the NL West is his lowest ERA against any single division, ahead of the AL East (2.86 ERA).

OFF AND RUNNING: Rogers' 1.39 ERA is the lowest by an Oriole through his first 14 starts of a season in franchise history (since 1954), surpassing **Jim Palmer** (1.51 ERA, 1975)...The lowest mark through 15 starts is also held by Palmer in 1975 (1.64 ERA) and 1972 (1.74 ERA).
⚡ The 1.39 mark is the lowest ERA through a major league starter's first 14 games of the season since NYM's Jacob deGrom in 2021 (0.95 ERA).
⚡ His ERA, opponent average (.172), on-base percentage (.220), slugging percentage (.232), and OPS (.452) on the year lead all major league pitchers (min. 90.0 IP).

LET'S GO STREAKING: Has allowed two runs or fewer in a career-high 12 straight games, the longest such stretch by an Oriole starter in franchise history (since 1954)... Rogers has tossed 6.0+ innings in a career-high 10 consecutive starts, tied for the longest active streak in MLB with ATL's Spencer Schwellenbach and the longest by an Oriole this season (last: **Corbin Burnes**, 17 GS, 4/26-7/30/24).
⚡ Has made 10 straight starts of 6.0+ innings and two or fewer runs allowed, setting the franchise record for the longest streak by an Oriole starter in club history.

THREE'S A CROWD: Has recorded a 3.38 ERA (5 ER/13.1 IP) in the third inning this season, his highest mark of any inning, ahead of the seventh frame (3.12 ERA)...Five of Rogers' 14 total runs allowed on the year have come in the third...Opponents are 10-for-50 (.200) in the third frame off him.

LIMITING THE LONG BALL: Since the beginning of the 2021 season, Rogers has allowed 0.76 home runs per nine innings, the sixth-lowest mark among all MLB starters during that stretch (min. 450.0 IP).
⚡ Has allowed one or zero home runs in 44 of his last 45 starts since September 12, 2022 (2 HR, 5/4/24 at OAK).
⚡ Rogers' 0.30 home runs per nine innings on the year would tie **Storm Davis** (1984) for the second-lowest mark by an Oriole starter in franchise history (since 1954), behind **Bob Turley** (0.25 HR/9.0 IP, 1954).

TWO-STRIKE SUPERSTAR: Rogers is holding opponents to a .109 batting average (19-for-174) and .287 OPS in two-strike counts...His .287 opponent OPS is the lowest among all major league pitchers (min. 150 BF)...In full counts, batters are slashing .212/.350/.242 (7-for-33).
