PLAYER'S BALL: The Giants and Braves meet for a second straight week, just nine days since their last matchup...SF swept the rain-altered, two-game series in Atlanta last week (Tue-Wed), outscoring them 14-7...the final game of that series was postponed due to weather and will be played on August 31 at Truist Park.

- ▶ The two wins last week put the Giants at 7-1 (.875) against the Braves since the start of last season...according to *Stats, LLC*, it's the fourth-best record by any MLB team against an opponent in the same league over that span (also: Yankees, 12-0 vs. Royals; Orioles, 9-0 vs. White Sox; Padres, 9-1 vs. Braves).
- ▶ SF swept its three-game series with Atlanta here at Oracle Park last June...that sweep marked the Giants' first home series win over the Braves since 2022.
- ▶ Overall, the Giants have won four of their last seven games at home dating to June 10.

NOW WHAT'S COOLER THAN BEING COOL? ICE COLD!: **C Drew Cavanaugh** will be making his MLB debut today as the starting catcher for SF...the 24-year-old was slashing .330/.445/.571 in 32 games with the River Cats with nine doubles, six homers, 22 RBI and 18 walks.

SHAKE IT LIKE A POLAROID PICTURE: **OF Victor Bericoto** showed off his power with a home run and an outfield assist for a second straight game yesterday...Bericoto's homer yesterday was nearly identical to his walk-off home run on Wednesday, with both registering a 108.7 mph exit velocity and traveling exactly 445 ft to center field.

- ▶ The Maracay, Venezuela native became the first Giants rookie in *Statcast* era (since 2015) to record a homer 445' or longer in two straight games...he's the first Giant overall to do so since **Mitch Haniger** (April 29-30, 2023 at SD in CMX) and first to do it stateside since **Austin Slater** (July 3-4, 2021 at AZ).
- ▶ Additionally, his outfield assist in the 3rd inning that registered at 94.2 mph, marking the hardest thrown outfield assist by a Giant this season and the hardest thrown outfield assist by a Giants left fielder since Slater had a 99.6 mph assist on July 24, 2018.
- ▶ Bericoto is the first Giants rookie outfielder since at least 1920 to have an outfield assist and a home run in consecutive games...he's also the first overall Giants outfielder to do so since **Dusty Rhodes** (Aug. 31-Sept. 1, 1953) (*SportsRadar*).
- ▶ Lastly, Bericoto became one of seven MLB rookies in the modern era (since 1900) with both a homer and an outfield assist in back-to-back games, joining Joe DiMaggio (1936), Devon White (1987), Jim Edmonds (1994), Carl Everett (1995), Hunter Renfroe (2017) and Christopher Morel (2022) (*Stats, LLC*).

SO FRESH, SO CLEAN: **OF Jung Hoo Lee** tripled with the bases loaded in the 6th inning to put SF at 18 triples this season, second-most in the Majors behind the Diamondbacks (19).

- ▶ The last time the Giants has as many triples before the halfway point of the season was 10 years ago, when they recorded 25 triples through 80 games in 2016.
- ▶ Paired with the homers by **IF Willy Adames** and Bericoto, the Giants now have 258 extra-base hits this season, tied for second-most in MLB behind only the Nationals (263).
- ▶ Lee himself is hitting an MLB-best .453 (43-for-95) with 13 extra-base hits, 13 RBI, 21 runs scored and five stolen bases in 24 game since coming off the IL on May 29.
- ▶ Overall, Lee's .332 average entering play today is second-best in MLB behind only Miami's Otto Lopez (.340).

ROSES: Giants starters have been a bright spot for SF as of late...after a rocky start to the season, SF's rotation has a 3.58 ERA in June, which is fourth-best in the Majors behind only the Marlins (3.36), Brewers (3.52) and Nationals (3.53).

- ▶ According to *Stats, LLC*, no Giants starting pitcher has allowed more than one home run in a game since May 18...SF's streak of 32 consecutive games without having their starter allow multiple homers is the second-longest streak in the Majors this season, trailing the Brewers' 34 such games from April 30-June 7).

