Setting the Table

OF Michael Harris II recorded his fourth consecutive multi-hit game Sunday afternoon and ran his hitting streak to seven straight overall, during which he has batted .455/.486/.879.

Atlanta's leadoff man has scored nine runs over these seven games, and has 17 runs over 20 total games in September. Just two leadoff batters in baseball - Shohei Ohtani with 21 and Kyle Schwarber with 19 - have scored more runs in the month.

Harris II has put 39 balls in play harder than 100 miles per hour this month, six more than any other player in baseball.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Mets tonight open a three-game midweek series with what is the 11th of 13 total games between the teams this season... This week will conclude the regular season slate between the clubs, who are next scheduled to meet from June 17-19 of next year, here at Truist Park.

A The Braves and Mets have split 10 total games between the clubs the season, although Atlanta has won each of the last two games in the series by a combined score of 13-2.

A Atlanta went 10-3 in 13 games with New York last season, a .769 winning percentage...Since the Mets were founded in 1962, the best single-season winning percentage the Braves have logged against New York is .778, going 14-4 in 18 games with the Mets in both 1964 and 1966.

A The Braves have won 21 of the last 30 games with New York dating to the 2022 season, outscoring the Mets 185-122 (+63) over the stretch.

A The Braves have taken the season series from their NL East rivals for six consecutive seasons...Prior to last year's 10-3 mark, they went 10-9 in both 2022 & 2021, 7-3 in 2020, 11-8 in 2019 and 13-6 in 2018...Since the start of the 2018 season, Atlanta is 66-43 (.606) against New York overall.

A Atlanta went 5-1 against New York here at Truist Park last season, but did drop the only series between the clubs here this year...The Mets won two-of-three here in April...Since Truist Park opened in 2017, the Braves are 36-25 (.590) against the Mets here in their home park.

A RH Luis Severino has four starts in his career against Atlanta, including two earlier this season, and is 1-1 with a 3.15 ERA (7 ER/20.0 IP) all-time versus the Braves...The 6-foot-2, 218-pound right-hander has allowed two runs over 5.0 innings in each of his two turns against Atlanta this year, while New York has won both games...Severino has won each of his last four decisions dating to August 17, going 4-0 with a 2.64 ERA over seven total starts in that span.

SPENCER SCHWELLENBACH: The right-hander is set to make the 20th start of his major league career and his second against New York...Schwellenbach tossed 7.0 scoreless innings on July 27 at Citi Field, fanning a career-best 11 in Atlanta's win, 4-0.

A Schwellenbach has made 12 starts this season against clubs with a winning record, and is 6-3 with a 3.18 ERA (25 ER/70.2 IP) in these turns... In seven games versus teams below .500, he is 1-4 with a 4.38 ERA.

A Over his last 13 games dating to July 6, the rookie has gone 6-3 with a 2.77 ERA (24 ER/78.0 IP) while Atlanta is 8-5 in his turns...His 2.77 ERA since that date ranks eighth in the National League, while his 6.62 strikeouts per walks ranks best.

A Schwellenbach ranks in the 96th percentile of pitchers in baseball in chase percentage (34.5%) and in the 93rd percentile in walk percentage (4.9).

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Braves enter the final week of the 2024 regular season with an 85-71 (.545) record, and currently sit outside of the National League playoff field...Atlanta's current record at 14 games over .500 is tied for the club's best mark of the season.

A The Braves are currently 1.5 games behind the Arizona Diamondbacks for the final wild card spot in the National League, and 2.0 games behind the Mets for second.

A Atlanta went 5-2 over seven games with Arizona this season to earn the tiebreaker, meaning that if the two teams finish the season with the same record the Braves will earn the playoff spot...Atlanta and New York are 5-5 over 10 games this season, meaning that the winner of the three-game series this week will own the tiebreaker.

A The Phillies and Brewers have clinched the NL East and NL Central divisions, respectively, while the Dodgers have clinched at least a postseason berth.

