RECENT REDBIRDS: The defending 2019 NL Central Champion Cardinals and division-rival Chicago Cubs continue their five-game series on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball at Wrigley Field tonight ... St. Louis is 4-2 on its current road trip through Cincinnati (2-1) and Chicago (2-1) after sweeping a doubleheader from the Cubs yesterday (first twinbill sweep of the Cubs since 2002 at Wrigley Field), and began the day in 2nd place in the NL Central, 2.5 games back of Chicago.

FLIGHT PATTERN: After a 16-day layoff from July 30-Aug. 14, (the longest midseason shutdown for a team in MLB history), St. Louis is in the midst of playing 53 games (11 doubleheaders) over the final 44 days this season (55 games in 45 days, if nec.) ... Yesterday began a stretch of 19 games over a 14-day span (5 DH) ... The Cardinals return to Busch Stadium for back-to-back twinbills against Minnesota (Sept. 8) and Detroit (Sept. 10) with the club's final off-day in between.

THE WINDY CITY: The Cardinals will have played 15 games in St. Louis and 13 games in the city of Chicago after the conclusion of this five-game series ... The last time the Cardinals were in the Windy City (August 15-19), they become the 3rd MLB team in history to play eight consecutive games vs. the White Sox (2-1) and/or Cubbies (2-3) in the city of Chicago, joining the 1916 Philadelphia Athletics and 1935 New York Yankees ... That road trip also marked the most consecutive games for any MLB team in any city since the 1952 Pittsburgh Pirates (eight in a row in New York City at Ebbets Field and Polo Grounds) ... Since 1892 when the Cardinals entered the NL, the 2020 season marks the first time in history that the Cubs will not play a regular season game in St. Louis (*Elias*).

ESPN SUNDAY NIGHT BASEBALL: The Cardinals are 57-59 all-time on the nationally televised ESPN Sunday Night Game of the Week ... Tonight is the Cardinals' only appearance on ESPN Sunday Night this season (went 0-4 in 2019).

WRIGLEY NIGHTS: The Cardinals and Cubs tonight are scheduled to play their 71st night game all-time at the Friendly Confines since lights were installed in 1988. The Cubs lead the series 45-25, with St. Louis 12-14 on Wrigley Nights since 2014.

GOLD NUGGETS: Paul Goldschmidt ranks among MLB leaders in OBP (.472, 1st), BA (.323, 9th), walks (27, T4th), PA/walk (4.63, 1st), Pitches/PA (4.31, 11th), BB/SO (1.69, 2nd) & line drive pct. (33.3, 10th) ... Reached base safely in 28 of 31 games ... Is the only MLB player with 20 or more walks and 16 or fewer strikeouts ... Leads MLB in BA (.500, 7-14) when leading off an inning and ranks 2nd with 0 Outs (.435, 10-23) ... Tied with Stan Musial (1954) for 5th-most walks (27) in team's first 31 games in franchise history, trailing Albert Pujols (32 - 2008), Miller Huggins (29 - 1912), Jim Edmonds (29 - 2000), and Scott Rolen (28 - 2003) ... Ranks 1st in OPS (1.035) and 3rd in SLG (.602), BA (.325) and OBP (.433) among all-time active MLB leaders vs. the Cubs.

FIVE ALIVE: St. Louis (13-0) is the only undefeated team in MLB when scoring 5 of more runs in a game this season (64-10 in 2019).

RUN PREVENTION: St. Louis pitching leads MLB in average against (.198), while its starting rotation (10 pitchers) paces all of MLB in opponent batting average (.190), slugging (.338), OPS (.615), and BABIP (.211), and is T1st in WHIP (1.06) ... **Austin Gomber** yesterday became the 10th Cardinals starter this season, T6thmost in MLB and the club's most since 11 starting pitchers in 2018.

BASES FULL OF BIRDS: In bases loaded situations in 2020, the Cardinals lead MLB in batting average (.472, 17-36) and on-base pct. (.524), and trail only the Padres (1.143, 1.621) in both slugging pct. (.806) and OPS (1.329).

