WEEKEND: The Giants look to secure a series win tonight in Game 2 of this three-game series vs. the Pirates...SF is 2-2 this homestand after taking last night's series opener (5-2) following a 1-2 record vs. the Padres Monday-Wednesday.

- ▶ SF has lost three straight series and eight of its last 10 games dating to the start of its last road trip on April 28.
- ▶ The Giants enter today eight games under the .500 mark...prior to this season, the last time SF was eight games under .500 was on September 18, 2022.
- ▶ The Giants are now 10-4 in games that they score four-or-more runs in a game...SF's three runs in the 7th last night were its most in an inning since April 26 vs. Miami (three runs in the 7th).
- ▶ SF's 15-23 (.395) record entering play today is tied for worst in the National League with the New York Mets...only the Angels have a worse record (15-24, .385).

KNOCK KNOCK: The Giants and Cleveland Guardians completed a trade today, with MiLB LHP **Matt Wilkinson** joining the Giants and SF also receiving Cleveland's 29th overall pick in the 2026 draft (Competitive Balance Round A) in exchange for **C Patrick Bailey**.

- ▶ Wilkinson is currently rated as the Guardians' 13th-best prospect, according to *Fan-Graphs*...the 23-year-old is 1-2 with a 1.59 ERA (5er, 28.1ip) and 36 strikeouts over six starts with Double-A Akron this season.
- ▶ Bailey, a two-time Gold Glove winner (2024 and 2025), spent parts of four seasons with SF (2023-2026) and slashed .224/.282/.329 with 22 home runs over 383 career games.

SELF CARE: In addition to the trade of **C Patrick Bailey**, the Giants made the following roster moves today.

- ▶ **RHP Logan Webb** placed on the 15-day IL with right knee bursitis (retro to May 6).
- ▶ **RHP Trevor McDonald** (#72) recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **C Logan Porter** (#13) selected from Triple-A Sacramento.

THE SPINS: RHP **Landen Roupp** draws the start tonight looking to rebound after a loss his last time out (four earned runs on eight hits and two walks at Tampa Bay on May 2).

- ▶ The Giants are 5-2 in Roupp's seven starts, with him factoring in the decision in all seven outings...he has struck out six or more batters in six of his seven outings.
- ▶ The righty has yet to face the Pirates in his career...only three active Pirates have history vs. Roupp in the Majors with Marcell Ozuna going 1-for-5, Brandon Lowe going 0-for-1 and Ryan O'Hearn going 1-for-1.
- ▶ Roupp's sinker has a run value of +7 in 2026, making it tied for the fourth-most valuable pitch in baseball this season per *Baseball Savant*...the Pirates are slashing .303/.400/.402 vs. sinkers this season.

LOVE LOST: Since 2021 the Giants are 8-8 here at home against the Pirates and have lost three of the five completed series in that time.

- ▶ Since its opening in 2000, the Giants have a losing record to the Pirates here at Oracle Park (38-43, .469)...the only other NL team SF has a sub-.500 record against in Oracle Park history is the Dodgers (111-115).
- ▶ Pirates starter Braxton Ashcraft's curveball has a +5 run value while accounting for a .104 opposing batting average and 25 strikeouts...the Giants' .266 batting average vs. curveballs in 2026 is tops in MLB while their .753 OPS vs. the pitch is third-best.
- ▶ Opponents have an .851 OPS and .345 batting average (10x29) on the first pitch of a plate appearance vs. Ashcraft this year...SF is slashing .290/.299/.473 on the first pitch in 2026.

GOOD NEWS: IF Rafael Devers has homered in two straight games and is currently on a team-best eight-game hitting streak.

- ▶ Since the start of the streak (Game 2 of a doubleheader on April 30), he is batting .346 (9x26) with four runs, two doubles, two homers, six RBI and a 1.041 OPS.
- ▶ Over his first 27 games, Devers was slashing .242/.266/.355 with a double, two homers, seven RBI and a .620 OPS vs. fastballs...in his last 11 games vs. fastballs, Devers is slashing .368/.409/.842 with three doubles, two homers, six RBI and a 1.251 OPS.

WITH SAN FRANCISCO: Roupp is in his third season with San Francisco and made his third career Opening Day roster...he is slated to make his eighth start of the season tonight after going 5-2 through his first seven starts.

LAST START: Saw his career-high four-game winning streak come to an end against the Rays...pitched 4.1 innings and took the loss, allowing four earned runs on eight hits while striking out six.

VS. PITTSBURGH: He'll be making his first career appearance against the Pirates.

