TODAY'S GAME: The Giants dropped last night's series opener and are now 1-5 in their last six games.

- ▶ The Giants and Padres' season series is knotted up at four wins apiece with five games remaining (two in SD and three at Oracle Park)...the Giants have been outscored by the Padres 41-32 (-9).
- ▶ SF has lost 15 of its last 23 games since August 11, falling four games below .500...SF has lost four-straight series entering yesterday's opener.

CHEERS!: OF Heliot Ramos celebrates his 25th birthday today.

WEBB GEMS: RHP Logan Webb will make his third start vs. San Diego this season...he's posted a 2.77 ERA (4er, 13.0ip) with eight strikeouts and 15 hits allowed in the two starts.

- ▶ Webb has pitched 183.2 innings this season, which ranks second in the Majors behind KC's Seth Lugo (186.0).
- ▶ Webb, who led MLB with 216.0 innings pitched last season, can become the first Giants pitcher to lead the Majors in innings pitched in two straight seasons since **RHP Gaylord Perry** led MLB in 1970 (328.2ip) and 1969 (325.1ip).
- ▶ He'd also be the first pitcher to lead MLB in innings in back-to-back seasons since Justin Verlander did so in 2011-2012.
- ▶ With 16.1 more innings pitched this season, Webb would become the first Giants pitcher with back-to-back 200.0 inning seasons since **RHP Jeff Samardzija** did so in 2016 and 2017.

BUILDING BLOCKS: Giants rookies have played big roles on both sides of the ball for the Giants in 2024.

- ▶ SF's rookie pitchers have thrown 459.0 innings so far in 2024, which is tied with Oakland for most in MLB...the 459.0 innings by SF rookies this season is the franchise's most since 541.1 innings pitched by rookies in 1975.
- ▶ On the other side, SF's rookie position players have appeared in 172 games this year, 14th most in the Majors, but have combined for a .755 OPS...the .755 OPS from rookies ranks second-best in MLB behind San Diego's rookies with a .774 OPS (Philadelphia's rookies have an .909 OPS but have only amassed 35 games played entering play today).

STEALING THE SHOW: IF Matt Chapman stole his 14th base of the season last night...he entered 2024 with 11 career steals.

- ▶ If Chapman were to reach 15 steals on the season, he would pair with **IF/OF Tyler Fitzgerald** (17 steals) as the first Giants duo to each steal 15+ bases in a season since **OF Grégor Blanco** and **OF Ángel Pagán** had 16 steals each in 2014.

OL' RELIABLES: RHP Tyler Rogers is currently tied with HOU's Bryan Abreu for most games pitched in MLB with 69, **RHP Ryan Walker** is tied for third with 68 games pitched.

- ▶ They would be the first Giants pitchers to finish inside MLB's top-3 in games pitched since **RHP John Brebbia** in 2022 finished third with 76 games pitched.
- ▶ The last Giant to lead the Majors in games pitched was **LHP Scott Eyre** with 86 games pitched in 2005.
- ▶ Walker is tied with HOU's Héctor Neris and MIA/SD's Tanner Scott for most wins among relievers with nine.
- ▶ The SF bullpen as a whole has pitched 572.2 innings, which is second-most in MLB behind Detroit (581.2), and has 587 strikeouts, which lead the Majors.

ROAD WOES: The Giants are 29-41 (.414) in road games this season...the .414 winning percentage is 26th in MLB, and is the third-lowest road winning percentage in the NL ahead of only Miami (26-42, .382) and Colorado (21-52, .288).

- ▶ Since the All-Star Break, SF is 10-13 on the road, going 2-4-1 in the seven completed series.
- ▶ By the numbers, SF has a .696 OPS (T-16th in MLB) on the road while averaging 4.23 runs per game (19th in MLB)...on the pitching side, SF has a 4.71 road ERA (26th in MLB).

LEADING OFF: The Giants have been one of MLB's better teams at putting pressure on opposing pitchers to start the inning as shown in the chart below.

