AT HOME: The Brewers are 16-10 at home, going 5-2-1 in series play.....the team has gone 11-3 in its last 14 home games after a 5-7 start.....have won 3 in a row at home.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 18-13 on the road, going 5-4-1 in series play.....the team took 2 of 3 games at Boston on its last trip to snap a streak of four straight road series losses.....the Brewers went 4-0-1 in their first five road series this season.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season.....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff....
Rickie Weeks (associate manager), **Daniel de Mondesert** (assistant coach) and **Charlie Greene** (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 12 replay challenges this season, going 7-5.....their last challenge came on 5/28 vs. Chicago-NL as an out call at second base involving Willy Adames stood.

TODAY'S STARTER: #54 - LHP ROBERT GASSER [4gs, 2-0, 1.96]

GASSER AT A GLANCE: Robert Gasser, who turned 25 yesterday, will be making his fifth start of the season....Gasser last started last Monday vs. Chicago-NL and received no decision in the Brewers' 5-1 win (6ip, 3h, Or, 0bb, 7k, 81 pitches).....the team is 4-0 in his starts.....he has 2 quality starts.....opponents are batting .250 (21-for-84, 0hr).....Gasser entered the 2024 season as the sixth-best prospect in the organization according to *Baseball America*.....he went 0-1 with a 5.25 ERA in 3 starts at Triple-A Nashville (12ip, 12h, 7r, 7er, 6bb, 17k, 4hr).....he was on Nashville's injured list from 3/29-4/23 with left elbow inflammation....Gasser was acquired from San Diego with three other players on 8/1/22 as part of the trade for LHP Josh Hader....he was selected by the Padres in Competitive Balance Round B of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft from the University of Houston and attended the University of New Mexico and San Joaquin Delta College.

STEP ON THE GAS! Robert Gasser has a 1.96 ERA, trailing only **Brandon Woodruff** (1.52) and **Freddy Peralta** (1.59) for the lowest ERA in franchise history by a pitcher through his first four Major League appearances in which all were starts.

LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON: Robert's father, Jim, was also a pitcher....Jim Gasser was drafted by Milwaukee (1984) and San Francisco (1986) but did not sign due to injury.

LAST SEASON: Gasser was named International League Pitcher of the Year and Brewers Co-Pitcher of the Year (with RHP Carlos Rodríguez) as he went 9-1 with a 3.79 ERA in 26 games/25 starts at Triple-A Nashville.....was an International League All-Star....led all of Triple-A Baseball and ranked second among Brewers Minor League pitchers in strikeouts (166).

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Is 16-14 with a 3.79 ERA in 62 games/61 starts (299.1ip, 272h, 142r, 126er, 110bb, 369k, 28hr).

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 2-0 with a 0.53 ERA in 3 starts (17ip, 1er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 0-0 with a 6.00 ERA in 1 start (6ip, 4er).

CAREER vs. WHITE SOX: Gasser has not faced the Chicago, Illinois White Sox.
