Andy Pages (LAD) cashed in two home runs for the Glendale Desert Dogs on Tuesday night, driving in two of his team's 20 runs in a victory over the Salt River Rafters. Pages currently holds an AFL slash of .333/.400/.667, and is tied for the AFL lead with two home runs.

T.J. Sikkema (KC) tossed four innings of one-run baseball for the Surprise Saguaros on Tuesday, collecting a win in his team's 3-2 victory over the Mesa Solar Sox. Sikkema allowed two hits and two walks, holding an even 1.00 WHIP on the afternoon.

Austin Martin (MIN) had a five-RBI showing for the Glendale Desert Dogs on Tuesday, going 4-for-6 with a double and home run. Through six games of action, Martin is 12-for-24 in the Fall League with a .500/.581/.708 slash.

Ryan Middendorf (MIL) pitched two innings in relief for the Glendale Desert Dogs on Tuesday, striking out five batters in two innings of work. The right-hander worked around a hit and walk, lowering his Fall League ERA to a 3.86 in 4 2/3 combined innings.

Jose Caballero (SEA) went 3-for-5 on Tuesday for the Peoria Javelinas, driving in four runs in his team's 10-6 victory over the Scottsdale Scorpions. Caballero is now 5-for-11 to begin his 2022 Fall League campaign; this year is his third in the AFL.

The Surprise Saguaros have maintained the best record (7-1), run differential (+17) and fewest runs allowed (34) in the Fall League through eight days of game action. Surprise has allowed 18 fewer runs than the league's second-lowest runs allowed total (Peoria, 52).

Arizona Fall League Alumni Spotlight

Albert Pujols (Scottsdale Scorpions, 2000) was selected in the 13th round of the 1999 MLB Draft out of Metropolitan Community College-Maple Woods (MO). He made his way to the Fall League just months before his eventual MLB debut with the St. Louis Cardinals in 2001, going on to play a combined 22 seasons with the Cardinals, Angels and Dodgers. A three-time MVP, 11-time All-Star, two-time Gold Glove Award winner, six-time Silver Slugger and two-time World Series champion, Pujols hit his 700th career home run in September of this year. He posted a career .296/.374/.544 batting slash in 3,080 MLB games.
