RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a nine-game, 11-day homestand vs. Boston (0-3), Kansas City (1-2) and Oakland (0-1, 2 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...they have dropped seven of their last eight games after posting an 11-4 mark in their previous 15 contests...following the homestand, Tampa Bay will meet AL East-leading Baltimore seven times in 11 days from May 31–June 10, traveling to Camden Yards for a three-game set (May 31–June 2) before a four-game series at Tropicana Field from June 7-10... sandwiched between the seven games are two off days (May 3 and 6) and a two-game set at Miami (May 4-5).

Last night, Tampa Bay was shut out for the third time this season, joining May 10 ys. New York-AL (2-0) and May 20 ys. BOS (5-0)...the 2023 Rays also suffered their

vs. New York-AL (2-0) and May 20 vs. BOS (5-0)...the 2023 Rays also suffered their third shutout defeat of the season on May 29, a 1-0 loss at Chicago-NL (1-0). The Rays were shut out by Oakland for the first time since July 22, 2016 (1-0, 13

inn.), and for the first time at Tropicana Field since May 23, 2015 (5-0). Tampa Bay's three hits matched a season low, joining March 31 vs. Toronto and May 20 vs. Boston.

The Rays have been held hitless through 5.0 innings in back-to-back games for the second time in franchise history, joining a three-game streak from June 29 July 1 2015

Tampa Bay suffered its second defeat this season when allowing zero earned runs (also April 19 at NYY), becoming the only club in the majors with two such losses... it marks the second time in franchise history that Tampa Bay has had two such defeats in a single season, joining the 2015 Rays (April 21 vs. BOS & July 29 vs. DET).

DUE FOR A BREAKOUT—In eight games since May 19, a stretch in which Tampa Bay is 1-7, the Rays have struggled at the plate...this follows an eight-game stretch from May 12-18 in which the Rays went 6-2 and saw greater offensive success.

During the current 1-7 skid, Tampa Bay ranks at the bottom of the majors in AVG (166), OBP (.246), SLG (.241), OPS (.488) and runs/game (2.25)...the Rays 13 XBH and

3 HR are both tied with the Cubs for the lowest marks in MLB during that time. Overall, the Rays have scored two runs or fewer in 21 games, tied with Washington for the third most such games in the majors behind Chicago-AL (28G) and Miami (22G)...Tampa Bay had 34 games with two or fewer runs a season ago, tied with Seattle for third fewest in the majors, trailing only Atlanta (24G) and Los Angeles-NL (30G).

The Rays 43 HR are second fewest in MLB behind Chicago-AL (38HR)...last season, their 101 HR through 55 games led the majors and were the fourth-most homers by any team through 55 games since 1901, trailing the 1999 Seattle Mariners (110HR), 2019 Minnesota Twins (106HR) and 2020 Los Angeles Dodgers (104HR).

MARATHON, NOT A SPRINT—From innings 1-3, Rays pitching has posted a 2.73 ERA and .206 opp. AVG, the second-best mark in the majors in each category behind the Cubs (2.29 ERA/.191 opp. AVG)...from innings 4-6, Tampa Bay owns a 6.22 ERA and .286 opp. AVG, both ranking last in the majors, with the next closest clubs being Oakland (5.46 ERA) and Chicago-NL (281 opp. AVG)...the Rays 3.94 ERA from the 7th inn. on ranks 17th in the majors, while their .231 opp. AVG is 12th.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE—When Tampa Bay draws 3+ walks in a game, they have posted an 18-11 (.620) record, compared to 8-18 (.308) when drawing two walks or fewer.

Tampa Bay produced an 11.3 pct walk rate (70BB/616PA) from May 1-18, the best walk rate in the majors during that stretch ahead of Philadelphia (10.6%, 68BB/641PA)...in eight games since, the Rays have registered a 7.1 pct. walk rate (20BB/280PA), the ninth-lowest mark in the majors.

Isaac Paredes is averaging 4.50 pitches per plate appearance, the second-highest mark in the majors (min. 150PA) behind CHC Mike Tauchman (4.51)...under the same parameter, Randy Arozarena's 4.29 pitches per plate appearance rank fifth in the AL/13th in the majors. in the AL/13th in the majors.

ON-BASE PAREDES—Isaac Paredes has reached base safely in 24 of his last 25 games since April 28, hitting .330/.434/.500 (29-for-88) with 6 2B, 3 HR, 13 RBI, 15 BB and 14 SO...he ranks third in the AL in both batting average and on-base pct. during that span... Paredes has reached safely in 34 of his last 37 games overall since April 14, posting the AL's third-best average over that timeframe (.319/43-for-135) behind TOR Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.336) and BOS Rafael Devers (.319).

Paredes is batting .279 (31-for-111) with 5 2B, 5 HR and 14 RBI with two strikes...min 75 AB his .279 two-strike average leads the AL and is fourth highest in the majors

75 AB. his 279 two-strike average leads the AL and is fourth highest in the majors behind STL Masyn Winn (.287) and LAD Mookie Betts/SD Luis Arraez (both .284). Paredes' 31 hits with two strikes are tied with Betts for second most in the majors, trailing only HOU Jose Altuve (33H).

AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL—Tampa Bay pitching has conceded 72 home runs, second most in the majors behind Chicago-AL (77HR)...the Rays have allowed at least 1 HR in a season-high eight straight games, the third-longest active streak in the majors behind Washington (10G) and Cleveland (9G)...it marks their longest such streak since Sept. 11-22, 2023 (11G).

