The Brewers tonight are looking to post their fourth season-high 4-game winning streak....the team also won 4 consecutive games from 3/29-4/2, 4/9-4/13 and 4/17-4/21.

By the Slimmest of Margins

The Brewers are 7-1 (.875) in 1-run games this season, best in the majors.

They're Out of Our League

The Brewers are 49-26 (.653) during Interleague Play since 2022, trailing only the Dodgers (48-22, .686)....the team has gone 6-3 in Interleague Play this season.

Yankee Doodle Dandies

The Brewers are hosting the Yankees at American Family Field for just the fourth time ever (also 2005, 2014 and 2022)....the team has won all of its series here against the Yankees, taking 2 of 3 games each time, and look for another series victory tonight.

Fine 'Penmanship

The Brewers lead the National League with a 2.60 bullpen ERA....the bullpen has posted a 1.25 ERA (64.2ip, 9er) in the last 15 games....Brewers relievers have gone 16.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 5-4 at home, going 1-1-1 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 12-4 on the road, going 4-0-1 in series play....their 12-4 record ties the best road start in franchise history (also 2014).

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

COACHES: First base coach **Quintin Berry** (4th season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (3rd season), assistant pitching coach **Jim Henderson** (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (6th season), third base coach **Jason Lane** (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator **Walker McKinven** (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach **Ozzie Timmons** (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff....

Rickie Weeks (associate manager), **Daniel de Mondesert** (assistant coach) and **Charlie Greene** (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made six replay challenges this season, going 5-1....their last challenge came on 4/24 at Pittsburgh as a safe call at first base involving Edward Olivares in the ninth inning stood.
