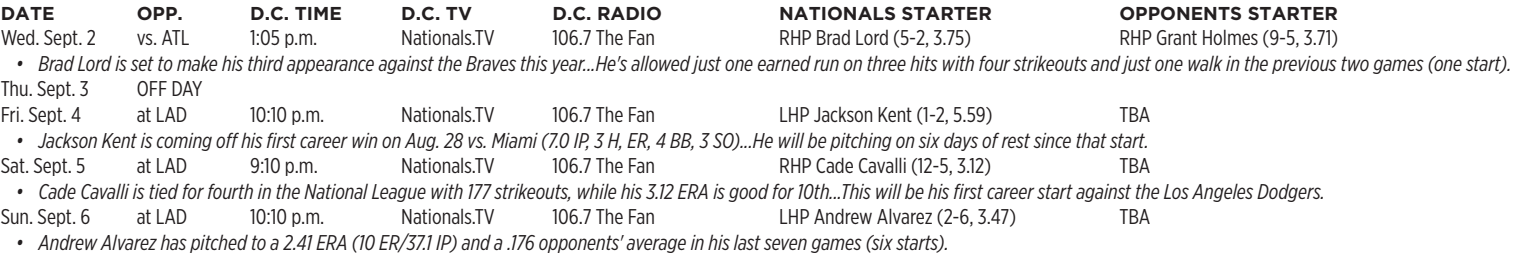

CAREER

Versatile right-hander made his Major League debut in 2025, seeing time as both a starter and a reliever.

- Is 4-9 with a 4.98 ERA in 23 career starts and 6-3 with one save and a 3.42 ERA in 58 career outings out of the bullpen.
- Earned the "Nationals Way" Award in 2024 after leading the organization with a 2.43 ERA...Was one of just two pitchers in Minor League Baseball to win 10 games, pitch to an ERA less than 2.50 and strike out 100.
- Was selected in the 18th round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of South Florida.

LAST APPEARANCE

Lord tossed 2.1 innings of one-run ball with two hits and one walk and four strikeouts against the Miami Marlins on August 29...He took a no-decision in the 5-4 win.

vs. ATLANTA

Lord is set to make his third career start and eighth career appearance against the Atlanta Braves...He has pitched to a 2.86 ERA (7 ER/22.0 IP) with 20 strikeouts against Atlanta.

AS A RELIEVER

Lord is 5-2 with a 3.82 ERA (26 ER/61.1 IP) with 57 strikeouts, four holds and one save in 29 games out of the bullpen this year.

- In 10 games from May 8-June 13, Lord went 3-0 and allowed only one earned run across 21.1 innings pitched...He held opponents to a .137 average (10-for-73) and struck out 21 hitters during that span.

Began the season in the bullpen before transitioning back to the starter role on April 8...Made six starts before returning to the bullpen...Became a starter again on July 22 and finished the season in the rotation

- Finished 10-4 with a 2.43 ERA, 135 strikeouts and 49 walks across 25 starts between High-A Wilmington, Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester.
- Was twice named Eastern League Pitcher of the Month (May and June) and earned one Eastern League Pitcher of the Week award (June 17).
- Was 5-0 with an 0.87 ERA (3 ER/31.0 IP) May...Was 3-0 with an 0.69 ERA (2 ER/26.0 IP with 27 strikeouts in June before he was promoted to Rochester.
- Struck out 10 in 7.0 scoreless innings and allowed only two hits against Bowie on June 12.