It marks the first time Tampa Bay has allowed 1+ HR in eight straight home games since June 8-24, 2023 (9G).
The Rays have allowed 47 HR at Tropicana Field (33G), the most by any club at

their home ballpark, with the next closest team being the Padres (42HR/31G). The 47 HR allowed through 34 home games are tied with the 2004 Devil Rays for second most in franchise history, ahead of only the 2000 Devil Rays (54HR).

BATTLE OF THE BAYS—Tampa Bay and Oakland continue a three-game set tonight at Tropicana Field...the Rays and A's will meet in Oakland for a four-game set from Aug. 19-22.

Tampa Bay took five of seven games from Oakland in 2023, including a three-game sweep at Tropicana Field from April 7-9 as part of its modern era-record-tying 13-game winning streak to open the season.

From Sept. 5, 1998–Sept. 5, 2003, Tampa Bay went 7-39 (.152) against Oakland...in 152 games since, the Rays have posted a 75-77 (.493) mark against the Athletics.

TONIGHT'S START—Pepiot will make his ninth start of the season tonight, including his sixth at home...was on the 15-day IL from May 6-22 (lower left leg contusion) after being struck by a 107.5 mph comebacker off the bat of NYM Starling Marte on May 5...in his last four starts prior to the IL stint, he went 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA (20.0IP, 5ER) and 0.85 WHIP... has not received more than three runs of support in any of his eight starts.

LAST TIME OUT—Worked into the 5th inning of the Rays 8-5 home loss to the Red Sox on May 22, throwing 66 pitches (ND, 4.0IP, 2H, 3ER, 4BB, 3SO)...held Boston scoreless through four frames, maneuvering around three walks...came on to begin the 5th inning, allowing a walk and HBP followed by an RBI-single by **Cedanne Rafaela**, which chased him from the contest...both of the runners Pepiot was responsible for came around to score following his departure. to score following his departure.

GREEN AND GOLD—Pepiot will be making his first career start against Oakland...in two career starts opposite AL West opponents, both of which came this season (April 1 vs. TEX & April 18 vs. LAA), he is 1-0 with a 5.40 ERA (11.2IP, 7ER)

WHIFF YOU PLEASE—Pepiot's 32.0 pct. whiff rate ranks second in the AL behind DET Jack Flaherty (35.7%) and fifth in the majors, trailing PIT Jared Jones (35.5%), SD Dylan Cease (33.1%) and MIL Freddy Peralta (32.2%) (min. 500 swings)...before being limited to 2.0 IP due to injury and a pitch count over his last two starts, Pepiot's 38 SO were tied with **Tyler Glasnow** for third most through a Rays pitcher's first six outings with the club, trailing **Taj Bradley** (42SO) and **Charlie Morton** (39SO).

TRAFFIC CONTROL—Min. 40.0 IP, he ranks among AL leaders in opp. average (3rd, .177) and WHIP (6th, 0.98)...he has allowed five or fewer hits in each of his eight starts—excluding openers, it ties the third-longest single-season streak by a Rays starter in club history, trailing only ninestart streaks by **Shane McClanahan** (2023) and **Tyler Glasnow** (2021)... Pepiot's streak is the longest to open a pitcher's Rays tenure in club history.

HEAT CHECK—Pepiot's four-seam fastball is one of the most effective pitches in the majors...opponents are just 6-for-68 (.088) against his four-seamer, and he has recorded 28 of his 44 SO on the pitch...the .088 average is the lowest

- he has recorded 28 of his 44 SO on the pitch...the .088 average is the lowest mark on any individual fastball in MLB (min. 35AB ending with pitch).

 Pepiot has produced a 39.7 pct. whiff rate on his four-seamer, the second-highest mark on any MLB pitcher's fastball (min. 150 swings), trailing only OAK Mason Miller's four-seamer (45.7%).

 The pitch has also generated a 36.4 pct. whiff rate in the strike zone...min. 50 in-zone swings, it signals the third-highest mark on any pitch behind Miller's four-seamer (41.5%) and teammate TB Shawn Armstrong's four-seamer (38.3%).

HUNGOUT TO DRY - The Rays have been outscored, 41-25 (-16), in Pepiot's starts, the lowest team run differential in any Tampa Bay pitcher's starts, with **Zach Eflin** (-15) being next closest...however, the Rays have scored 11 total runs across his last two starts (5.5 R/G) after recording 13 runs in his first six (2.2 R/G).

In his career as a starter, Pepiot is 6-0 with a 2.83 ERA (60.1IP, 19ER) when receiving just two or more runs of support (12GS) and 1-3 with a 5.16 ERA (29.2IP, 17ER) with one or zero runs (6GS).

MEET ME IN THE MIDDLE—He has been at his best in the middle frames of his outings, posting a 1.23 ERA (22.0IP, 3ER) and 0.73 WHIP in innings 2-4 while pitching to a 7.23 ERA (18.2IP, 15ER) and 1.29 WHIP in all other frames.

LOCKED IN-From April 18-29, Pepiot recorded 6.0 IP and yielded three hits or fewer in three consecutive starts, turning in a 1.00 ERA (18.0IP, and 0.72 WHIP in those games...he became the seventh pitcher in franchise history to turn the trick in three straight starts, including the first since **Tyler Glasnow** from July 25-Aug. 14, 2023.

KING OF COORS—Pepiot recorded a career-high 11 SO without issuing a walk on April 7 at COL...he became the fifth pitcher (8th instance) in Rays history with 11+ SO and no walks on the road (last: Blake Snell on April 8, 2019 at CWS)...became the first visiting pitcher and third overall (Jon Gray & Germán Márquez) to record 6.0+ IP, 10+ SO and no walks at Coors Field.