A Philadelphia's win last night officially clinched the NL East, snapping Atlanta's six consecutive titles in the division...The Braves won all six NL East crowns from 2018-2023, and entered the season with the longest active streak of division titles in baseball.

MATT OLSON: Reached base three more times on Sunday afternoon, going 2-for-3 with a walk and an RBI...He has reached base multiple times in each of his last nine games, the longest such active streak in baseball.

A Olson has just two longer streaks of reaching multiple times in his career, doing so in 10 straight games last September and in 11 straight last August.

A Olson's RBI was his 98th on the year, and his home run on Saturday was his 29th...He is looking for his fourth consecutive season of at least 30 home runs and 100 RBI...He is the only player in baseball to have 30 & 100 in every year from 2021-23.

A With one more homer and two more RBI this year, Olson will become just the third Brave since the team moved to Atlanta in 1966 with three straight seasons of 30 homers and 100 RBI...Chipper Jones (1998-2001) and Dale Murphy (1982-1985) both did so in four straight years.

A Sixteen of Olson's 29 homers (55%) and 54 of his 98 RBI (55%) have come over his last 54 games dating to July 27...His 54 RBI since that date are the most in baseball, and his 16 homers are tied for fifth...He has batted .283/.382/.606 with a .988 OPS in that span.

GIO URSHELA: Extended his hitting streak to six games with a three-hit effort on Sunday afternoon, including his second homer in as many days...Since making his Braves debut on August 20, he has batted .270/.289/.423.

A All three of Urshela's home runs with Atlanta have come over his last 10 games dating to September 13, during which he has hit .333/.350/.667.

- A* Making his 20th start of the season and second against New York (NL).
 - A* Fanned 11 hitters over 7.0 scoreless frames in his last outing against the Mets.
 - A* Held Cincinnati to one run over 6.0 innings pitched in his last start.
 - A* Is a combined 3-1 with a 2.65 ERA in six starts against NL East opponents.
- A* He needs three strikeouts to have the most in Braves franchise history through a player's first 20 career games.
 - A* Ian Anderson and Brandon Beachy are tied for the most in that span with 120.
- A* This season, he's fanned 118 batters, to just 22 walks...In the Modern Era (since 1900), his 5.36 K/BB ratio is the fifth-highest among rookies with as many innings pitched (103.2), shy of Masahiro Tanaka (6.71, 2014), Chicago's (NL) Shota Imanaga (6.36, 2024), Seattle's George Kirby (6.05, 2022) and Houston's Roy Oswalt (6.00, 2001).
- A* Is 4-2 with a 2.75 ERA and averaging 6.0 innings pitched over his last 10 starts.
 - A* Since the beginning of July, his ERA is the eighth lowest in the NL (min. 10 GS).
- A* Schwellenbach is 6-3 with a 3.18 ERA against teams with .500 records or better this year.
 - A* Only Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (2.29) and LA's Yoshinobu Yamamoto (NL - 2.28) have lower ERA's among rookies against such clubs this season (min. 10 starts).
- A* Producing a 34.6% chase rate this season.
 - A* The second highest rate among pitchers with at least 10 starts this year... Trailing only Philadelphia's Christopher Sánchez (36.9%).
- A* Throwing strikes on 69.3% of his pitches.
 - A* The highest mark among MLB starters with at least 10 outings.