BIRD BYTES: Happy 24th birthday Jordan Hicks ... Paul DeJong has 2 HR and 7 RBI through the first six games of the road trip ... Since August 14, the Cardinals lead MLB with 273 plate appearances with RISP (53-218, .249/.380/.338) ... St. Louis has scored 55 of 136 runs (40%) with two outs ... Dakota Hudson leads MLB in ground ball pct. (58.2%) since making his MLB debut (July 28, 2018).

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (Sept 6, 2016): The Cardinals homer five times in a come-from-behind, 9-7 win over Pittsburgh at PNC Park, which included three homers during a four-run ninth inning. Down to his final strike with two outs, Matt Carpenter's game-tying, pinch hit solo blast was St. Louis' 15th pinch hit homer of the season, a new MLB record. Yadier Molina's first inning grand slam pushed the club's consecutive game homer streak to 25, tying an NL record.

Paul DeJong graduated from Antioch (III.) Comm. High School...played college baseball at Illinois State University (2013-15) while majoring in biochemistry and pre-medicine.

Kolten Wong (August 16, 2013 at Wrigley Field), Dakota Hudson (July 28, 2018 at Busch Stadium), Tyler O'Neill (April 19, 2018 at Wrigley Field), Andrew Knizner (June 2, 2019 at Busch Stadium), Tommy Edman (June 8, 2019 at Wrigley Field), and Johan Oviedo (Aug. 19, 2020 at Wrigley Field) made MLB debuts against the Cubs.

Mike Maddux's brother, Greg Maddux, was a Hall of Fame pitcher for Chicago for parts of 10 seasons (1986-92, '04-06)...originally selected by the Cubs in the 2nd round of the 1984 MLB draft.

Tommy Edman (junior) and **Nico Hoerner** (freshman) were teammates at Stanford Univ. in 2016.

Jason Heyward played the 2015 season with St. Louis...originally traded by Atlanta with Jordan Walden to St. Louis for Tyrell Jenkins and Shelby Miller (Nov. 17, 2014).

As compensation for the departure of Heyward signing with the Cubs, **Dakota Hudson** was selected by St. Louis with the 34th overall pick in the first round of the 2016 MLB draft.

Cubs VP of Scouting **Dan Kantrovitz** previously served as the Cardinals Scouting Director (2012-14)...was also a Cardinals 25th round draft pick out of Brown University in 2001...took his first job in MLB as the Cardinals Scouting Coord. (2004).

Cubs Catching Coach **Mike Borzello** played four seasons (1991-94) in the Cardinals minor league system....originally selected by St. Louis in 1991.

Daniel Descalso played parts of five seasons in a Cardinals uniform (2010-14)...appeared in 44 postseason games and was a member of the 2011 World Champion Cardinals...originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2007 MLB Draft.

Cardinals broadcaster and Hall of Fame outfielder **Jim Edmonds** played part of 2008 with the Cubs.

Rowan Wick was selected as a catcher in the 9th round of the 2012 MLB draft...played/pitched six minor league seasons in the Cardinals org. before selected off waivers by San Diego (Feb. 16, 2018).

- His .696 win pct. (16-7) was the best by Cardinals rookie since Dick Hughes (.727, 16-6) in 1964, while his 3.35 ERA was best by Cardinals rookie since Shelby Miller (3.06) in 2013. Both marks trailed Atlanta's Mike Soroka (.765, 2.68) among NL rookies.
- Was 9-2 with a 2.75 ERA in 17 starts at Busch Stadium this season with the Cardinals going 13-4 (.765) in his home starts. His nine home wins are the most by a St. Louis rookie since Shelby Miller had 10 in 2013, while his .818 winning pct. ranks 5th among all Cardinals rookie starters and highest since Harvey Haddix (.867, 13-2) in 1953.
- Hurled 174.2 innings in 2019, marking the most innings pitched by a St. Louis rookie in the regular season since Rick Ankiel had 175.0 IP in 2000.