T-MAC: Was the Giants' 11th-round pick in 2019 out of George County High School in Lucedale, MS...originally committed to South Alabama for college ball before signing...made his debut with SF during the final game of the 2024 season and has made appearances at the Major League level in each season since.

LAST TIME OUT: Turned in his shortest outing of the season last Saturday in Miami as the Giants lost 6-3 to the Marlins...he lasted only 3.0+ innings (facing three hitters in the 4th inning but recording no outs), allowing five runs (three earned) on three hits while walking three batters and also hitting three batters...McDonald was lucky in the sense that only one of the six free baserunners he permitted came around to score (one of the walks came with the bases loaded, however, and did walk in a run).

A FEW BUMPS: After pitching extremely well in his first three outings while filling in for the injured **Logan Webb** (2-0 with a 2.37 ERA with SF' going 3-0 in those outings), McDonald has gone 0-5 with a 6.75 ERA (20er, 26.2ip) in his last six starts with the Giants winning only one of those games...McDonald hasn't escaped the 4th inning in three of those six outings and in each of his last two starts entering play today.

DIGGING DEEPER: During this rough stretch, batters have slashed .311/.432/.393 (.826 OPS) off his sinker compared to .255/.300/.319 (.619 OPS) off the sinker in his first three outings...he also has an 13.3% walk rate during these last six starts (3.9% walk rate in his first three starts).

VS. ATLANTA: Will face the Braves for the first time in his career this evening...growing in Lucedale, MS, the Braves were the closest Major League team to his hometown.

EXTREME SPLITS: In his nine starts at the MLB level this year, McDonald has limited right-handed hitters to a .171 average with a .472 OPS and just two extra-base hits allowed (both doubles)...lefties, however, have a .312 average with a .941 OPS off McDonald...lefties have seven doubles, a triple and four homers...Atlanta's starting lineup versus a right-handed pitcher typically features five left-handed hitters and one switch-hitter.

GROUNDING: Entering this start he owns a 57.0% groundball rate, which sits in the 95th percentile among Major Leaguers...his 57.0% groundball rate is fourth-best in the Majors if you lower the innings threshold to 45.0...he trails PHI's Christopher Sánchez (58.2%), WSH's Brad Lord (57.4%) and LAA's Jack Kochanowicz (57.2%).

ORDER UP...: He's been most effective the first time through the order this year with hitters going a combined 12-for-72 (.167) with a .611 OPS...it goes upward from there with opposing hitters hitting .269 with a .731 OPS the second time through and .343 with an .886 OPS the third time through.

ON THE HOME FRONT: While his 6.10 home ERA (14er, 20.2ip) dwarfs his 3.96 road ERA (11er, 25.0ip), McDonald actually has limited opposing hitters at Oracle Park to a .657 OPS compared to a .774 OPS on the road...similarly, hitters are hitting .218 off him here at home versus .268 on the road...half of McDonald's 14 earned runs allowed at home came in one inning (the 4th inning on May 22 vs. the White Sox)...outside of that one inning, McDonald has allowed seven earned runs in 20.0 home innings (3.15 ERA).

IN TRIPLE-A IN 2026: Went 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (9er, 15.0ip), 12 strikeouts and a 1.53 WHIP in five Triple-A games (four starts) for Sacramento...was much better at home (1-0 with a 2.79 ERA in three games) than on the road (0-1 with a 10.13 ERA in two games).

TOMORROW'S STARTER **LOGAN WEBB RHP** #62
2026 RECORD: 4-5, 3.35 ERA
 ▶ Threw his fourth career complete game last Sunday at Miami...suffered the loss despite working 8.0 innings with two runs on five hits with five strikeouts as the offense was unable to pick him up in a 2-1 loss to the Marlins.
 ▶ Since returning from the IL (right knee bursitis) on May 29, he has a 1.02 ERA (4er, 35.1ip) with 28 strikeouts, a .172 BAA and 0.74 WHIP in five starts...he lowered his ERA from 5.06 prior to his IL stint to a current 3.35 mark.
 ▶ Will face the Braves for the 10th time in his career...is 4-1 with a 2.59 ERA in the nine starts and has a 1.74 ERA in his last three starts vs. them dating to 2024.