UP IN THE RANKS: Prior to his tough start against Tampa Bay, Roupp's 2.55 ERA was tied for fifth-best in the NL...the underlying stats suggest the onus wasn't completely on him, as he still carries a FIP of 2.70, which ranks eighth in the Majors amongst qualified starters.

OF THE HIGHEST VALUE: Ranks in the 97th percentile of the league in pitching run value (10)...in terms of run value, his sinker is tied for the second-most effective pitch in the majors with an RV of seven... he also ranks in the 98th percentile in hard hit percentage (23.5%), and is the only primary starting pitcher in the Majors that has yet to give up a barreled ball this season.

STOPPER: Roupp has become a stopper for SF...dating back to last season, Roupp is 8-6 following a loss with a 3.19 ERA (32er, 90.1ip).

ROAD WARRIOR: Through the early going this season, has a 2.01 ERA in four starts on the road (3-1, 22.1ip, 5er) compared to a 4.67 ERA at home (inflated after a tough start vs. the Mets)...this is the opposite of 2025, as he had a 2.63 ERA (14er, 48.0ip) in nine starts at Oracle Park compared to a 4.76 ERA (31er, 58.2ip) in 13 starts on the road.

MIXING IT UP: In 2025, Roupp's curveball (thrown 35.7% of the time) was very effective, as opponents were just 29x147 (.197) with 49 strikeouts and a 35.8% whiff rate against it...this season, he's mixing his pitches more, as his curveball usage has dropped to 28.8%...it's been just as effective, as opponents are 9x47 (.191) off the curve with a 33.3% whiff rate... the big change is his cutter usage, which has increased from 6.7% in 2025 to 12.4% through six starts in 2026.

2025 SEASON: Was the Giants' fourth starter for most of the season...had his year cut short after suffering a left knee bone bruise in his start on August 20 at San Diego...the injury shut his season down and he went 7-7 with a 3.80 ERA (45er, 106.2ip), 102 strikeouts and 45 walks allowed in 22 starts (eight quality outings)...the Giants went 12-10 in his outings.

AIN'T NOBODY GOT TIME FOR THAT: With the bases empty, Roupp averaged 11.9 seconds between pitches in 2025, which was tied for the second-quickest in the Majors...Cincinnati's Brent Suter was quickest with only 11.5 seconds between pitches with the bases empty...Roupp has been a tad slower this year, averaging 12.9 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, which is still sixth-fastest in MLB...league average thus far in 2026 is 16.1 seconds.

INJURED LIST: Last year, he missed a total of 54 games (approximately nine starts) with right elbow inflammation (missed 19 games) and a left knee inflammation/bone bruise (35 games) missed.

2026 RECORD: 1-4, 5.00 ERA

- ▶ Will make his eighth start of the season tomorrow...tossed 5.1 scoreless innings with four hits, five strikeouts and a walk last Sunday at Tampa Bay.
- ▶ Will face the Pirates for the 14th time in his career and first since 2022...is 5-4 with a 3.84 ERA in the 13 starts.
- ▶ In four starts at Oracle Park, Mahle has a 2.91 ERA (7er, 21.2ip), .235 BAA and .657 opponents' OPS.

#47 RYAN BORUCKI ▶ LHP *(bohr-RUCK-ee)*

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

Last Game: 5/5 vs. SD; 1.0ip, 2h, r, er (20 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are 4-for-24 (.167) with three walks and seven strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .181 clip (71-for-393) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 11-for-23 with five XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Played for Pittsburgh from 2023-2025, pitching in 87 games.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP *(BROO-baker)*

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 5/5 vs. SD; 1.0ip, 2h, r, er, 2bb, k (38 pitches)

- ▶ Nine of his 12 appearances this year have been scoreless (2.65 ERA).
- ▶ Has thrown 8.1 scoreless innings in six appearances on the road...has a 5.19 ERA (5er, 8.2ip) in six games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in eight of 12 contests (5.82 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 11-for-37 (.297) with four XBHs off him while lefties are 5-for-25 (.200).
- ▶ Six of his 12 appearances have been 1.1+ innings.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Pirates in the 6th round in 2015 out of University of Akron...made his debut with Pittsburgh in 2020 and spent three seasons with PIT from 2020-22, appearing in 63g (61 starts).