HOMERS: Despite last night's solo home run by **OF Michael Conforto** providing the entire offense for SF, the Giants have not been home run dependent this season...their percentage of runs via the home run is 37.4%, which is the 27th-ranked percentage in MLB.

- ▶ On the road, however, SF has scored 45.3% of its runs via the home run, which is fifth in MLB...at home the Giants have scored 29.7% of runs on homers, which is the lowest in MLB.
- ▶ SF's 3.3% home run rate on the road is tied for seventh-highest in MLB and tied for third-highest in the NL.

STRIKING: SF has struck out 10+ times in 14 of its last 22 games, including 11 times last night...SF is 2-12 in those games.

- ▶ San Diego's starter tonight, RHP Dylan Cease, is fourth in MLB with 201 strikeouts.
- ▶ SF's 237 strikeouts since August 12 are third-most in the Majors behind Colorado (244) and Tampa Bay (242)...however, SF's 29.8% strikeout rate in that time is highest in MLB.
- ▶ The Giants have struck out looking 321 times this season, which is fourth-most in MLB.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: Earned his first career All-Star selection, joining **OF Heliot Ramos** as the two Giants in the Mid-summer Classic...Webb became the first homegrown (drafted and developed) Giants pitcher to be named to an All-Star Game since **LHP Madison Bumgarner** was selected to the team in 2016.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his ninth loss of the season on Sunday against Miami...worked 6.0 innings and allowed six runs on eight hits with four strikeouts and a home run.

SEVEN HEAVEN: Over his last seven outings dating to July 31, Webb has gone 4-1 with a 2.61 ERA (14er, 48.1ip), .191 opposing average and 39 strikeouts...however, the right hander has surrendered 10 earned runs (three HRs) in 11.0 innings (8.18 ERA) with a .261 clip over his past two starts.

VS. SAN DIEGO: Will be facing the Padres for the 13th time in his career and third time this season...is 3-2 with a 2.55 ERA (20er, 70.2ip) and 58 strikeouts in the 12 games (11 starts)...faced them twice in the first 10 games of the season and allowed four runs on 15 hits with eight strikeouts over 13.0 innings of work (2.77 ERA).

ON THE LEADERBOARDS: Webb leads all NL pitchers in innings this season at 183.2 and ranks second in MLB, just behind KC's Seth Lugo (186.0ip)...the right-hander also ranks among the top of MLB leaderboards in FIP (2.96, 5th), fWAR (4.0, T-6th), quality starts (18, T-7th) and ERA (3.43, 20th).

DADDY LONG LEGS: Webb has finished at least 7.0 innings on 15 different occasions so far this season, most of any pitcher in the Majors...only three other Giants starters this year have finished 7.0 innings (**Blake Snell** (4x), **Jordan Hicks** on April 5 vs. SD and **Kyle Harrison** on May 7 at COL).

KEEP 'EM IN THE YARD: Despite giving up three homers in his last two starts, Webb has still surrendered just 10 homers this season (third-fewest among qualified pitchers) and has surrendered a total of five homers over his past 13 starts (84.1ip)...Webb's 0.49 HR/9ip this season is currently a career-best and third-best in the Majors, trailing only ATL's Chris Sale (0.45) and PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (0.45).

BOOTS ON THE GROUND: Through 29 starts this year Webb owns a 57.5% ground ball rate, fourth-best in the Majors behind HOU's Framber Valdez (61.1%), PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (59.2%) and ATL's Max Fried (59.0%)...he leads the Majors with 317 produced ground balls this season.

SHUT THE FRONT DOOR: Threw his second career shutout on July 31 in SF's 1-0 victory against the A's...limited Oakland batters to just five hits with a walk and six strikeouts, achieving the feat in just one hour & 55 minutes (106 pitches)...the outing marked his third career complete game and first since September 25, 2023 vs. San Diego...Webb's previous career shutout came on July 9, 2023 vs. Colorado, when SF also won the game 1-0 in one hour and 56 minutes...the right-hander joined **Greg Maddux** as the only MLB players to toss multiple 9+ inning 1-0 shutouts in under two hours in the Wild Card era (since 1995) (*Stats, LLC*).