2024 Recap

- A* Schwellenbach struckout 42 hitters in the month of August; the most by a Braves pitcher in franchise history in their first year in a single calendar month.
- A* His 102 strikeouts are the most in franchise history through a player's first 15 games.
 - A* Schwellenbach recorded his 85th career strikeout on 8/16 and passed Ian Anderson for the most strikeouts in franchise history through a player's first 13 games.
- A* Became the first pitcher in the live ball era to have at least 77 strikeouts and issue 12 walks or less through a player's first 12 career games.
- A* Schwellenbach fanned 28 hitters and issued just one walk in the month of July... Became the first player in the live ball era to strikeout as many hitters without issuing more than a walk in a calendar month in their first year.
- A* Fanned 11 Mets hitters while scattering two hits over 7.0 scoreless innings on July 27...The 11 strikeouts set a new career high.
 - A* Since the mound moved to its current distance of 60 ft. 6 inches in 1893, he is just the third rookie to strike out at least 10 in two straight starts, following Dwight Gooden (September 12 and 17, 1984) and Cincinnati's Nick Lodolo (September 9 and 14, 2022).
- A* Became the first player in Braves franchise history to strikeout at least 10 hitters without allowing a run in one of his first 10 career games.
- A* Became the third Braves rookie in franchise history with 7.0 or more shutout innings, no walks, and 11 or more strikeouts...Bob Sadowski, 9/5/63 and Spencer Strider, 9/1/22 are the other two.
- A* Through his first 11 career games, Schwellenbach has struckout 70 hitters while only allowing 10 free passes...became the first player in the live ball era to record as many strikeouts while issuing 10 or less walks.
 - A* Prior to his last start, he was just the third pitcher in Baseball Reference's database with at least 60 strikeouts and 10 or fewer walks issued over the first 10 games of a career.
- A* Became the only rookie in the modern era to to strikeout eight or more hitters without issuing a walk in three consecutive starts (7/21-8/2)...Credit StatsPerform.
- A* Struckout J.D. Martínez to reach 60 punchouts through his fist 10 games...Tied with Brandon Beachy for the second most in franchise history through a player's first 10 games.
- A* Pitched 13.0 scoreless innings in two starts with Double-A Mississippi while recording 17 strikeouts and issuing just one walk, earning the win in both games.
- A* Made six starts for High-A Rome and went 2-1 with a 2.53 ERA this season.
- A* Began his major league career with 24 starts at the professional level between Single-A Augusta, High-A Rome and Double-A Mississippi.

- A* Selected by the Braves in the second round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Nebraska.
 - A* Missed the 2022 season recovering from Tommy John surgery.
- A* In 2021, he was named the Big Ten Player of the Year and the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year.
 - A* Was also a Golden Spikes Award Semifinalist, ABCA/Rawlings First-Team All-

- Owns a 10.13 strikeout-per-9.0 innings ratio, as well as a 3.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

- In nine of his relief appearances, has struck out at least three batters...Just four National League relievers have done so more often.
- Bummer's 33.1 Hard-Hit Percentage ranks in the 89th percentile among major league pitchers.
- Opponents are hitting ground balls off him 62% of the time (league average 43%)...Ranks in the 98th percentile.
- From July 13-26, struck out three batters in four consecutive appearances...The last Braves reliever with such a run was Steve Bedrosian from July 9-27, 1982.
- Was acquired by Atlanta from Chicago on November 16, 2023, in exchange for INF Braden Shewmake, LHP Jared Shuster, INF Nicky Lopez, RHP Michael Soroka and minor-league RHP Riley Gowens.

Saves/Opp: 0/1 Holds: 1 1st Batter/Retired: 46/28 Inherited Runners/Scored: 20/4

- **With RISP, opposing batters are hitting .150 (9-for-60) off him, which ranks seventh-best in Major League Baseball among pitchers with as many batters faced (70) in such situations.**
- Four of Chavez's 20 inherited runners have scored, the eighth-best percentage (20%) in the N.L. (min. 20 IR).
- Reached 1,000 career strikeouts on June 10...Among active primary relievers, his 1,034 strikeouts rank sixth.
- From 2021-present, owns a 2.55 ERA (51 ER/180.0 IP) as a Brave...With other clubs during that period (TEX, CHC, LAA), has pitched to a 7.16 ERA (13 ER/16.1 IP).

- This season, has pitched to a 2.59 ERA (12 ER/41.2 IP) across 33 relief outings with Triple-A Gwinnett.
- Has posted a 11.23 K/9 at Triple-A this season.
- Earned the win in his MLB debut on July 23 2023 in Milwaukee...Prior to that, the last Atlanta reliever to earn a win in his MLB debut was Jesse Biddle, who beat the New York Mets on April 21, 2018.