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

Last Game: 5/8 vs. PIT; 1.0ip, bb (11 pitches)

- ▶ Has surrendered three runs (two earned) in 15.1ip this year (1.17 ERA).
- ▶ Has not allowed an earned run in his last 9 games (7.0ip, 3h, 1r, 6bb, 2k).
- ▶ Lefties are just 1-for-16 (.062) against him this season, and 18-for-99 in his career (.182).
- ▶ His 23.3% hard hit rate ranks in the top 2% of MLB.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP *(kill-EE-en)*

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 5/8 vs. PIT; 1.0ip, h, r, er, 2bb (35 pitches)

- ▶ Earned his first career save Monday night despite allowing a homer in SF's 3-2 win...has allowed a run in each of his last two outings after allowing just one run in his first 14 games.
- ▶ Has a 9.53 K/9ip ratio.
- ▶ Owns a 25.7% strikeout rate but also has a 14.3% walk rate...owns a .208 xBA.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are just 5-for-34 (.147) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 4-for-24 (.167) with two homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#63 JOEL PEGUERO RHP *(jo-EL peh-GAIR-oh)*

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 5/6 vs. SD; 1.0ip, k (8 pitches)

- ▶ Activated on Tuesday after 10 rehab games with Triple-A Sacramento...missed SF's first 35 games while recovering from a left hamstring strain that also held him out of most of Spring Training.
- ▶ Has tossed 2.0 scoreless frames since returning from the IL, allowing just one hit so far.
- ▶ Had a 4.82 ERA (5er, 9.1ip) with 11 strikeouts and a 0.86 WHIP in the 10 rehab outings.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut in 2025 with SF after signing with the org. prior to the season on an MiLB contract...posted a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA (6er, 22.1ip), 17 strikeouts and a 1.03 WHIP over 17 games.
- ▶ His sinker averaged 99.8 mph and his four-seamer 99.9 mph last season...his slider averaged 91.6 mph and accounted for 12 of his 15 strikeouts.

#57 GREGORY SANTOS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter

Last Game: 5/5 vs. SD; 2.0ip, 2h, 2r, 2er, bk (28 pitches)

- ▶ Had his contract selected April 29 in Philadelphia.
- ▶ Started the year in Triple-A and had a 2.45 ERA (3er, 11.0ip) with three walks, six 6k's and a .220 BAA in eight games with Sacramento.
- ▶ Touched 100.1 mph a couple of times in Sacramento this season...averaged 97.0 mph with his fastballs (four-seamer & sinker).
- ▶ Signed a minor league deal with SF on Dec. 19 and received an invite to the Giants camp...made four appearances in the spring (5er, 3.1ip).
- ▶ Made the Mariners Opening Day roster and appeared in eight games out of the bullpen, going 1-1 with a 5.14 ERA (4er, 7.0ip) before undergoing a cartilage cleanup surgery to address a knee inflammation...was sidelined until September.
- ▶ In his second stint with the Giants...was originally acquired by SF from Boston on July 25, 2017 as part of the return for IF Eduardo Nuñez...made his debut with the Giants on April 22, 2021 and appeared in five games with SF between 2021-22 (8er, 5.2ip, 5k)...was dealt to the White Sox following the 2022 season.

#74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 5/6 vs. SD; 1.0ip, 2h, 2r, 2er, 2bb (29 pitches)

- ▶ Failed to convert each of his last two save chances and is 3-for-6 on the year.
- ▶ Last season, his 87.0 mph avg. exit velo ranked in top 7% of MLB...this season it sits at 84.2 mph, which is tenth-best in the Majors.
- ▶ Batters are 4-for-23 in ABs that end with his slider (.174) and 12-for-34 (.353) in ones that end with his sinker...last season, batters hit .277 (41x148) off his sinker and .207 (18x87) off his slider.
- ▶ In his 45 career save opportunities, Walker owns a 6.17 ERA (29er, 42.1ip)...in his 162 games in a non-save situation, Walker owns a 2.33 ERA (45er, 174.0ip).

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

Last Game: 5/8 vs. PIT; 1.0ip, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Leads the team with eight holds, which is tied for the fourth-most in the Majors.
- ▶ 13 of his 17 appearances this year have been scoreless.
- ▶ Opponents are just 7-for-53 (.132) off him this year.
- ▶ Batters are just 3-for-31 with 12 K's off his splitter this season.
- ▶ His 1.71 xERA is fourth-best in the Majors among relievers behind Mason Miller (0.62), Bryan Baker (1.62) and Dylan Lee (1.68).
- ▶ Winn's .153 xBA is sixth-best among qualified relievers.

- ▶ Has a hit in six of his last eight games (7x31) after going 1x33 in eight games prior...still, is just 7-for-55 (.127) with one walk, a .288 OPS and 19 strikeouts over his last 14 games.
- ▶ Snapped a streak of 16 straight games with a strikeout yesterday... his 47 strikeouts are tied for seventh-most in the NL.
- ▶ 14 of his 30 hits this year have been for extra-bases (11 2B, three HR) but has one XBH since April 18 (a double last Sunday in TB)... the 11 doubles are tied for second-most in the NL.

#1 LUIS ARRAEZ ▶ IF
